Quick Hits

- Matt Viator won his 50th career game as head coach at McNeese... he has moved into a tied for 4th all-time on the school's coaching chart for most wins, tied with A.I. Ratcliff who was the school's second head coach and compiled a 50-42-2 record from 1946-54
- Game will be televised by Southland TV for the second consecutive week... it's the third straight game to be televised... Oct. 20 game at Sam Houston State was broadcast by Comcast SportsNet Houston
- Junior RB Marcus Wiltz ran for his third 100-yard game of the season when he rushed for 111 on 19 carries... the first two yards he picked up on Saturday put him at 1,000 in his career... he has rushed for 1,109 yards in his career
- Champlain Babin topped the 1,000 career rushing yards mark against Central Arkansas and now has 1,089 in his career
- A week after setting a career high with 15 tackles at Sam Houston State, safety Terence Cahee matched that with 15 in the win over Stephen F. Austin
- With 2 catches on Saturday, Darius Carey has now caught at least one pass in every game as a Cowboy (19 straight games)
- Junior QB Cody Stroud set a personal best with 3 TD passes in a game in Saturday's win over SFA... Stroud has contributed to at least one touchdown every game this season
- Two of McNeese's conference losses are by a combined two points (25-24 at SLU, 27-26 vs. UCA)
- Cowboys hold a 25-11 lead in the all-time series over Nicholls State including a 12-4 advantage in Thibodaux
- Matt Viator is 5-1 against the Colonels as a head coach and has won the last three meetings
- Academic rates are out and McNeese football has set a record with an APR of 961... numbers won't be officially released until April but the 961 is the highest recorded by McNeese football in school history
- Outscored opponents 154-61 in first half for the season
- Collected 450th all-time win against Weber State
- Blue Wall defense has 12 sacks through 8 games. Last year, the Cowboys totaled 13 sacks in 11 games
- McNeese's win over Middle Tennessee on Aug. 30 was the school's third over an FBS school since 2000 (3-12)
- The Cowboys' 301 rushing yards at Weber State was the most since gaining 311 against Central Arkansas in 2007
- McNeese is the dean of the Southland Conference, having joined the league in 1972
- Cowboys have won 13 Southland championships - more than three times more than the next current league foe
- McNeese played in the 1997 and 2002 FCS national championship game - falling 10-9 to Youngstown State in 1997 and 34-14 to Western Kentucky in 2002
- The Pokes have made 14 FCS playoff appearances, more than double the amount of the next Southland team

MCNEESE VS. NICHOLLS SERIES HAS EXCITING HISTORY

McNeese leads the all-time series against the Colonels by a 25-11 margin and has won the last three meetings, but the series has had some excitement over the years.

- Last year, the Cowboys trailed 10-7 at the half before scoring 17 third quarter points to open up the game
- In 2008, Nicholls hit a 37 yard FG with 2:23 to play to put the Colonels up 38-27 but the Cowboys came back and scored a TD and a 2-point conversion to cut it to 38-35 with 1:01 to play... an onside attempt by McNeese was recovered by the Colonels as the visitors upset the No. 12 team in the country
- In 2001, the Cowboys secured the SLC championship with a 7-point win after scoring the game-winning touchdown with 14:55 to play in the 4th quarter
- In 1998, Nicholls scored on a 45-yard pass with 8 seconds remaining to defeat the Cowboys 31-30 in a SLC championship year for McNeese
- In 1992, the game against Nicholls marked the debut of QB Kerry Joseph who entered the game in the second half and McNeese trailing 14-7... Joseph led the Cowboys to a 21-17 win and scored the game-winning TD on a 10-yard run with 1:45 left in the game... McNeese would end up finishing the season with a perfect 7-0 league mark

THIRD OF THREE STRAIGHT TV GAMES THIS SATURDAY

Saturday will mark the third and final three consecutive games to be televised - two by Southland TV and one (Sam Houston State) on Comcast SportsNet Houston... Southland TV can be watched in Lake Charles on the CW Network (channel 7) and also on Channel 30 on DirecTV.

VIATOR REACHES MILESTONE WIN

With the 35-24 win over Stephen F. Austin on Saturday, head coach Matt Viator has now notched 50 victories in his career at McNeese.

