## POKES AIM FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT WIN WHEN VISITING NICHOLLS

- McNeese will be looking to corral its fourth straight win and second consecutive away from home when it visits Nicholls at 3 p.m. on Saturday.
- The Cowboys have won 3-straight since winning the first three games of the 2018 season.
- McNeese has won 4 of its last 5 games, averaging 36 points scored in those four wins.
- Searching for their first 4-game winning streak since winning six straight from the last 3 games of the 2017 season through the first 3 games of 2018.
- The Cowboys are guaranteed at least a .500 season for the 15th straight season, ranking as the fourth-longest streak among current FCS teams.

## LAST TIME OUT

- McNeese had its open date last Saturday but before that, defeated Northwestern State 30-20 for its 15th straight win over the Demons in Cowboy Stadium.
- The win was the third straight for the Cowboys and fourth victory over the last five games.
- McNeese outscored NSU 21-3 in the second half and 13-0 in the fourth quarter alone.
- D'Andre Hicks gave McNeese its first KOR for a TD on the season, that being a 96-yard score for the first TD of the game. It's ranks tied as the fourth-longest KOR for a TD in school history.
- Cody Orgeron completed 16 of 18 passes for 191 yards and two TDs, and for the fifth time this season, did not throw an interception.
- Chris Livings recorded 3 QB sacks to inch his way closer to the school's all-time sacks record of 31. He now has 28.

## VS. NICHOLLS

- Saturday's game will mark the 44th meeting between McNeese and Nicholls with the Cowboys holding a 31-12 lead in the series.
- McNeese has won 9 of the last 10 outings and had an 8-game winning streak snapped in 2017 when Nicholls pulled out a last-second 37-35 win on a field goal.
- The Cowboys are 15-5 in Thibodaux and have won three of the last four in Nicholls' Guidry Stadium.

## MCNEESE TEAM NOTABLES

- McNeese has accumulated 400 yards of offense or more in four of the last five games after not tipping 400 yards in each of the first five.
- The Cowboys have won the turnover battle in 8 of 10 games this season and are 4-0 when not committing a turnover.
- 5-2 on the year when leading at halftime and has won 48 of 55 games when leading at half dating back to the 2012 season.
- Defense has held its last seven opponents to under 100 yards rushing.
- Cowboys are 5-0 on the year when not throwing an interception.
- Forced 23 turnovers through 9 games, ranking No. 3 in the FCS in turnovers forced.
- McNeese has forced a turnover in 23 of the last 24 games.

## MCNEESE PLAYER NOTABLES

- **QB Cody Orgeron** has thrown for 1,248 yards and 13 TDs in the last five games, a 249.6 passing average... he's connecting on 62.5 percent of his passes during that time (90-144) and thrown just two interceptions... has thrown multiple TDs in six straight games and eight times on the season... ranks 17th in the FCS with 21 passing TDs and 27th with 140 points responsible for... set a new school record with 403 total offensive yards against UCA... his 60 total plays registered at UCA was one off the school record of 61 set by Tim Leger in against Northern Iowa in 1996... his 26 completions at UCA ranks tied as the 7th-most in a game in school history... two 300-yard passing games on the season... 384 total plays on the year, closing in on the record of 454 held by Kerry Joseph (1995).
- **WR Cyron Sutton** set a new school record against SFA with his seventh straight game to catch a TD pass... has caught at least one pass in 19 straight games... ranks 13th in FCS with 9 touchdown catches which also ranks tied as the 2nd-most in school history in a season... 20th in the FCS with 860 receiving yards (4th in school history), and 26th with 86.0 receiving yards per game.
- **RB Justin Pratt** has rushed for 100 yards or more in two of the last three games and is averaging 107 yards per game rushing during that span... has rushed for 100 yards or more 6 times in his career... 86 yards shy of becoming just the 15th player in school history to rush for 2,000 yards in a career.
- **DL Cody Roscoe** has recorded at least a half a sack in five straight games and leads the team with 8 total sacks.
- **WR Trevor Begue** has set season bests with 44 catches for 655 yards and 8 TDs... needs 105 receiving yards to reach the 1,000 yards in a career milestone... ranked 21st in the FCS with 8 receiving TDs which also ranks as the fourth most in a season in school history.
- **LG Grant Burguillos** will be making his 38th consecutive start on Saturday. The record is 52 straight held by Reggie Nelson from 1995-98.

