Quick Hits

- McNeese will celebrate Senior Day at Saturday's game
- Members of the 1997 Southland championship team and FCS national championship game participant will be in attendance as well and will be recognized at halftime
- Cowboy's have secured their 8th straight winning season - longest streak in the SLC
- MSU holds a 22-12-1 lead in the all-time series against Lamar and is 2-0 since the series resumed in 2010
- 11-5 record against the Cardinals in Cowboy Stadium
- McNeese's score to open the game at UTSA was the 5th time this season the Cowboys have scored on their opening drive of the ballgame
- QB Cody Stroud set a new single-game school record with 34 pass completions against UTSA... he threw for a career-best 346 yards
- Stroud's total passing yards was the 4th most recorded in a single-game in school history... he has also thrown 8 td passes in the last three games and has 17 on the season - 4th most in a single-season in Cowboy history
- WR Wes Briscoe caught a TD pass for the third consecutive game... all three were the Cowboys' first score
- Briscoe also had a career-high 6 catches and a season-best 99 yards receiving
- McNeese kept UTSA off the scoreboard in the first quarter making it the fifth time this season and third straight game for the Cowboys to hold their opponents scoreless in the opening period
- Matt Viator won his 51st career game as head coach at McNeese against Nicholls... he has moved into sole possession of 4th on the school's all-time chart for most wins... he needs 7 more to tie Les DeVall for 3rd
- Running backs Champlain Babin and Marcus Wiltz have topped the 1,000 career rushing yards mark this season... currently, Wiltz has 1,207 while Babin has rushed for 1,139
- With 4 catches on Saturday, Darius Carey has now caught at least one pass in every game as a Cowboy (21 straight games)
- Two of McNeese's conference losses are by a combined two points (25-24 at SLU, 27-26 vs. UCA)
- Academic rates are out and McNeese football has set a record with an APR of 961... numbers won't be officially released until April but the 961 is the highest recorded by McNeese football in school history
- Outscored opponents 188-71 in first half for the season
- Collected 450th all-time win against Weber State
- McNeese is the dean of the Southland Conference, having joined the league in 1972
- Cowboys have won 13 SLC championships - more than three times more than the next current league foe
- McNeese played in the 1997 and 2002 FCS national championship game - falling 10-9 to Youngstown State in 1997 and 34-14 to Western Kentucky in 2002
- The Pokes have made 14 FCS playoff appearances, more than double the amount of the next Southland team

MCNEESE HOLDS ADVANTAGE IN ALL-TIME SERIES

McNeese has a 22-12-1 lead in the all-time series against Lamar and is 2-0 since the series resumed in 2010.

- Cowboys are 11-5 against the Cardinals in Cowboy Stadium and have won the last four games played in the venue
- Last Lamar win in Cowboy Stadium came by way of a 12-3 victory in 1982

UTSA GAME WAS ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS FOR STROUD

Junior quarterback Cody Stroud has the best statistical game of his career last Saturday against the Roadrunner. Not only did Stroud throw for a career-best 346 yards, he also broke or tied several McNeese school records

- His 34 pass completions buried the old single-game record of 25 completions set by Subester Brooks in 1985 and tied by Derrick Fourroux in 2009
- Stroud completed 11 straight passes in the fourth quarter to tie the school record set by Blake Prejean against Northern Iowa in 1999
- His 346 yards passing is the fourth most in a single-game in school history
- Stroud's two touchdown passes gives him 17 on the season - 4th most in a single-season
- Those two tds also increases his career total to 29 which ranks him 6th on the school's career list
- He became the 11th player in school history to record 4,000 total offensive yards... he currently has 4,277 to rank 9th on the school's all-time career list

TWO COWBOYS HONORED FOR PLAY AT UTSA

McNeese safety Chris Raggett and wide receiver Wes Briscoe have been recognized by College Football Performance Awards as their pick as the Southland Conference's defensive back player of the week and wide receiver of the week.

- Raggett led the McNeese defense with 13 tackles and two tackles for a loss
- Briscoe caught a career-high six passes for a season-high 99 yards and a touchdown

MCNEESE SECURES 8TH STRAIGHT WINNING SEASON

With its 42-10 win over Nicholls on Nov. 3, McNeese has assured itself its eighth consecutive winning season. That's the longest streak in the Southland Conference with the next closest teams being Sam Houston State and Central Arkansas with three straight winning seasons counting this year.

MCNEESE TO RECOGNIZE 22 SENIORS ON SATURDAY

Twenty-two McNeese Cowboys will don the blue and gold for the final time in their career on Saturday when the Cowboys host Lamar. A pregame ceremony will take place to recognize those seniors. The list includes: OL Mitchell Amy, RB Champlain Babin, FS Malcolm Bronson, WR/PR Darius Carey, OL Carson Chaisson, WR Damion Dixon, WR DeVionté Edmonson, OL Miguel Gauthreaux, OL Taylor Johnson, TE Josh Jordan, OL Brett Koonce, OL Jonathan Landry, DE Eric LeBlanc, K Josh Lewis, FB Kegan Myers, LB Joe Narcisse, S Chris Raggett, OL Alec Savoie, FB Logan Slaydon, S Ford Smesny, CB Seth Thomas and DT Pat Williams.

