## STORY LINES

- This is the first ever meeting between the Panthers of Florida Tech and the Cowboys of McNeese State.
- The Panthers are 3-2 all-time against DI-FCS competition. FIT defeated Stetson 20-13 in 2013. Florida Tech then beat the Hatters again 54-12 in 2014 before falling to Bethune Cookman 33-34 later that season. In 2015, FIT was dealt a 17-28 loss to Southeastern Louisiana. The Panthers then knocked off Presbyterian 28-7 last season.
- Florida Tech is 11-12 all-time in away contests. The Panthers last road loss came against West Alabama 35-45 on Oct. 22, 2016 in Livingston, Ala.
- The Panthers are 8-3 all-time against non-D2 competition, including a 6-0 record against such opponents at home.

**PANTHERS RECEIVE PRESEASON RANKING**

Florida Tech has been ranked 24th in the nation by the 2017 College Football America Yearbook Preseason Top 30 Poll.

Joining FIT in the poll are fellow Gulf South Conference members No. 6 North Alabama, No. 12 North Greenville and No. 23 Valdosta State.

**FIT RECEIVES VOTES IN AFCA POLL**

The Panthers are receiving votes in the Sept. 4 American Football Coaches Association Division II Coaches' Top 25 Poll. FIT is joined by fellow GSC members North Alabama (11), West Georgia (25), Valdosta State (RV) and Delta State (RV).

**HAYNES NAMED PRESEASON POTY CANDIDATE**

FIT running back will not come into the season under the radar. After proving himself as one of the players at his position in the nation, the junior was named a preseason candidate for the Harlon Hill Trophy, awarded to the best player in Division II.

The leading rusher in the GSC last year, Haynes recorded 1,076 yards on the ground with 10 touchdowns.

**HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE**

Florida Tech has been on a good roll at home recently, going 15-7 all-time at home. The Panthers last defeat in Melbourne came against North Greenville in the NCAA First Round Playoff Game in 2016. FIT's last home victory was a 44-0 shut out of Virginia-Lynchburg on Sept. 2, 2017.

**HIGH-FLYING OFFENSE**

The Panthers feature one of the top scoring offenses in the GSC in 2017. FIT's average six touchdowns and 44.0 points a game rank first and second best in the league, respectively.

**TOP DEFENSE**

So far in 2017, Florida Tech is the only team in the GSC to not allow a score and ranks first in the league in passing defense (30.0) and total defense (155.0). The Panthers are one of five teams in the country to shut out their opponent in the first week of the season. In addition, FIT's defensive yards per play (2.42) and total defense (155.0/game) rank third and fifth best in the nation.

**THE CAPTAINS**

Florida Tech will have three captains in 2017. Offensive lineman Blake Stone will serve as the offensive captain and JT Hassell has been selected defensive captain. Tityus Mitchell is the Panthers' special teams captain. Additionally, the Panthers will name a fourth captain the night before each game.

**PANTHERS PICKED FOURTH IN GSC**

Entering its fifth season, the Florida Tech football team has been picked to finish fourth in the Gulf South Conference by the GSC member coaches.

The Panthers claimed 47 points in the 2017 GSC Football Preseason Coaches Poll. Four-time GSC champion and defending national runner-up North Alabama tops the poll with 62 points and seven first place votes. Valdosta State, in second and West Georgia, in third, garnered the remaining two first place votes.

Florida Tech was picked third in the Gulf South Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll prior to the 2016 season.

**PRESEASON ALL-GSC TEAM**

Florida Tech landed four players on the 2017 Preseason All-Gulf South Conference Team.

Two Panthers on the offensive side of the ball were recognized were selected in Antwan Haynes and Mark Cato.

Haynes, a junior running back, was named to the All-GSC First Team in 2016 after scoring 12 total touchdowns and leading the league in rushing yards (1,076) and all-purpose yards (1,783).

Cato, redshirt-senior quarterback, led the GSC in passing efficiency in 2016 (152.2), while racking up 2,263 passing yards, 455 rushing yards and 28 total touchdowns.

A pair of defenders were also selected to the preseason All-GSC team in Adonis Davis and Jo Jackson.

Davis, a junior defensive lineman, was a First Team All-GSC selection in 2016, following a season in which he notched 35 total tackles and ranked in the Top-5 in the conference in forced fumbles (3), sacks (6.5) and tackles for loss (15.0).

Jackson, a senior defensive back, led the GSC in passes defended (16) and pass breakups (13), while also recording 35 tackles and three interceptions.

Additionally, the GSC listed the conference's top newcomers from each team for the 2017 season. For FIT, freshman tight end Mason Wilfong, junior linebackers Kendall Duckworth and JT Hassell and senior wide receiver Demetrius Frazier made the cut.

**GSC GAME OF THE WEEK RENEWED**

The Gulf South Conference Game of the Week returns for its 13th season with a 10-game slate featured exclusively on ESPN3 and the ESPN app. Florida's Space Coast Office of Tourism will serve as the title sponsor of the package, which will include in-game features and online promotional contests throughout the season.

ESPN3 will serve as the exclusive carrier of the league's package for the fourth straight season. This year's slate will feature nine Saturday games and one Thursday night contest.

Don Russell will continue to be the play-by-play voice of the league, and he will once again be joined by Rick Rhodes as the color commentator. Gulf Coast Mobile L.L.C. will produce the package for the sixth year in a row.

