COACHES:

CLINT CONQUE is in his 13th season at the helm of the UCA football program. He has an **93-53-0** overall record and is the winningest coach in the long history of UCA football, dating back to 1908.

Conque came to UCA from the offensive coordinator position at Louisiana Tech in 2000. He passed UCA Sports Hall of Famer Harold Horton as the winningest coach in school history with the win over Eastern Illinois in 2010. Conque and Horton are the only two coaches in school history to reach the 70-win mark.

Conque led the Bears to their first-ever NCAA Playoff appearance in 2001. UCA finished 9-3 that season, the most wins in a year since the 1992 season. He took them back to the playoffs in 2005, winning two straight road games and advancing to the national quarterfinals.

His Bears finished the 2008 season with the best record in the Southland Conference at 6-1 but were ineligible for the league title due to their transition. Conque was named the SLC Coach of the Year that season.

A year ago, Conque took the Bears to their first-ever Division I Playoff appearance, and won the first road playoff game by a Southland Conference team since 2004, beating Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, Tenn. He was named a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award for the second time last season.

Conque, 51, is a Louisiana native who played collegiately at Nicholls State after graduating from Catholic High School in Baton Rouge and playing two years at Southwest Mississippi Junior College.

Conque was a first-team AP All-American as a outside linebacker at Nicholls State. He was inducted into the Nicholls State Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006. His previous coaching stops were at Louisiana Tech, Samford University and McNeese State.

MATT VIATOR is in his seventh season as the head coach of the Cowboys. His record at McNeese is 49-21, while his overall head coaching record is the same.

Viator, a Lake Charles native and a 1986 McNeese graduate, has won three SLC championships at his alma mater. Viator coached high

RED BEANS & RICE BOWL:

The Bears and Cowboys will meet in the fifth "Red Beans & Rice Bowl" on Saturday in Lake Charles. UCA is 3-1 in the previous games, with all three of those wins coming in Conway. UCA has retained the trophy the past two years.



THE SERIES:

The overall series is tied 3-3, with five of those games coming since UCA joined the Southland Conference in 2006. UCA is 3-0 at home in Conway and 0-3 in games played in Lake Charles, La.

LAST WEEK: UCA 34, Nicholls State 114

UCA dominated the second half, outscoring Nicholls State 21-0 and holding the Colonels to just 70 yards of offense after halftime.

Junior quarterback Wynrick Smothers completed 31 of 43 passes for 289 yards, including a 13-yard touchdown pass to senior Dominique Croom. UCA rushed for 222 yards, led by senior Jackie Hinton with 106 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries.

Senior receiver/returner Jesse Grandy tied the school single-game record with 13 receptions for 111 yards, and had a highlight-reel punt return for a touchdown called back by penalty.

Senior RB Terence Bobo and sophomore QB Jacoby Walker added rushing touchdowns and Eddie Camara kicked field goals of 42 and 22 yards. UCA finished with 511 yards of total offense.

LAST YEAR: UCA 21, McNeese State 18

The Bears jumped out to a 21-7 lead early in the second quarter, then held on as the Cowboys made it close at the end.

UCA had two big plays in the first half, an 81-yard touchdown pass from Nathan Dick to Dominique Croom and a 98-yard fumble return for another score by middle linebacker Frank Newsome. Dick also hit Brett Soft with a 25-yard TD pass for the Bears' 21 points.

McNeese came back with a 27-yard field goal by Josh Lewis and a 4-yard pass from Cody Stroud to Devio Edmonson with 3:43 to play.

UCA finished with only 256 total yards of offense, while

McNeese had 422. UCA rushed for 55 yards on 29 attempts. Stroud completed 24 of 38 passes for 312 yards with 1 TD and 2 interceptions for the Cowboys.

BY THE NUMBERS:

A) Senior receiver Dominique Croom had one of the top receiving performances in school history against Murray State, catching 10 passes for 184 yards and a touchdown against Murray State.

That yardage is the fifth best in school history, and the highest total since 2004 for an individual receiver. For his career, Croom has 120 catches (6th all time) for 1,554 yards (11th) and 14 touchdowns. He has topped the 100-yard mark twice this season.

