KICK-OFF NOTES

McNEESE-NSU FINALLY MEET UP AFTER 2-YEAR HIATUS

- McNeese and Northwestern State will meet up for the first time since the 2021 season when the Cowboys visit the Demons on Saturday afternoon.
- The two teams last played in the 2021 season when they faced-off twice - Oct. 16 at NSU (35-17 McNeese win) and a month later on Nov. 20 (24-20 NSU win) at McNeese.
- The game in 2022 was canceled due to the Southland Conference readjusting the slate with the addition of Lamar to the league, and last season, the game, which was McNeese's homecoming, was canceled after NSU halted its season following a team tragedy.
- At 5-5, the Cowboys have the most wins in Gary Goff's three years at the helm, and most since the 2019 season (7-5)
- McNeese QB Kamden Sixkiller will get his fifth start of the season and fourth straight... it'll also be his seventh career start.
- The redshirt freshman picked up his first win as a starting in the team's last outing, 31-3 over East Texas A&M on Nov. 2.
- The 31 points scored against ETAM were the most by the Cowboys in conference play since scoring 35 at Nicholls on Oct. 22, 2022.
- Recorded 400 yards of offense in two straight games (401 at Nicholls and 401 vs. ETAM).

GAMEDAY BULLETS

- P Finn Lappin has four punts that have soared 60 yards or longer and 19 punts of 50 or more yards... last season the Cowboys had 5 punts of 50 yards or more.
- RB Joshon Barbie has rushed for 100 yards or more in two straight games and is coming off a 124-yard outing against East Texas A&M.
- Barbie has rushed for all 7 of his TDs on the season in the last 6 games.
- K Tyler Larco has made at least one FG in four straight games and is 7-7 during that span.
- Larco kicked a career-long 47-yard FG at Nicholls on Oct. 26... it's the 3rd-longest made FG in the Southland Conference this season.

GAME #11 GAME NOTES: AT NORTHWESTERN STATE

SERIES HISTORY

- McNeese and Northwestern State will be meeting for the 73rd time on Saturday with the Cowboys holding down a 49-22-1 lead in the series.
- The two teams played every year from 1951-2021
- The Demons won the last time the two met by a score of 24-20 in the 2021 season finale in Lake Charles.
- McNeese has won 17 of the last 20 meetings and has beaten the Demons in 8 of the last 10 games played in Turpin Stadium.
- NSU's win in Lake Charles in 2021 was the first for the Demons in Cowboy Stadium since 1988, snapping a 15-game winning streak for McNeese.

LAST TIME vs. THE DEMONS

- McNeese scored the first 7 points of the game but NSU responded with 17 unanswered to take a 17-7 lead into the half.
- A 10-yard run by Deonta McMahon in the third quarter, his second of the game, cut the margin to 17-14 but NSU got a 4th-quarter touchdown pass by former QB Zach Clement (now QB at SLU) to go up 24-14.
- McNeese added its final TD with just over 4 minutes to play.

YUSEF LEAK, JOVONI BORBON NAMED MIDYEAR

ALL-AMERICAN BY PHIL STEELE

- McNeese defensive back Yusef Leak and long snapper Jovoni Borbon have been named to the 2024 FCS Mid-Season All-American Team by Phil Steele, both garnering fourth-team honors.
- Leak, a senior from Orlando who is in his first season as a Cowboy after transferring from the University of St. Thomas, leads the team and tied for 1st in the Southland Conference with 8 pass break-ups on the season.
- He's also sixth on the team with 37 total tackles, has one pass interception, a tackle for a loss, forced a fumble and has a recovery.
- Borbon has been one of the most reliable and accurate deep snappers in the FCS all season, snapping for both punts, field goals and extra points.

LECLAIR EXTENDS CONSECUTIVE STARTS STREAK

- All-conference lineman and senior Cole Leclair will make his 32nd consecutive start as a Cowboy against Commerce this weekend.
- In addition, he's started in 44 straight games in his college career.
- Leclair started all 14 games at Valdosta State before transferring to McNeese for the 2022 season.
- Leclair is second on the team with 659 snaps played.

