## KICK-OFF NOTES

- Following an unplanned open date with Northwestern State canceling the remainder of its football season, McNeese will be back in action on Saturday when it visits Southeastern for game No. 9 of the 2023 season.
- With McNeese's homecoming game being canceled last Saturday and this week's game played in Hammond, the Cowboys will be playing their 5th of the last 7 games on the road.
- Southeastern will also be coming off an open date, this one schedule... the Lions defeated Northwestern State, 37-20, in Natchitoches on Oct. 19 in what would be NSU's final game of the season.
- The Lions' win over the Demons snapped the program's worst start since 1971 when it finished with an 0-11 record.
- The last five games have been decided by a total of 16 points (28-27 SLU in '22; 23-20 SLU and 38-35 SLC in spring '21; 25-20 SLU in fall '21; 38-34 McNeese in '19).
- McNeese head coach Gary Goff was the Lions' WR coach in 2003 and 2004 under Hal Mumme and helped guide SLU to a 51-6 win over the Cowboys in the 2004 campaign.
- The Cowboys will be looking to pick up their first win in Hammond since 2010 (13-10), and snapping a streak of six straight losses in Strawberry Stadium.

## INSIDE THE NUMBERS

**520** | McNeese recorded its 520th all-time win in a less-than-climatic fashion when it came in last Saturday's forfeit win against Northwestern State. In now its 80th season, McNeese has compiled an all-time record of 520-321-13 for a 62 percent winning mark.

**96** | Total number of tackles by sophomore linebacker Micah Davey on the season for a 13.7 per game average, ranking him No. 1 in the Southland and 2nd in the FCS. He's recorded double-digit tackles in all six games on the season and is on pace for 151 stops and threatening the school record of 171 (Charles Ayro, 1997).

**57** | Total number of Cowboys who have made their collegiate debut this season.

**39** | Consecutive PATs made by sophomore kicker Garrison Smith - made all 25 last season and is 14-for-14 this season.

**29** | Number of first time starters for the Cowboys this season - 13 against Tarleton, 6 at Florida, 2 at Alcorn State, 5 at Eastern Illinois, 1 at A&M-Commerce, 2 vs. UIW.

**18** | Consecutive starts by offensive linemen Cole Leclair and Dylan Dauzart as a Cowboy, the most of any current McNeese players... Leclair has made 32 straight starts dating back to the 2021 season at Valdosta State where he started all 14 games.

# GAME #9: AT SOUTHEASTERN

## SERIES HISTORY

- Saturday's game will be the Golden Anniversary for the series between the Cowboys and Lions with McNeese holding a slight 25-24 all-time lead.
- The two teams first played in 1951 and met every year from '51-'73 then played five more times up until Southeastern discontinued the program following the 1985 season... SLU revived the program in 2003 and the two teams have played every year since.
- SLU began playing a Southland Conference slate in 2004, and since becoming a member, the Lions hold an 11-9 lead in the series.
- Southeastern has had the upper hand as of late, winning four straight in the series and 9 out of the last 12 meetings.
- Since 2003, at least one team has been ranked in the FCS Top 25, 17 times in 21 outings with the highest ranking a No. 1 spot by McNeese in 2003 (58-20 Cowboys' win).
- SLU's highest ranking in the series occurred in October 2021 when the 8th-ranked Lions held off a late 4th quarter Cowboy rally for a 23-20 win.
- McNeese's most dramatic win over the Lions came in the 2010 season when kicker Josh Lewis made a 52-yard field goal as time expired to give the Cowboys a 13-10 win in Hammond.

## LAST TIME vs. THE LIONS

- McNeese scored 14 points in the final 51 seconds of the second quarter, including a 42-yard TD run by backup quarterback Walker Wood, to give the Cowboys a 20-14 halftime lead. Then a 3-yard TD run by Deonta McMahon midway through the third quarter upped the margin to 27-14 before Southeastern scored 14 straight points, including the game-winner just minutes into the fourth quarter.
- That score for the Cowboys to give them 27 points, ended a 99-yard drive that needed just five plays as Wood completed two long passes to freshman WR Jon McCall for 39 and 42 yards... those would be the only two receptions by McCall, totaling 81 yards.
- The Cowboys possessed the ball three times in the quarter following the Lions' go-ahead score, but was unable to get any scoring threat put together.
- McNeese freshmen defensive backs Crajaun Bennett and Thomas Miles each recorded their first interceptions of their career.