- Of those 22 seniors, 8 have been named All-Conference at one time or another
- Three (Bronson, Savoie, Carey) have earned All-American honors
- In four years, these players have helped compile 27 wins (just about a 7-win per season average) and helped win the 2009 SLC championship

COWBOYS CREATING TONS OF TURNOVERS

It's been quite a while since the McNeese defense has had such an advantage in the turnover margin department.

- Cowboys are currently plus-13 in turnover margin
- The last time McNeese had this high of a plus margin was in the 2007 regular season unbeaten slate with a plus-17 number
- 6 interceptions in last three games
- For the first time this season, McNeese did not force a turnover when it failed to get a takeaway from UTSA

VIATOR REACHES MILESTONE WIN

With the 42-10 win over Nicholls State on Nov. 3, head coach Matt Viator has now notched 51 victories in his career at McNeese.

- 4th on the school all-time career win list... needing 7 more to tie Les DeVall for 3rd
- Second fastest head coach to get to 50 wins in career in school history
- Most wins among Southland head coaches at their respective schools
- Tied for 9th on the SLC list for all-time wins
- Has never had a losing season

CAREY EXTENDS STREAK TO 21 STRAIGHT GAMES

Senior WR/PR returner Darius Carey caught 4 passes on Saturday to extend his streak to 21 consecutive games with a reception. A transfer from North Texas prior to last season, Carey has caught at least one pass in every game (21) in his McNeese career. He currently leads the team with 30 catches for 430 yards.

WILTZ, BABIN REACH CAREER MILESTONE

Running backs Marcus Wiltz and Champlain Babin have both topped the 1,000 career rushing yards mark this season

- Wiltz has 1,207 rushing yards in his career and Babin 1,139... both are on the verge of cracking the school's top 25 career rushing list

WILTZ BRINGS 4TH QUARTER MAGIC

Marcus Wiltz is definitely the go-to back when the Cowboys need yards in the fourth quarter. Due to either games getting out of hand or being injured, Wiltz has played in the 4th quarter just five times this season but his presence has been known. In those games, he has accumulated 188 rushing yards (22 at Middle Tennessee, 25 vs. Northwestern State, 66 vs. Central Arkansas, 51 vs. Stephen F. Austin and 24 at Nicholls). He has also scored on touchdown runs of 29 yards (vs. UCA) and 35 yards (vs. SFA). He is averaging 38 yards a game in the 4th quarter alone.

RUSHING GAME'S BIG GAINS

The McNeese running game, ranked No. 2 in the Southland Conference and 21st nationally with a 204.0 per game average, has had 58 plays this season where it has rushed for 10 yards or more. Twelve of those plays came against Middle Tennessee, 10 more against McMurry, 5 at Weber State, 4 at SLU, 5 against Northwestern St., 6 vs. UCA, 4 at Sam, 4 vs. SFA, 8 at Nicholls and 1 at UTSA.

- Since Matt Viator has been head coach, McNeese has rushed 200 or more 33 times and the team has compiled a 30-3 record
- McNeese is 5-0 this season when rushing for 200 or more in a game and 1-3 this when rushing for less than 200 yards.

YOUNGSTERS MAKING NOISE

Several Cowboy true and redshirt freshmen have seen a significant amount of playing time this season

- True freshman punter Jean Breaux ranks 6th in the SLC with a 40.5 average and has had 4 punts downed inside the 5 yard line and 6 inside the 10... he's second in the league with 15 punts downed inside the 20 and is 4th in net punting with a 35.6 average
- True freshman linebacker Bo Brown got his first career start against SFA and responded with his first interception of his young career. He also tipped a pass that was picked off by the Cowboys. At Middle Tennessee, he recovered a fumbled punt return that led to a McNeese score and eventually the win... he ranks 7th on the team with 43 tackles
- RS freshmen RBs Terrell Alfred, Kelvin Bennett and Dillon Berlin finished 1-2-3 in rushing for the game against McMurry... Bennet led the Cowboys with 94 yards rushing at Nicholls
- True freshman DE Cameron Smith has 8 quarterback hurries
- True freshman DB Brenten Spikes had his redshirt pulled after the injury to Bronson... has appeared in the last 8 games and has 16 tackles, a tackle for a loss and a QB hurry
- RS freshman CB Gabe Hamner has seen action in all 10 games and is 13th on the team with 31 tackles... got his first career start against Northwestern State... has 3.5 tackles for a loss, 0.5 sacks, 3 passes broken up, 1 forced fumble and 1 QB hurry

ZONING IN WHEN IN RED ZONE

The Cowboys are doing a great job of getting points when they get inside of the Red Zone

- 43 times in the Red Zone this year with 38 scores, an 88.4 percentage
- 28 TDs and 10 FGs. Three missed FGs and two fumbles
- Opponents are 27 of 34 in the Red Zone (21 TDs, 6 FGs)
- McNeese is 15 for its last 16 in Red Zone chances in the last five games.

