## Quick Hits

- 2-0 to start the season for the first time since the 2009 season when it started 3-0 before falling 42-32 at Tulane
- Five consecutive wins dating back to last season
- Senior safety Chris Raggett voted this week's SLC Defensive Player of the Week
- 69 total and 45 first half points scored on Saturday were the second most scored in a game in school history
- 45-0 halftime lead was the widest halftime margin since holding a 49-0 lead over Southern Virginia in 2008
- McNeese played everyone that dressed out on Saturday night
- 54-16 home record since 2000
- McNeese had four players score their first career points on Saturday - redshirt freshman RB Dillon Berlin (TD), red-shirt freshman RB Kelvin Bennett (TD), sophomore kicker James Bice (1 FG, 3 PAT), senior safety Chris Raggett (2 TDs off interceptions)
- Raggett's 2 pic 6s set a McNeese single-game record and tied a NCAA FCS single-game record. It also tied a McNeese individual season record (Rody Gully, 2002) and is one off the career record (Gully 2002-2003)
- The Cowboys are 7-0 under Viator in home openers
- Series with Weber State is tied at 1-1
- First meeting was in 1990 and a 27-7 WSU win in Cowboy Stadium
- McNeese won 23-22 at Weber State in 1992
- Cowboys are 9-8 all-time against members of the Big Sky Conference
- Record includes a 6-5 advantage in FCS playoff games
- WSU head coach Jody Sears was the defensive coordinator at Eastern Washington in 2007 when it defeated the Cowboys 44-15 in the first round of the FCS playoffs
- McNeese's win over Middle Tennessee was the school's third over an FBS school since 2000 (3-12)
- All three wins are against Sun Belt Conference members (W 24-19 at Louisiana-Monroe, 2002; W 38-17 at Louisiana-Lafayette, 2007; W 27-21 at Middle Tennessee, 2012)
- The Cowboys also defeated Florida International 30-27 in 2004, one year before they joined the Sun Belt
- It is believed that backup QB Tyler Bolfig's touchdown pass on his first career pass attempt at MTSU was the first time that has happened in McNeese history
- McNeese is the dean of the Southland Conference, having joined the league in 1972
- Cowboys have won 13 Southland championships - more than three times more than the next current league foe
- The team played in the 1997 and 2002 FCS national championship game - falling 10-9 to Youngstown State in 1997 and 34-14 to Western Kentucky in 2002
- The Pokes have made 14 FCS playoff appearances, more than double the amount of the next Southland team

## RAGGETT EARNS DEFENSIVE HONORS

- Senior safety Chris Raggett was named this week's Southland Conference Defensive Player of the week and College Football Performance Award National Defensive Back Player of the Week
- Raggett set a McNeese single-game record while tying a National FCS record with two interceptions returned for touchdowns in McNeese's 69-7 win over McMurry
- He's the third Cowboys player in two weeks to garner conference honors
- RB Marcus Wiltz was named SLC Offensive Player of the Week last week along with punter Jean Breaux as Special Teams Player of the Week

## POKES RETURN TO THE POLLS

- Cowboys return to the national polls for the first time since bowing out after their Oct. 15 loss at Central Arkansas last season
- Moved up 3 spots to No. 19 in the Sports Network Top 25 and 2 spots to No. 19 in the FCS Coaches Top 25 poll

## BMW BACKFIELD ON CRUISE CONTROL BUT THE YOUNG GUN EXPRESS TOOK CENTER STAGE ON SATURDAY

- McNeese's offensive backfield consists of returners Champlain Babin (B), Javaris Murray (M) and Marcus Wiltz (W)
- All three combined to run for 219 yards on 38 carries for a 5.8 yards per carry average at MTSU
- Against McMurry, 3 redshirt freshmen - Terrell Alfred (75 yards), Kelvin Bennett (60 yards) and Dillon Berlin (41 yards) paced the rushing attack
- Bennett and Berlin each scored their first career touchdowns