GAME #11 GAME NOTES: AT NORTHWESTERN STATE

QB SIXKILLER TO GET 4TH STRAIGHT START

- Redshirt freshman quarterback Kamden Sixkiller has officially been named the starting QB for the Cowboys for the final three games due to previous starter Clifton McDowell opting to have surgery on an injured finger on his throwing hand.
- Sixkiller started the final two games of the 2023 season as a true freshman and has started four games this season, including the last three.
- On the year, he's completed 52.6 percent of his passes (80-152) for 889 yards with three touchdowns and five interceptions.
- He's thrown for 200 or more yards the last three of the last four games with 722 total during that span.
- He got the start at Texas A&M and completed 9 of 19 passes for 80 yards, a TD and two interceptions.
- He's also rushed for 138 yards on the season.

FINN-SANITY: LAPPIN NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST FOR FCS TOP FRESHMAN

- McNeese freshman punter Finn Lappin is one of 30 FCS freshmen to be named to the in-season watch list for the Stats Perform 2024 Jerry Rice Award which honors the FCS Freshman of the Year.
- Lappin is the only player on the list to represent the Southland Conference.
- Lappin currently leads the league and is ranked No. 4 in the FCS in with a 46.6 punting average.
- His current average is nearly three yards longer than the single-season school record of 43.8 (Alex Kjellsten, 2018; Don Stump, 1979) and is .1 yards off the SLC single-season record (46.7 by Joe Zema of UIW set in 2017).
- A native of Melbourne, Australia, Lappin has booted 19 punts that have gone for 50 yards or more on the season, 13 more than the Cowboys had all of last season.
- He's recorded four punts of 60 yards or more and has had 11 downed inside the 20-yard line.

GET THAT OUTTA HERE

- McNeese's defense has recorded 50 pass break-ups on the season, 24 more than all of the 2023 slate (26).
- Transfer CB Yusef Leak leads the team with 8 PBU's which also ranks No. 1 in the SLC.
- Levi Wyatt is 2nd with 7 PBU's while Boogsie Silver has 5 PBU's.
- The team school record for PBU's in a season is 85 which happened during the 2002 National Championship game run (15 games).
- The most PBU's in a regular season is 64 (2019).

TIGHT END APPRECIATION

- McNeese tight end Logan Mauldin has become one of the top tight end targets in the Southland Conference, ranking 2nd among all TEs with 13 catches (Sean Sallis of Commerce leads with 18 catches).
- The junior transfer from Coastal Carolina has been targeted 19 times this season, ranking as the 6th-most on the team.
- He hauled in a career-high five passes at Nicholls.

REVVED UP RUNNING GAME

- McNeese rushed for a season-high 367 yards against East Texas A&M two weeks ago in its last outing.
- That amount lifted the Cowboys to No. 1 in the league in rushing offense with a 185.6 average.
- It's the fourth time this season the Cowboys have rushed for 200 yards or more in a game and the fourth-most in school history.
- McNeese had two, 100-yard rushers in the game - Joshon Barbie (124) and Bryce Strong (career-high 121).
- Barbie has rushed for 100 yards or more in two straight games and is ranked 6th in the league with 598 rushing yards on the season.
- His 7 rushing TDs are tied as the 3rd-most in the league.

LB MICAH DAVEY CLIMBING TACKLES LIST

- After missing four games due to injured ribs suffered against Texas A&M, All-American linebacker Micah Davey has returned to form, averaging 11 tackles per game in his three games back.
- Coming off a 15-tackle contest against East Texas A&M, lifting his season total to a team-high 71 in six games played (11.8 per game average).
- He's made 291 tackles in his career, ranking 15th in the school's career record book, and needing just 9 more to become only the 14th player in school history to reach that milestone.

EXPLOSIVE PLAYS

- McNeese's offense has produced 149 plays that have gained 10 or more yards on the season.
- Included are 45 plays that have gained 20 or more yards.
- The most 10-plus yard plays in a game were 20 against Alcorn State (11 passing and 9 rushing).
- The Cowboys recorded 15 plays when rushing for 10 yards or more against East Texas A&M in the last outing.