B) UCA rushed for 353 yards against Bacone. It was the most rushing yards in the Clint Conque era (12+ years). The 153 rushing yards by Willie Matthews was the most since Brent Grimes had 155 yards on 11 carries vs. Nicholls State on Oct. 24, 2009.

The 573 total yards of offense is the most since the Bears rolled up 556 yards against Texas State last season.

C) UCA's defense held Bacone to 0 for 15 on third-down conversions. Bacone finished with only 109 yards of total offense (31 rushing, 78 passing)

D) The 70 points scored against Bacone was the most since the Bears put up 79 against Central Methodist in 1976. The most points scored by UCA since moving to NCAA Division I was a 63-point effort (63-21) against Texas State in 2007.

E) Sophomore placekicker Eddie Camara tied the school single-game record by kicking 10 PATs against Bacone. The feat had been accomplished two previous times, the last in 1976 (Garry Odom vs. Central Methodist). The other was by Harold Henderson against Arkansas State in 1922.

F) UCA had the ball for 10:26 of the fourth quarter against Sam Houston two weeks ago, scoring two TDs to overcome a 10-point deficit.

G) UCA and SFA combined for 13 fumbles and 3 interceptions in a downpour at Homer Bryce Stadium. SFA lost 6 of 10 fumbles, while UCA lost 2 of 3. The Bears returned one 72 yards for a TD.

THE CONFERENCES:

The Bears have been members of the Southland Conference since they moved to Division I FCS in 2006. UCA's record in SLC games is officially 25-13. The Bears also beat two SLC teams (Sam Houston & Stephen F. Austin) in their first year in the league when they did not play a full league schedule.

The Cowboys have been in the Southland Conference since 1972 and have an overall conference record of 189-82-5 over 40 seasons.

NATIONAL POLLS:

The Bears jumped up to No. 17 in the FCS Coaches' Poll and to No. 21 in The Sports Network poll after the win over Nicholl State last Saturday. McNeese State sits at Nos. 15/19 this week.

UCA will play five teams this season that were either ranked or receiving votes in the preseason polls. They include Sam Houston State (No. 1), SFA, Murray State, McNeese State and Eastern Illinois.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK:

UCA failed to have one of the Southland conference players of the week for the first time this season this week, although it had two honorable mentions (Wynrick Smothers/Jonathan Woodard).

UCA got its sixth SLC Player of the Week honor in just five weeks last week when Woodard earned the defensive award.

Woodard, a redshirt freshman from Brentwood, Tenn., forced two fumbles and recovered three, including a 72-yard return for a TD in the

fourth quarter against SFA. He also had 2 tackles for loss.

UCA QB Wynrick Smothers earned his second honor of the season two weeks ago. Smothers completed 24 of 41 passes for 318 yards and 2 TDs, and also ran for another score against No. 3 Sam Houston State.

Sophomore wide receiver Dezmin Lewis earned the SLC Special Teams Player of the Week two weeks ago. He returned a blocked punt for a TD and a bad snap over the punter's head for another score. Lewis also had a TD reception.

Smothers was the SLC Offensive Player of the Week, while senior receiver/returner Jesse Grandy was the SLC Special Teams Player of the Week in Week 2 against Murray State.

Smothers completed 31 of 41 passes for 358 yards (all career highs) and five touchdowns to five different receivers. Grandy returned a punt 72 yards for a touchdown and finished with 238 all-purpose yards (73 receiving, 75 kick return, 90 punt return).

Linebacker Rojae Jackson earned the SLC's Defensive Player of the Week in Week 1 against Ole Miss. UCA now has won 32 SLC Player of the Week awards since officially being eligible for league awards in 2007.

ON THE STRIPES:

The Bears finished a perfect 5-0 on "The Stripes" last season, their new purple & gray striped turf field, and improved that mark to 8-0 with wins over Sam Houston State and Nicholls State so far this season. UCA has three remaining home games, next week against Lamar, against Northwestern State on Nov. 3 and against Eastern Illinois on Nov. 17.

Over the past seven seasons, UCA's home record is 38-8, including 7-0 in 2008 and 5-0 last season.

The turf is GeoSurface, the same that was put down on UCA's baseball field (Bear Stadium) and softball field (Farris Field) over the past two years. The field features alternating purple and gray panels every five yards, with a large midfield logo and two large logos behind both end zones.

