Panthers Jump Out Of Conference With Trip To Louisiana

Eastern Illinois (2-6) at McNeese (1-7) Cowboy Stadium (17,000) • Lake Charles, La. November 5, 2022 • 7 p.m. • TV: ESPN+

NOTES TO KNOW

- A pair of teams both looking to snap losing skids meet on Saturday night in Lake Charles, Louisiana as Eastern Illinois travels to McNeese for a late season, non-conference contest. This is one of two Southland Conference teams on EIU's schedule this year as part of the scheduling alliance between the OVC and Southland. EIU previously beat Northwestern State at home in early October. Since that win over Northwestern State, EIU has dropped three straight games to stand at 2-6 on the season, 1-2 in the OVC. McNeese is 1-7 overall and dropped to 0-4 in the Southland after a tough, one-point loss to nationally ranked Southeastern Louisiana on Saturday.
- Stone Galloway extended his consecutive field goals made streak to 14 straight with a 21-yard make on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. Galloway is 10-for-10 this season and is just one of two kickers in the FCS that remain perfect on the season. Colby Kintner of The Citadel is the other kicker perfect this season going 8-for-8. The 14 consecutive made field goals are the longest streak in the Ohio Valley Conference in the last 20 seasons.
- Colin Bohanek was active on the field for the Panthers defense on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. The third year linebacker finished with a career high 15 tackles including 12 solo stops. The 12 solo tackles were tied for 10th on the EIU single game list. It marked the third time this season and sixth time in his career that Bohanek had double figure tackles in a game. Last season he was second in the OVC in tackles with 89 while tied for the conference lead with 11 tackles for loss. This season he is fifth in the OVC in tackles with a team high 62 including 6.5 tackles for loss.
- Defensive lineman Colby Smith joined the takeaway party for the season as he picked off a screen pass on Saturday against Tennessee Tech. Smith became the seventh different player to intercept a pass this season. EIU currently ranks seventh in the FCS in interceptions with 12 while the Panthers defense is 10th in the FCS in turnovers gained with 17. Elijawah Tolbert is the team leader with three interceptions while Colin Bohanek, Jordan Vincent and Tyris Harvey all have two picks.
- Jordan Vincent blocked a Tennessee Tech field goal attempt on the final play of the first half with Mark Aitken scooping it up and racing 65 yards for a touchdown. It was the first blocked field goal returned for a touchdown by the Panthers since the 2007 season when Trevor Frericks blocked a field goal and Rashad Haynes returned it for a score in a win over Samford. It was EIU's first blocked kick this season as the Panthers have blocked at least one kick in four straight seasons.