Against Top 10 teams, the Cowboys are 23-41-1 and are 12-22 vs. Top 5 opponents. The Cowboys have played the No. 1 team in the country seven times, winning one. In the Cowboys' run for the 2002 national championship, McNeese went 8-1 vs. ranked opponents with the lone loss coming to Western Kentucky in the title game. In 1995, McNeese posted a 7-1 record against ranked teams with the only loss coming in the semifinals to Marshall.

Gary Goff was announced as McNeese's 18th football head coach in school history on December 19, 2021 and formally introduced on Dec. 20 in front a packed Endzone Club Room full of McNeese faithful.

Goff is entering his third season at the helm, which expects to bring the Cowboys back to their rightful place at the top of the Southland Conference with one of the strongest recruiting classes in the last 20 years.

Despite the 2023 season not going as planned, the Cowboys got a breakout season from sophomore linebacker Micah Davey, who was named an All-American by six different organizations, including first team honors by Walter Camp and the AFCA.

Davey also placed seventh in the voting for the Buck Buchanan Award which goes to the top defensive player in the FCS.

In his first season with the Cowboys, Goff's team produced the Southland Conference's Offensive Player of the Year in running back Deonta McMahon, who led the league and ranked No. 5 in the nation in rushing with 128.0 yards per game. As a team, McNeese led the league and ranked 19th in the nation with 200.5 yards rushing per contest.

Following a rough start to the season, McNeese ended the year with three straight wins and lost the previous two games by a combined six points.

Goff came to McNeese after he led Valdosta State to the program's sixth NCAA National Championship appearance on Dec. 18, 2021 and back-to-back Gulf South Conference titles in his two playing seasons as head coach in Tiletown (three overall seasons). He finished his VSU career with a 22-3 record. He also coached eight seasons at Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, and is 60-53 in 10 playing seasons of coaching.

The Blazers finished the 2021 season with a 12-2 record overall, falling in the NCAA Division II National Title to Ferris State. VSU went 6-1 in the Gulf South Conference, sharing the league title with West Florida. Goff was named GSC Coach of the Year for the second time in 2021, as he was Co-GSC Coach of the Year in 2019.

In 2021, the Blazers placed 17 players on the All-GSC team including nine on the first

unit. Valdosta led the NCAA in total offense for the season, averaging 527.2 yards per game, was second in rushing (267.0, 5th in NCAA) and third in passing (260.2, 30th in NCAA).

Defensively, the Blazers led the league in passing defense (159.9), sixth in rushing defense (188.3) and third in total defense (348.2). Additionally, VSU averaged 43.2 points per game (2nd in the GSC, 5th NCAA) while allowing just 22.7 points to rank third in the conference.

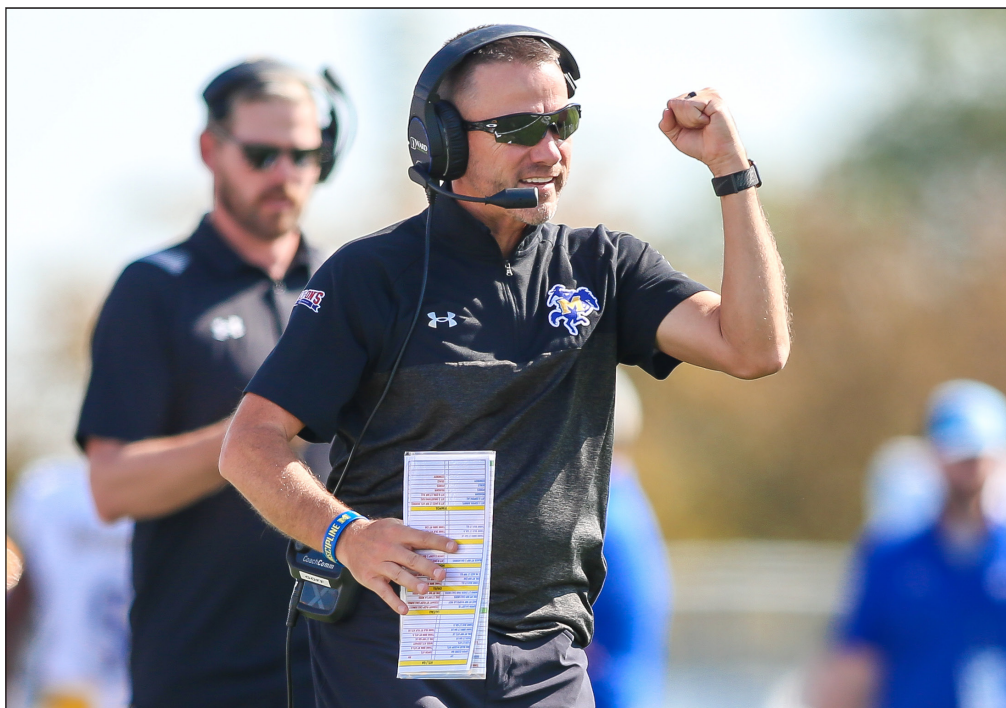
His team included three Division II Conference Commissioner's Association (D2CCCA) All-Americans - offensive lineman Ralph Singleton (1st team), linebacker Nick Moss (1st team), and defensive lineman Brian Williams (2nd team). Singleton also garnered first team AP All-America honors while Moss earned AP second team honors.