### RECORDS TIED OR BROKEN IN 2019

- QB Cody Orgeron set a single-game mark with 403 total offensive yards against UCA on Oct. 12. Orgeron finished with 344 passing and 59 rushing. The old record was 399 set by Derrick Fourroux in 2008.
- WR Cyron Sutton set a new single-game record with 13 catches against Central Arkansas on Oct. 12. That broke the old mark of 10 held by four other players, including Sutton.
- Sutton with TD catches in seven straight games.
- DL Cody Roscoe set a single-game record against HBU with six passes batted down at the line of scrimmage.
- Punter Bailey Raborn set a new record against Oklahoma State on Sept. 7 when he had seven punts downed inside the 20-yard line.

## LIVINGS LOOKING TO MAKE HISTORY

- Senior defensive end **Chris Livings** will get a shot to make history this season with his eyes set on the school's all-time sacks record.
- Livings will enter Saturday's game ranked second all-time with 28 quarterback sacks, needing just 3 more to match the record held by Bryan Smith (2004-07) and 6.5 to break the mark.
- His 28 total sacks ranks tied as the 8th most in Southland Conference history in a season.
- Livings recorded eight sacks in 2018 to match a season-best for him (2016).
- In addition, the Lake Charles native has recorded 38 tackles for loss, ranking him 4th all-time.
- Livings recorded a sack in each of the first two games, one against SLU, one vs. HBU, and a half sack at SFA.

## 4TH QUARTER DOMINANCE

- The fourth quarter for the Cowboys has been a welcomed sight the last three games.
- During that span, McNeese is outscoring its opponents by a 40-7 margin and outgaining them 410-177 in total offense.
- The Cowboys have also held the last three opponents to 1 of 9 on third downs in the fourth quarter and have doubled up on the time of possession by a 29:31 to 15:29 advantage.

- McNeese has six players in this year's squad that have already received their bachelor's degree: DL Marval Bourgeois, DL Jonta Jones, DE Chris Livings, OL Blaise Scriber, WR Rhashid Bonnette, LB Justin Jackson.

- McNeese was picked for a sixth place finish by the league head coaches and sports information directors, something that is uncharted waters for the Cowboys.
- Nicholls, the 2018 Southland Conference champions, have been picked to repeat.

**THIS IS McNEESE - A WINNING TRADITION**

- McNeese has a great tradition of football and is celebrating its 76th year of action this season.
- The Cowboys have won a Southland Conference record 14 league titles and have made 16 playoff appearances, also a league record.
- Played in the 1997 and 2002 FCS national championship games, falling to a Jim Tressel-coached Youngstown State team, 10-9, in 1997 and fell 34-14 to Western Kentucky in 2002.
- Prior to moving to the FCS division after the 1981 season, McNeese appeared in three Independence Bowl games, winning the very first Indy Bowl in 1976 by a 20-16 score over Tulsa. The Cowboys played in the 1979 Independence Bowl, falling 31-7 to a Syracuse team that featured Art Monk, and the 1980 bowl, losing 16-14 to Southern Mississippi.
- Former McNeese All-American defensive back Leonard Smith was a first round draft pick by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 1984 NFL Draft. He was the 17th overall selection, the highest ever from the Southland Conference which was later matched by Northwestern State running back John Stephens in the mid-80s.
- Smith signed with the Buffalo Bills and played in two Super Bowls. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2014 and the Louisiana Sports Hall of Fame in 2015.
- Former Texas A&M legendary coach R.C. Slocum played tight end for McNeese from 1964-67. He was inducted in the College Football Hall of Fame in 2012.
- McNeese President Dr. Daryl Burckel was an All-American linebacker for the Cowboys from 1977-80 and played in the 1979 and 1980 Independence Bowl games.
- 7 Southland Conference titles in the 2000s (2001, 2002, 2003, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2015)
- The first program in conference history to win three straight titles (2001-03)
- 14 straight winning seasons ranking as the fourth-longest active streak in the FCS.

