POKES CLOSE OUT SEASON WITH BATTLE OF THE BORDER RIVALRY GAME

- McNeese will conclude the 2022 season on Saturday night when it renews its rivalry against Lamar in the resurrection of the Battle of the Border rivalry game.
- The Cowboys are coming off a 21-10 win at HCU last week to mark the second straight victory and first in Southland Conference play.
- Lamar stepped out of league play and dropped a 51-14 game at New Mexico State.
- The Cowboys will be looking to win their third straight game for the first time since the 2019 season while closing out the season with three consecutive wins for the first time since 2017.

COWBOYS AND CARDINALS

- McNeese and Lamar will meet up for the 40th time in the history of the series after taking a one-year hiatus in 2021 while Lamar competed in the WAC.
- The Cowboys lead the series 27-11-1 and are 13-8 at home.
- Lamar has defeated McNeese the last two matchups in Cowboy Stadium - 27-26 in overtime in the spring of 2021, and 21-17 in 2018 when the Cardinals.
- Since Lamar re-started the program in 2010, McNeese has posted an 8-3 record in the 11 previous meetings.
- All three of Lamar's wins over the Cowboys in that span have occurred in Cowboy Stadium (spring 2021, 2018, 2014).

SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NEWS AND NOTES

LAMAR at McNEESE • 7 p.m. • ESPN3

- The regular season closes out under the lights in Lake Charles for the 40th playing of the Battle of the Border.
- The teams last met in the Spring 2021 season with Lamar taking a 27-26 overtime win.
- McNeese is 12-8 in this series at home and has won 7 of the last 10.
- Lamar has won the last two meetings in Lake Charles, including in the 2021 spring season by way of a 27-26 overtime victory.

SOUTHEASTERN at NICHOLLS • 6 p.m. Thursday • ESPN+

- The River Bell Classic will help decide the title race this season. If SLU wins, the Lions are conference champions. If Nicholls wins, there's a three-way tie for second.
- This series will play its 33rd game, with the record tied at 16 wins apiece. Nicholls won last year's meeting, 45-42.
- SLU has won the last two meetings in Thibodaux, where the series is tied 7-7.
- This game will have the eyes of the FCS nation, as it's the only game on the Thursday calendar in the entire nation.



HCU at TARLETON • 2 p.m. • ESPN+

- The Huskies head to Stephenville for an out-of-conference game to end the season.
- This is HCU's first-ever meeting with the Texans.
- Tarleton is 5-5 on the season (1-3 in conference) and is on a three-game losing skid.

TENNESSEE ST. at A&M-COMMERCE • 2 p.m. • ESPN+

- The Lions and Tigers will tangle for the first time in 36 years as A&M-Commerce looks to snap a three-game skid and finish over .500 in its first season in Division I.
- TSU was a 15-6 winner in the only prior meeting in 1986 when TSU was ranked No. 5 in I-AA and TAMUC had just moved to Division II.
- Tennessee State is 3-7 on the year and 2-3 in the OVC, having lost its last three games.



McNEESE SCHEDULE NOTES

• The Cowboys opened the season on the road for the third time in the last five years and the second time against a Big Sky Conference opponent (at Northern Colorado in 2018 - won 17-14), falling to Montana State by a 40-17 score.

• **Montana State:** The Cowboys and Bobcats met for just the second time in history and first in the regular season. McNeese defeated Montana State 21-14 in the first round of the 2002 FCS playoffs in Lake Charles. The Cowboys went on to play for the national championship for the second time in school history, falling to Western Kentucky by a 34-14 score.

• **Rice:** The Cowboys dropped a 52-10 decision to Rice in the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

• **Alcorn State:** The Cowboys welcome back Alcorn State to The Hole for the second time in the last four seasons. McNeese is 4-0 all-time against the Braves, having won 17-14 in 2019. This game will also mark the return of 7 p.m. kick-offs, the first time that has happened since 2013, and will be under the lights for the first time since 2019 after Hurricane Laura destroyed the standards in August 2020.

