Missouri State (0-1)

### THE KICKOFF

Lincoln will play for a second win in less than a week on Thursday (Sept. 6) when the Blue Tigers travel to Springfield, Mo. to play Missouri State in a 6:00 p.m. CDT contest. The game, Lincoln's first vs. an NCAA Division I opponent since 2013, will be streamed online through ESPN3.

The Blue Tigers are 1-0 on the season after gutting out a 10-7 victory over Lane in a neutral site game in Memphis, Tenn. last Saturday (Sept. 1). Lincoln took advantage of a stout defense that limited the Dragons to just 123 yards of total offense and forced three turnovers en route to its first season-opening victory since 2015.

Missouri State opened its 2018 campaign on the road against Oklahoma State on August 30, with the Cowboys prevailing, 58-17. This game renews a series that date backs to 1969 with 15 meetings, most of which came when both Missouri State and Lincoln were members of the MIAA.

## QUICK HITS

- Thursday night marks the 16th meeting between the Blue Tigers and the Bears, with Missouri State leading the all-time series, 10-5. MSU and LU played each other every year while both teams were in the MIAA from 1972 to 1981, with the first meeting dating back to 1969. Lincoln won the first four games of the series, but Missouri State has won each of the past four meetings.

- This is Lincoln's first game against an NCAA Division I opponent since playing Grambling State in the Missouri Classic back in 2013. That was also the last time that LU beat a DI team, as Lincoln defeated Grambling State, 47-34.

- A victory against Missouri State would give the Blue Tigers back-to-back victories for the first time since ending the 2013 season with home wins against Northeastern State and Southwest Baptist.

- If the Blue Tigers beat the Bears, it would mark the first time that Lincoln has started a season 2-0 since 1972, when LU won its first five contests en route to a 9-1 overall record and a conference championship.

- Lincoln is seeking its first true road win since defeating Langston in the 2015 opener, 35-32.

- This will be the first Thursday night game for Lincoln since 2013, when the Blue Tigers opened the season in St. Charles, Mo. against Lindenwood.

- The Blue Tigers enter Saturday with an all-time record of 254-452-24.

- Steven Smith is in his second season as the head coach of the Blue Tigers and has a career record of 2-9.

- Lincoln is in its fifth season as a member of the GLVC. LU was in the MIAA for 23 years, including three-straight from 2011-13, for football before making the switch in 2014. The GLVC is the fifth different conference in which the Blue Tigers have been a member, joining the Midwest Athletic Association, the Great Lakes Football Conference, the Central States Football League and the MIAA.

- This is the 88th season of Lincoln football. The Blue Tigers first fielded a team in 1920 and played every year until 1943, when Lincoln took a year off due to World War II. LU then played each season from 1944-1989. The football program was disbanded at that point, but was brought back in 2000.

## BLUE TIGERS TO WATCH

**OFFENSE** - Henry Ogala got the starting nod in Lincoln's win over Lane and threw for 142 yards with a scoring pass. Blake Tibbs was his top target with six grabs for 86 yards, including a team-long 49-yard reception. Terry Hunter led the team on the ground with 41 yards while Hosea Franklin, who caught the touchdown pass, joined Kimbo Ferguson as Lincoln's other ball carriers.

**DEFENSE** - The Lincoln defense was outstanding in LU's opening win, forcing three turnovers while holding Lane to just 123 yards of total offense. The Blue Tigers made three sacks and five tackles for loss, and broke up five passes with a pair of picks.

Amani Nelson led the team with nine tackles, six of which were solo, while Isaiah Gray and Edwin Durassaint each added six takedowns. Gray had a strong all-around afternoon, finishing with a sack and a fumble recovery, while Ben Shumate forced that turnover and ended his day with four tackles. Quan Mason and Victor Williams also had sacks, with Mason finishing with three QB hurries.

Joseph Madrigal had one of LU's biggest stops of the day with an interception at the one-yard line in the fourth quarter of Lincoln's season-opening win, while Durassaint also had a pick at the end of the game to clinch the victory. 16 different Blue Tigers had at least one tackle, five different Blue Tigers broke up a pass.