UCA was the last team in the Southland Conference to change from natural grass to artificial turf.

NATIONAL RANKINGS:

Junior quarterback Wynrick Smothers is ranked 7th in the nation in points responsible for (17.0). He is 11th in total offense (1,708), 13th in completions per game (23.5) and 19th in pass efficiency (145.93).

Senior WR/KR Jesse Grandy is 10th in kickoff returns (29.4).

The Bears are first in the nation in tackles for loss (8.83 per game), 4th in fourth-down conversions (90%), tied for 6th in interceptions (10), 6th in punt returns (20.38), 8th in scoring offense (39.0), tied for 8th in fumbles recovered (8), 16th in turnover margin (+7) and 19th in kickoff returns (24.39).

PICKED OFF:

The Bears have recorded 10 interceptions this season, with eight different players grabbing one. Juniors Radarius Winston and Josh Jones are the only players with two interceptions.

The latest one was by true freshman Dillion Winfrey (Bryant, Ark.) against Nicholls State.

Through six games, the Bears are well past halfway to last

year's total of 17 interceptions. Jestin Love had a team-high five last season. He also had a team-high six interceptions in 2010.

NICHOLLS BY THE NUMBERS:

UCA ran 89 offensive plays to just 41 for Nicholls State on Saturday. The Bears finished with 30 first downs compared to 12 by the Colonels.

UCA held Nicholls State to under 100 yards rushing (98), the third team that has rushed for less than 100 yards against the Bears. Murray State had 67 yards and Bacone had 31.

Nicholls averaged 9.0 yards per play in a 20-point loss.

FIRST TIMERS:

Four players got their first career starts last week against Nicholls State. True freshman Dillion Winfrey started at cornerback and had a career-high 5 tackles and his first career interception. Sophomore Marvin Mitchell started at safety and had 2 solo tackles.

Redshirt freshman Alex Willis started at center for the first time, while sophomore Clay Murphy got the start at one receiver position and caught a career-high 5 passes for 24 yards.

SECOND WIND:

The Bears have allowed less than 90 yards in the second half of their past two games.

UCA held Stephen F. Austin to just 85 second-half yards two weeks ago, then shut out Nicholls State last week with only 70 yards of total offense after halftime.

RUSHED:

The Bears had their second game of the season with 200+ rushing yards last week against Nicholls State. UCA finished with 222 net yards on the ground, led by senior Jackie Hinton with 106 yads on 18 carries. The Bears averaged 4.8 per carry.

UCA also had more than 200 yards against Bacone, rushing for 353 yards in that game, an average of 7.5 per play.

OPPOSITE STARTS:

The Bears opened the 2011 season with a 1-3 record in September and an 0-1 mark in Southland Conference play after losing their opener at Sam Houston State.

That record included two FBS losses (Arkansas State, Louisiana Tech).

This year, UCA was just the opposite at 3-1 and 1-0 after a win over SHSU in Conway. The lone loss was in the season opener at SEC foe Ole Miss.

In 2011, UCA strung together seven regular-season victories and another in the first round of the FCS Playoffs before losing again.

SPORTS HALL OF FAME:

UCA inducted the Class of 2012 into the UCA Sports Hall of Fame at a banquet last Saturday. The newest class includes: John Cameron (football), Anita Curry (basketball), David Evans (football), Mickey Johnson (basketball/coaching), George Jones (baseball/golf/basketball/coaching), J.E. Lawrence (football/administration), John Robinson (basketball/track/coaching), Bill Shimek (football/basketball/baseball) and Verlon Spencer (football).

This year's class is the 12th to be inducted.

THIRD AND NOT MUCH:

The Bears have held their last four opponents to just 12 of 54 (22%) on third-down conversions.

Bacone was 0 for 15, Sam Houston was 6 for 15, SFA was 6 of 16 and Nicholls was 1 of 7.

For the season, UCA's opponents have converted 25 of 83 (30%) third downs. UCA is 37 of 94 (39%) on third downs and 9 of 10 (90%) on fourth downs.

INJURIES:

The Bears will play the remainder of the season without senior running back Anthony Blackmon, who injured his knee last month and had surgery. Blackmon had 10 yards on 5 carries in three games this season.