• **Mississippi College:** The Cowboys hold a 3-0 all-time lead over the Division II Choctaws. Mississippi College is a member of the powerful Gulf South Conference, a league where Cowboys' head coach Gary Goff competed in the last two seasons.

• **Incarnate Word:** The Cowboys will open up Southland Conference play at the defending conference champions. The two squads split the series last season with UIW winning 31-0 at San Antonio and the Cowboys coming back with a 28-20 upset win in Lake Charles and snapping a three-game losing streak to the Cardinals.

• **Texas A&M-Commerce:** This game will mark the first meeting between the two schools since 1971 when Commerce went by East Texas State. The Lions won the first meeting, 57-26, in 1970 while the Cowboys took a 47-3 win the following year.

• **Nicholls:** The two teams have traded wins the last six meetings while the home team has won five of the last six. Nicholls held off the Cowboys 24-14 in Lake Charles last year. McNeese leads the all-time series 31-15.

• **Southeastern:** The Cowboys will host the Lions for their homecoming game this season while looking to snap a three-game losing streak. McNeese leads 25-23 all-time. McNeese head coach Gary Goff was the WR coach for the Lions in 2003-04 while Cowboys' WR coach Felton Huggins was a record-holder WR under Goff.

• **Eastern Illinois:** McNeese is 2-0 all-time vs. the Panthers with a 49-7 win at home in the second game of the 1993 season.

• **HBU:** This game will be played at HBU for the second straight season. McNeese leads the all-time series 4-0 and posted a 44-3 win last year.

• **Lamar:** The Battle of the Border returns after a year hiatus. McNeese leads 28-15-1 all-time and has held the upper hand in the series since Lamar's return to football in 2010 with the Cowboys holding an 8-3 advantage.

- Of the 14, four have been with the Cowboys since their signing out of HS - Barkat, Lewis, Semien and Williams.

McELROY NAMED SLC, LSWA OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- McNeese senior running back Marcus McElroy, Jr. has been named this week's Southland Conference and Louisiana Offensive Player of the Week, it was announced on Monday.
- McElroy came off the bench in Saturday's 21-10 win at HCU and rolled up a career-high 136 yards on the ground while scoring two touchdowns.
- The Denver native, who is playing his only season with the Cowboys, averaged 11.3 yards per carry in the game and had five of his 12 carries go for 10 or more yards with four of those going for 20 or more with his longest run coming on his first carry of the game which went for 30 yards.
- His 100-yard rushing game was the eighth for the Cowboys on the season (Deonta McMahon with six, McElroy and D'Angelo Durham with one each).
- McElroy is the first Cowboy to receive a weekly conference award while being the third honored by the Louisiana Sports Writers Association, joining McMahon and kicker Garrison Smith.

McMAHON TO WIN SLC RUSHING TITLE

- Senior RB Deonta McMahon will become the first Cowboy to win the Southland Conference rushing title since the 2008 season when Toddrick Pendland led the league in rushing.
- Heading into Saturday's finale, McMahon has rushed for 1,169 yards for a 116.9 yards per game average, both league highs.
- He also tops the SLC in all-purpose yards with 1,642 yards and a 164.2 ypg average.
- He's coming off a 197-yard rushing game at HCU to mark his 6th 100-yard game of the season and 9th in his career.
- He ran for a career-high 211 yards in a win over Eastern Illinois two weeks ago that ranks as the 11th-best rushing game in school history.
- His six 100-yard games this season ranks as the 2nd most in school history in a single season while his 9 career 100-yard games ranks as the

6th-most in a career in school history.

• He'll enter Saturday's game with 1,916 career rushing yards, ranking 17th all-time in school history, and looking to become just the 16th player ever in McNeese history to collect 2,000 rushing yards.

• He's also the first Cowboy player to rush for 1,000 yards in a season since 2015 (Marcus Wiltz 1,287).

• 10 rushing TDs this season is the 7th-most in a single season while his 19 career rushing scores rank as the 13th-most in school history.