## HEAD COACH STERLIN GILBERT

**ANGELO STATE, 2002 • FIRST SEASON (6-4)**

Sterlin Gilbert, former offensive coordinator at the University of South Florida, was named the 16th head football coach for the McNeese Cowboys on Dec. 5, 2018.

Having spent the previous two seasons at USF under head coach Charlie Strong, Gilbert guided the Bulls' offense to a top 25 ranking in eight NCAA statistical categories in his first season, including sixth in total offense (513.0 ypg), eighth in rushing (264.1 ypg) and 10th in scoring (38.3 ppg).

The Bulls went 10-2, defeated Texas Tech in the Birmingham Bowl and finished ranked No. 21 in the AP poll. Quarterback Quinton Flowers ranked in the top 30 in six NCAA statistics, including ninth in total offense (332.4 ypg) and 27th in passing touchdowns with a USF record 27. Flowers, a second team all-conference pick and one of four USF offensive players to earn all-conference honors, tied the USF season passing record (2,911) while rushing for 1,078 yards and accounting for 36 total touchdowns. Flowers' 605 total yards and 503 passing yards at UCF (11/24/17) set USF records and were tabbed as the College Football Performance of the Year by Athlon Sports. Meanwhile, receiver Marquez Valdes-Scantling set a USF record with 879 receiving yards as the Bulls set program records for yards per game (513.0 ypg), plays (1,001), first downs (309) and fewest turnovers (14) while totaling 6,156 yards, the second-most in program history.

In 2018, the Bulls averaged 444.2 ypg of total offense, 31.5 points per game, 202.5 rushing yards per game and 241.7 passing per game en route to a 7-5 record and a spot in the Dec. 20 Gasparilla Bowl against Marshall. USF won its first seven games and was ranked in the top 20 in the national polls while possessing one of the nation's top offenses through the first half of the season.

Gilbert's Texas offense ranked 17th in the nation and second in the Big 12 in rushing (293.3 ypg) and was 16th nationally and fifth in the Big 12 in total offense (491.3 ypg). Running back D'Onta Foreman became the 28th player in FBS history to rush for over 2,000 yards in a season, running for over 100 yards in all 11 games he played and ranking first in the nation in rushing yards per game (184.4 ypg), second in total rushing yards (2,028 yards) and third in all-purpose yards (191.18 ypg). Foreman earned first team All-America honors and was named the 2016 Doak Walker Award winner and the 2016 Big 12 Conference Offensive Player of the Year. Freshman quarterback Shane Buechele earned honorable mention as the conference's Offensive Freshman of the Year.

In 2015, Gilbert led a Tulsa offense that ranked 11th in the nation in passing (333.2 ypg), 13th in total offense (507.4 ypg) and 21st in scoring (37.2 ppg). First-team all-conference wide receiver Keyarris Garrett ranked second in the country in receiving yards (1,451) and receiving yards per game (120.9 ypg) and tied for ninth in receptions (88). Quarterback Dane Evans ranked seventh in the country in passing (329.8 ypg) and 25th in efficiency (151.3).

In 2014, Gilbert served as co-offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Bowling Green. The Falcons gained 432.9 total yards per game (41st NCAA), while averaging 173.0 yards on the ground and 259.9 yards passing. The production came without starting QB Matt Johnson, who was injured and would a year later earn 2015 Mid-American Conference Offensive Player of the Year honors. Gilbert mentored backup QB James Knapke to 3,173 passing yards, the seventh-best mark in program history, despite his only having 10 previous collegiate passing attempts. Wide receiver Roger Lewis recorded 1,093 receiving yards and earned first-team All-MAC honors. BGSU running backs combined for 2,192 yards and 26 TDs as the Falcons finished the season with a victory over South Alabama in the 2014 Camellia Bowl.

