THE MATCH-UP: Marist opens Pioneer Football League play at Valparaiso. Kickoff is at 1 p.m. Eastern.

HOW TO FOLLOW US: Geoff Brault (play-by-play) and Steve Eggink (analyst) will have the call the Red Fox Network with a free audio stream. The pregame show begins at 12:45 Eastern. Game updates will be available on Twitter via Marist Football (@Marist_FBall). Todd Ickow (play-by-play) and Jeff Vlk (analyst) will have the call on ESPN3.

LAST TIME OUT: Before a record 6,154 fans at Tenney Stadium, Marist dropped its home opener to Bryant, 34-17. Dwayne Menders Jr. tied the program's single-game record with 12 receptions. Mike Arrington had a team-best 13 tackles.

MARIST IN THE NFL: Jason Myers, who played at Marist from 2009-12 and graduated in 2013, is in his third season as the Seattle Seahawks' placekicker and seventh in the NFL. With the New York Jets in 2018, Myers became the first Marist football player to earn a Pro Bowl berth. In 2020, Myers went a perfect 24-for-24 on field goal attempts, and had the longest made field goal in the NFL with a 61-yard kick. Myers holds the club record with 39 consecutive made goals, a streak that started in 2019 and went until Sept. 26.

OUR LEADERS: Marist has five captains this season: red-shirt junior LB Mike Arrington, red-shirt senior QB Austin Day, graduate S Kyle Fleitman, red-shirt junior OL Ben Johnson, and red-shirt junior LB Arthur Pinckney. All five are in their first year as captains.

ABOUT VALPARAISO: The Beacons went 0-3 in non-league play, but opened PFL play with a 24-21 come-from-behind triumph at Drake. Picked sixth in the PFL Preseason Poll, Valpo had five Preseason All-PFL selections. These include reigning PFL Offensive Player of the Year Robert Washington (running back), and Co-Special Teams Player of the Year Ben Niesner (punter).

UP NEXT: Marist plays its first Pioneer Football League home game against Stetson on Saturday, Oct. 9. Kickoff is set for noon.

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through three decades of growth, is in his 30th year as the program's head coach and 31st overall with the Red Foxes. He also coaches the team's quarterbacks.

Parady is the winningest coach in program history, and the longest-tenured head coach in Division I football. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won four league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

Three former Marist football players have signed contracts with NFL teams since 2013. In 2014, the Miami Dolphins' Terrence Fede became the first former Marist football player to appear in an NFL game. Marist graduate Jason Myers was the Jacksonville Jaguars' kicker for two-and-a-half seasons. On Sept. 20, 2015, the first NFL games with Marist graduates on each team took place when Miami played at Jacksonville. Myers became the first Marist football player selected to the Pro Bowl following the 2018 season. Overall, nearly 20 former Marist football players have gone on to have professional opportunities in the NFL, Europe, and in arena football.

In his tenure as head coach, Parady has posted a 142-154-1 record, with four league championships and a record of 101-73-1 in league contests. The Red Foxes won a share of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007, and a share of the Pioneer Football League championship in 2013.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth. Sarah is a 2017 graduate of Marist.

- Marist is 6-for-26 on third down (23%), while the opposition is 13-for-27 (48%).
- **Kyle Fleitman** was named a national semifinalist for the Campbell Trophy.

Marist in the PFL

- Marist is in its 12th season in the Pioneer Football League in 2021.
- The Red Foxes are 45-43 all-time in PFL play. Marist is 6-11 in September, 25-15 in October, 14-16 in November, and 0-1 in December. Marist is 23-22 at home, and 22-21 on the road. Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

Player Notes

Quarterbacks

Austin Day (14) became Marist's starter midway through the 2018 season, and has 14 career starts. Day holds Marist's single-game passing yards record with 440, which came in a double overtime win against Davidson in his first career start on Oct. 20, 2018. He tied a program record with five passing touchdowns in the game. He is a captain. At Columbia, Day was 9-for-16 for 103 yards, a touchdown, and an interception. He sat out the Bryant game due to injury. ... **Brock Bagozzi (18)** became the first true freshman under head coach **Jim Parady** to start when he took the first snap against Bryant on Sept. 25. Bagozzi is 23-for-43 for 272 yards, two TDs, and an INT this season. ... **Julian McGarvey (8)** has seen his first collegiate action this year. He is 5-for-14 for 29 yards, and also sees action on Marist's punt coverage unit.

Running Backs

Hunter Cobb (34) started the final six games of the 2019 season. He finished the year with 13 touchdowns, the highest total for a Marist running back since 2008. Over the final five games of the season, Cobb averaged 125.4 rushing yards per game. Cobb has 110 rushing yards through two games, and is averaging 5.5 per carry. ... Fifth-year senior **Mekhai Johnson (48)** has appeared in 25 career games, and started the first four games of the 2019 season. He has averaged 5.8 yards per carry in his career, and has 591 rushing yards. He has 170 rushing yards and three touchdowns at Morehead State on Oct. 27, 2018. Johnson scored a receiving touchdown against Bryant..