OFFENSIVE LINE LEADING THE WAY

- Line has helped open up holes that has allowed the running game to chalk up 57 rushing plays of 10 yards or more on the season



SCOUTING THE CARDINALS

The Cardinals picked up their first conference win this season with a 34-24 victory against Nicholls State ... Lamar improved to 4-1 all-time against Nicholls in football, including a 3-0 record in Beaumont ... Kevin Johnson caught a touchdown in the first quarter for his 13th score of the season to match the single-season Lamar record set by Sammy Carpenter in 1952 ... Johnson has 10 receiving touchdowns which is the second highest single-season total in school history ... he trails Howard Robinson, who recorded 12 in 1979 ... QB Ryan Mossakowski got his first start since the Sept. 29 conference opener against Southeastern Louisiana ... Mossakowski was 15 of 24 for 168 yards, three touchdowns and two interceptions before getting knocked out of the game in the third quarter ... the Cardinals play their most com-

mon opponent in McNeese State this Saturday in the Battle of the Border ... Lamar is 8-21-1 all-time against McNeese State as a four-year institution ... the Cowboys have won eight of the last nine meetings and both games since Lamar resumed its football program, including 45-17 win in Beaumont last year ... in last year's game, Lamar wide receiver J.J. Hayes snagged a school-record 14 catches in the game ... Hayes finished with 189 yards and a touchdown in the game ... QB Caleb Berry, who relieved Ryan Mossakowski Saturday against Nicholls, came off the bench last season against McNeese State to finish 16 of 23 for 150 yards with a touchdown and two picks.

McNeese State, 1986

Head Coach (51-25, 7th season)

One of the most successful coaches in the NCAA's FCS division, McNeese State's Matt Viator has put together winning percentages of 69 percent (overall) and 75 percent (league games only) in his previous six years as the

Cowboy head coach.

During that period he has led his team to three Southland Conference titles and to two runnerup finishes, averaging seven victories a year.

The winningest active coach in the league, Viator will carry a 45-20 overall record and a 31-10 league mark into the upcoming season.

The Cowboy coach, a graduate of McNeese, had served as an assistant coach on the staff for eight years before stepping into the top job four games deep into the 2006 season. Taking over a squad that had won but one of its first four games he led the team to a 6-2 record the rest of the way that year, won the SLC title and put his team into the NCAA championship playoffs.

That was the start of one of the most electrifying coaching rises in conference history as the very next year his team posted only the fourth undefeated, untied regular season record in the university's history, won the league title for a second year and participated in the NCAA FCS championship for a second straight year.

Since then his team also won the 2009 title and finished second in the league standings in both 2008 and 2010. The Cowboys finished fourth last season.

Viator has earned numerous coaching honors including two SLC coach of the year awards and a Louisiana collegiate coach of the year honor. He has also been a finalist for the national Eddie Robinson award twice.

He claimed his first collegiate coaching victory in his very first game as head coach when the Cowboys posted a 30-27 win over Southern Utah in 2006.

His 45th win came in the final game of the 2011 season - a triumph on the road against Lamar as the Cowboys won their last three games and will carry that winning streak into the 2012 season.

Viator is the 14th head coach in McNeese history. His 6-2 rookie record included a 5-1 mark in league play, the team winning the final five league games of the year.

His teams have been ranked in the top 25 national poll four of the last six seasons.

Prior to his becoming head coach, Viator had served the university as offensive coordinator and is regarded as one of the top Division I offensive minds.

The Cowboys have ranked among the national leaders in offense for eight of the past 11 years and the university has also produced the Southland Conference's top offensive performer four of the last eight seasons.

His offenses have led the league in scoring five times and in 2008 set school records for total offense per game, passing offense per game and scoring average per game.

The Cowboys had the nation's leading scorer in 2009, tailback Toddrick Pendland, and a year ago had the No. 2 punt returner in the nation in Darius Carey, a returnee for 2012.

Before he joined McNeese, Viator was one of the top prep coaches in Louisiana, producing an 81-37 won-lost record, winning one state crown and five league titles. He joined McNeese in 1999 as linebacker coach and was made offensive coordinator in 2000, the Cowboys leading the league in both scoring offense and total offense that year.

He is married and wife Schantel is a school teacher. His father is the late Nolan Viator, a former Cowboy coach, player (QB, MVP) and member of the McNeese Hall of Fame.
