McKendree -- Last Time Out...

The Bearcats used a pair of big plays from its defense in the closing minutes to register a 29-10 victory last Saturday at Saint Joseph's College. With McKendree leading 16-10, Austin Weltha intercepted a Pumas' pass and returned it 45 yards for a touchdown with 3:53 to play. On Saint Joseph's next offensive play, Cruz Navarro had another interception that set up a 15-yard touchdown burst by Treye Williams with 2:01 on the clock to seal the win. On the day, the Bearcats held the Pumas to just 281 yards of total offense. A.J. Wentland paced the McKendree defensive unit with a game-high 12 tackles, while Kyle Kirkpatrick added eight solo stops. Weltha chipped in with seven tackles as Navarro added six in addition to their interceptions. Brett Pearman notched two of the Bearcats' four quarterback sacks on the day, while Lucky Baar blocked a field goal in the later stages of the second quarter. Offensively, Shayeen Edwards rushed for a career-high 87 yards to lead the way for McKendree. Isaac Fisher rushed for 55 yards and a score while completing 17-of-28 pass attempts for 94 yards.

Missouri S & T -- Last Time Out...

The Miners built a 31-point lead early in the fourth quarter and cruised to a 40-23 win on the road last Saturday at Lincoln University. Lamar Wilkes and D'Luis West were each responsible for three touchdowns on the day for Missouri S & T. Wilkes went 15-of-25 through the air for 204 yards with a trio of TD passes. West gained a game-high 82 yards on the ground with three rushing scores against the Blue Tigers. Wilkes' favorite target was Braxton Graham, who had five receptions for 102 yards with a TD. Elrod Spencer and Dustin Schindler also had touchdown catches in the effort. Defensively, Austin Truvillion led the Miners with eight tackles, while Landon Compton contributed seven stops. Nate Brown and Isaac Williams each posted an interception at Lincoln.

LAST MEETING -- McKendree vs. Missouri S & T...

On Oct. 25, 2014 at Leemon Field, McKendree built a 24-0 lead through three quarters of play and held off a late charge by Missouri S & T to post a 27-24 Homecoming victory. Isaac Fisher led the way offensively as he completed 34-of-49 pass attempts for 295 yards. Fisher matched a team record that he set earlier in the season with his 34 completions in a game. He also ran for a team-best 84 yards and two touchdowns. Darius Crochrell grabbed eight passes for 75 yards, while Cameron James added seven receptions for 72 yards against Missouri S & T. Steven O'Block booted a pair of field goals, including a 39-yarder with 1:20 to play to help seal the victory for the Bearcats. On the defensive side, A.J. Wentland had a team-best seven tackles along with an interception. George Hill and Bryce Colvin each added five stops. For Missouri S & T, Peter Simpson was 13-of-25 in the passing department for 218 yards with a pair of touchdowns. Lamar Wilkes was 2-of-12 in the contest for 19 yards. Chris Kennard led the Miners' ground attack with 27 yards on four carries. Melvin Stovall and Leon Moody each had six catches in the effort. Dillon Bowman recorded a game-high 14 tackles while adding an interception for Missouri S & T, while Dawan Ferguson added nine tackles.

Bearcat Tracks...

WELTHA NAMED GLVC DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Austin Weltha earned the Great Lakes Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week award for his performance in the Bearcats' win at Saint Joseph's College on Oct. 17. Weltha had seven tackles, including 2 1/2 for loss in the 29-10 victory. Weltha also provided perhaps the biggest play of the game with his 45-yard interception return for a touchdown with 3:53 to play to push the Bearcats' lead to 22-10. It is the first career GLVC weekly honor for Weltha. He is also the fifth different McKendree player to be recognized by the league in 2015, and the third Bearcat defender, joining A.J. Wentland and Lucky Baar.

BEARCATS vs. THE SHOW-ME STATE: McKendree has a record of 11-8 against teams from the state of Missouri since 1996. The Bearcats are 5-4 in road contests in such games. McKendree won its only other game played in the state of Missouri this year -- a 41-23 decision at William Jewell College back on Sept. 26.

20 SEASONS OF FOOTBALL: 2015 marks the 20th season of football at McKendree since the program was revived in 1996.

200 AND COUNTING: The Sept. 12 contest at West Liberty marked the 200th football game played by McKendree since bringing back its football program in 1996.

DOUBLING UP: McKendree has scored at least 10 points in a game in 174 of its last 186 outings.

POINTS NOT TAKEN: The 10 points allowed by McKendree at Saint Joseph's College are the fewest given up by the Bearcats' defense in the program's NCAA Division II era (since 2012). It is the lowest point total for McKendree opponent since the Bearcats defeated Trinity International University 24-9 at Leemon Field during the 2011 season. It is also the fewest points allowed by McKendree in a conference game since a 54-7 triumph at Waldorf College in 2010.

PICK-SIX : Austin Weltha had the Bearcats' first interception return for a touchdown of the season with his 45-yard score at Saint Joseph's College. In fact, the last two McKendree pick-six efforts have come from current members of the Bearcats' linebacking corps. A.J. Wentland had a 29-yard INT return for a score at Northwood University in September 2014.

