SCOUTING THE LAST OUTING

It was in-and-out for the Bearcats on Friday as they handled NAIA-member Hannibal-LaGrange University with ease in McKendree's season home opener and beat the Trojans 80-39. The win moves the Bearcats to a 3-0 overall record start for a second consecutive year with yet to play in GLVC action. Freshman guard Moses Wilson (Aurora, III.) led all scorers with 13 points on a perfect shooting night of 6-for-6, including a three-pointer and four dunks. He supplemented his scoring with three rebounds and a pair of steals.

KEEP PUTTING A LID ON IT!

Since November 17th, and up till this point (November 24th) after anchoring down against Hannibal-LaGrange by holding the Trojans to just 39 total points, McKendree still holds firm at first in all of NCAA Division II scoring defense by limiting their opposition to just 45.3 points per contest. They are also a +4.2 margin over the second-ranked team, which so happens to be GLVC-foe Missouri S&T, who holds opponent scoring to 49.5 points per game.

REBOUND THAT JAWN!

Three McKendree players thus far have averaged 6.0 rebounds or better per game, with two of which are guards (Rini Harris and Andrew Moore) and one is a forward (Noah Franklin). You would have to go back to the 2017-18 season to find the last time a Bearcat team finished the year with three more players who ended the season averaging 6.0 rebounds or greater, with Malcom Mabry (9.6), Nolan Gerling (6.5), and Rathen Carter (6.0).

THREE-AND-OH-YEAH

McKendree is entering their fourth game of the season at a 3-0 mark for a second straight season and a sixth time overall in their 14th year as an NCAA Division II program. Similar to last year, the Bearcats opened their regular season in the annual GLVC/G-MAC Crossover with their third contest being their home-opener. Last year's team averaged a 28.0 point margin of victory through their first three regular season games while this year's team has averaged a 24.0 margin. The program is historically 2-3 in reaching a .500 record when starting the year 3-0 (in Division II era).

HISTORY SHOWCASE

Against Central Missouri, this is the first-ever meeting between the two teams within the NCAA Division II era. As a matter of fact, McKendree has never faced off against a current member of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAA) in its Division II history. Against Concordia-St. Paul, it will also be the two's first matchup in the Division II era, and like Central Missouri, it will be the Bearcats' first contest against a current member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).

ABOUT THE COACHES



GEORGE SUGGS, HEAD COACH

George Suggs has served as the head men's basketball coach at McKendree University since March 23, 2021. Since taking the helm, Suggs has rapidly elevated the Bearcats program to new heights in NCAA Division II. In his first season (2021–22), Suggs guided McKendree to a 14-12 record—marking the highest winning percentage of the program's NCAA DIII era—and led the Bearcats to their first-ever victory in the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC) Tournament. His impact was immediately recognized, earning him HoopDirt.com NCAA Division II Coach of the Week honors in January 2022. The 2022–23 season proved historic, as Suggs led McKendree to its first-ever GLVC Championship, first NCAA Tournament appearance, and a run to the Sweet Sixteen. Under his leadership, former players such as Milos Vicentric became the program's first NCAA Division II All-American, while standout guard Bryson Bultman earned First-Team All-GLVC and Second-Team All-Region honors. Remarkably, Suggs has never missed the postseason as a head coach. Suggs began his coaching journey at McKendree in 2018 as a graduate assistant for two seasons before being promoted to full-time assistant coach in 2020 for one. Prior to coaching, Suggs was a standout 6-foot-10 forward at Bellarmine University, where he scored over 1,000 career points. He was a First-Team All-GLVC selection and the GLVC Defensive Player of the Year in 2015–16. Suggs helped lead the Knights to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including Sweet Sixteen and Final Four runs. Known for his shooting ability, he finished his collegiate career with a 43% three-point percentage and a 77.4% free-throw mark. A native of St. Louis, Missouri, and graduate of Vianney High School, Suggs earned his bachelor's degree in communications from Bellarmine University in 2016 and a master's degree from McKendree University in 2020. He was also a Dean's List honoree during his academic career.



randy Baruth, assistant coach

Randy Baruth is the assistant men's basketball coach at McKendree University. Baruth is entering his first season with the program after a highly successful 13-year tenure as head coach at Saginaw Valley State University (SVSU), where he accumulated a GLIAC (Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Conference Championship, a GLIAC Divisional Championship, an NCAA Midwest Regional Championship, and an NCAA Elite Eight Appearance. He developed 34 GLIAC All-Conference selections, including eight All-Defensive Team honorees and standout Freshman of the Year C.J. Turnage. Baruth's most notable season came in 2015-16, when he led SVSU to a 25-8 record, capturing the GLIAC regular season title, and an NCAA Division II Elite Eight appearance. That year, he was named the GLIAC Coach of the Year. Other program milestones under Baruth's leadership include: •First-ever win over an NCAA Division I program (Western Michigan, Nov. 22, 2021) •GLIAC South Division champions (2021-22) · National No. 1 ranking in NABC Coaches Poll (Dec. 6, 2022) · 15 total appearances each in the NABC Coaches Poll and [former] DDSCS. Media Poll Prior to SVSU, Baruth built his coaching résumé through several impactful leaders. Baruth joined then head coach Tim Miles at North Dakota State University in 2002, when they were a part of the NCAA Division II North Central Conference (NCC) as a Graduate Assistant before he earned his first of many full-time positions, working five years as the lead assistant to legendary Coach Don Meyer at Northern State University are 2004-2009. While at Northern State, Baruth helped lead the Wolves to two NCAA Division II Midwest Regional Sweet Sixteen appearances. Baruth then rejoined Miles' staff at Colorado State University as part of the Mountain West Conference from 2009-2011 as the Director of Player Development in the program's PAC-10 debut. Throughout his career, Baruth has built strong recruiting ties across the U.S. and internationally. Overall, Baruth has developed 58 all-league players, 11 profession