## RUSHING FOR 200 EQUALS VICTORY

- McNeese has rushed for 200 or more yards in four consecutive games dating back to last season... all four games were wins.
- Since 2000, the Cowboys have rushed for 200 or more yards in 60 games and is 55-5 when doing so
- Since Matt Viator has been head coach, McNeese has rushed 200 or more 30 times and the team has compiled a 27-3 record

## YOUNGSTERS MAKING NOISE

Several Cowboy true and redshirt freshmen have seen a significant amount of playing time and are contributing well

- True freshman punter Jean Breaux ranks 2nd in the SLC with a 42.1 average and has had 4 punts downed inside the 5 yard line
- True freshman linebacker Bo Brown recovered a fumbled punt return at MTSU that led to a McNeese score and eventually the win
- RS freshmen RBs Terrell Alford, Kelvin Bennett and Dillon Berlin finished 1-2-3 in rushing for the game against McMurry
- RS freshman QB Tyler Bolfiging leads the SLC in pass efficiency with a 312.3 rating
- True freshman DE Cameron Smith leads the team with 5 quarterback hurries



### **NOWHERE TO RUN**

The resurrection of McNeese's "Blue Wall" defense has been prominent in the first two games of the 2012 season

- McNeese held Middle Tennessee to 103 yards rushing in the season opener and stopped McMurry to minus-3 yards rushing on Saturday night
- Pokes sacked the McMurry QBs six times and added another 9 tackles for a loss
- Opponents are averaging 2.2 yards per carry
- Defense has not allowed a rushing TD this year

### **CAJUN KICKER DROPPING THEM DEEP**

- True freshman place kicker Jean Breaux will likely be called something different every time he lines up to kickoff... the correct way to say Jean is (sz-OH-n) where the J is pronounced with the SZ sound as in "vision"
- Breaux has had four punts downed inside the 5-yard line already this season

### **ZONING IN WHEN IN RED ZONE**

- McNeese is nearly perfect when it gets in the Red Zone to score some points
- 13 times in the Red Zone this year and 12 scores
- 9 TDs and 3 FGs. One missed FG.
- Cowboys were a perfect 8 for 8 in the Red Zone againe McMurry with 6 TDs and 2 FGs
- Opponents are 5 of 7 in the Red Zone
- McMurray scored 1 of 3 times

### **CAREER DAY**

Several Cowboy players had career firsts in Saturday blowout win over McMurray

- RBs Dillon Berlin and Kelvin Bennett scored their first career TDs
- K James Bice made his first career FG and PAT
- S Chris Raggett scored his first career TD off an interception
- KR Kenny Brown returned his first career kick... went for 56 yards
- LB Hayden Dobbs intercepted his first career pass
- QB Leon Blouin attempted and completed his first career pass
- DLs Michael Ware, Krishon Seastrunk and DEs Chris Loveless and Logan Gladney recorded their first career sacks

## OFFENSIVE LINE READY TO LEAD

- Cowboys return all five starters from last year's unit and got the services back from another - Miguel Gauthreaux - who started every game in 2010 but missed the entire 2011 season due to a knee injury
- Line includes three players that have earned all-conference honors (Gauthreaux, Alec Savoie, Jonathan Landry) and another, Savoie, who has been named to several all-America teams.

## BROTHERLY LOVE IN THE DEFENSE

- Senior all-American free safety Malcolm Bronson and his backup, brother Ryan Bronson, will be wrapping up a three-year playing career together. Ryan still has one year remaining to play.
- The brothers are the nephews of former McNeese and San Francisco 49ers standout Zach Bronson
- Malcolm led the team with 90 tackles and three interceptions last season while Ryan had nine stops while playing in nine games

## SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE GETS STRONGER

- With Texas-Arlington, Texas State and Texas-San Antonio all leaving the league last year, the conference has further strengthened its membership with the addition of Oral Roberts, the University of New Orleans, Houston Baptist, Abilene Christian and Incarnate Word
- ORU and UNO are non-football playing schools
- Houston Baptist is starting up football and will start competition in 2013 and will field a full Southland slate in 2014
- Abilene Christian and Incarnate Word are making a transition from Division II to Division I

