SERIES HISTORY (UNK LEADS 17-12)

* Last year in Kearney the Griffons scored the final 19 points to post a 25-17 victory. MWSU out gained UNK by a 370-369 margin and took advantage of three Loper turnovers

* Mo West is averaging 34 points per game to win nine of the last 10 in the series

* The Lopers lone win in the last 31 years over the Griffs came in the 2017 season opener, 14-3. It was the debut for UNK head coach *Josh Lynn* and MWSU head coach *Matt Williamson*

COACH MATT WILLIAMSON (3RD YEAR/17-14)

A former Griffon All-American defensive linemen, Williamson most recently was defensive coordinator at FCS-member Stephen F. Austin State (Texas).

Taking over the reigns of the program in December 2017, he served as DC at FCS-member Central Arkansas in 2013 when the Bears beat the Lopers, 31-0. Williamson's other DC job came at Mo West in 2005-2006.

LOPER-GRIFFON SERIES HISTORY (UNK LEADS 17-12)

This has been a series of streaks as UNK winning the first four games, starting in 1970. After a 9-7 MWSU win in 1974, the Lopers won another four in a row before taking seven straight from 1982-1988.

More recently, the Griffons have won nine of the last 10 including all four played in St. Joe (1997, 2012, 2014 & 2016). Last year in Kearney, Mo West scored the final 17 points to record a 25-17 victory. The Lopers led 17-6 at the half but its second half drives resulted in two punts, two turnovers and a failed 4th down conversion. Overall MWSU out gained UNK by a 370-369 margin and had a plus three turnover margin.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

Missouri Western is averaging 41 points and 445 yards per game thanks to a 88% rate in the red zone (37 of 42) including 34 touchdowns. The Griffis also convert 45% of the time on third down.

A two deep with eight senior starters is led by quarterback *Wyatt Steigerwald* (#12), a transfer from NE Oklahoma A&M. He was the backup in 2018 but is making the most of his one-year as a starter, completing 58% of his passes for 227 yards per game, 25 TD's and only five INT's. Steigerwald has also been sacked just 13 times.

His favorite targets include sophomore TE *Cam Grandy* (#89), redshirt freshman WR *Devon Holmes* (#84) and *Cooper Burton* (#14). They've combined for 11 scoring receptions and 1,017 yards. Note Grandy isn't listed on the two deep this week.

Next the backfield features grad transfer *Markel Smith* (#6) and 5-7 junior *Shamar Griffith* (#3). Smith (5-11, 230 lbs.) was the 2015 F.O.Y. for Central Missouri with the pair combining for 14 scores and 1,348 yards. Finally five seniors dot the o-line and are led by 2018 1st-team All-MIAA pick and center *Hayden Eatinger* (#72).

DEFENSIVE NOTES

Just one senior -- WLB *Anthony Williams* (#23) -- starts on a unit giving up 28 points and 467 yards per game. Allowing 4.4 yards per carry, Mo West had forced 17 turnovers (10 fumbles & seven INT's) and has a 69% red zone rate (25 of 36). That includes giving up just 20 TD's.

Junior LB's *Evan Chohon* (78) and *Williams* (72) have combined for 150 tackles to rank among the MIAA individual leaders in stops. Williams has 6.5 TFL's, four PBU's and two fumble recoveries with Chohon at 5.0 TFL's.

The secondary features junior corner *Sam Webb* (#27) who has a team-best three INT's as well as nine PBU's. He is tied for second in the league in picks and has also made 24 tackles. Finally redshirt freshman end *Cameron Ravenell* (#44) and senior nose guard *Marquis Caldwell* (#43) have a combined 13 TFL's including 4.0 sacks.

SPECIAL TEAM NOTES

Junior kicker *Sam Aviles* (#19) has made 4 of 9 field goal attempts with his long effort being a 46-yarder vs. Washburn. He also is 44 of 45 on PAT's and averaging 56 yards kicking off with 11 touchbacks. Next, senior *Luke Theis* (#38) has a 38.7 punt average with 12 efforts landing inside the 20-yard line. Finally true freshman *Trey Vaval* (#31) is the MIAA leader in both punt (13.8) and kickoff (34.4) return averages. The 6-0, 165 lbs. defensive back brought back a kick 91 yards for a score vs. UCM.

NEBRASKA-KEARNEY FOOTBALL '19/COACH LYNN

Josh Lynn was named the 18th head football coach in Nebraska-Kearney history on Jan. 4th, 2017.

Lynn, who served as UNK's offensive coordinator in 2017, coaches the Loper slot receivers, cruisers (TE's) and running backs. Throughout his 17-year coaching career he has coordinated both sides of the ball and coached every position except the defensive line.

The Lynn era started with a bang as the Lopers upset Missouri Western State, 14-3, in the 2017 season-opener. It marked UNK's first August or September win since joining the MIAA in 2012. Kearney went on to beat Northeastern State, 42-27, and Missouri Southern State, 16-6, while battling two-time defending champion NW Missouri State before falling by just a 13-0 score. The Bearcats were ranked No. 1 in the nation at the time.

On the year, the Lopers were among the MIAA leaders in total defense (368 yards per game), rushing defense (125.4 ypg), fourth down conversion rate (57%) and fewest sacks allowed (19). Seven Lopers were named to the all-league team with 35 making the MIAA Academic Honor Roll (minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average). UNK also had one player, defensive end Jacob Bartling, named Academic All-District.

Last season saw the Lopers improve again, going 5-6 and beginning the fall with back-to-back wins. They capped their most successful season since 2012 with a last minute road victory, 17-16, in the season finale at Washburn. Subsequently, 11 Lopers were named to the All-MIAA team as UNK was among the national leaders in rushing, going for 30 touchdowns and 269 yards per game. The defense was stingy once again with UNK playing eight games decided by 14 points or less.