KORBIN FARMER, ASSISTANT COACH

Korbin Farmer is an Area Representative for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) in the Greater St. Louis region. In this role, he supports coaches and athletes at the middle school, high school, and collegiate levels, including at McKendree University and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, by leading team Bible studies and gameday chapels. Farmer began his coaching career at McKendree University in 2020 as a graduate assistant under former Head Coach Chris Foster, and continued under current Head Coach George Suggs during the 2021–22 season. He then transitioned to a volunteer assistant role in 2022. A former standout collegiate player, Farmer played four seasons at Millikin University, appearing in 93 games with 44 starts. He tallied 465 points, 340 rebounds, 64 blocks, and earned multiple academic and leadership honors, including being honored as a four-time CCIW (College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin) Jack Swartz Award recipient, and served as a two-time President of the Millikin Council. Farmer graduated summa cum laude from Millikin University in 2020 with a bachelor's degree in mathematics and philosophy and completed his MBA at McKendree University in 2022, graduating as the program's top student. A Columbia, Illinois native, Farmer helped lead his high school to its first-ever IHSA (Illinois High School Association) 3A regional title and scored over 1,000 career points.



Donovan Franklin. Graduate assistant

McKendree University Men's Basketball welcomed Donovan Franklin as the program's Graduate Assistant Coach, joining Head Coach George Suggs' staff in the summer of 2024. A decorated former player and rising coach, Franklin brings a wealth of experience at multiple levels of the game—from high school to professional basketball, both domestically and internationally, Franklin's first season on the Bearcats' staff (2024-25) saw immediate impact. He helped guide McKendree to its best start in GLVC conference play (3-0) since joining the league in 2012-13. The Bearcats finished the season with an overall record of 14-14 and placed 8th in the GLVC, carning their fifth consecutive appearance—and sixth overall—in the GLVC Championship Tournament. Under Franklin's guidance, McKendree produced a GLVC Second Team All-Conference selection as well as an All-Defensive Team honorce. Before beginning his coaching career, Franklin enjoyed a successful professional and collegiate playing career. He played one season overseas with Killester Basketball Club in Ireland's Men's Super League and spent two seasons with the St. Louis Spirits of the ABA (American Basketball Association). Franklin reached the 1,000-point milestone at NCAA Division II Pittsburg State University (Pitt State) in the MIAA. In 54 games played (49 starts), he averaged 32 minutes per game and sort 48.7% from the field. He earned Third Team All-MIAA honors in 2019 and was an Honorable Mention All-MIAA selection in 2018. Prior to Pitt State, Franklin competed at NCAA Division I Indiana State University in the Missouri Valley Conference. During the 2016-17 season, he appeared in 26 games (2 starts), averaging 4.2 points and 1.5 rebounds in 12.8 minutes per contest. Franklin began his collegiate career at Gulf Coast State College in Panama City, Florida—the same junior college attended by Indiana State legend Carl Nicks. In his lone season at Gulf Coast, Franklin led the team in scoring at 14.9 points per game while shooting 45.5% from the field and grabbing 4.3 reb



JOE BUHLMAN, GRADUATE ASSISTANT

Joe Buhlman joined the McKendree University Men's Basketball staff in 2025 as a Graduate Assistant, bringing with him a wide-ranging background in coaching, player development, operations, and leadership across multiple levels of the game. Prior to McKendree, Buhlman served as head coach at Beach Basketball in Los Angeles, where he led teams ages 12-16 to notable success. His teams captured wins at high-level events such as Made Hoops and defeated multiple teams from the UA and PUMA circuits. Renowned for instilling a culture of accountability, Buhlman emphasized not just athletic excellence, but academic and personal growth among his players. His coaching excellence earned him a spot on staff at the prestigious Pangos All-American Camp in Las Vegas, where he coached multiple 4- and 5-star recruits. Buhlman's collegiate experience includes time at Pepperdine University, where he contributed to both the men's and women's basketball programs. As a two-year manager for the Waves' men's team, he supported practice preparation and day-to-day operations in the highly competitive West Coast Conference. Additionally, he served as a practice player for the women's team, providing high-level competition and gaining in-depth knowledge of Division I systems and strategies. Beyond the college scene, Buhlman worked with West Coast Elite/All in Elite, one of the top grassroots basketball programs in the nation. There, he specialized in social media outreach and brand development, helping connect with dozens of prospective student-athletes each week. Buhlman's player development expertise was also honed at the Ultimate Fieldhouse in Walnut Creek, California, where he coached using Shoot360's cutting-edge technology. He further contributed to youth development through roles with Excel in Basketball Camps, NextLevel Basketball, and De La Salle High School's summer programs. As a senior at De La Salle, he captained the varsity team to the 2020 North Coast Section Division I Championship and was honored with the Spartan Award for