UCA should have linebacker Zach Bush back this week after missing three of six games this season. Linebacker Rojae Jackson is questionable after an injury last week against Nicholls. Safety Karl Brady is expected back after missing last week's game.

BEHIND THE LINE:

UCA's defense recorded 11 plays of minus yards against Ole Miss in the season opener, including three sacks. The Rebels lost 32 yards on the 11 plays.

UCA's sacks were turned in by Rojae Jackson (1.5), Markeith Gaines (1) and Radarius Winston (0.5). Blake Childress had a team-high 3 tackles for loss. Winston also had an interception, while Josh Jones blocked a field goal attempt and Jeremy Jester forced a fumble.

Against Murray State, UCA had 11 more lost-yardage plays, including 5 sacks (Nate O'Connor, Jonathan Woodard, Marvin Mitchell, Jeremy Jester). UCA also intercepted three passes.

Two weeks ago against Bacone, it was 11 more tackles for loss. The amazing part of that stat was it was 11 different players.

The Bears had seven TFLs last week (and an interception) against Sam Houston State and added 9 more against SFA.

The Bears are leading the nation at the FCS level in tackles for loss (8.8 per game). UCA's individual leader is junior middle linebacker Justin Heard with 8 TFLs, followed by end Jonathan Woodard (6.0) and linebacker Blake Childress (5.5).

FUMBLE-ITIS:

UCA linebacker Seth Allison forced three fumbles against SFA, while defensive end Jonathan Woodard recovered three, including one he returned 72 yards for a touchdown. Other fumble recoveries came from Rojae Jackson, Matt Hornbuckle and Markeith Gaines. Woodard forced two of the fumbles and Hornbuckle had the other.

Nicholls State only had one turnover last week.

vs. LOUISIANA:

The UCA football program has a 16-12 all-time record against schools from the state of Louisiana. The Bears were 4-1 last season, including home wins over McNeese State and Southeastern Louisiana and road wins over Nicholls and Northwestern State. The loss was at Louisiana Tech.

UCA will face four Louisiana schools over the next five weeks, starting

with Nicholls State last Saturday.

The UCA roster has nine players hailing from the state of Louisiana.

THE SUITES:

First Security Field at Estes Stadium debuted a dozen new luxury suites for the home opener on Sept. 15.

The 12 suites are located above the stands on the east side of the stadium, connected to the new Bear Hall residence hall. UCA's athletic administration offices are moving into the floor just below the suites, also with a view of Estes Stadium.



GRANDY RETURN:

Grandy's 72-yard punt return for a touchdown against Murray State was the first for a UCA player since 2007. Tristan Jackson last returned one 69 yards against Stephen F. Austin on Nov. 10, 2007.



PLAYING UP:

The Bears faced their first BCS opponent and their first South-eastern Conference foe in Ole Miss last month, losing 49-27 after leading 20-14 at halftime.

The crowd of 50,545 at Vaught-Hemingway Stadium in Oxford was the largest to ever watch a UCA athletic team.

SLC HONORS:

The Bears open the season with nine players on the preseason All-Southland Conference team. They include first-teamers Seth Allison (graduate linebacker), Jackie Hinton (senior running back) and Dominique Allen (junior offensive lineman).

The second-teamers are senior receiver Jesse Grandy, senior receiver Dominique Croom, senior offensive lineman Corey Howard, sophomore placekicker Eddie Camara, junior defensive tackle Matt Hornbuckle and junior safety Jestin Love.

UCA returns six of its nine All-SLC players from last season.

APR LEADERS:

The Bears have led the Southland Conference in APR (Academic Progress Rate) for the past two years, one of only five schools in the nation to lead their respective conferences in consecutive years.

UCA's score of 951 was 13 points higher than the second-place school in the SLC and was the highest of any school in the state of Arkansas.

Among Arkansas schools, Arkansas State was second at 948, followed by Arkansas at 936 and Arkansas-Pine Bluff at 928.

CONFERENCE FINISH:

The Bears finished 6-1 in Southland Conference play for the second time in four seasons last year. Sam Houston State, which beat UCA in September, won the league at 7-0.

UCA also finished 6-1 and in first place in the league back in 2008 but was ineligible for the official conference title or postseason berth because of its transition to Division I.