- Tied for 4th on the school all-time career win list with A.I. Ratcliffe (50-42-2 from 1946-54)
- Second fastest to get to 50 wins in career in school history
- Most wins among Southland head coaches at their respective schools
- Tied for 9th on the SLC list for all-time wins

MAKING A PUSH FOR THE POSTSEASON

If McNeese wins its remaining three games, the Cowboys will finish 8-3 on the season. Will that be enough to get them an at-large bid into the 20-team FCS national playoffs? Here's why it should

- At 8-3, the Cowboys will post at least the second best overall won-loss record in the Southland Conference, a league that should garner 2, possibly 3, playoff spots
- Should McNeese win out, that'll give the squad two wins over FBS schools (Middle Tennessee State and Texas-San Antonio)... no other team in the nation would have that on its resume
- Sure close losses don't factor in, but the Cowboys lost two conference games by a total of two points and both came with less than three minutes to play in the contest
- McNeese would have the minimum of 7 Division I wins that most committee members look at when selecting at-large teams

STROUD, THOMAS RECOGNIZED BY THE CFPA

McNeese quarterback Cody Stroud and cornerback Seth Thomas have been recognized as the College Football Performance Awards SLC players of the week after the Cowboys' 35-24 conference win over Stephen F. Austin on Saturday

- Stroud completed 18 of 29 passes for 188 yards and three touchdowns... he also did not throw an interception
- Thomas picked off a pass with 4:18 to play in the 4th quarter that lead to a touchdown run and give McNeese its margin of victory.



BMW EXPRESS BACK IN ACTION

McNeese running back corps of Champlain Babin (B), Javaris Murray (M), and Marcus Wiltz (W) continues to be one of, if not the most, dominant offensive backfield trio in the Southland Conference.

- Two are ranked in the top 10 in the league in rushing - Wiltz (3rd, 68.7), Murray (4th, 57.1)
- The trio has accounted for 1,137 of McNeese's 1,671 rushing yards for the season and 6 tds
- Averaging 5.1 yards per carry
- Wiltz leads the team with three 100-yard rushing games on the season

WILTZ, BABIN REACH CAREER MILESTONE

Running backs Marcus Wiltz and Champlain Babin have topped the 1,000 career rushing yards mark - Babin earlier in the season and Wiltz this past Saturday

- Babin has rushed for 1,089 yards in his career and needs 384 more to break into the school's all-time career rushing leaders top 25 list
- Wiltz needed 2 yards on Saturday to crack 1,000 and ran for 111, giving him 1,109 in his career

WILTZ BRINGS 4TH QUARTER MAGIC

Marcus Wiltz is definitely the go-to back when the Cowboys need yards in the fourth quarter. Due to either games getting out of hand or being injured, Wiltz has played in the 4th quarter just four times this season but his presence has been known. In those four games, he has accumulated 164 rushing yards (22 at Middle Tennessee, 25 vs. Northwestern State, 66 vs. Central Arkansas and 51 vs. Stephen F. Austin). He has also scored on touchdown runs of 29 yards (vs. UCA) and 35 yards (vs. SFA). He is averaging 41 yards a game in the 4th quarter alone.

SATURDAY WAS A DAY OF FIRSTS FOR TWO COWBOYS

Two McNeese football players recorded firsts in Saturday's win over SFA... redshirt freshman WR Kenny Brown caught his first career touchdown pass on his first career reception while junior tight end Manny Busch made his first career reception.

HONORING AN INJURED LEADER

McNeese All-American free safety Malcolm Bronson saw his season come to an unexpected end in week three of the season when he suffered a knee injury in the third quarter against Weber State. In 3 of the last 4 games, two of the Cowboys' defensive leaders and one on offense has honored Bronson by wearing his No. 34 - linebacker Joe Narcisse against Northwestern State, safety Ford Smesny against Central Arkansas and all-purpose back Darius Carey at Sam Houston State. Malcolm was a team captain in Saturday's game and wore the jersey himself. Malcolm's brother, Ryan, moved into the starting free safety spot after the injury. Ryan was injured at Southeastern Louisiana with a broken right hand. He wears a soft cast during games and has picked off two passes since, including one this past Saturday. The brothers are the nephews of former McNeese and San Francisco 49ers standout safety Zack Bronson.