During the 2012-13 seasons, Gilbert served as the offensive coordinator at Eastern Illinois, where in his second year he was named 2013 FootballScoop FCS Coordinator of the Year. The Panthers led the nation in total offense (589.5 ypg) and scoring (48.2 ppg), while ranking second with 372.4 passing yards, and 20th with 217.1 rushing yards per game, leading to a 12-2 record and an Ohio Valley Conference Championship.

Under the guidance of Gilbert, QB Jimmy Garoppolo was named the 2013 Walter Payton Award winner, the FCS equivalent of the Heisman Trophy, given to the nation's best player. Garoppolo led the nation and ranked second in FCS single-season history with 5,050 passing yards, while ranking second in

the nation and fourth in FCS history with 53 passing TDs. He was also third in the country in passing efficiency (168.3) and was chosen as OVC Offensive Player of the Year.

During his two seasons with Gilbert, Garoppolo passed for 8,873 yards and 84 TDs. He finished his career seventh in FCS history with 13,156 passing yards, and sixth with 118 passing TDs. He went on to become a second-round draft choice by the New England Patriots in the 2014 NFL Draft.

In addition to Garoppolo, five other players were named 2013 first-team All-OVC, representing each position group with running back, wide receiver, tight end and offensive line. Three more players were named to the second team.

Two-time consensus first-team All-American WR Erik Lora led the nation in receptions with 123, which tied for second in FCS history, only behind his own record of 136 in the previous season. He was also second in TD receptions with 19 (tied for sixth all-time in FCS), and third in receiving yards with 1,544 (16th all-time in FCS). He finished his career second in FCS history with 332 receptions, and 12th with 4,006 yards.

Fellow WR Adam Drake was just behind Lora with 85 receptions for 1,305 yards (fifth in the nation) and 13 TDs (eighth in the nation) and earned second-team All-OVC honors. Both went on to sign free agent

contracts with NFL teams.

The running backs came up 12 yards short of a pair of 1,000-yard rushers, including first-teamer Shepard Little with 1,551 yards (seventh in the nation) and 15 TDs, and second-teamer Taylor Duncan with 988 yards and 10 TDs. Tight end Jeff LePak (51-723-8), OT Dominic Pagliara and OG Collin Seibert accounted for the other members of the OVC first team and were selected third-team All-America, while offensive linemen Nick Borre made the second team, and Jimmy Lowery was on the All-Newcomer Team.

In his first season at EIU, Gilbert directed a Panthers offense that ranked sixth in the nation in passing (334.9 ypg), seventh in total offense (470.9 ypg) and eighth in scoring (36.5 ppg). The offense set several school records at the time, including touchdown passes with 34. That year, Garoppolo was seventh in the nation in total offense (318.5 ypg), while Lora set the FCS record for receptions (136) and led the nation in receiving yards with (1,664/sixth all-time in FCS) en route to being named OVC Offensive Player of the Year. Seibert joined him on the all-conference first team, while RB Jake Walker rushed for 1,133 yards and 12 TDs and made the second team, along with TE Sam Hendricks and C Kevin Kapellas.

A former standout Texas high school quarterback and coach, Gilbert enjoyed a successful career as a high school coach. He was head coach at his alma mater, San Angelo Lake View (TX) High School, from 2008-10 and earned West Texas High School Coach of the Year honors in 2008. He was also a highly successful offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Temple (TX) High School (2011) and Abilene Cooper High School (2006-07).

He began his coaching career as an assistant coach at Springtown (TX) High School (2003-04) before moving for one season to serve as a graduate assistant at the University of Houston.

Gilbert was a three-year starter and two-year captain at quarterback at Angelo State University, where he led the Rams to back-to-back Lone Star Conference South Division championships and concluded his career fourth all-time in total offense at the school. He was also a two-time All-State