KORDELL WILLIAMS ADDED TO BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Senior linebacker Kordell Williams has been added to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List as the top defensive player in the FCS.
- Currently 2nd in the SLC with 108 total tackles and with 10.8 tackles per game which ranks him 3rd in the FCS.
- Tops the league and is 5th in the FCS with 61 solo tackles and a 6.4 per game average.
- He's 4th in the Southland with 9.0 tackles for a loss.
- Six double-digit tackle game of the season.
- 328 career tackles which ranks as the 8th-most in a career in school history.

NOTES ON THE COWBOYS

- In all four conference losses, McNeese trailed by one score or led in the fourth quarter (led 27-21 with 13:44 vs. SLU; led 35-34 with 11:15 left at Nicholls; 28-20 at UIW with less than 10 minutes to play; 20-15 vs. TAMUC with 12 minutes remaining).
- After playing its first five games without an interception, McNeese has picked off 9 passes in the last 5 games.
- The 3 picks vs. SLU was the first 3-interception game for the Cowboys since picking off 3 at HCU last fall.
- McNeese has scored in 17 of its last 19 chances in the red-zone over the last five games (14 TDs, 3 FG).
- Averaging 28 points and 408 yards of offense over the last four games after averaging just 19 points and 309 yards of offense through the first six games of the season.

Gary Goff, who led Valdosta State to the program's sixth NCAA National Championship appearance this past Saturday and back-to-back Gulf South Conference titles in his two playing seasons as head coach in Tilton (three overall seasons), was named McNeese's 18th head coach in school history back in December.

Goff finished his VSU career with a 22-3 record. He also coached eight seasons at Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, and is 60-53 in 10 playing seasons of coaching.

The Blazers finished the 2021 season with a 12-2 record overall, falling in the NCAA Division II National Title to Ferris State. VSU went 6-1 in the Gulf South Conference, sharing the league title with West Florida. Goff was named GSC Coach of the Year for the second time in 2021, as he was Co-GSC Coach of the Year in 2019.

This past season, the Blazers placed 17 players on the All-GSC team including nine on the first unit. Valdosta led the NCAA in total offense for the season, averaging 527.2 yards per game, was second in rushing (267.0, 5th in NCAA) and third in passing (260.2, 30th in NCAA).

Defensively, the Blazers led the league in passing defense (159.9), sixth in rushing defense (188.3) and third in total defense (348.2). Additionally, VSU aver-

aged 43.2 points per game (2nd in the GSC, 5th NCAA) while allowing just 22.7 points to rank third in the conference.

His team this past season included three Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCCA) All-Americans - offensive lineman Ralph Singleton (1st team), linebacker Nick Moss (1st team), and defensive lineman Brian Williams (2nd team). Singleton also garnered first team AP All-America honors while Moss earned AP second team honors.

VSU also ranked No. 3 in the NCAA with 320 first downs made, seventh with four defensive TDs scored, seventh in 3rd-down conversion percentage (.500), fourth in red-zone offense percentage (.929), first in sacks allowed per game (0.15), and ninth in tackles for loss allowed per game (3.31).

In 2019 he led the Blazers to a season of 10-1 and 8-0 in Gulf South Conference play, earning Gulf South Conference Co-Coach of the Year honors. Goff continued on the

outstanding tradition of VSU football as the Blazers won their first ten games of the season, ranked No. 1 nationally throughout the regular season and a berth in the second round of the NCAA Division II Football playoffs.

G o f f

coached a league-best 13 All-GSC selections in 2019 and GSC Offensive Player of the Year Rogan Wells. Wells earned American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) All-America honors, was a finalist for the prestigious Harlon Hill Trophy and recently named the GSC Offensive Player of the Decade. Along with Wells, senior offensive linemen Adonis Sealey and Brandon Kemp earned All-America honors. Junior long snapper Pippin Davis was named Second Team Academic All-

America[®] by CoSIDA. Kemp signed an undrafted free agent contract with the Tennessee Titans of the NFL in April.