SACK MASTERS: McKendree defensive ends Lucky Baar and Brett Pearman continue to wreak havoc on opposing quarterbacks. Heading into today's game with Missouri S & T, Baar (1.33 sacks per game) and Pearman (1.08 sacks per game) rank first and second, respectively, in the Great Lakes Valley Conference in quarterback sacks. Among all NCAA Division II players, Baar is sixth in the category while Pearman is 11th overall.

FISHER FACT OF THE WEEK: Isaac Fisher is poised to move into the top 10 on the Bearcats' career rushing list. He enters the Missouri S & T contest with 1,412 career yards and is 13th on the team's all-time chart. Fisher needs 37 yards on the ground to take possession of 10th place on the Bearcats' career rushing list:

- 10) Marlon Chenault -- 1,448 yards
- 11) Ryan Herring -- 1,437 yards

O'BLOCK A NATURAL AT SAINT JOSEPH'S : Steven O'Block matched a career-high by kicking three field goals in the Bearcats' win at Saint Joseph's. Included in that effort was a season-long and career-tying 42-yarder in the first quarter. In two career games on the natural grass surface of Alumni Stadium at Saint Joseph's, O'Block is a perfect 5-for-5 in field goal tries. Interestingly, O'Block has kicked two field goals of 40 or more yards at McKendree, with both of them coming at Saint Joseph's (he also had a 42-yard effort as a freshman in 2013). O'Block is 8-of-8 in field goal tries through six games in 2015.

MCKENDREE RECEIVERS CATCHING ON: Entering today's game against Missouri S & T, five current members of the Bearcats' receiving corps are in the team's all-time top 10 for receptions: Cameron James (1st with 131), Pat Doty (5th with 69), Sean Dowling (7th with 48), Tyler Brewer (tied for 8th with 45) and Dustin Walls (10th with 43). James (1st with 1,404 yards), Doty (8th with 792 yards) and Walls (10th with 638 yards) all rank in the top 10 in career receiving yards as well.

WENTLAND WATCH: A.J. Wentland continues to climb the McKendree career list for tackles. Entering the Missouri S & T contest, Wentland is sixth on the all-time chart with 227 tackles. He needs three stops to pass Ryan Thornhill (229 tackles) for fifth on the list and 12 tackles to move ahead of the late Cory Wilson (238 tackles) into the fourth spot. Deveon Moss holds down third place on the McKendree career list with 245 tackles. Brandon Nigro currently sits atop the Bearcats' career list with 295 tackles.

SIGN OF THINGS TO COME?: The triumph at West Liberty marked the first win for McKendree in a road opener since the 2009 season. Since the revival of the football program in 1996, the Bearcats have won their road opener eight different times. In each of those seasons, McKendree closed the year with a winning record. In fact, the Bearcats averaged better than eight wins per season in those instances.

ONE MORE IN THE WIN COLUMN: McKendree needs a victory in one of its final four games of the 2015 season to notch its first winning season in five years. The Bearcats last finished above the .500 mark in 2010, when the team posted a 9-3 overall record.

This Date in Bearcat Football History

Oct. 24, 2009

McKendree built a 21-0 lead in the third quarter and held off a late rally from host William Penn University to record a 24-14 victory in Oskaloosa, Iowa. The win was the seventh in a row for McKendree and kept the Bearcats undefeated in Mid-States Football Association-Midwest League play. Nick Fuhler set career-highs with five catches for 117 yards, while Joe Beimfohr added a team-leading 127 rushing yards on the day. Tight end Byron Gettis also threw a 35-yard touchdown pass to Fuhler out of the Bearcats' "Royal" formation. Austin Fisher was 10-of-19 on the day for 161 yards and a touchdown. Jordan Fark kicked a 21-yard field goal midway through the fourth quarter to help give the Bearcats a two-score lead. Antonio Greer paced the McKendree defense with eight tackles, while Derrell Nicholas and Heath Bohannon each added seven tackles. In the game, McKendree was 9-of-16 on third-down opportunities.

Oct. 24, 1998

In the highest scoring Homecoming game since McKendree returned to the gridiron in 1996, the Bearcats posted a 40-36 victory over Saint Xavier University in front of a crowd of approximately 2,500 fans at Leemon Field. McKendree piled up 427 rushing yards on the day, including a game-high 152 yards by Louis Harden. Jarrod Karnes added 83 yards and two touchdowns on the ground for the Bearcats. Defensively, Jason Stearns returned a pair of fumbles for scores, including a 40-yarder that gave McKendree a 19-point advantage in the third quarter. With Saint Xavier driving for the potential game-winning score late in the fourth quarter, Craig Nix intercepted a Cougars' pass at the goal line with 12 seconds remaining to lock up the win for the Bearcats. Ryan Thornhill and Mike Garavalia each posted eight tackles to lead the McKendree defense.

McKendree University Head Football Coach Mike Babcock



Mike Babcock was named as the 17th football coach in the history of the Bearcats' program back in December 2013. The 2015 season will mark Babcock's third on the sidelines for the Bearcats.