- Coached by Frank Scelfo who is in his 6th season and has compiled a 35-29 overall mark, including a 4-1 record against McNeese.
- Last three losses were by a combined 14 points - 14-13 vs. Tarleton, 33-26 at UIW, 30-24 vs. Lamar.
- Last year's Southland Conference champions, Southeastern was picked to repeat the feat this year, edging out UIW in the league preseason poll.
- Had 17 players named to the league's preseason All-SLC teams, including eight on the first team.
- Quarterbacks Zachary Clement (1st team) and Eli Sawyer (2nd team) swept the QB positions on the teams.
- HB Bauer Sharp has been named to the Phil Steele Midseason All-American 2nd Team.
- SLU is 2nd in the league in total offense (386.4) and second in passing offense (266.1).
- WR Darius Lewis is 2nd in the conference with 38 catches and is 3rd with 504 receiving yards.
- Starting TE Jacob Logan played for the Cowboys from 2017-19 and played in 28 games during that time... this year, Logan has appeared in all eight games this season and has made 9 catches for 117 yards and three touchdowns.
- SLU has had 5 SLC Player of the Week selections on the season - S Ian Goodley (Defensive - Sept. 4), P Austin Dunlap (Special Teams - Sept. 18 and Sept. 25), S Victory Tademey (Oct. 23), and KR Tristan Goodly (Oct. 23).

## GAME #9: AT SOUTHEASTERN

### FOUR DOWNS

- McNeese is 1-7 for the second straight year and will be looking to repeat the good part of last season when it ended the year with three straight wins.
- The Cowboys are being outscored 76-10 in the second half the last four games and 140-34 in the 2nd half for the season.
- The Cowboys have scored on 10 of 12 red-zone opportunities on the season including 6 touchdowns.
- The 6 red-zone TDs are all on rushes.
- Hamm's 72-yard TD run against Eastern Illinois is the longest in the SLC this season.
- Walk-on RS sophomore QB Ryan Roberts earned his first start of the season against UIW and became the first McNeese QB to throw for 200 yards on the season when he completed 17 of 30 passes for 200 yards, two TDs and an interception.
- Roberts saw his first action on the year at A&M-Commerce, and in two games, has completed 29 of 49 passes (59%) for 305 yards, 2 TDs and an interception and has a 121 efficiency rating.
- Walk-on RS freshman RB Joshon Barbie saw action for just the second time in his career, both coming in the last two games, and ran for 117 yards on 21 carries with a TD.
- Barbie's 21 carries were the most by a McNeese rusher this season while his 100-yard game was just the second by a Cowboy player on the season.
- LB Micah Davey is ranked 1st in the SLC and 2nd in the FCS in total tackles (96), tackles per game (13.7) and solo tackles per game (7.6)
- Davey has recorded 7 of the 9 double-digit tackle games on the season by a McNeese defender, the other two are from sophomore transfer DB Boogsie Silvera (12 tackles at Florida and vs. UIW).
- Offensive linemen Cole Leclair and Dylan Dauzart have started 18 consecutive games as a Cowboys dating back to last season, the longest current streak on the team.
- Adding in his starts when he played at Valdosta State before transferring to McNeese, Leclair has started in 32 consecutive contests.
- Sophomore WR Jon McCall is 2nd in the Southland Conference and is ranked 15th in the FCS with five TD catches on the season
- McCall's 106 yards receiving against UIW (5 catches) is the first 100-yard receiving game for the Cowboys this season.
- McCall has made at least one catch every game this season and has three or more catches in five straight games.
- His five TD grabs have all come in the last four games.
- True freshman WR Makhi Paris leads all freshmen receivers in the Southland with 22 catches and 275 receiving yards.
- Paris has made at least one catch in every game this season and has 10 of his grabs in the last two outings.