ESTES CROWDS:

The Bears set a new stadium attendance record in the season opener on Sept. 1, 2011. The Bears and the Henderson State Reddies, old rivals through the Arkansas Intercollegiate Conference (NAIA) and Gulf Conference (Division II) days, played in front of a standing-room only crowd of 12,755 at First Security Field at Estes Stadium.

The East stands overflowed before the kickoff, with students and late-arriving fans pouring into the north end zone early in the first quarter. The top 10 crowds in stadium history have all come in the past four seasons. The biggest crowd prior to the HSU game was 12,620 against Nicholls State on Nov. 3, 2007. Second on the list is a crowd of 12,312 against Sam Houston State on Oct. 11, 2008.

A crowd of 11,127 for the SFA game on "Band Day" on Oct. 1 was No. 7 on the list.

HOME RECORD:

Over the past seven seasons, the Bears are 38-8 at home at First Security Field at Estes Stadium, including 7-0 in 2008 and 5-0 last season.

The lone losses were to South Dakota State in 2007, North Alabama in the NCAA Division II playoff quarterfinals in 2005, to Valdosta State in 2004 and to SFA, Texas State and North Dakota in 2009, and to Northwestern State and Sam Houston State in 2010.

SENIOR CLASS:

UCA has 15 seniors on the roster for the 2012 season. They include: WR Jesse Grandy, RB Jackie Hinton, DB Desmond Wilcox, LB Seth Allison, RB Terence Bobo, RB Anthony Blackmon (out with injury), DB Rojae Jackson, P Kevin Buford, WR Brett Soft, DE Jeremy Jester, OL Arturo

Hernandez (out with injury), OL Corey Howard, DT Larry Duvall, DE Devin Hawkins and DT Justin Williams.



THE LOSSES:

The Bears lost four games last season (9-4), all to teams that won conference championships.

They lost to the No. 1 FCS team Sam Houston State, the SLC champion. They lost to FBS Arkansas State, the Sun Belt champion. They lost in overtime to FBS Louisiana Tech, the Western Athletic Conference champion. And they lost in the second round of the FCS Playoffs to Montana, the Big Sky champ.

All four games were on the road.

Those three teams were a combined 43-12 overall and 19-1 in their respective conferences last season.

SOLID SECONDARY:

One of the strengths of the 2012 squad should be the defensive secondary, led by All-SLC selection and 2010 SLC Freshman of the Year Jestin Love at strong safety.

Junior free safety Radarius Winston, a starter in 2010, returns after missing all last season with a foot injury. Junior starters Dominique Brown and Marcus Peters return at cornerback, along with junior Josh Jones and senior Desmond Wilcox.

Junior safety Karl Brady is actually listed in the first two-deep as a co-starter with Love at strong safety.

Love had 11 career interceptions in just two seasons, including three returned for touchdowns. He is currently second in interception return yards (236) in school history and tied for second in interception returns for touchdown (3).

WINNING STREAK:

The Bears closed the 2011 regular season with a seven-game winning streak with the victory over Texas State on Nov. 12, then pushed it to eight games with a first-round playoff victory at Tennessee Tech.

It was the longest winning streak for the Bears since moving to NCAA Division I FCS in 2006 and the longest overall since an eight-game run in 2005 from a team that finished 11-3.

SPREADING THE WEALTH:

UCA quarterbacks completed passes to 16 different receivers last season, with seven different ones catching 20+ passes.

Four of the top five receivers are returning, including No. 1 Jesse Grandy (49-788), No. 2 Dominique Croom (38-518), Nov. 4 Terence Bobo (28-290) and No. 5 Dezmin Lewis (27-386).

Nine different players caught passes in Week 1 at Ole Miss, led by Lewis with 6 catches for 41 yards and a TD. Nine caught passes at Murray State, five of which caught touchdown passes. Eight caught passes against Bacone and just five against Sam Houston and five again in the rain at SFA. Six caught passes against Nicholls, including first-timer Clay Murphy (5 catches).

FIRST ROAD WIN:

The Bears are the first team from the Southland Conference to win an FCS playoff game on the road since Sam Houston State beat Eastern Washington 45-34 in 2004.



Sam Houston then lost 34-13 at Montana in the semifinals.