**SPECIAL TEAMS** - Fernando Ramirez made his Blue Tiger debut a memorable one, scoring LU's first points of the game on a 40-yard field goal to give Lincoln a first quarter lead it would never relinquish. Ramirez averaged 60.3 yards on kickoffs with one touchback. In the punting game, Wolky Belancourt averaged 20.3 yards with one leading to a fair catch.

In the return game, the Blue Tigers were led by A'Jani Johnson with three punt returns for 28 yards, while Hasan Muhammad-Rogers averaged 12 yards on his two punt returns. Brenton Wrigley handles LU's long-snapping duties while Belancourt also serves as the holder.

### MISSOURI STATE AT A GLANCE

Peyton Huslig was the Bears' top offensive threat in their opener, passing for 150 yards and a pair of scores while adding 58 more yards on the ground. Jordan Murray and Antwan Woods caught the touchdown passes while Jason Randall led the team with four receptions for 52 yards. Randall also had nine rushing attempts at Oklahoma State while Jeremiah Wilson and Aaron Denson also contribute to Missouri State's back field.

Kam Carter led the defense with 12 tackles, including 11 solo, at Oklahoma State, while Zack Sanders and Kevin Ellis each made seven takedowns, with Sanders picking off a pass. Austin Henderson forced a fumble, which was recovered by Jordan Wilkes, and Skyler Hulse and Matt McClellan each recorded sacks. The Bears made seven tackles for loss in the opener, but allowed 436 rushing yards as well as 296 yards through the air.

Brendan Withrow averaged 44.6 yards on 10 punts against Oklahoma State, landing three inside the 20 with two going at least 50 yards. Nick Williams averaged 65.0 yards on kickoffs while Parker Lacina made his only field goal attempt, a 40-yarder. Matt Rush and Zack Sanders are the main kick returners.

### THE COACHES

**Steven Smith** was named the 22nd head coach of the Blue Tigers last December after a successful four-year run as the offensive coordinator of Albany State. Smith, who has also coached at Tennessee State, Delta State and Virginia State, helped Albany State go undefeated in league play in three of his four seasons. Smith's teams have made for NCAA Division II playoff appearances and he has coached 21 all-conference honorees and eight All-Americans. Smith additionally has coached with six NFL teams, most recently serving as an assistant under Romeo Crennel with the Kansas City Chiefs in 2012.

**Dave Steckel** is in his fourth year as the head coach of the Bears, and has continued to improve the program in every season. The offense in particular shone in 2017, as the program led the Missouri Valley Conference in rushing for most the year. In 2016, Steckel coached MSU to a win over No. 24 Indiana State, its first against a ranked team in three years. Much of Steckel's background is on the defensive side of the ball, however, as he spent 14 years at the University of Missouri, helping the program win back-to-back SEC East titles in 2013 and 2014. Steckel coached 15 all-conference linebackers while at Mizzou.



**SHUTDOWN DEFENSE:** Lincoln shut out Lane in the second half of its season-opening victory and held the Dragons to just 123 yards of total offense. Through the first week of the season, LU leads the GLVC in 11 different defensive categories, with the Blue Tigers giving up just nine first down, 65 yards through the air and 58 rushing yards.

**BALL CONTROL:** Lincoln's offense was good at controlling the clock last year, as LU led in time of possession in six of its 10 games, finishing 21st in DII with 32:08 minutes of possession per game. That trend continued in the opener, as LU won the time of possession battle again by controlling the ball for 34:01.

**PICK 'EM:** In 10 games in 2017, Lincoln was held without an interception. The Blue Tigers broke that trend early in 2018 with two picks against Lane, both of which helped seal the victory. Joseph Madrigal made the first interception of the year at LU's own one-yard line to stop a potential scoring drive while Edwin Durassaint sealed the victory with his pick on the final play of regulation.

**BLOCK PARTY:** With eight blocked kicks in 2017, the Blue Tigers finished fifth in NCAA Division II and led the GLVC. That total was four more than the total that Lincoln posted in 2016, when LU was fourth in the GLVC standings. Lincoln also ended the year second in the country in blocked punts, while Cody Alexander, Joseph Madrigal and Victor Williams, who each recovered kicks in the end zone, were 12th in DII in punt return touchdowns.

**ALL-CONFERENCE:** The 2018 Blue Tigers feature a pair of All-GLVC performers in Isaiah Gray and Blake Tibbs. Gray, a defensive lineman, had 5.0 tackles for loss and eight quarterback hurries last year and made 46 total takedowns en route to an all-league second team award. Tibbs, meanwhile, was LU's top receiver with 38 catches and three touchdowns and earned honorable mention status.