## FCS PLAYOFFS EXPANDING

- Now a 20-team bracket playoff, the Football Championship Subdivision will increase to 24 teams for the 2013 season

### A WINNING TRADITION

- McNeese is now in its 69th season of football
- Has been 72 years since the Cowboys fielded their first team
- Played a 5-game schedule in 1940
- Dropped the sport following the 1940 season because of WWII and resumed it in 1945
- 448 wins since that first season
- 96 victories coming in the 2000s
- 96-46 since 2000 for a .674 percentage
- 180-81-5 record in Cowboy Stadium
- 54-16 at home since 2000
- Cowboy Stadium has played host to greats such as Roger Staubach (Pensacola Navy, 1968), Terry Bradshaw (Louisiana Tech, '67 and

'69); Jackie Smith (Northwestern State, 1960); Chad Pennington (Marshall, 1995); Daunte Culpepper (Central Florida, 1995).

- McNeese has had nine unbeaten seasons at home with three of those coming since 2000 (2-0 in 2005, 8-0 in 2002 and 5-0 in 2000).

# Matt VIATOR

*McNeese State, 1986*

**Head Coach** (47-20, 7th season)

One of the most successful coaches in the NCAA's FCS division, McNeese State's Matt Viator has put together winning percentages of 69 percent (overall) and 75 percent (league games only) in his previous six years as the

Cowboy head coach.

During that period he has led his team to three Southland Conference titles and to two runnerup finishes, averaging seven victories a year.

The winningest active coach in the league, Viator will carry a 45-20 overall record and a 31-10 league mark into the upcoming season.

The Cowboy coach, a graduate of McNeese, had served as an assistant coach on the staff for eight years before stepping into the top job four games deep into the 2006 season. Taking over a squad that had won but one of its first four games he led the team to a 6-2 record the rest of the way that year, won the SLC title and put his team into the NCAA championship playoffs.

That was the start of one of the most electrifying coaching rises in conference history as the very next year his team posted only the fourth undefeated, untied regular season record in the university's history, won the league title for a second year and participated in the NCAA FCS championship for a second straight year.

Since then his team also won the 2009 title and finished second in the league standings in both 2008 and 2010. The Cowboys finished fourth last season.

Viator has earned numerous coaching honors including two SLC coach of the year awards and a Louisiana collegiate coach of the year honor. He has also been a finalist for the national Eddie Robinson award twice.

He claimed his first collegiate coaching victory in his very first game as head coach when the Cowboys posted a 30-27 win over Southern Utah in 2006.

His 45th win came in the final game of the 2011 season - a triumph on the road against Lamar as the Cowboys won their last three games and will carry that winning streak into the 2012 season.

Viator is the 14th head coach in McNeese history. His 6-2 rookie record included a 5-1 mark in league play, the team winning the final five league games of the year.

His teams have been ranked in the top 25 national poll four of the last six seasons.

Prior to his becoming head coach, Viator had served the university as offensive coordinator and is regarded as one of the top Division I offensive minds.

The Cowboys have ranked among the national leaders in offense for eight of the past 11 years and the university has also produced the Southland Conference's top offensive performer four of the last eight seasons.

His offenses have led the league in scoring five times and in 2008 set school records for total offense per game, passing offense per game and scoring average per game.

The Cowboys had the nation's leading scorer in 2009, tailback Toddrick Pendland, and a year ago had the No. 2 punt returner in the nation in Darius Carey, a returnee for 2012.

Before he joined McNeese, Viator was one of the top prep coaches in Louisiana, producing an 81-37 won-lost record, winning one state crown and five league titles. He joined McNeese in 1999 as linebacker coach and was made offensive coordinator in 2000, the Cowboys leading the league in both scoring offense and total offense that year.

He is married and wife Schantel is a school teacher. His father is the late Nolan Viator, a former Cowboy coach, player (QB, MVP) and member of the McNeese Hall of Fame.