Finally, juniors Sal Silvio (LB) and Darrius Webb (RB) both garnered All-Central Region honors from Don Hansen's Football Gazette with seniors Malik Webb (CB) and Trey Lansman (WR/TE) being looked at from professional teams.

A native of Eunice, N.M., and an Eastern New Mexico graduate, Lynn helped turn his alma mater around, leading the Greyhounds to 30 wins (27 by NCAA rules) between 2012-16. The 'Hounds also made two C.H.A.M.P.S. Heart of Texas Bowl appearances and earned a share of the 2013 Lone Star Conference (LSC) title. In his ninth year as a collegiate head coach, Lynn has a **52-45 overall record**.

Prior to his return to Portales, Eastern hadn't had a winning season since 2004. They recorded four straight winning campaigns and were this tabbed as the top collegiate program in New Mexico (all levels) in 2015 by HERO Sports.

In 2016, ENMU went 7-5 and battled Fort Hays State in the Heart of Texas Bowl. Tying for third place in the LSC, the 'Hounds led the league in total offense (473.4 yards per game) and rushing offense (344.6 ypg) while ranking second in passing efficiency (160.5) and rushing defense (105.3 ypg).

The 'Hounds' bowl trip in 2013 marked ENMU's first post-season appearance in 30 years, with the LSC title the program's first conference title since 1991. Subsequently, Lynn was named the LSC Coach of the Year, was tabbed as the Region 4 Coach of the Year by two different outlets and was runner up for the Liberty Mutual National Division II Coach of the Year award.

Between 2013-16 the 'Hounds have set numerous school re-

records while ranking among the national leaders in a variety of categories, including total offense, rushing offense, passing efficiency, rushing defense and punt return yards.

Prior to returning to Portales, Lynn spent seven years (2005-11) at New Mexico Military Institute. He was head coach in 2011, leading the Broncos to nine wins, a bowl berth and a national ranking of sixth in the NJCAA (National Junior College Athletic Assoc.). Working alongside his brother, Jeff, Lynn was NMMI's defensive coordinator for four years before becoming assistant head coach and offensive coordinator in 2010. From 2005-09, NMMI was New Mexico's winningest collegiate program.

He also worked in the defensive secondary and with the outside linebackers at Division II power Delta (MS) State in 2004. Lynn began his coaching career at his alma mater where he was a restricted earnings coach and then a graduate assistant.

In his playing days, Lynn was a two-time first-team all-conference tight end who helped ENMU win back-to-back LSC South Division titles in 1999 and 2000. His teammates also voted him a co-captain twice during his career.

Holding a B.S. in Physical Education and a Master's in Sports Administration from ENMU, Lynn comes from a football-coaching family. His brother, Jeff, recently was the head football coach at Roswell (N.M.) High School and his father, David, is in the New Mexico High School Coaches Association Hall of Honor after a nearly four-decade coaching career.

He is married to the former Pamela Zens, herself a standout volleyball for Division I Hofstra (N.Y.) University. They have three children in Bryson (8), Carly (4) and Levi (3).

BIG DAY FOR D-GOOD

Redshirt senior back *David Goodwin* (#9/Lauderhill, FL) had himself a day against Central Missouri, scoring twice and averaging 9.6 yards per carry. Finishing with a career-best 191 yards on just 19 attempts he also caught an eight-yard pass.

The rushing total pushes the New Mexico Military Institute transfer over 1,000 career yards mark, making him the fourth current Loper (*Dayton Sealey, Luke Quinn & Darrius Webb*) to reach that mark.

MORE PASSING FOR TJ

Redshirt freshman QB *TJ Davis* (#2/Colorado Springs) had his best passing day as a Loper in the loss to Central Missouri, going 9 of 14 for 221 yards and three TD's. The incompletions featured two drops including a likely 66-yard TD toss that would've cut the Mules lead to 30-27 early in the third. Davis could've had another TD score as UNK dropped a TD pass after UCM jumped off-sides. Davis started his collegiate career 1 of 8 for three yards, two INT's and no TD's. He's now completed at least 52% of his passes in each of the last five games.

BIG PLAYS X 2

In addition to a 63-yard "Hail Mary" to win the game, Central Missouri connected on several other big plays. They included TD catches of 26, 34 and 50 yards as well as completions of 30, 33 and 39 yards, respectively.

Over the last two weeks UCM's Brook Bolles and FHSU's Chance Fuller went a combined 51 of 79 (64.5 pct.) for 899 yards, eight TD's and one INT against the Loper defense. They were sacked a total of five times to run for -18 yards.

UNK has now allowed 47 passing plays of at least 15 yards this fall with 17 going for TD's (36.1 pct.). In its four losses the Lopers have given up 30 such plays (10 TD's); in its five wins the number is 17 "big" plays (six scores).

Conversely the Loper run defense has allowed just 10 runs of at least 15 yards with only two resulting in six points.

SILVIO NEEDS 1 FOR 300; TOP SIX IN SACKS

All-American candidate *Sal Silvio* (#32/Kansas City) had a season-best 13 tackles (nine solo), including a three-yard sack, in the loss to Central Missouri. That makes him just a stop shy of joining the 300 career tackle club. The 2018 All-Region selection is now up to 299 career stops which includes 32.5 TFL's (11.0 sacks). He also has 10 forced fumbles, seven fumble recoveries and two INT's.

Finally Silvio's 7.0 sacks tie him for sixth most in school history for a single season and are the most by a Loper since end Mason Brodine had 8.0 in 2009. The record of 9.5 was set by end Nate Reicks in 2008.