Wide Receivers

Dwayne Menders Jr. (1) has 273 all-purpose yards this season, and tallied 758 all-purpose yards in 2019. Menders tied Marist's single-game record with 12 receptions vs. Bryant (for 146 yards and a touchdown). ... **Scott Scherzer (84)** caught his second career touchdown at Columbia in his first career start, and had a career-high seven catches vs. Bryant. He is second on the team in catches (9) & receiving yards (131). ... **Sydney Person (15)** has started Marist's first two games, and has one reception for six yards. ... **Brett Landis (16)** and **Will Downes (81)** each had their first career reception at Columbia.

Tight End

Wyatt McMahon (85) has started each of Marist's first two games, and has one reception. He is currently pursuing his Master's degree. ... **Brandon Lysick (35)** has two receptions for 13 yards. ... **Max Mazzella (83)** made his collegiate debut against Bryant.

Offensive Line

Ben Johnson (72) is the lone player on this unit who started prior to this year. Johnson started the final six games at right tackle in 2019, and started at left tackle at Columbia. He is a captain. ... **Ethan Parrish (68)** saw playing time in 2019 as a reserve at both guard positions, has taken over at center. ... **Anthony D'Urso (73)**, who saw time as a reserve and on special teams in 2019, starts at right guard. ... Red-shirt freshmen **Zaire Cooper (77)** and **Nico Negron (78)** start at left guard and right tackle, respectively. ... Graduate **Matt McKnelly (79)** returned to action vs. Bryant at right tackle. ... **Jake Anapol (74)** and **Masin Cobb (64)** have seen significant action as reserves.

Defensive Line

Aaron Acosta (90) has 11 tackles, including two TFLs. Acosta was named a Freshman All-American in 2019, and Preseason All-PFL this season. He played in nine games, with three starts, in 2019. He registered seven tackles for loss and four sacks, both of which ranked second on the team. ... **Jacob Abill (92)** and **Nick Foglia (93)** essentially shared the nose tackle position in 2019, with Foglia starting six games and Abill five. This year, Foglia is the starter inside, with Abill taking over at defensive end opposite Acosta. Foglia was named Academic All-District this past school year. ... The Red Foxes have experience with red-shirt junior defensive ends **Halil Gecaj (95)** and **Carson Badamo (99)**.

Linebackers

Mike Arrington (2), **Jayden Johnson (6)**, and **Arthur Pinckney (44)** are all-first year starters. Arrington has a team-high 23 tackles, including the team's single-game best (13 vs. Bryant). Johnson is second on the team with 21 tackles, with 10+ in each game. Pinckney is tied for fourth at 14. ... Arrington and Pinckney are both captains. Pinckney is Co-President of Marist's Black Student-Athlete Alliance, and is Marist's nominee for the Allstate AFCA GoodWords Team.

Cornerbacks

True freshman **Al Stallworth (28)** has started both games and has six stops. ... **Isaiah Smith (7)** sat out vs. Bryant due to injury, but had five stops at Columbia in his first career start. ... Red-shirt freshman **Josh Popoca (32)** started and had two tackles vs. Bryant. ... True freshman **Austin Trimble (38)** had a tackle at Columbia. ... **Tyhir Harley (3)** has played in seven career games.

Safeties

Kyle Fleitman (22) is a captain, was named Second Team All-PFL in 2019, and Preseason All-PFL this year. In his first year as a starter in 2019, Fleitman notched 62 tackles, two interceptions, and five pass break-ups. He is currently pursuing his Master's degree. Fleitman has 16 tackles, two PBU, a forced fumble, and a TFL. He had 11 stops vs. Bryant ... **Teddy Wright (5)** is tied for fourth on the team with 14 tackles, and has 1.5 TFL and a fumble recovery. He had 10 stops vs. Bryant. ... **Clayborne Fields III (21)** had his first career INT vs. Bryant, and has two PBU this year. ... **Jhonny Quest (23)** had a tackle at Columbia, and has been a key reserve since 2019. ... Red-shirt sophomore **Kyle Coffindaffer (33)** has six tackles in his first year after transitioning from linebacker.

Specialists

Luke Paladino (36) is 5-for-5 on PATs & 1-for-1 on FG (38). He was 11-for-14 on field goal attempts and 28-for-29 on PATs in 2019. Paladino has made three kicks of 45 yards or longer. ... **Dominic Donohue (25)** is averaging 36.0 yards per punt this season, and has forced seven fair catches on 10 punts. He is also the team's holder. ... **Dwayne Menders Jr. (1)** had an 82-yard punt return TD at Columbia, and **Mekhai Johnson (48)** had a 47-yard kickoff return at Columbia. Johnson is averaging 25.3 yards per kickoff return this season. ... **Justin Iaccio (59)** is the long snapper and has appeared in five career games.