### 27 FIRST TIME STARTERS

- A total of 29 players have made their first collegiate start this season with two being true freshmen (WR Makhi Paris, TE Reed Boyd) and 3 others are redshirt freshmen (OL Hayes Creel, DE Masey Lewis, DB Joe Ward).
- 13 players made their starting debuts against Tarleton State in the season opener; 6 more got their first career start the next week at Florida; 1 at Alcorn State; 4 at East-

- ern Illinois and 1 at A&M-Commerce and 2 vs. UIW.
- The defensive backfield has seen the most first-time starters with 8 followed by the defensive line with 6, offensive line with 5, wide receivers with 4, tight ends and running backs 2, and linebacker and quarterback with 1 each.
- In addition to the 29 players having made their first-ever collegiate start this season, 26 others have seen action for the first time, bringing the total number of players making their collegiate debut on the season is 55.

### YOUTH MOVEMENT

- McNeese is the third-youngest team in the FCS in terms of number of freshmen and sophomores on the current two-deep with 28.
- A total of 46 freshmen and sophomores have seen ample amount of playing time this season with six freshmen making starts.

### MICAH DAVEY MOVING UP TACKLING LIST

- Redshirt sophomore linebacker Micah Davey continues to pace the Cowboys and Southland Conference with 96 total tackles on the season, averaging 13.7 per game.
- Tied a career-high with 18 tackles against Alcorn State on Sept. 16.
- Those 18 tackles rank as the 3rd-most in the FCS this season.
- He has recorded 10 or more tackles in all 7 games on the season and 10 times in his career.
- He recorded his first-career 10-tackle game at Rice in the second game of the 2022 season.

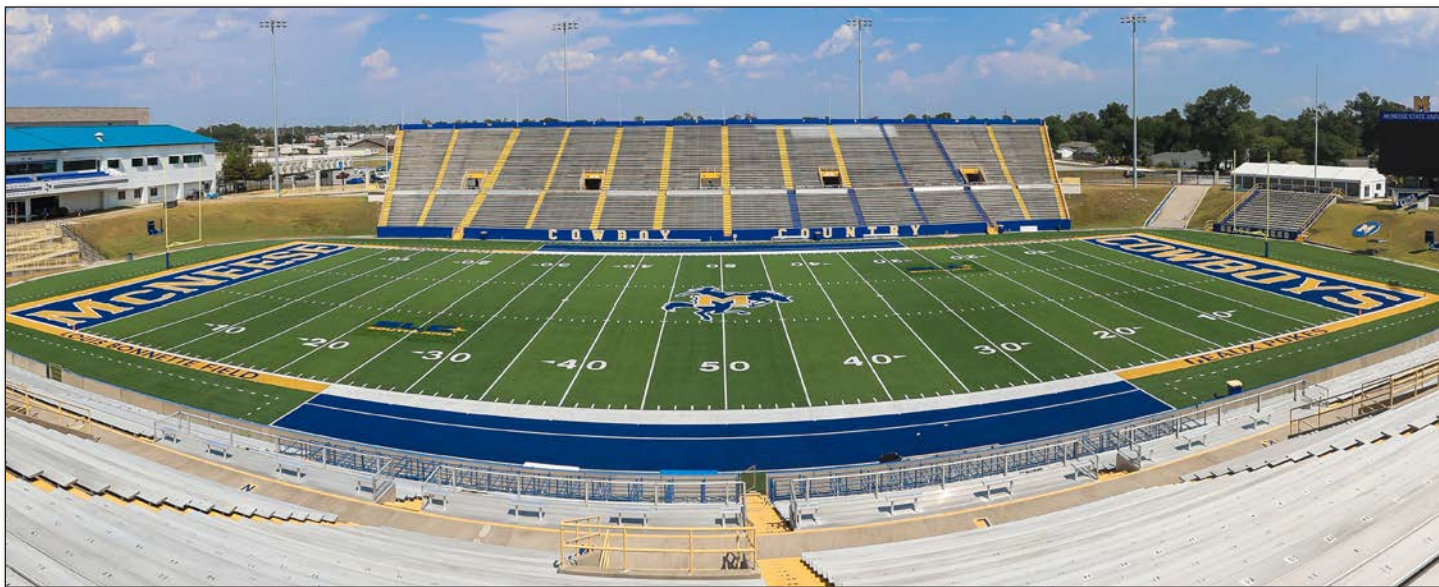
## COWBOYS vs. FCS RANKED OPPONENTS

Since moving to the Division I-AA/FCS ranks in 1982, McNeese has played a total of 134 games against ranked opponents and compiling a 56-77-1 record. Since 1990, McNeese is 55-59-1. Against Top 10 teams, the Cowboys are 23-41-1 and are 12-22 vs. Top 5 opponents. The Cowboys have played the No. 1 team in the country seven times, winning one. In the Cowboys' run for the 2002 national championship, McNeese went 8-1 vs. ranked opponents with the lone loss coming to Western Kentucky in the title game. In 1995, McNeese posted a 7-1 record against ranked teams with the only loss coming in the semifinals to Marshall.