- Punter Trey Wilhoit continues to be a special teams weapon for the Panthers as he had four punts on Saturday against Tennessee Tech for an average of 51 yards per punt. Wilhoit had a long punt of 59 yards with one pinned inside the 20-yard line. For the season Wilhoit ranks eighth in the FCS in punting average at 44.4 yards per punt. He has a long of 62 yards with 12 punts over 50 yards and ten of his 38 punts inside the 20-yard line. EIU's single season record for punting average is 44.6 set by Kevin Cook during the 2007 season.
- Jaelin Benefield rushed for a season high 79 yards to lead the Panthers ground game on Saturday as he moved over the 1,100 yard mark for his EIU career. Benefield moved into 28th place on the EIU career rushing charts as he has 1,122 career yards. In his career Benefield has two 100-yard rushing days. He is currently third on EIU's team with 12 receptions for 101 yards and one touchdown.
- Jordan Vincent continues to make plays for the Panthers from his safety position and did so once again against Tennessee Tech. He blocked the field goal attempt at the end of the first half as part of his defensive effort on the day which included seven tackles and two pass break-ups. Six of Vincent's seven tackles were solo stops as he leads the OVC with 41 solo tackles this year which ranks 25th in the FCS. He is also now the team leader with five pass break-ups to go with his two interceptions.
- Eastern Illinois played a clean game in terms of penalties as the Panthers were not flagged one time in the Saturday game with Tennessee Tech. The last time EIU played a game with no penalties called on the Panthers was Nov. 23, 2019 at Austin Peay in the final game of the season, a stretch of 23 games. Prior to that, it had been ten seasons since EIU's last game without a penalty called the final game of the 2010 season on Nov. 13, 2010 at Illinois State. EIU currently leads the OVC and ranks 29th in the FCS in fewest penalty yards per game.
- Eastern Illinois defense recorded six tackles for loss on Saturday against Tennessee Tech as the Panthers now rank 35th in the FCS in team tackles for loss averaging 6.4 per game. EIU's best tackle for loss performance this season was at Tennessee State with 12 including four sacks. Colin Bohanek is the Panthers leader with 6.5 tackles for loss while Jordan Miles (5.5) and Joel Barrows (5) are just behind. Eleven different players have at least two tackles for loss this season.
- Eastern Illinois run defense made it eight straight games this season that the Panthers have not allowed an individual 100-yard rusher. David Gist of Tennessee Tech was the closest this past weekend finishing with 99 yards. On the year EIU ranks 40th in the OVC in rushing defense allowing 132.5 yards per game. Four times this season opponents have been held under 100 yards rushing with a season low 54 yards by Northwestern State.
- Quarterback Zach Weir played the second half on Saturday seeing playing time for the second straight game under center. Weir replaced the injured Jonah O'Brien against Tennessee Tech as the Panthers second quarterback, Dom Shoffner, was unable to play due to an injury suffered early the previous week at Tennessee State. Weir passed for 63 yards going 6-of-15. Shoffner is expected to return this week for EIU having played in five games this season passing for 112 yards and rushing for 267.
- Eastern Illinois shuffled its offensive line on Saturday against Tennessee Tech as Max Stineman started at center marking the fourth different player to start at center this season for the Panthers. Stineman has started all eight games this season with seven starts at left guard. Elkhanan Tanelus opened the year at center but was hurt in the second game. Jack Valente has one start at center and Michael McNicholas has four starts at center. Both Valente and McNicholas have slid to other starting spots in the offensive line when not starting at center.
- Saturday will be close to a homecoming for several players on the Eastern Illinois roster as the Panthers play in the Southwestern part of Louisiana at McNeese. Defensive lineman Braylon Willis is from Lafayette, Louisiana just over an hour from Lake Charles. The Panthers roster also includes six players from the neighboring state of Texas with Jaelin Benefield the closest from the Houston metro area, just 2 and 1/2 hours away.
- Eastern Illinois head coach Chris Wilkerson will lead the Panthers into a Saturday night contest at McNeese. As a player Wilkerson was a member of the EIU team during the Panthers two previous contests with the Cowboys in the early 1990s. He was a redshirt defensive lineman during the 1990 meeting and had one tackle during the 1993 contest at McNeese.
- Saturday's non-conference game at McNeese will mark the latest in a season EIU has played a non-conference game in nearly a decade. The last time EIU played a late non-conference contest was to close out the 2012 regular season at Central Arkansas under first year head coach Dino Babers. Both EIU and UCA had already locked up their conference automatic bids to the FCS playoffs EIU winning the OVC and UCA winning the Southland Conference. In that game, Erik Lora became the FCS single season record holder for receptions.

