McKendree -- Last Time Out...

The Bearcats outlasted West Liberty University in double overtime last Saturday at Leemon Field, 16-15. Playing in its first overtime game in 12 years, McKendree took a 16-9 lead on a 15-yard touchdown pass from Elcee Burke to Sean Dowling in the second extra period, and Steven O'Block's added the point after. The Hilltoppers answered with a touchdown to pull within a point, but elected to go for the two-point conversion and the win. West Liberty fumbled the snap, and Tobias Cook recovered the loose ball to give McKendree the win. A.J. Wentland led a strong defensive effort with a game-high 16 tackles along with a sack, pass break-up and fumble recovery. Wentland also became the Bearcats' career leader in tackles with a first-quarter stop. Lucky Baar matched a career-high with 12 tackles and added three more sacks, giving him six on the young season. Austin Weltha finished the day with 10 tackles and a pair of interceptions for McKendree. Shayeen Edwards rushed for a game-high 98 yards on 32 attempts to pace the rushing attack for McKendree. Burke threw for 129 yards on the day, with Dustin Walls catching six passes for 51 yards. Dowling added four receptions for 55 yards. O'Block booted three field goals in the contest, while Monte Wolke set a new team record with a 78-yard punt in the fourth quarter.

Drake -- Last Time Out...

The Bulldogs dropped a 56-28 decision last Saturday on the road at South Dakota State University. Quarterbacks Grant Kraemer and Cody Thibault combined to throw for 224 yards and a pair of touchdowns against the Jackrabbits. Eric Saubert and Keegan Gallery each had six receptions in the effort, with Saubert hauling in a touchdown pass. Conley Wilkins led the ground attack with 67 yards on 18 carries. Drew Lauer registered an 87-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the fourth quarter for Drake. On defense, Jabari Butler had a team-leading 11 tackles at SDSU, including seven solos. Taylor Coleman chipped in with eight stops, while Mike Maize had the Bulldogs' lone quarterback sack in the outing.

LAST MEETING -- McKendree vs. Drake...

On Sept. 2, 2000 in Des Moines, Iowa, McKendree kicked off its 2000 season with a 28-11 loss to Drake. The Bearcats grabbed an early 7-0 lead thanks to a 28-yard touchdown strike from Billy Gray to Kolin Peterson. After the Bulldogs knotted the contest at 7-7, McKendree took its final lead of the day on the first of two safeties against Drake. Just five seconds into the second quarter, a high snap on a punt saw the football sail through the back of the end zone, giving the Bearcats a 9-7 cushion. Oku Satcher and Ricardo Harris combined for a sack of the Bulldogs' quarterback in the end zone midway through the fourth quarter to give McKendree its final points of the day. Allen Walter led a balanced rushing attack for the Bearcats with 52 yards on 10 carries. Kyle Roach added 42 yards on 10 rushes. Gray threw for 70 yards, hitting Clyde Brown, Jr., twice for 16 yards. Defensively, Darius Green paced McKendree with eight tackles, while Harris and Chucky Davis each had seven stops. Playing in his first game for the Bearcats. Cory Wilson came up with six tackles in the contest.

Bearcat Tracks...

BEARCATS vs. THE HAWKEYE STATE: McKendree enters today's game with an overall record of 32-12 against teams from the state of Iowa. The Bearcats have won 11 of their last 14 contests against schools from Iowa. This will be McKendree's first game versus an opponent from the Hawkeye State since dropping a 14-0 decision at Grand View University back on Oct. 15, 2011.

ROAD OPENERS: The Bearcats are 9-11 (.450) in their first road game of the season since returning to the gridiron back in 1996. McKendree snapped a five-game losing streak in road openers last year with a 50-27 triumph at West Liberty University.

BEARCATS TO FACE FAMILIAR FCS FOE: McKendree will be playing its first Football Championship Subdivision (formerly NCAA Division I-AA) opponent since the 2000 season this afternoon against Drake University. The last FCS team that the Bearcats faced was...Drake University. In that meeting, the host Bulldogs posted a 28-11 victory over McKendree in the Bearcats' 2000 season opener.

McKENDREE vs. THE FCS: Today's contest will mark the fifth for McKendree against a Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) -- formerly Division I-AA -- opponent. The Bearcats are 2-2 all-time against such programs:

- **1996 -- Evansville 21, **McKENDREE 8** (at Evansville, Ind.)
- **1997 -- **McKENDREE 30**, Evansville 26 (at Leemon Field)
- **1999 -- **McKENDREE 38**, Dayton 31 (2 OT) (at Dayton, Ohio)
- **2000 -- Drake 28, **McKENDREE 11** (at Des Moines, Iowa)

EXTRA EFFORT: McKendree's 16-15 double-overtime victory against West Liberty University marked the first time in 12 years that the Bearcats have played in an overtime contest. The last time McKendree needed more than 60 minutes to decide the outcome of a game was in 2004, when the Bearcats edged past Saint Ambrose University 38-31 in double overtime. McKendree has now played five overtime games since 1996, and is a perfect 5-0 in those contests.