## GAME NOTES: "THE HOLE"



### LOUIS BONNETTE FIELD AT COWBOY STADIUM

The 2023 season will mark the 58th year for McNeese to play in Cowboy Stadium, one of the most feared places to play for opponents.

Dubbed "The Hole" for its unique design and layout, the stadium was constructed in 1965 and renovated and expanded to a 17,410 seating capacity in 1975. Added in 1998 was a \$3 million, three tier press box. In 2005, a new scoreboard and sound system (\$1.1 million renovation) debuted. In 2008, seating increased to 17,610 with the completion of the renovated Jack Doland Field House that features 200 box seats (End Zone Club) that overlook the north endzone.

In 2018, a new Matrix Turf with Helix Technology artificial turf was installed, giving Louis Bonnette Field a new look. It was replaced in 2000 after damages caused by Hurricanes Laura and Delta.

The Cowboys also have a practice area (A.I. Ratcliff Field) that includes three football fields on the east side of the stadium.

Throughout its 57-year history, Cowboy Stadium has hosted several NFL Hall of Fame and other notable players such as Roger Staubach (Pensacola Navy, 1968), Terry Bradshaw (Louisiana Tech, 1967 and 1969), Jackie Smith (Northwestern State, 1960), Chad Pennington (Marshall, 1995), Daunte Culpepper (Central Florida, 1995), Mike Tomlin (William & Mary, 1993), just to name a few.

The Cowboys have had 15 unbeaten regular seasons at home with eight of those coming since the year 2000 (5-0 in 2017; 5-0 in 2015; 6-0 in 2009; 6-0 in 2007; 2-0 in 2005; 5-0 in 2003; 8-0 in 2002 and 5-0 in 2000).

Since 2000, McNeese is 94-36 (.799) in Cowboy Stadium.

#### MCNEESE IN OVERTIME GAMES

Since the NCAA instituted overtime in 1996, McNeese has played in seven overtime games, posting a 5-2 overall record.

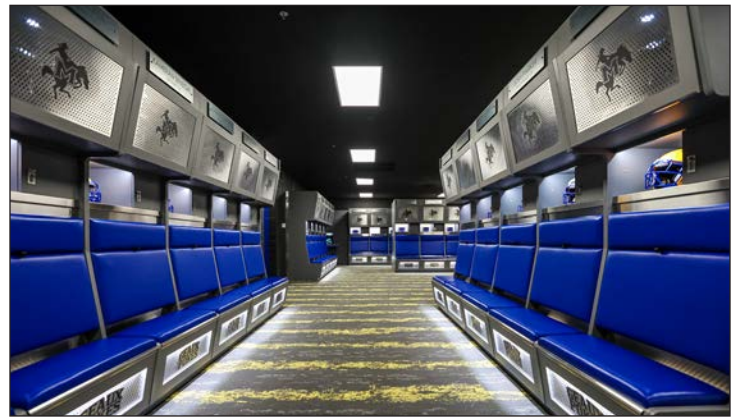
## GAME NOTES • FACILITY ENHANCEMENTS

### McNeese Football's New \$1.1 Million Locker Room

Construction began in early June on the new state-of-the-art locker room and was revealed to the players for the first time when they reported for fall camp in late July. The locker room includes 116 custom hybrid lockers, similar to what is housed in the Los Angeles Rams' locker room. The lockers are made from a gray nano technology laminate which is self-healing and scratch resistant on the sides, doors and footlocker face with upper and lower compartments.

Each locker includes stainless steel pull-out, tilt-down should pad and knee brace gear rack and tray with a fan drying system integrated to circulate air in pad compartment, forcing the air into the pads. The lockers also include a helmet fan drying system, electrical outlets with two USB charging ports, LED lights, lift-up head rest with fold down back rest system, footlocker box with digi lock capabilities.