The 2014 campaign turned into a memorable one on many fronts for Babcock and the Bearcat football program. McKendree closed the year as one of the hottest teams in the Great Lakes Valley Conference, winning its final five games to post a 5-6 overall record. The late-season run also gave the Bearcats a 5-3 mark in GLVC play, which enabled the squad to finish in a tie for second in the league standings. That is McKendree's highest GLVC finish in the conference's brief football history.

There were several record-breaking performances along the way enjoyed by some of McKendree's veteran players. Sophomore defensive lineman Lucky Baar rewrote the Bearcats' record book by leading NCAA Division II with 26 1/2 tackles for loss and 18 quarterback sacks. Both statistics also set new program and league records as Baar earned GLVC Defensive Player of the Year honors along with first-team Little All-America accolades from the Associated Press. Baar became the first Bearcat player to earn either honor.

Baar led a group of 10 McKendree players who received All-GLVC awards which included sophomore linebacker A.J. Wentland and junior offensive lineman Derrik Starrett as first-team honorees. In his first year as a starter at middle linebacker, Wentland had a school-record 132 tackles and had at least 10 tackles in a game 10 times during the Bearcats' 11-game schedule.

On the offensive side of the ball, Babcock's Bearcats were just as prolific in 2014. As a team, McKendree established new program marks in nearly every passing category. Led by junior Isaac Fisher, the Bearcats' quarterbacks threw for 2,749 yards while completing nearly 62 percent of their pass attempts.

The season passing average of 249.9 yards per game also set a new team record. McKendree finished in the top third of the GLVC in total offense (428.4 YPG), passing offense (249.9 YPG) and scoring offense (30.1 PPG). During the Bearcats' season-ending five-game win streak, the offensive unit produced 41 points per contest while gaining better than 512 yards per outing.

Fisher became one of the top offensive threats in the GLVC in 2014. In addition to throwing for a career-high 2,722 yards and tying a personal best with 19 touchdown passes, Fisher became the first McKendree quarterback to lead the team in rushing for a season. He gained 764 yards on the ground and led the Bearcats with nine rushing TDs. Under Babcock's tutelage, Fisher was second in the GLVC in both total offense (316.9 YPG) and passing (247.5 YPG).

In his first season at McKendree, Babcock led the Bearcats to four victories, including a thrilling 32-28 come-from-behind win in the 2013 season opener -- which also marked Babcock's head coaching debut -- at Leemon Field against Tiffin University. A total of 11 McKendree players earned All-Conference honors from the Great Lakes Valley Conference during Babcock's rookie season as a head coach, including first-team selections in senior Richie Rebmann and sophomore Brett Pearman.

Babcock came to McKendree after spending five years as an assistant coach at Colorado State University-Pueblo, one of the top NCAA Division II programs in the country. In his last four years at CSU-Pueblo, Babcock served as the ThunderWolves' quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator. Under his leadership, CSU-Pueblo registered back-to-back undefeated regular seasons and claimed Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) championships. The ThunderWolves were the top-ranked team in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) regular-season poll in both 2011 and 2012.

With Babcock at the offensive controls, CSU-Pueblo set 13 team and 15 individual offensive records as the ThunderWolves advanced to the national quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II playoffs in 2012. CSU-Pueblo set new team season standards in every major passing category, including attempts, completions, yards, touchdowns and completion percentage. The ThunderWolves also established new records for total offensive yards, plays and points scored this year.

During the 2012 season, CSU-Pueblo averaged 35.8 points and 442.6 yards of total offense per game this season. The ThunderWolves were ranked first in the RMAC and 11th in NCAA Division II in passing efficiency through games of Dec. 1. In addition, CSU-Pueblo ranked among the top 30 in the nation in scoring offense.

Babcock arrived at CSU-Pueblo after spending the 2007 season as the tight ends coach and director of football operations at the University of San Diego, where he helped the Toreros to a Pioneer Conference championship. Prior to that, Babcock served as the quality control intern for offense for two seasons at the University of Colorado. He served as an assistant in coaching the Buffaloes' offensive line, tight end and special teams.

Babcock began his coaching career at his alma mater, the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). He was an undergraduate and graduate assistant with the Bruins from 2000-04. After spending the 2000-02 season coaching the UCLA linebackers, Babcock shifted to defensive line coach in 2003. He wrapped up his stay at UCLA by guiding the Bruins' offensive line in 2004.

During his stay at UCLA, Babcock helped coach the Bruins to four bowl appearances, and also helped guide the top-ranked defensive unit in the Pac-10 in 2001.

As an undergraduate at UCLA, Babcock was a linebacker and played on the Bruins' 1997 and 1998 Pac-10 championship squads, and played in both the Cotton Bowl (1998) and Rose Bowl (1999). UCLA put together a 20-game win streak during Babcock's playing days. Babcock earned both of his degrees from UCLA -- an undergraduate degree in 2002 along with his master's degree in 2005.

Babcock and his wife Kimberly have two children: Tyler and Emily.