- Kicker Stone Galloway was among a group of six FCS kickers recognized for their performances in September on the Fred Mitchell Award Watch List. Galloway is 10-for-10 on field goal attempts this season and 22-for-22 on extra points. He currently leads the Panthers in scoring with 52 points. Galloway has made 14 straight field goals dating back to last season. This season he ranks 23rd in the FCS in field goals made and is tied for first in field goal percentage as one of two players that are perfect on field goal attempts this season. He now has 23 career field goals to rank 7th on the EIU career list.
- Eastern Illinois wide receiver Isaiah Hill was named a semifinalist for the NFF Campbell Trophy released on Sept. 28. Hill is one of 37 candidates from the FCS level and two selected from the Ohio Valley Conference. Hill, a preseason All-OVC selection at wide receiver, earned his undergraduate degree in criminal justice and is currently enrolled in the MBA program. Hill made his first appearance of the 2022 season against Lindenwood with five receptions for 77 yards. He went over the 100 career reception mark in the game and now has 101 receptions and 1,139 yards.
- Eastern Illinois offensive line has gained experience over the last couple of years with several players starting as true freshmen in 2019 and playing against more experienced defensive players. Three of EIU's projected starting linemen Elkhanan Tanelus, Chad Strickland and Anthony Imperio have all played for the last three years with Tanelus and Strickland set to be starters for their fourth seasons for the Panthers.
- EIU added five FBS transfers to the Panthers roster for this upcoming season. Joining EIU are quarterbacks Dom Shoffner (Charlotte) and Jonah O'Brien (Colorado State) along with Ira Armstead (Virginia) who transferred to EIU in the spring as a quarterback but has moved to wide receiver. On the defensive side EIU added Tre'jon Lewis (Texas Tech) and Elijah Ball (Purdue). The Panthers now have nine total FBS transfers on the roster.
- EIU added 12 junior college transfers to the roster this season with a number of them expected to make an immediate impact. Listed in the Panthers first two-deep of the season are incoming junior college players Max Stineman (OL), Terrance Shaw (OL), Colby Smith (DL), Braylon Willis (DL), Alexandar Oyawale (LB) and Trey Wilhoit (P).
- Eastern Illinois had six players named to the preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team heading into this season. Wide receiver Isaiah Hill and tight end Jay Vallie were selected on the offensive side of the ball. Defensive linemen Jordan Miles and Tim Varga were joined on the defensive preseason All-OVC team by safety Jordan Vincent and corner Russell Dandy. Transfer Foday Jalloh was named a top newcomer to watch this season.
- Eastern Illinois has two legacy players on its roster this season with freshmen Carson Fichtel and Mike Smith Jr. Fichtel's father Brad was an All-American lineman for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Smith's father Mike was a defensive back for the Panthers in the early 1990's. Both fathers were teammates of current EIU head coach Chris Wilkerson.
- Eastern Illinois football once again has jumped into the international pool of players as part of their 2022 roster. Already returning to the team was Daniel Luoma who is from Finland. Last year, Luoma who is a reserve tight end served as the Panthers kickoff specialist averaging 59.2 yards per kick with eight touchbacks. The Panthers added Jaxson Isaac to the roster just before fall camp. Isaac is from Regina, Saskatchewan and played at the College of DuPage last season. Prior to Luoma the last European player on the EIU roster was Pascal Matla from Holland in the early 2000's. The last EIU player from Canada was Conrad Praamsma in the mid-1990's.
- Eastern Illinois has announced its team captains for the 2022 season as voted on by the team during the spring. Defensive players Jordan Vincent, Colin Bohanek and Tim Varga were selected along with offensive players Jaelin Benefield and Jay Vallie.
- The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrating its 75th anniversary this season and the conference football alignment has a new member with Lindenwood joining. EIU will host Lindenwood this year as the Panthers homecoming opponent on Oct. 15 but their meeting will not count as an OVC game due to a late adjustment to the OVC schedule and teams only playing five conference games. The OVC and Big South have announced a future scheduling agreement which will include schedules for the 2023 and 2024 seasons.
- Eastern Illinois football has seven players on its current roster that already have earned their undergraduate degree as they prepare to play this upcoming season. The seven graduate players are Elijah Benoit, Bryce Dewberry, Isaiah Hill, Foday Jalloh, Markenzy Pierre, Justin Thomas and Jay Vallie. They are part of the 810 players at the FCS level competing this season with their degree already in-hand.