In addition to the new lockers, the locker room received a new paint job and installation of a new sport traffic carpet. Also, the bathroom and shower area received a new overlay epoxy floor and ceiling repairs and paint.



### \$31 Million Press Box Construction Begins

McNeese State University broke ground on a new press box for Cowboy Stadium on Thursday, June 29. In 2020, Hurricanes Laura and Delta devastated Southwest Louisiana including the Cowboy Stadium press box.

The new facility boasts 25 suites, a 1,700-square-foot sky club and an open patio-type area. The top two levels extend goal line to goal line. Football operations, media, radio and television will be on the second level (former film deck).

Visitors to McNeese for sporting and other events added approximately \$4.3 million to the economy of Southwest Louisiana in 2021. Suites in the new press box will provide McNeese football fans with a premium venue for watching games with friends, family and business associates, drawing more visitors to the region. Sales for the suites will bring in millions of dollars for McNeese.

McNeese is the proud home to 15 NCAA Division 1 athletic teams. Last year, total attendance at McNeese ticketed sporting events was 132,225, of which 44,790 were for football as the Cowboys led the Southland Conference in attendance.

The construction is scheduled to be fully completed for the 2025 football season.

## HEAD COACH GARY GOFF

Gary Goff was announced as McNeese's 18th football head coach in school history on December 19, 2021 and formally introduced on Dec. 20 in front a packed Endzone Club Room full of McNeese faithful.

In his first season with the Cowboys, Goff's team produced the Southland Conference's Offensive Player of the Year in running back Deonta McMahon, who led the league and ranked No. 5 in the nation in rushing with 128.0 yards per game. As a team, McNeese led the league and ranked 19th in the nation with 200.5 yards rushing per contest.

Following a rough start to the season, McNeese ended the year with three straight wins and lost the previous two games by a combined six points.

Goff came to McNeese after he led Valdosta State to the program's sixth NCAA National Championship appearance on Dec. 18, 2021 and back-to-back Gulf South Conference titles in his two playing seasons as head coach in Tiptonville (three overall seasons).

He finished his VSU career with a 22-3 record. He also coached eight seasons at Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, and is 60-53 in 10 playing seasons of coaching.

The Blazers finished the 2021 season with a 12-2 record overall, falling in the NCAA Division II National Title to Ferris State. VSU went 6-1 in the Gulf South Conference, sharing the league title with West Florida. Goff was named GSC Coach of the Year for the second time in 2021, as he was Co-GSC Coach of the Year in 2019.

In 2021, the Blazers placed 17 players on the All-GSC team including nine on the first unit. Valdosta led the NCAA in total offense for the season, averaging 527.2 yards per game, was second in rushing (267.0, 5th in NCAA) and third in passing (260.2, 30th in NCAA).

Defensively, the Blazers led the league in passing defense (159.9), sixth in rushing defense (188.3) and third in total defense (348.2). Additionally, VSU averaged 43.2 points per game (2nd in the GSC, 5th NCAA) while allowing just 22.7 points to rank third in the conference.

His team included three Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCCA) All-Americans - offensive lineman Ralph Singleton (1st team), linebacker Nick Moss (1st team), and defensive lineman Brian Williams (2nd team). Singleton also garnered first team AP All-America honors while Moss earned AP second team honors.

VSU also ranked No. 3 in the NCAA with 320 first downs made, seventh with four defensive TDs scored, seventh in 3rd-down conversion percentage (.500), fourth in red-zone offense percentage (.929), first in sacks allowed per game (0.15), and ninth in tackles for loss allowed per game (3.31).

In 2019 he led the Blazers to a season of 10-1 and 8-0 in Gulf South Conference play, earning Gulf South Conference Co-Coach of the Year honors. Goff continued the outstanding tradition of VSU football as the Blazers won their first ten games of the season, ranked No. 1 nationally throughout the regular season and a berth in the second round of the NCAA Division II Football playoffs.

Goff coached a league-best 13 All-GSC selections in 2019 and GSC Offensive Player of the Year Rogan Wells. Wells earned American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) All-America honors, was a finalist for the prestigious Harlon Hill Trophy and recently named the GSC Offensive Player of the Decade. Along with Wells, senior offensive linemen Adonis Sealey and Brandon Kemp earned All-America honors. Junior long snapper Pippin Davis was named Second Team Academic All-America® by CoSIDA. Kemp signed an undrafted free agent contract with the Tennessee Titans of the NFL in April.