Fans can access each contest on the GSC's official ESPN3 page at [gscsports.org/ESPN3](http://gscsports.org/ESPN3) or visiting [WatchESPN.com](http://WatchESPN.com).

FIT will be featured two times this season. The Panthers' contests with West Alabama (Oct. 21) and Delta State (Nov. 11) will be featured.

**PANTHERS ON THE NATIONAL STAGE**

Florida Tech will play in front of a national audience three times in 2017. Fans will be able to watch the Panthers two times on WatchESPN and the ESPN App as part of the GSC Game of the Week schedule. Additionally, the Panthers' matchup with in-state rival West Florida (Sept. 30) will be part of the NCAA Division 2 Football Showcase and will be aired on ESPN3.

**COASTAL CLASSIC**

There's a new rivalry forming in the GSC, with West Florida becoming the second Division II football team in the Sunshine State in 2016. When the Panthers and Argonauts met last season, the game will be dubbed the Coastal Classic, with both sides vying for an anchor themed trophy. UWF won the inaugural contest 42-39.

**TEAM ADIDAS**

The Panthers will wear three different sets of uniforms – crimson, gray and white – in 2017. All are part of the Adidas Shockweb collection. With two helmets at their disposal - crimson and gray - FIT has its choice of 18 different uniform combinations.

**TOP NOTCH COMPETITION**

The Gulf South Conference has long been respected as one of the deepest and strongest conferences in all of NCAA Division II football. The conference has received some confirmation of this belief as Hero Sports lists the GSC number one in their conference power rankings.

The Great Northwest Conference is in the second spot, followed closely by the Lone Star Conference.

**STAFF CHANGES**

Florida Tech saw some changes to its staff in the lead up to the 2017 season.

Rick Minter joins the staff as the Panthers' Defensive Coordinator and defensive line coach. Minter comes to FIT from Georgia State where he served as the defensive line coach.

Dan Owen has been promoted from grad. assistant to full-time coach and given the duties of special teams coordinator and cornerbacks coach.

Chris O'Leary is FIT's new safeties coach after a two-year stint at Georgia State as a graduate assistant working with defensive staff.

Aaron Archie is the team's new linebackers coach after serving three seasons as linebackers coach at his alma mater, Indiana State.

Tommy Crayton joins FIT as the running backs coach after working one season with Southeastern in 2016.

**STEVE ENGLEHART**

Head football coach Steve Englehart enters his fifth season at the helm of the Panther football team. During his first four seasons, Englehart has steered FIT to 26-19 overall record, including a 14-13 record in Gulf South Conference action.

The program's fourth season, in 2016, was unquestionably its most successful, as the Panthers earned their first-ever appearance in the NCAA Playoffs and finished with an 8-3 overall record and a 5-2 mark in the GSC. During the 2016 season, FIT knocked off NCAA DI Presbyterian College, No. 14 Valdosta State, West Georgia and Delta State to clinch the program's inaugural NCAA Playoff berth as the No. 3 seed in Super Region 2.

In 2015, the football program came within one game of a conference championships and a postseason bid with a 7-4 record. The Panthers registered a pair of monumental wins during the campaign, becoming the first team to defeat then No. 5 Delta State on its home turf in over three years and knocking off the nation's No. 1 ranked team in West Georgia on Senior Day at Florida Tech Panther Stadium.

In 2014, Englehart's Panthers surprised and shook up the college football world. FIT notched its first-ever win over a ranked opponent with a thrilling 37-31 victory over No. 12 Tarleton State at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas, the home venue of the NFL's Dallas Cowboys. The following week the Panthers returned to the Sunshine State and narrowly dropped a game at Division I opponent Bethune Cookman after failing to convert a two-point attempt at the end of the game. The program tallied another first later in the year, garnering its first GSC road win with a dramatic 33-32 win at West Alabama. FIT finished the year with a 6-5 overall record and a 3-4 mark in the GSC.

Englehart led Florida Tech Football to a 5-7 record in the program's inaugural season in fall 2013. The Panthers' victories included their inaugural game against Stetson, a Gulf South Conference win versus Shorter, a Homecoming triumph over Warner, their last regular season game against Webber International and a victory in the first-ever Eastern College Athletic Conference Division II Futures Bowl over Alderson Broaddus.

Prior to settling in Melbourne, Englehart was the offensive coordinator at his alma mater, Indiana State University, in 2010. His unit set program records, scoring 351 points and 48 touchdowns, and averaged the 17th-most yards in the Football Championship Subdivision at 411.8 yards per game. Running back Darius Gates excelled under Englehart as he averaged 10.6 points per game, which led the Missouri Valley Conference and was second at the FCS level.

Englehart also coached for four years at NCAA Division III Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology. At the time of his hiring, Englehart was the second youngest head coach in all of NCAA football at 28 years old. He guided the Fightin' Engineers to a 26-14 record. His .650 winning percentage is still the best in program history. During his last three years at Rose-Hulman, his players combined for 30 All-Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference awards. Englehart also coached quarterback Derek Eitel who graduated with every major career passing record, and was named HCAC Player of the Year in 2009.

Englehart played quarterback at Indiana State from 1996-99 where he ran the triple option. He earned letters in 97, 98, and 99. He was named to the Gateway Football Conference's All-Academic Team in 1998 and 1999, was named a GTE Scholar Athlete three times, and earned Sycamore Honor Athlete recognition for four seasons.

Englehart and his wife, Carrie, reside in Melbourne and have three children, Caden, Ty, and Lila.
