LOYOLA GREYHOUNDS (2-15, 1-5 PATRIOT LEAGUE)

- Junior **Stephanie Karcz** enters the game ranked second on Loyola's career record for steals. In just her third season, Karcz has come up with 254 career steals to trail only Katie Sheahin's school record of 347 from 2009-13.
- Karcz has grabbed 66 steals this season, a League best and the fifth-most in the NCAA this year. She also leads the team in rebounding and assists, with her 10.4 rebounds per game ranking fourth in the Patriot League and her 50 assists ranking fifth.
- In scoring, sophomore **Isabella Therien** leads the squad and ranks seventh in the Patriot League with 12.9 points per game.
- In conference only games, Therien leads the team with 14.7 points per game, while freshman **Taleah Dixon** is contributing 9.0 per game.
- Karcz ranks second in the League in rebounding in conference only games, grabbing 11.8 boards. She's also first with 16 steals and tied for sixth with 14 assists.

BUCKNELL BISON (14-4, 5-1 PATRIOT LEAGUE)

- Bucknell enters the contest tied for first place in the Patriot League.
- The Bison were picked as the preseason favorites in the Patriot League Preseason Poll.
- Kaitlyn Slagus leads three Bison in double-digit points, as she's scoring 13.0 points per game. Ellie Mack is second at 11.4 points per game, while Kate Walker averages 11.4.
- Slagus also leads the team in rebounds, with 7.9 per game.
- Kyi English is the team's leader in assists, with 53, while Walker has dished out 51.
- English and Abby Kapp share the team lead in steals, each grabbing 28.

UP NEXT

• Loyola will hit the road for two games. The Greyhounds will first head to Colgate on Saturday for a 2 p.m. game, before traveling to Lehigh on Wednesday for a 6 p.m. tipoff.

LOYOLA WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- Loyola University Maryland women's basketball is in its 48th season of action and sixth year of play in the Patriot League, a conference it joined prior to the 2013-14 season.
- Prior to joining the Patriot League, Loyola was in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference.
 The Greyhounds joined the conference in 1989 and, through its 22 years of membership, posted an overall record of 196-205 in MAAC games. Loyola also won two MAAC Tournament titles, in 1993 and 1994.
- Joe Logan is in his 14th season as Loyola's head coach. A 1996 alum of the school, Logan is the program's all-time leader in wins and carries a 169-228 record into the 2018-19 campaign.

COMEBACKS NOT ENOUGH

- Loyola's comeback fell short in four-straight games; at St. Joseph's, vs. Mount St. Mary's, at Towson and against Saint Francis Brooklyn.
- The Greyhounds never trailed against Saint Francis Brooklyn through regulation on Friday, December 7, but the Terriers tied the game for a fifth time with less than one second remaining to force overtime. The two teams ended up playing to three overtime periods with St. Francis eventually pulling away with a seven-point advantage at the 1:38 mark of the third overtime. Loyola cut its deficit to two, 72-70, with 26 seconds to play, but the Terriers hit three free throws to escape with the 75-70 win.
- On Tuesday, December 4, at Towson, the Greyhounds faced a 23-point deficit in the third quarter but worked to pull within three, 60-57, on redshirt senior **Bri Betz-White**'s trey with 1:33 to play. The Tigers wouldn't allow Loyola to come any closer though as they hit two free throws to account for the 62-57 final.
- In a 49-46 loss at Saint Joseph's on November 25, the Greyhounds outscored the Hawks 12-6 in the fourth quarter, but Saint Joseph's forced Loyola into a turnover with four seconds to go and then held onto the one-posession victory.
- Against Mount St. Mary's on December 1, Loyola pulled within four, 70-66, with 1:40 to play. The Greyhounds would only be able to score one more point after that, though, as the Mount extended its lead back to 10 for a 76-66 victory.