RALLY 'CATS: The Bearcats' come-from-behind victory over Angelo State on Sept. 1 marked the fourth time in the Mike Babcock Era that the McKendree football team overcame a double-digit deficit to rally for a win. The last time it happened came against Northwood University early in 2015 campaign. The Bearcats trailed the Timberwolves 24-13 before scoring the final 14 points to post a 27-24 triumph at Leemon Field.

PILING UP THE POINTS: In its last 17 regular-season games, McKendree has posted a 14-2 record. The Bearcats have scored in double figures in each of those games, and are averaging 37.7 points per contest during that span. McKendree has hit the 50-point mark five times in that stretch.

78-YARD MONTE: Making his first collegiate start, Monte Wolke set a new McKendree record for longest punt when he boomed a 78-yard effort in the fourth quarter against West Liberty. That broke the previous long punt of 74 yards, which came off the foot of Mark Albertini in a 1999 game at the University of Saint Francis (Ind.).

ELITE 11: McKendree have 11 seniors on its 2016 roster: Lucky Baar, Tyler Brewer, Sean Dowling, Tyler House, Brandon Moody, Steven O'Block, Clint Rattermann, A.J. Wentland, Jeremiah Wilkins, Jabaree Winston and Brandon Zehr.

UNI-TRACKER: McKendree made history of sorts against Angelo State by wearing purple uniform pants for the first time in program history. The purple pants give the Bearcats multiple uniform combinations as they can also be worn with the new white road jerseys. We will track the McKendree football record in 2016 while wearing certain combinations.

THAT'S A FIRST: McKendree and West Liberty played to a 0-0 halftime tie at Leemon Field last Saturday. That is the first time since the Bearcat football program was revived in 1996 that a McKendree contest was scoreless heading into the intermission, marking a span of 211 games.

RECORDS WATCH: A.J. Wentland surpassed Brandon Nigro as the career leader in tackles during the Bearcats' victory at home against West Liberty. Three other McKendree players on the 2016 roster have a chance to become the Bearcats' career leader in at least one statistical category. Listed below are those players, with their current rank and the statistics needed to become the all-time leader in the respective categories:

LUCKY BAAR

- Tackles for Loss -- Second all-time with 51. Oku Satcher holds the Bearcats' career record with 59.
- Quarterback Sacks: Second all-time with 35. Oku Satcher is the program's all-time leader with 38.
- Forced Fumbles: Tied for third with six. Zach Carter and Deveon Moss lead the way with eight.

STEVEN O'BLOCK

- Kick Scoring -- Third all-time with 215 points. Stephen Webb set the Bearcats' career mark with 253.

SEAN DOWLING

- Receiving Yards -- Fifth all-time with 1,001. Cameron James closed his McKendree last year with a program-record 1,614 yards.

SIX THOUSAND AND COUNTING: With its 33-point outburst in the 2016 season opener against Angelo State, the McKendree football program has now scored more than 6,000 points since returning to the gridiron in 1996. The Bearcats have scored 6,037 points entering today's game.

This Date in Bearcat Football History...

Sept. 17, 2005

A touchdown pass in the final 34 seconds lifted host Saint Francis (Ind.) to a 28-21 victory over McKendree in a battle of NAIA top-six teams in Fort Wayne, Ind. The Bearcats built a 21-7 lead on the first play of the second half when Dominique Jones raced 62 yards for a touchdown. But the host Cougars clamped down and rallied with 21 unanswered points to steal the victory. Jones finished with a team-high 99 yards on the ground, while Mike Harrison paced the Bearcats' defensive effort with a season-high 13 tackles.

Sept. 17, 2011

McKendree lost its 2011 road opener at the University of Saint Francis (Ind.), 33-7. Stephen Wallace accounted for the Bearcats' lone touchdown of the afternoon when he scored from a yard out to cap a 16-play, 71-yard drive late in the third quarter. Myron Hicks etched his name into the McKendree record book when he hauled in his 71st career pass to move past Byron Gettis for the team's all-time record. Chris Montgomery gained a team-high 58 yards on 18 carries. Brandon Nigro paced the Bearcats' defense with 13 tackles.

McKendree University Head Football Coach Mike Babcock



The 2016 campaign marks the fourth season that Mike Babcock will serve as the head coach of the McKendree University football program. Babcock was named as the 17th football coach in the history of the Bearcats' program back in December 2013.

In the three-plus years since taking the helm of the Bearcats' program, Babcock has helped lead McKendree through its early steps as NCAA Division II members. The Bearcats have increased their win total in each of Babcock's first three years in Lebanon while leading the team's rise within the Great Lakes Valley Conference ranks as well. Babcock enters the 2016 season with a record of 17-14 at McKendree.