EIU HEAD COACH CHRIS WILKERSON

Chris Wilkerson was hired as the 26th head coach in Eastern Illinois football history on Jan. 26, 2022. A former player and assistant coach at Eastern Illinois, Wilkerson returns home and becomes the first EIU alumnus to serve as the Panthers head football coach. Wilkerson played and coached under OVC/EIU Hall of Fame Coach Bob Spoo. A 1995 graduate of EIU, Wilkerson coached at EIU until the 2001 season. He had assistant stops at San Jose State and Dartmouth before serving the last ten years as the head coach at the University of Chicago. Wilkerson has a 51-27 career record entering the 2022 season. MCNEESE HEAD COACH GARY GOFF

Gary Goff is in his first season as the head coach at McNeese after having led Valdosta State to the 2021 NCAA Division II National Championship Game where they lost to Ferris State. Goff is a veteran coach with additional head coaching experience at Tiffin University. He is 1-7 in his opening season at McNeese but holds a career record of 61-60. Goff played football at Valdosta State under head coach Hal Mumme and offensive coordinator Mike Leach.

SCOUTING MCNEESE

McNeese enters this non-conference contest on the heels of nearly knocking off nationally ranked Southeastern Louisiana. The Cowboys made a change at quarterback in the one point Saturday loss with Walker Wood taking over under center for Knox Kadum. Wood has passed for 203 yards while Kadum has passed for 978. The ground game is paced by Deonta McMahon with 761 yards and nine touchdowns. On defense Kordell Williams has been a top play maker with 88 tackles including 7.5 tackles for loss and two sacks. Tyler Barnes has three interceptions to go with his 44 tackles.

THE SERIES

Eastern Illinois and McNeese will be meeting for the third time in program history when they square off in Lake Charles, Louisiana on Saturday night. McNeese won both previous meetings including a 49-7 victory at home in 1993. This is the first game in a home-and-home series between the two schools as part of the Ohio Valley Conference and Southland Conference scheduling alliance for 2022 and 2023.

OVC VS. SOUTHLAND CONFERENCE THIS SEASON

Eastern Illinois will play at McNeese as part of the OVC/Southland scheduling alliance. This will be EIU's second game this season as part of that agreement having already picked up a 35-27 win over Northwestern State. So far this season the OVC is 6-1 in games against Southland Conference opponents. Teams from the two leagues will have two additional games with tonight's EIU at McNeese contest and Tennessee State vs. Texas A&M Commerce later in the season.

OVC CELEBRATES 75TH ANNIVERSARY

The Ohio Valley Conference is celebrating its 75th anniversary during the 2022-23 academic year. The OVC is the eighth oldest NCAA Division I conference. Eastern Illinois is entering its 27th season as a member of the OVC. The EIU football team has won seven OVC championships with former head coach Bob Spoo one of two EIU members of the OVC Hall of Fame. EIU has had four OVC Defensive Players of the Year and four OVC Offensive Players of the Year including 2002 Walter Payton Award winner Tony Romo and 2013 Walter Payton Award winner Jimmy Garoppolo.

SHUT OUT STREAK ENDS

Eastern Illinois had a 139 game streak of not being shut out in a game end Sept. 12, 2015 at Northwestern during 41-0 loss. The last time EIU had been shut out was Oct. 11, 2003 during a 41-0 loss versus Eastern Kentucky. In the 2015 season opener EIU had its streak of consecutive games scoring a touchdown end at 65 after the Panthers were held out of the end zone. The last time EIU had failed to score a touchdown was October 10, 2009 at Penn State. Eastern Illinois football is bringing one of its own back home as Panthers Athletic Director Tom Michael has announced the hiring of Chris Wilkerson as the 26h head coach in EIU football history.

Wilkerson played for the Panthers from 1991-94 earning his degree from EIU in 1995. He began his coaching career on the staff of Bob Spoo working with the Panthers from 1995-2001. He led the special teams unit all seven years and also had stints as defensive coordinator, linebackers coach and defensive line coach. The Panthers reached the NCAA FCS playoffs four times and won a pair of conference championships during his tenure. Wilkerson's defenses and special teams were regularly ranked in the national top 20 in numerous categories.