STACKED LINEUP

- The Greyhounds return their entire starting lineup from the 2017-18 team that finished tied for sixth in the Patriot League. Loyola also gets redshirt senior **Bri Betz-White** back for a fifth year after she missed last season due to injury.
- In returning its entire starting lineup, Loyola brings back 93.3 percent of its scoring, 92.6 percent of rebounding, 88 percent of assists and 90.6 percent of steals from its 2017-18 team.
- Stephanie Karcz, the 2017-18 Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year and first-team All-Patriot League honoree, and Isabella Therien, the 2017-18 Patriot League Rookie of the Year, also return, in addition to seniors Ashley Hunter and Courtney Vannoy, juniors Alexis Gray and Molly Taylor, and sophomore Delaney Connolly; all players who logged time in the starting lineup last year.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS

- Loyola was picked to finish third by a poll of Patriot League coaches and sports information personnel prior to the 2018-19 season. Bucknell was voted as the preseason favorite with 154 points and 14 first-place votes, while American checked in second with 137 points and two first-place votes. The Greyhounds captured the remaining four first-place votes and 129 points.
- Lehigh and Navy were ranked tied for fourth with 91 points and were followed by Holy Cross (81 points), Army West Point (75), Lafayette (63), Boston U. (56) and Colgate (23).
- Stephanie Karcz, the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year last season, was one of two guards and five players named to the Preseason All-Patriot League Team. She was joined by American senior forward Cecily Carl, Bucknell senior forward Kaitlyn Slagus, Bucknell senior guard Kate Walker and Preseason Player of the Year Lauren Manis, a junior forward from Holy Cross.

TRIPLE DOUBLES X2

- **Stephanie Karcz** became the first player in program history to record a triple double last year against Colgate (14 pts, 11 reb, 10 ast) and she already has another this year.
- At Monmouth, Karcz finished with 12 points, 12 rebounds and 10 steals to become the second player in program history to reach double-digit steals in a game.

SERIES HISTORY

- Although Bucknell leads the all-time series, 15-7, against Loyola, the two programs split last year's season meetings.
- The Greyhounds snapped a three-game losing skid in the series with a 68-65 road win over the Bison on January 17.
- Less than one month later, Bucknell came to Reitz Arena and handed the Greyhounds a 74-69 loss.
- The two teams split the first 10 meetings before Loyola joined the Patriot League for the 2013-14 season.
- Since becoming conference rivals, the Bison have dominated, winning 10 of the 12 meetings.

CHASING RECORDS

- Three Greyhounds are currently climbing Loyola's all-time career records.
- Senior **Bri Betz-White** is among the top-10 in all-time scoring leads, 3-point field goals made in a career, free throws made and career assists, while junior **Alexis Gray** joins Betz-White in 3-point field goals made in a career.
- Junior **Stephanie Karcz** is also tied for second in career steals, with 250 in less than three full seasons.

REVVING UP KARCZ

- Stephanie Karcz had a breakout sophomore season for the Greyhounds, being named the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year and to the All-Patriot League First Team for a first time, and to the All-Defensive Team for a second-straight season. She was one of two guards and five players named to the Preaseason All-Patriot League Team this year.
- She was one of three players in the Patriot League to average a double-double on the year (14.0 ppg, 10.3 rpg), while she was the only one to do so in conference play (14.2, 11.7).
- Karcz also broke three of Loyola's rebounding records last year single-game rebounds (21 vs. American), single-season rebounds (300) and single-season defensive rebounds (224) and finished the season second on Loyola's single-season steals records with 112, just six shy of Katie Sheahin's school records of 118 set during the 2010-11 season.
- In reaching double figures in scoring through 21 of 30 games in 2017-18, she has now reached double digits in points 38 times throughout her career.
- She also posted nine double-doubles in 2017-18, including a string of four-straight against Army West Point (10 pt, 15 reb), at Boston University (23 pts, 13 reb), against Holy Cross (21 pts, 19 reb) and American (12 pts, 21 reb), to move her career total to 14.
- Karcz recorded the program's first-ever triple-double against Colgate on January 21, 2018, finishing with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 10 assists. Karcz's 10 assists were one shy of tying the program's all-time single-game record, while she joins Dave Wocjik, a player on Loyola's men's basketball team from 1987-91, as the only Greyhounds to ever post a triple double.
- Karcz finished the year ranked seventh in the League in scoring (14.2), first in rebounding (10.6 pg), fourth in field-goal percentage (.427), second in assists (4.1), third in assist/turnover ratio (1.6), first in steals (3.7) and third in minutes (34.3).
- Her 112 steals ranked sixth in the NCAA last year, while her 3.73 per game was fourth.