RUSHING FOR 200 EQUALS VICTORY

- Since 2000, the Cowboys have rushed for 200 or more yards in 62 games and is 57-5 when doing so
- Since Matt Viator has been head coach, McNeese has rushed 200 or more 32 times and the team has compiled a 29-3 record
- McNeese is 1-3 this season when not rushing for 200 yards or more

Twelve of those plays came against Middle Tennessee, 10 more against McMurry, 5 at Weber State, 4 at SLU, 5 against Northwestern St., 6 vs. UCA, 4 at Sam and 4 vs. SFA.

YOUNGSTERS MAKING NOISE

Several Cowboy true and redshirt freshmen have seen a significant amount of playing time this season

- True freshman punter Jean Breaux ranks 6th in the SLC with a 40.0 average and has had 4 punts downed inside the 5 yard line and 6 inside the 10... he's tied for first in the league with 14 punts downed inside the 20 and is third in net punting with a 36.0 average
- True freshman linebacker Bo Brown recovered a fumbled punt return at MTSU that led to a McNeese score and eventually the win... he ranks 9th on the team with 32 tackles
- RS freshmen RBs Terrell Alford, Kelvin Bennett and Dillon Berlin finished 1-2-3 in rushing for the game against McMurry
- True freshman DE Cameron Smith is tied for 3rd on the team lead with 8 quarterback hurries
- True freshman DB Brenten Spikes had his redshirt pulled after the injury to Bronson... has appeared in the last six games and has 11 tackles, a tackle for a loss and a QB hurry
- RS freshman CB Gabe Hamner has seen action in all 8 games and is 11th on the team with 27 tackles... got his first career start against Northwestern State... has 3.5 tackles for a loss, 0.5 sacks, 1 forced fumble and 1 QB hurry

ZONING IN WHEN IN RED ZONE

The Cowboys are doing a great job of getting points when they get inside of the Red Zone

- 35 times in the Red Zone this year with 31 scores, an 88.6 percentage
- 22 TDs and 9 FGs. Two missed FGs and two fumbles
- Opponents are 22 of 26 in the Red Zone (18 TDs, 4 FGs)
- McNeese was a perfect 4 for 4 with 4 TDs against SFA

OFFENSIVE LINE LEADING THE WAY

- Line has helped open up holes that has allowed the running game to chalk up 50 rushing plays of 10 yards or more on the season
- Cowboys return all five starters from last year's unit and got the services back from another - Miguel Gauthreaux - who started every game in 2010 but missed the entire 2011 season due to a knee injury
- Line includes three players that have earned all-conference honors (Gauthreaux, Alec Savoie, Jonathan Landry) and another, Savoie, who has been named to several all-America teams.

VIATOR HONORED AT JENNINGS HS GAME ON OCT. 5

Cowboys head coach Matt Viator, the head coach of the 1992 Jennings HS Louisiana State Championship team, was honored by his former school along with his 1992 squad for the 20-year anniversary of the state championship at Jennings' Oct. 5 game.

MCNEESE CELEBRATES TITLE IX ANNIVERSARY ON OCT. 13

McNeese athletics celebrated the 40th anniversary of Title IX with a halftime on-field recognition of former and current McNeese women's athletes on Oct. 13. Title IX was written into law on June 23, 1972 by President Richard Nixon. McNeese fielded its first women's athletic program in 1974 with the birth of the basketball and volleyball teams. In 1978, softball hit the field for the first time along with women's tennis and in 1986, women's track took flight. Cowgirls soccer launched in 1996 and golf in 2001. In 38 years McNeese women's athletics has won nine Southland Conference championships, has had three conference players of the year and 176 all-SLC selections.

COWBOYS OUTSTANDING IN THE CLASSROOM

Although it won't officially be released by the NCAA sometime in April, McNeese has gotten some great news about its latest APR (Academic Progress Rate)

- McNeese football has registered a single-season rate of 961 which is the highest rate in school history for football and well above the 930 NCAA benchmark
- There were 34 football players named to the Southland Conference Commissioner's List in 2011
- 26 football players were named to the McNeese honor roll in Spring 2012; 29 in Fall 2011; 38 in Spring 2011; and 36 in Fall 2010
- The football team also logged 246 hours of community service in 2011-12