**GOOD START:** Lincoln was one of just three GLVC programs to win its season opener, joining McKendree, which edged Northern Michigan, 34-28, and Missouri S&T, which earned a 31-14 win over Eastern New Mexico. This is the first time since 2015 Lincoln has started a season 1-0.

## 2018 GLVC Players of the Week

### WEEK ONE

**Offense:** Tyler Swart, Missouri S&T

**THURSDAY NIGHT FOOTBALL:** Lincoln will play a Thursday night game for the first time since 2013 when the Blue Tigers play at Missouri State on Sept. 6. Lincoln opened 2013 at Lindenwood on a Thursday, and then beat DI program Grambling State the following week, 47-34. That was the last time LU played a Division I school.

**DII DEFENSE:** Lincoln's strength in 2017 was on the defensive side of the ball, as LU finished the year ranked highly in both the GLVC and Division II in several stats. The Blue Tigers were second in the conference, and 41st in the country, in passing defense (183.9) as well as 42nd in the nation and second in the league in total defense (330.8). Lincoln also rated 70th in DII in rushing defense (146.9), and was among the country's leaders in blocked kicks, finishing fifth in the nation with eight overall and second nationally with five blocked punts on the season.

**NICE TO MEET YOU:** Lincoln will play two teams for the first time ever in 2018, beginning a series against UW-Oshkosh on Sept. 15 and vs. Tarleton State on Nov. 3. Wisconsin-Oshkosh is a Division III program that plays in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, with LU's only other game vs. an opponent from that league being a 3-0 victory over UW-La Crosse in 1975. Tarleton State, meanwhile, plays in the Lone Star Conference.

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Blue Tigers will spend a lot of time on the road in 2018, as Lincoln will play only four games at Dwight T. Reed Stadium. That's the fewest in a season for LU since 2008, when the Blue Tigers played four home contests in a nine-game season. LU plays 11 contests in 2018, including six true road games as well as a neutral site contest in Memphis on Sept. 1.

**ON THE AIR:** Blue Tiger football is back on KJLU, as six of Lincoln's 11 games will be broadcast this season. All four of Lincoln's home contests, as well as the road games at Truman State on Oct. 13 and Missouri S&T on Oct. 27, will air on 88.9 FM in Jefferson City.

## WEEK ONE - Lincoln (MO) 10, Lane 7

MEMPHIS, Tenn. - The defense tallied three sacks, made a pair of interceptions and pitched a shutout in the second half as the Lincoln football team earned a 10-7 win over Lane in the season opener for both programs on Sept. 1.

The Blue Tigers had five tackles for loss and broke up three passes as Lincoln limited Lane to just 123 yards of total offense and nine first downs. Edwin Durassaint had an interception for Lincoln in the third quarter while Joseph Madrigal made the Blue Tigers' second pick late in the fourth, all but sealing the win with an interception on the Lincoln one-yard line.

Lincoln scored on its first drive of the season, as Fernando Ramirez booted a 44-yard field goal after the Blue Tiger defense helped set the offense up in tremendous starting field position with a sack by Steve Henderson. Hosea Franklin had a 13-yard run to start the drive, then later scored early in the second quarter on the Blue Tigers' second drive on a six-yard reception.

Lane hit a quick 74-yard touchdown pass on its ensuing possession, but the defenses took over from there. Lincoln was led by Amani Nelson with nine tackles, including one for a loss. Durassaint, Victor Williams, Chavon Gross, Isaiah Gray and JaJuan Chambers each made three tackles, with Gray also posting a sack and a fumble recovery.

Quan Mason also had a sack while Gross added a tackle for loss, and both players matched Will Sewell and Austin Harris with two tackles apiece. Thomas Burton broke up two passes, and Mason had a quarterback hurry.

Offensively, Henry Ogala completed 12 passes for 142 yards and the score, while Blake Tibbs led the receiving corps with six grabs for 86 yards. Terry Hunter led the rushing attack with 41 yards, including a big 16-yard gain late in the fourth quarter to help the Blue Tigers run down the clock. Ramirez, meanwhile, averaged 60 yards on three kickoffs.