- Edwards was a two-time all-section performer for Hampton High School, where she led the Talbots to the Section Championship in 2016 and 2017. She was also a two-time selection to the Seneca Valley Tip Off All-Tournament Team as a point guard.

BETZ-WHITE IS BACK

- Bri Betz-White, a first-team all-conference performer in 2016-17, was the lone guard named to the Preseason All-Patriot League team last year but missed the year due to injury.
- Betz-White has started more games than any other Greyhound in program history, as she recorded her 101st start at Towson on December 4. Alyssa Sutherland previously held the school record for games started with 100 starts from 2009-13.
- After ranking fourth in the League in scoring, with 15.0 points per game, in 2016-17, Betz-White picked up All-Patriot League First Team accolades. She also ranked second in the League in minutes played (34.9 per game), tied for third in steals (3.5 per game), sixth in field goal percentage (.415) and 10th in assist/turnover ratio (1.2) that year.
- Betz-White reached double figures in scoring through 25 of 31 contests as a junior, including dropping at least 20 points on six occasions. Her career-high 37 points vs. Colgate marked the most for a League player that year, while it was also the most for a Greyhound in Joe Logan's 12 years as a head coach and the most for a Loyola player since Patty Stoffey had 39 vs. Fairfield in 1990.
- With her 408th point of the 2016-17 season, Betz-White became the 21st player in program history and the 101st Patriot League player to reach 1,000 career points.

THERIEN IT UP

- Isabella Therien reached double figures in scoring in 24 of 26 games her freshman year and was voted the Patriot League Rookie of the Year after sixth-ranked freshman in the NCAA in scoring, averaging 15.2 points per game.
- Therien's 18 points vs. Cornell marked the most for a Greyhound rookie in their collegiate debut under head coach Joe Logan and the most for a Loyola freshman since at least 1990, as records were not kept prior to then. Therien played 17 minutes in the win over Cornell, going 7-for-10, including draining her first and only 3-point attempt.
- Against George Mason, Therien played 21 minutes and shot 50 percent (5-for-10) from the field, finishing with 16 points. She also added six rebounds in the contest.
- Therien missed the next four games due to injury, but returned at Mount St. Mary's, and scored 10 points against both the Mount and at St. Francis Brooklyn, before turning in 15 points vs. Towson, 13 at No. 15 Maryland, 12 at Delaware and a career-high 21 against preseason Patriot League favorite Army West Point. She followed it up with 15 points at Boston University, 18 against Holy Cross, 19 against American, 16 at Bucknell and 16 vs. Colgate. Against Lehigh, she tied her personal-best of 21 points and she added 10 at Army West Point, 20 at Holy Cross, 14 at American and 11 against Lafayette. Against Bucknell, she turned in a career-high 26 points, and then had 18 at Colgate, 14 at Lehigh, 17 against Navy and 15 against Boston University.
- In the loss to Navy in the quarterfinal round of the Patriot League Tournament, she finished with 18 points, marking her 13th-straight game with double-figures in scoring.