FAMOUS ALUMS:

UCA's most famous football alumnus is Monte Coleman, who played 16 seasons (1979-94) with the Washington Redskins and won three Super Bowl titles. Coleman was a linebacker and safety at UCA from 1975-78 and is currently the head football coach at Arkansas-Pine Bluff.

Other former UCA football players include wide receiver Willie Davis (KC Chiefs, Houston Oilers, Tennessee Titans); defensive end Jacob Ford (Tennessee Titans, 6th rd, 2007) and Larry Hart (Jacksonville Jaguars, 5th rd, 2009).

UCA's most famous non-football alum is Scottie Pippen, a six-time NBA champion and two-time Olympic Dream Teamer.

POSTSEASON HISTORY:

UCA made its first NCAA Division I FCS Playoff appearance last season in just its second year of postseason eligibility, reaching the second round before falling at perennial power Montana.

The Bears made two trips to the NCAA Playoffs while at the Division II level. They lost a first-round game at Catawba in 2001 and then advanced to the quarterfinals in 2005. UCA went on the road and beat Albany State 28-20 and Presbyterian (52-28), then lost 41-38 in overtime at home to North Alabama.

UCA had beaten fellow Gulf South Conference team North Alabama in double overtime in the regular season matchup, also in Conway.

During their NAIA days, UCA won three Division I national championships, in 1984, 1985 and 1991. The first two were co-championships as the Bears tied Carson-Newman 19-19 and Hillsdale (MI) 10-10. The 1991 title was won outright with a 19-16 victory over Central State (Ohio).

IN-STATE PLAYERS:

The Bears have 24 players from the state of Arkansas on the 2012 roster, including 11 listed on this week's depth chart.

UCA's top two returning tacklers, Seth Allison and Justin Love, are both from in-state, while two of the three tailbacks (Terence Bobo, Anthony Blackmon) and the top receiver (Jesse Grandy) are from Arkansas.

ALL-AROUND ALLISON:

Graduate linebacker Seth Allison led the Bears in tackles last season with 110, and also added 15.5 tackles for loss (-73) and 4 sacks (-38).

He ranked fifth in the SLC in tackles and tied for fourth in tackles for

loss. Allison also recorded 2 interceptions, 2 breakups, 2 forced fumbles and 1 fumble recovery.

His best game came against FCS national runnerup Sam Houston State when he had a career-high 16 tackles (12 solo) and 3.5 tackles for loss in the road loss.

Allison was named UCA's Male Student-Athlete of the Year at last month's Bear Nation Celebration banquet. He is also a two-time member of the SLC All-Academic team who is currently working on his master's degree. He graduated with a degree in finance.

UP FRONT:

The Bears lost four starters on the offensive line from last year, all seniors who exhausted their eligibility. They were Logan Roubique, Joe Lehocky, Brad Jakel and Matt Dickerson.

The Bears have one true freshman, two redshirt freshmen, four sophomores, two juniors and one senior listed in their two-deep on the offensive line. The top returnees are junior All-SLC selection Dominique Allen (6-3, 295) and senior Corey Howard (6-1, 290). Two players, sophomore Cole Caruthers and redshirt freshman Kyle Stouffer, will fill big roles this season.

Senior Arturo Hernandez suffered an achilles injury during summer workouts and is out for the season.

Last year's offensive line allowed just 15 sacks while throwing 462 times for 3,650 yards in 13 games.

ON THE TUBE:

UCA will have two games televised on the SLC TV Network this season, vs. Sam Houston State on Sept. 22 in Conway and vs. Northwestern State on Nov. 3 in Conway.

UCA's record in televised games over the past 10 seasons is 14-7.

WINNING SEASONS:

The Bears recorded their seventh winning season in the past eight last year, and their 31st in the last 36 years (dating back to 1976).

UCA tied the school record for wins six years ago (11-3) and finished 8-3 in both 2004 and 2006. They are a combined 57-29 over the past seven seasons, five of those at the NCAA FCS level.

WINNING WAYS:

UCA entered the 2012 season as the winningest college football team in the state of Arkansas since 2001. Their best outing was an 11-3 record back in 2005 when they reached the quarterfinal round of the NCAA Division II Playoffs and tied the school record for victories. Here are the records since 2001.
