COWBOYS VISIT RIVAL DEMONS LOOKING FOR FIRST LEAGUE WIN

- McNeese returns from its open week to continue with beginning the second half of the season at Northwestern State at 3 p.m. on Saturday.
- The Cowboys are coming off an open week and prior to that, dropped a 38-35 contest to Southeastern. NSU picked up its first win of the season this past Saturday after rallying for a 21-17 win at HBU.

SERIES VS. NORTHWESTERN STATE

- Saturday's game will mark the 71st meeting between McNeese and Northwestern State with the Cowboys holding a 48-21-1 lead in the all-time series.
- This is the longest running series for McNeese which began back in 1951 and has been played every year since.
- The Cowboys have won 14 of the last 15 meetings and had won 13 straight in the series until NSU snapped the streak in 2018 with a 37-34 double OT win in Natchitoches.
- Since that loss, the Cowboys have won two straight, including 21-7 in the spring at NSU.
- The Cowboys are 23-12-1 at Northwestern State and are 8-2 in the last 10 meetings in Turpin Stadium.

HEAD COACH FRANK WILSON

SECOND SEASON AT McNEESE (4-8), 6TH SEASON OVERALL (23-37)

Frank Wilson became McNeese's 17th head coach in program history back in January of 2020 as the first African-American head football coach in school history and the second in the history of the Southland Conference.

The New Orleans native, who is widely considered one of the top recruiters in college football, spent four seasons as the head coach at UTSA before arriving on the McNeese campus.

Wilson, arguably, had his most difficult season of coaching in 2020-21 after McNeese and Southwest Louisiana took a direct hit from Hurricane Laura, a Category 4 storm with sustained winds of over 150 mph, then six weeks later, was hit with Category 2 storm Hurricane Delta. Wilson's leadership as a coach, father-figure and community leader was on full display as he helped rally the team, school and community both mentally

and physically and just six months later while facilities and homes were still ravaged, he led the Cowboys onto the field for his first time on Feb. 13 in what was one of the most remarkable comeback wins in Cowboy history when McNeese rallied to defeat Tarleton State 40-37 in double-OT.

The spring season saw McNeese overcome obstacles and adversity from all angles and played its best football of the season late, winning two of its last three games while two of the losses on the season were by a combined six points.

Wilson's debut campaign at UTSA made history as he led the Roadrunners to six wins and the 2016 Gildan New Mexico Bowl to match the NCAA modern startup program record by reaching a bowl game in just their sixth season.

Wilson guided UTSA to bowl eligibility for the second straight season in 2017. The Roadrunners pulled off another program first when they defeated Baylor, 17-10, in the season opener in Waco for UTSA's first victory against a team from a Power 5 Conference.

During his four years at UTSA, 26 players garnered All-Conference USA, two were named All-Americans, a league Defensive Player of the Year, two Freshman of the Year selections, a semifinalist for the Lou Groza Award and the prestigious William V. Campbell Trophy.

Prior to being named head coach at UTSA, Wilson served a six-year stint as the running backs coach and recruiting coordinator at LSU from 2010-15, where he also served as associate head coach for his final four seasons with the Tigers. He also has been an assistant coach at Tennessee (2009), Southern Miss (2008) and Mississippi (2005-07).

While at LSU, he was recognized as the nation's top assistant coach at his position in 2011. Wilson also was named the 2011 Recruiter of the Year by Rivals.com, the 2014 NFL.com Top Recruiter in College Football and the 2015 Scout.com SEC Recruiter of the Year.

As the recruiting coordinator at LSU, Wilson led the Tigers to back-to-back top-five recruiting classes in 2014-15 among five total groups that ranked among the top 10 nationally. He served as the lead recruiter for a long list of prominent players, including Odell Beckham Jr., La'el Collins, Jeremy Hill, Jarvis Landry, Tyrann Mathieu, Zach Mettenberger and the nation's No. 1 overall recruit in 2014 in Leonard Fournette, a 2014 Freshman All-SEC honoree and consensus first team All-American a year later.

Overall, Wilson has coached or recruited 40 individuals who have made it to the NFL. That list includes Davenport, Jordan Moore, Kevin Strong Jr., Dalton Sturm, Josiah Tauaefa and Jarveon Williams from UTSA, Beckham Jr., Collins, Fournette, Hill, Landry, Mathieu and Mettenberger along with Lamin Barrow, Kendell Beckwith, Alfred Blue, Will Clapp, Malachi Dupre, Ego Ferguson, Russell Gage, BenJarvus Green-Ellis, Derrius Guice, Jerald Hawkins, Kenny Hilliard, Anthony Johnson, Deion Jones, Arden Key, Kendrick Lewis, Terrance Magee, Ronald Martin, Dexter McCluster, Denarius Moore, Eric Reid, Stevan Ridley, Duke Riley, Trai Turner, Mike Wallace, Spencer Ware and James Wright.