Under Babcock's leadership, the McKendree football program enjoyed a breakthrough season in 2015. The Bearcats turned in the first winning season in the program's NCAA Division II era, going 8-2 overall while finishing second in the GLVC standings at 6-2. McKendree -- which won its final five games of 2014 -- continued its roll into 2015 by opening the year with a five-game win streak. The Bearcats' success was noted by the raters in the American Football Coaches Association Division II poll as the team earned its first-ever vote in the weekly ratings in early November. Along the way, Babcock coached 15 players to All-GLVC honors in 2015, including six first-team selections.

Babcock received the first post-season coaching honor of his McKendree career last fall when he was selected as the HERO Sports 2015 Super Region 4 Coach of the Year. The award placed Babcock on a list of finalists for the HERO Sports 2015 NCAA Division II Coach of the Year.

Offensively, McKendree rewrote the team's record book, setting new program marks for points scored (388), points per game (38.8 PPG), total offense (4,873 yards), passing yards (2,872 yards), completion percentage (.661) and passing touchdowns (23). McKendree also equaled a school record by scoring 51 touchdowns. In addition to leading the GLVC in scoring offense, total offense and rushing offense (200.7 yards per game), the Bearcats finished the year ranked in the top 20 of the final NCAA Division II statistical report in completion percentage, scoring offense and third-down conversion percentage (.480).

The offense explosion in 2015 was led by senior quarterback Isaac Fisher, who capped his final season in a McKendree uniform by being named the GLVC Offensive Player of the Year. Fisher registered school records with 3,595 yards of total offense, 2,792 passing yards with 21 touchdowns through the air. On the ground, Fisher rushed for a team-leading 803 yards with nine more scores. He closed his playing days for the Bearcats as the program's career leader with 10,257 yards of total offense, 780 pass completions, 8,508 passing yards and 64 passing TDs.

Senior wide receiver Cameron James put the final stamp on his four-year McKendree career by taking over the team's career lead in nearly every receiving category. James finished with 150 catches for 1,614 yards and 16 touchdowns. Equally as dangerous in the return game, James set a new McKendree career standard with 62 kick returns. He also took over the program's lead in all-purpose yards with 4,583.

McKendree was just as impressive on the defensive side of the ball in 2015. The Bearcats paced the league in scoring defense, allowing its opponents just 19.8 points per contest. After finishing at the bottom of the conference in pass defense in 2014, McKendree improved dramatically just a year later, closing the 2015 campaign by ranking second overall in the category. The team was fourth in the nation in quarterback sacks per game, averaging 3.5 per outing.

For the second consecutive year, junior linebacker A.J. Wentland set a new program mark for tackles in a season. After ending the 2014 season with 132

tackles in 11 games, Wentland bettered the mark last season with 135 total stops in the Bearcats' 10-game schedule. Wentland, who was a first-team All-GLVC honoree, picked up second-team All-Super Region 4 accolades from the Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCA).

Babcock came to McKendree after spending five years as an assistant coach at Colorado State University-Pueblo, one of the top NCAA Division II programs in the country. In his last four years at CSU-Pueblo, Babcock served as the ThunderWolves' quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator. Under his leadership, CSU-Pueblo registered back-to-back undefeated regular seasons and claimed Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC) championships. The ThunderWolves were the top-ranked team in the final American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) regular-season poll in both 2011 and 2012.

With Babcock at the offensive controls, CSU-Pueblo set 13 team and 15 individual offensive records as the ThunderWolves advanced to the national quarterfinals of the NCAA Division II playoffs in 2012. That year, CSU-Pueblo averaged 35.8 points and 442.6 yards of total offense per game a season. The ThunderWolves were ranked first in the RMAC and 11th in NCAA Division II in passing efficiency.

Babcock arrived at CSU-Pueblo after spending the 2007 season as the tight ends coach and director of football operations at the University of San Diego, where he helped the Toreros to a Pioneer Conference championship. Prior to that, Babcock served as the quality control intern for offense for two seasons at the University of Colorado. He served as an assistant in coaching the Buffaloes' offensive line, tight end and special teams.

Babcock began his coaching career at his alma mater, the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). He was an undergraduate and graduate assistant with the Bruins from 2000-04. After spending the 2000-02 season coaching the UCLA linebackers, Babcock shifted to defensive line coach in 2003. He wrapped up his stay at UCLA by guiding the Bruins' offensive line in 2004.

During his stay at UCLA, Babcock helped coach the Bruins to four bowl appearances, and also helped guide the top-ranked defensive unit in the Pac-10 in 2001.

As an undergraduate at UCLA, Babcock was a linebacker and played on the Bruins' 1997 and 1998 Pac-10 championship squads, and played in both the Cotton Bowl (1998) and Rose Bowl (1999). UCLA put together a 20-game win streak during Babcock's playing days. Babcock earned both of his degrees from UCLA -- an undergraduate degree in 2002 along with his master's degree in 2005.

Babcock and his wife Kimberly have two children: Tyler and Emily.