Wilkerson comes to EIU after a successful run as the head coach at the University of Chicago where he has posted winning seasons in seven of his eight seasons including an 8-2 record this past season with an offense that featured the leading rusher in Division III football. He has a 51-27 record in nine seasons as the UChicago head coach with the team not competing during the 2020 season due to COVID-19.

"I'm excited to welcome Chris Wilkerson back home as the next head football coach at Eastern Illinois," said Michael. "The passion with which Chris played the game as a Panther, the passion with which he speaks about EIU, show what a truly special place EIU is. He brings with him a proven track record of building a program with success on both sides of the football. I have no doubt that Chris will bring that same passion back to this program on the field when the Panthers suit up this fall."

"My family and I are extremely humbled and honored to be coming home to Eastern Illinois University and look forward to leading our football family into the future! This opportunity is something I have dreamed about since 1995. I understand the passion, and pride the EIU Football family has for our program. We understand the accomplishments of our football alumni as well as the storied tradition of Panther Football. Our staff will work tirelessly, thoughtfully and with passion to help our collegiate athletes reach their fullest potential," said Wilkerson. "Eastern Illinois University represents excellence in academics and athletics but most importantly excellent PEOPLE! I want to thank President Glassman, Joe Dively, Athletic Director Tom Michael, Deputy Athletic Director Mark Bonnstetter, Tony Romo and all those involved in the search process for this amazing opportunity and a chance to come HOME! I look forward to building relationships with our current players and reconnecting those Panther Football Alumni and together resurrecting our proud Football Tradition."

"Chris was on Coach Spoo's staff when I was a student-athlete. I thought very highly of him at that time and have followed his coaching career," said former EIU All-American quarterback and recent College Football Hall of Fame inductee Tony Romo. "He has the football knowledge on both sides of the ball that will enable the EIU program to be successful. He is the right person to lead our program and I'm excited to have him back home as our next head football coach."

"I am thrilled to learn of Chris Wilkerson being hired as head football coach at Eastern Illinois University. There is not anyone who has more invested in Panther football than Chris – having been a player; graduate assistant; full-time assistant; and defensive coordinator for the Panthers, Chris not only has an unparalleled knowledge of what it takes to be successful at EIU, his love and loyalty for Eastern athletics is real and authentic. Simply put, Chris Wilkerson is the right guy, with the right skill set, at the right time to lead Panther football. Chris, his wife Sharna and family will be wonderful representatives of Eastern Illinois University and Panther athletics as the "first family" of Panther football," said former EIU offensive coordinator and current Syracuse football Director of Player Personnel, Roy Wittke.

His teams have excelled on the field and in the class room at UChicago since Wilkerson took over the program in 2013. His first season the Maroons posted a 6-4 record including the second 4-0 start to a season in the program's modern era. He has guided the school through three different conference affiliations with a 39-15 record in conference play. In all Wilkerson has coached three Division III All-Americans, five Academic All-Americans, nine All-Region selections, four Conference Players of the Year and 94 All-Conference selections during his time at UChicago.

Prior to his arrival at UChicago, he previously served on Dartmouth College's coaching staff from 2005-13 and was named Associate Head Coach in 2007. During his tenure at Dartmouth, Wilkerson's broad range of responsibilities included defensive coordinator, special teams coordinator, running backs coach, linebackers coach and recruiting coordinator. The team was ranked in the top 10 nationally in a number of categories, including punt return average, blocked kicks, individual rushing average and fewest fumbles lost. His pass defense ranked 14th in the country in his debut season.

Wilkerson coached the defense and special teams at San Jose State University from 2002-04. In 2003, he was a nominee for the Broyles Award, given annually to the nation's top assistant coach.

Wilkerson and his wife, Sharna (a former EIU softball player), have three children – Isabella. Pevton and Charlotte.