In six seasons at LSU, Wilson developed seven running backs that were selected in the NFL Draft, including first-team All-SEC performers in Fournette, Guice, Hill and Ridley. During his tenure, the Tigers posted a 61-17 overall record, captured the 2011 SEC Championship and appeared in the National Championship Game that same season.

Under his guidance, LSU rushed for at least 200 yards 39 times, including 12 300-yard

games. The Tigers also recorded 45 100-yard individual rushing performances and four 1,000-yard individual rushers.

Wilson joined the LSU staff after spending the 2009 season at Tennessee, where he coached the wide receivers under Lane Kiffin.

Prior to joining the Tennessee staff, Wilson spent the 2008 season as the running backs coach/recruiting coordinator at Southern Miss under Larry Fedora.

From 2005-07, Wilson served as the running backs/assistant special teams coach at Mississippi, where he recruited prominent future NFL stars Kendrick Lewis and Mike Wallace. He also developed a first-team all-conference running back in Green-Ellis.

Wilson joined the Rebels' staff after serving one year as director of athletics for the New Orleans Public School System after spending three-and-a-half seasons as head football coach and offensive coordinator at O. Perry Walker High School.

Wilson led O. Perry Walker to two District 10-4A championships and the Louisiana Class 4A State Championship game in 2002. He was honored by the NFL as the 2002 Louisiana Coach of the Year and was voted by his peers as the Louisiana Class 4A Coach of the Year. Wilson also was a finalist for the 2002 Nike National Coach of the Year.

During his head coaching stint at O. Perry Walker, Wilson developed 22 players who earned Division I scholarships, including 11 in 2002 to rank as the nation's largest high school class of D-I signees. The 2002 team defeated national-power John Curtis Christian School, 20-0, during the regular season, which snapped a 136-game district winning streak for John Curtis and marked the first time that team had failed to score in 303 consecutive games, a national record.

Wilson spent three years as an assistant coach at Edna Karr High School, also in New Orleans, from 1997-2000. He served as offensive coordinator at Edna Karr during the 1999 season in which the team reached the Class 3A state finals and recorded its best statistical season on offense in the program's history.

Wilson got his start in coaching as a student assistant at his alma mater, Nicholls State University, working with the running backs while he finished his degree. While in Thibodaux, Wilson helped coach the first 1,000-yard rusher in school history and was part of the biggest turnaround in NCAA history at the time for the Colonels, who improved from 0-10 in 1995 to 8-2 in 1996.

A three-year letterman at Nicholls, Wilson earned honorable mention all-conference honors as a running back his sophomore year.

Wilson attended Geneva University in Beaver Falls, Pa., his freshman season, earning conference Freshman of the Year honors as a running back and kick returner. He also earned first team all-conference honors and was an honorable mention NAIA Division II All-American.

Wilson received his bachelor of arts degree in general education from Nicholls State in 1997.

Wilson and his wife, Tiffany, have three children: Alaina, Sabree and Frank IV, who is a redshirt freshman defensive back for the Cowboys this fall.

POKIN' AROUND

- McNeese has won 198 all-time games in Southland Conference play, more than any other league team past or present.
- McNeese ranks No. 1 in the SLC and 10th in the FCS in kickoff return defense by allowing just 15.6 yards per return.
- 1st in SLC and 12th nationally having blocked two kicks.
- McNeese is one of 55 teams in the FCS that has not had a kick of any kind blocked this season.
- The Cowboys are 1st in SLC and 10th nationally with passes had intercepted (2).
- 1st in SLC and 4th nationally in punt return average at 21.5 per return.
- 1st in SLC and 37th nationally by allowing 125.8 rushing yards per game.
- After being outscored 104-33 in the first half, the Cowboys are outscoring opponents 76-65 in the second half.

PIERCE PRODUCING ON OFFENSE AND ST

- KR, PR and WR Mason Pierce has come on strong in both special teams and offensively.
- Heading into Saturday's game at NSU, Pierce is ranked 3rd in the league and 17th in the FCS in KO return average (27.2)
- His 100-yard return to start the game at Southern was the first ever for McNeese to open the game with an KOR for a TD.
- He's also only the second player in school history to return a kickoff for 100 yards (Chris Fontenette in 1992).
- Had a career-long 66-yard punt return against SLU which is the longest in the season by any player in the league.
- His three TDs scored against the Lions are the most by a player in the conference this season.
- 2 of 5 games has accumulated over 100 yards in KO returns (105 vs. West Florida; 111 at Southern).
- 100 all-purpose yards or more in 3 of 5 games this season with a high of 192 in last outing against Southeastern.
- 3rd in SLC and 25th in FCS with 615 total all-purpose yards.