SCOUTING THE COLONELS

- Had its season-opening game at Oregon State postponed because the team could not get out of Thibodaux due to the effects of Hurricane Issac.
- Has lost 11 straight Southland Conference games... last league win was over Southeastern Louisiana in the 2010 season finale.
- Nicholls racked up a Southland-conference record 751 yards of total offense in a 73-17 win over Evangel on Sept. 22... the 73 points was the second-highest point total in program history. In 1994, Nicholls defeated Livingston 77-7, where the previous program-mark for total offense (614 yards) was set. Nicholls had a chance to break the record against Evangel, but downed the ball twice after reaching the 3-yard line in the final minute... set a school record with 36 first downs and finished with 361 yards passing, marking only the second time since 1998 that the team surpassed the 300-yard plateau. The other came when LaQuintin Caston threw for 319 yards against South Alabama in 2010... team also had 390 rushing yards, which is its highest total since rushing for 427 yards against Texas State

in 2007. The Colonels finished with two 100-yard rushers – Tuskani Figaro (134) and Marcus Washington (110) – for the first time in almost two years. Jesse Turner almost gave Nicholls three as he finished with 98 yards rushing.

Four Colonels were named to the 2012 Preseason All-Southland Team, led by first-teamers, senior punter Cory Kemps and sophomore tight end Nick Scelfo. Kemps earned first-team honors in 2011, while Scelfo was named second team. Also representing the Colonels on the list is the second-team running back tandem of senior Jesse Turner and junior Marcus Washington. Washington earned second-team in 2011 as the feature back, averaging 4.5 yards per carry and Turner, who had a limited role last season due to a knee injury, was named second-team in 2010 after leading the conference with 5.7 ypc.

McNeese State, 1986

Head Coach (50-24, 7th season)

One of the most successful coaches in the NCAA's FCS division, McNeese State's Matt Viator has put together winning percentages of 69 percent (overall) and 75 percent (league games only) in his previous six years as the

Cowboy head coach.

During that period he has led his team to three Southland Conference titles and to two runnerup finishes, averaging seven victories a year.

The winningest active coach in the league, Viator will carry a 45-20 overall record and a 31-10 league mark into the upcoming season.

The Cowboy coach, a graduate of McNeese, had served as an assistant coach on the staff for eight years before stepping into the top job four games deep into the 2006 season. Taking over a squad that had won but one of its first four games he led the team to a 6-2 record the rest of the way that year, won the SLC title and put his team into the NCAA championship playoffs.

That was the start of one of the most electrifying coaching rises in conference history as the very next year his team posted only the fourth undefeated, untied regular season record in the university's history, won the league title for a second year and participated in the NCAA FCS championship for a second straight year.

Since then his team also won the 2009 title and finished second in the league standings in both 2008 and 2010. The Cowboys finished fourth last season.

Viator has earned numerous coaching honors including two SLC coach of the year awards and a Louisiana collegiate coach of the year honor. He has also been a finalist for the national Eddie Robinson award twice.

He claimed his first collegiate coaching victory in his very first game as head coach when the Cowboys posted a 30-27 win over Southern Utah in 2006.

His 45th win came in the final game of the 2011 season - a triumph on the road against Lamar as the Cowboys won their last three games and will carry that winning streak into the 2012 season.

Viator is the 14th head coach in McNeese history. His 6-2 rookie record included a 5-1 mark in league play, the team winning the final five league games of the year.

His teams have been ranked in the top 25 national poll four of the last six seasons.

Prior to his becoming head coach, Viator had served the university as offensive coordinator and is regarded as one of the top Division I offensive minds.

The Cowboys have ranked among the national leaders in offense for eight of the past 11 years and the university has also produced the Southland Conference's top offensive performer four of the last eight seasons.

His offenses have led the league in scoring five times and in 2008 set school records for total offense per game, passing offense per game and scoring average per game.

The Cowboys had the nation's leading scorer in 2009, tailback Toddrick Pendland, and a year ago had the No. 2 punt returner in the nation in Darius Carey, a returnee for 2012.

Before he joined McNeese, Viator was one of the top prep coaches in Louisiana, producing an 81-37 won-lost record, winning one state crown and five league titles. He joined McNeese in 1999 as linebacker coach and was made offensive coordinator in 2000, the Cowboys leading the league in both scoring offense and total offense that year.

He is married and wife Schantel is a school teacher. His father is the late Nolan Viator, a former Cowboy coach, player (QB, MVP) and member of the McNeese Hall of Fame.