Under Goff's guidance, the Blazers continued their outstanding offensive play as the team finished second nationally in third down conversion percentage at a .528 clip. The Blazers were fourth nationally in completion percentage (.701), while finishing 14th nationally in first downs gained (276). VSU was 11th nationally in rushing offense at 260.2 yards on the ground per game, while it was 12th nationally in passing efficiency at 162.12. VSU finished third nationally in total offense at 522.1 yards per game, while finishing 20th nationally in scoring offense at 38.9 points per game.

The Blazers also were outstanding on defense as the team was 32nd nationally in total defense, allowing 311.5 yards per game and held teams to a 111.71 passing efficiency for 33rd nationally out of 166 NCAA Division II programs. The Blazer defense held teams to 124.4 yards per game on the ground for 44th nationally. The opposition scored just 18.5 points per game on the Blazers for 23rd nationally and tops in the conference.

Goff arrived at VSU from NCAA Division II Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, where he was the head coach of the Dragons from 2011-18. In 2018, Goff had his best season at Tiffin as he guided the Dragons to a 9-2 campaign and a 6-2 record in the Great Midwest Conference as the team began the season 9-0. Tiffin was ranked as high as No. 15 in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 in 2018. Goff had 16 Dragons named to G-MAC All-Conference teams in 2018.

In 2016, Goff guided the Dragons to their first winning season since the 2006 season as the team went 8-3 with Goff earning Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Coach of the Year honors, the first in program history. He had one of the top offens-

es in country in 2016 averaging 434.5 yards per game, while his quarterback Antonio Pipkin was a Harlon Hill nominee and was named GLIAC Player of the Year. Pipkin tallied seven Tiffin career records and four GLIAC records, ranking 13th all-time in career total offense, 19th in total offense per game, 27th in career passing yards, and is only the third quarterback at the Division II level to ever accumulate at least 2,000 rushing yards and throw for 10,000 passing yards in a career. That season, Goff also had the program's first Academic All-American as 74 players finished the 2016 fall se-

with a 3.0 grade point average or higher.

Prior to Goff's arrival in 2011, Tiffin University was a combined 2-31 from 2008-2010.

Goff joined Tiffin after a highly successful 2010 season at West Virginia Wesleyan where he was the offensive coordinator and quarterback coach. There, he helped guide the team to a massive turnaround as it was 2-8 in 2009 and went 9-2 in 2010, tying for the most wins in school history. The team was ranked nationally for the first time and broke 12 offensive school records.

Before West Virginia Wesleyan, Goff coached at Division I Princeton University where he was the pass game coordinator and receivers coach. He also served as co-offensive coordinator and receivers coach at New Mexico State for four seasons as he helped lead the team to second nationally in passing offense and total offense.

The Aggies broke 21 offensive school records, while ranking 15th nationally in scoring offense. Goff coached the nation's top receiver, two-time All-America selection Chris Williams, who signed with the Cleveland Browns.

Goff, who has served as offensive coordinator for three teams, also was offensive coordinator at Iowa Wesleyan University (2002-03) and coached at Southeastern Louisiana, helping it to lead the nation in total offense. He also had coaching stints at Woodstock (Ga.) High School and Cherokee (Ga.) High School.

He played for former Blazer head coach Hal Mumme

and former offensive coordinator Mike Leach at Valdosta State and graduated in 1996. During his time in Tiletown, Goff helped lead the Blazers to their first Gulf South Conference title in 1996 and the first two NCAA playoff seasons in program history in 1994 and 1996. Goff began as a walk-on for the Blazers in the spring of 1993 after transferring to VSU from the University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D. He then earned a scholarship culminating in being named a team captain in 1996. Goff and the Blazers went 35-13 during his career at VSU under Mumme earning letters in 1995 and 1996. While at

VSU, Goff and his teammates helped lay the foundation for where the VSU football program is today.

Goff earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from VSU and holds a master's degree from Tiffin. Goff is a native of Picayune, Miss., and he and his wife Tiffanie have two children, Tyler and Audrey.