Under Goff's guidance, the Blazers continued their outstanding offensive play as



the team finished second nationally in third down conversion percentage at a .528 clip. The Blazers were fourth nationally in completion percentage (.701), while finishing 14th nationally in first downs gained (276). VSU was 11th nationally in rushing offense at 260.2 yards on the ground per game, while it was 12th nationally in passing efficiency at 162.12. VSU finished third nationally in total offense at 522.1 yards per game, while finish-

ing 20th nationally in scoring offense at 38.9 points per game.

The Blazers also were outstanding on defense as the team was 32nd nationally in total defense, allowing 311.5 yards per game and held teams to a 111.71 passing efficiency for 33rd nationally out of 166 NCAA Division II programs. The Blazer defense held teams to 124.4 yards per game on the ground for 44th nationally. The opposition scored just 18.5 points per game on the Blazers for 23rd nationally and tops in the conference.

Goff arrived at VSU from NCAA Division II Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, where he was the head coach of the Dragons from 2011-18. In 2018, Goff had his best season at Tiffin as he guided the Dragons to a 9-2 campaign and a 6-2 record in the Great Midwest Conference as the team began the season 9-0. Tiffin was ranked as high as No. 15 in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 in 2018. Goff had 16 Dragons named to G-MAC All-Conference teams in 2018.

In 2016, Goff guided the Dragons to their first winning season since the 2006 season as the team went 8-3 with Goff earning Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Coach of the Year honors, the first in program history. He had one of the top offenses in country in 2016 averaging 434.5 yards per game, while his quarterback Antonio Pipkin was a Harlon Hill nominee and was named GLIAC Player of the Year. Pipkin tallied seven Tiffin career records and four GLIAC records, ranking 13th all-time in career total offense, 19th in total offense per game, 27th in career passing yards, and is only the third quarterback at the Division II level to ever accumulate at least 2,000 rushing yards and throw for 10,000 passing yards in a career. That season, Goff also had the program's first Academic All-American as 74 players finished the 2016 fall semester with a 3.0 grade point average or higher.

Prior to Goff's arrival in 2011, Tiffin University was a combined 2-31 from 2008-2010.

Goff joined Tiffin after a highly successful 2010 season at West Virginia Wesleyan where he was the offensive coordinator and quarterback coach. There, he helped guide the team to a massive turnaround as it was 2-8 in 2009 and went 9-2 in 2010, tying for the most wins in school history. The team was ranked nationally for the first time and broke 12 offensive school records.

Before West Virginia Wesleyan, Goff coached at Division I Princeton University where he was the pass game coordinator and receivers coach. He also served as co-offensive coordinator and receivers coach at New Mexico State for four seasons as he helped lead the team to second nationally in passing offense and total offense.

The Aggies broke 21 offensive school records, while ranking 15th nationally in scoring offense. Goff coached the nation's top receiver, two-time All-America selection Chris Williams, who signed with the Cleveland Browns.

Goff, who has served as offensive coordinator for three teams, also was offensive coordinator at Iowa Wesleyan University (2002-03) and coached at Southeastern Louisiana, helping it to lead the nation in total offense. He also had coaching stints at Woodstock (Ga.) High School and Cherokee (Ga.) High School.

He played for former Blazer head coach Hal Mumme and former offensive coordinator Mike Leach at Valdosta State and graduated in 1996. During his time in Tipton, Goff helped lead the Blazers to their first Gulf South Conference title in 1996 and the first two NCAA playoff seasons in program history in 1994 and 1996. Goff began as a walk-on for the Blazers in the spring of 1993 after transferring to VSU from the University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D. He then earned a scholarship culminating in being named a team captain in 1996. Goff and the Blazers went 35-13 during his career at VSU under Mumme earning letters in 1995 and 1996. While at VSU, Goff and his teammates helped lay the foundation for where the VSU football program is today.

Goff earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from VSU and holds a master's degree from Tiffin. Goff is a native of Picayune, Miss., and he and his wife Tifanie have two children, Tyler and Audrey. Tyler is a freshman receiver for the Cowboys this season.