TO 1,000 AND BEYOND

- Bri Betz-White became Loyola's 21st and the Patriot League's 101st player to record 1,000 points throughout their career, as she reached the plateau on Wednesday, Feb. 22, 2017.
- Betz-White dropped 23 points vs. Holy Cross to become the sixth Greyhound to reach the milestone before the start of their senior season.
- She's also the fourth Greyhound to record all 1,000 points under head coach Joe Logan.
- Katie Sheahin (1,513 points from 2009-13), Miriam McKenzie (1,398; 2008-12) and Erica DiClemente (1,123; 2006-11) all reached the milestone under Logan, while Katie Scherle hit her 1,000th point in her senior season, Logan's first at the helm of the program.
- The fastest player to 1,000 points was Patty Stoffey, as she is the lone Greyhound to have hit the milestone as a sophomore. Stoffey finished her career as the program's record holder with 2,467 career points from 1991-95.
- Lorrie Schenning (1,565 points from 1986-90) trails Stoffey on the school's all-time record chart and is joined by Sheahin, Kathy O'Halloran (1,431; 1976-80) and McKenzie as the only players to record their 1,000th point as juniors.

PUTTING THE STUDENT IN STUDENT-ATHLETES

- Loyola earned a top-five ranking from the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) in July when the Greyhounds were ranked fifth amongst all 349 NCAA Division I teams with a 3.736 GPA on the WBCA's Academic Top 25 Team Honor Roll.
- This marks the second time in the last three years that the Greyhounds have been ranked among the top-10 in the NCAA, as the 2015-16 squad was ninth.
- Four members of the team posted perfect 4.0 GPAs during both the Fall 2017 and Spring 2018 semesters **Alex Barazotti**, **Delaney Connolly**, Madelene McDonald and **Courtney Vannoy**.
- In addition, a League-best 14 Greyhounds were named to the Patriot League Women's Basketball Academic Honor Roll. The team ended the spring semester with a cumulative 3.616 grade-point average, tops among Loyola's 17 teams. That mark was buoyed by a stellar 3.797 mark during the Spring 2018 semester.

2017-18 IN REVIEW

- The Greyhounds finished the season with a 9-21 overall record at a 7-11 mark in Patriot League play, placing them in a tie for sixth place with Holy Cross.
- In sweeping Holy Cross during the season, Loyola earned the No. 6 seed in the tournament and a first-round bye.
- The Greyhounds traveled to No. 3 seed Navy, where it lost 63-55 in the quarterfinals.

HEAD COACH JOE LOGAN



- Joe Logan was named Loyola's 11th head women's basketball coach on May 12, 2005.
- Logan has more wins at Loyola than any other head coach in program history.
- He earned his 150th career victory with a 74-30 win over Lipscomb in the 2016-17 opener.
- In 2010-11, Logan coached the Greyhounds to their first postseason victory in program history by knocking off Old Dominion, 67-65, in the first round of the WNIT.
- That same year, Logan led Loyola to a second 20-plus win season in his tenure, as the Greyhounds tied a program record 21 wins.
- With a 67-54 win at Siena College on January 7, 2012, Logan picked up his 101st victory to record more wins than any other head coach in Loyola women's basketball history.
- Throughout his tenure, Logan registered more Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference wins (76) than any other Loyola head coach. He also led the Greyhounds to two trips to the title game of the MAAC Championships (2006 and 2011).
- He led the Greyhounds to arguably the most successful year in program history in 2010-11, tying the record for most wins in a single season with 21, and setting the mark for the most conference wins in a single season with 15.
- Under Logan, nine student-athletes have been named to all-conference teams. Two players earned MAAC Sixth Player of the Year honors, while eight players have been named to allconference rookie teams. In 2011, guard Katie Sheahin became Logan's first conference player of the year, while she received back-to-back MAAC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2011 and 2012.
- On Thursday, Jan. 29, 2015, Logan led Loyola to its 500th program victory. He was a part of 40.6 percent of the 500 wins up until that point.
- He earned his bachelors of arts in history with a minor in business from Loyola in 1996.
- Logan is married to the former Susan Bryce (Loyola '96), who played basketball for the Greyhounds from 1994-98. The couple has three kids, Maggie, Rose and Joseph.