- He's coming off a 17 tackle game against Southeastern, recording a league and FCS high 15 solo tackles.
- 33 solo stops on the year tops the SLC and ranks tied for 8th in the FCS.
- He's recorded 10 or more tackles in 4 straight games.
- He's nearing cracking the top 20 career list in total tackles, now with 170, needing 73 more to break in at No. 20.

FROM WALK-ON TO RECORD-HOLDER, ORGERON KEEPS CLIMBING CAREER LISTS

- Having played only one season of organized football prior to arriving at McNeese, 6th year quarterback, and 3rd year starter, Cody Orgeron, has become one of the top QBs in school history and continues to climb the school career record lists.
- With his 3 TD game against Southeastern in his last outing, he moved up to No. 5 with 43 career TDs thrown (13 more for 4th).
- He's one of just seven QBs in school history to throw for 5,000 yards in a career, now with 5,594 yards, needing 400 more to move into 6th place.
- Ranks 7th with 455 completions (7 for 6th, 42 for 5th).
- 8th with 776 pass attempts (34 for 7th, 65 for 6th).
- Has 6,553 total yards, ranking him 6th all-time (172 to move into 5th, 356 for 4th, 835 for 3rd).
- 959 career rushing yards, needing 41 more to become just the 5th QB in school history to run for 1,000 yards in a career.
- 1,124 total plays accumulated, ranking as the 5th most in school history (12 to move into 4th and 40 for 3rd. Record is 1,649).
- He's thrown for 300 yards or more five times, needing one more to match the school record of 6 held by James Tabary.

POKES PICKED 4TH IN POLL

- McNeese has been picked for a 4th place finish in the Southland Conference preseason poll.

CHAMBERS NAMED TO BUCHANAN AWARD PRESEASON WATCH LIST

- Three months after placing fourth in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award as the FCS top defensive player, McNeese defensive end Isaiah Chambers was tabbed as one of 35 players to the initial watch list.
- A preseason All-American by three different organizations, Chambers earned consensus All-American honors following the spring season by being named first team All-American by five different organizations - Associated Press, AFCA, Stats Perform, Hero Sports and Phil Steele. He was also named national defensive player of the year by Phil Steele and was tabbed the Southland Conference and Louisiana Defensive Player of the Year.
- Chambers is one of nine defensive linemen named to the watch list and is one of two Southland Conference players on the list (Southeastern Louisiana DB Ferlando Jordan).

CHAMBERS ALSO NAMED TO REESE'S SENIOR BOWL WATCH LIST

- McNeese All-American defensive end Isaiah Chambers has been named to the 2022 Reese's Senior Bowl Watch List.
- The Reese's Senior Bowl is the nation's most prestigious college all-star game, as it annually serves as the first step of the NFL draft process. The Reese's Senior Bowl has had 106 total players and 36 selected in the first three rounds of the 2021 NFL Draft.
- This year's game will be held February 5, 2022 and broadcast live on NFL Network.
- Chambers is one of just three players from the Southland Conference to be listed to the watch list and 37 players from non-FBS squads (29 FCS, 8 non-D1). Other Southland players named to the list include Nicholls wide receiver Dai'Jean Dixon and Southeastern quarterback Cole Kelley.
- McNeese has sent three players to the Senior Bowl in school history - defensive back Keith Smith (2003), defensive end Kavika Pittman (1995), and offensive lineman Jim Files (1976). All three were selected in the NFL Draft - Pittman and Files in the second round and Smith in the third.

McNeese quarterback Cody Orgeron and the Cowboy defense came up big in Saturday's 21-7 win over Northwestern State in Southland Conference action. Orgeron threw for 306 yards on 17 of 22 passing touchdown passes of 2 and 75 yards. It's the third 300-yard passing game of his career. True freshman running back Josh Parker led an injury-hampered running game with 77 yards on 16 carries. Defensively, defensive end Isaiah Chambers recorded three sacks, Darius Daniels with one while Andre Sam and Dorion Pollard each picked off a pass, the first for the Cowboys this season. 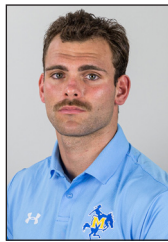