VSU also ranked No. 3 in the NCAA with 320 first downs made, seventh with four defensive TDs scored, seventh in 3rd-down conversion percentage (.500), fourth in red-zone offense percentage (.929), first in sacks allowed per game (0.15), and ninth in tackles for loss allowed per game (3.31).

In 2019 he led the Blazers to a season of 10-1 and 8-0 in Gulf South Conference play, earning Gulf South Conference Co-Coach of the Year honors. Goff continued the outstanding tradition of VSU football as the Blazers won their first ten games of the season, ranked No. 1 nationally throughout the regular season and a berth in the second round of the NCAA Division II Football playoffs.

Goff coached a league-best 13 All-GSC selections in 2019 and GSC Offensive Player

of the Year Rogan Wells. Wells earned American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) All-America honors, was a finalist for the prestigious Harlon Hill Trophy and recently named the GSC Offensive Player of the Decade. Along with Wells, senior offensive linemen Adonis Sealey and Brandon Kemp earned All-America honors. Junior long snapper Pippin Davis was named Second Team Academic All-America[®] by CoSIDA. Kemp signed an undraft-



ed free agent contract with the Tennessee Titans of the NFL in April.

Under Goff's guidance, the Blazers continued their outstanding offensive play as the team finished second nationally in third down conversion percentage at a .528 clip. The Blazers were fourth nationally in completion percentage (.701), while finishing 14th nationally in first downs gained (276). VSU was 11th nationally in rushing offense at 260.2 yards on the ground per game, while it was 12th nationally in passing efficiency at 162.12. VSU finished third nationally in total offense at 522.1 yards per game, while finishing 20th nationally in scoring offense at 38.9 points per game.

The Blazers also were outstanding on defense as the team was 32nd nationally in total defense, allowing 311.5 yards per game and held teams to a 111.71 passing efficiency for 33rd nationally out of 166 NCAA Division II programs. The Blazer defense held teams to 124.4 yards per game on the ground for 44th nationally. The opposition scored

just 18.5 points per game on the Blazers for 23rd nationally and tops in the conference. Goff arrived at VSU from NCAA Division II Tiffin University in Tiffin, Ohio, where he was the head coach of the Dragons from 2011-18. In 2018, Goff had his best season at Tiffin as he guided the Dragons to a 9-2 campaign and a 6-2 record in the Great Midwest Conference as the team began the season 9-0. Tiffin was ranked as high as No. 15 in the American Football Coaches Association Top 25 in 2018. Goff had 16 Dragons named to G-MAC All-Conference teams in 2018.

In 2016, Goff guided the Dragons to their first winning season since the 2006 season as the team went 8-3 with Goff earning Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) Coach of the Year honors, the first in program history. He had one of the top offenses in country in 2016 averaging 434.5 yards per game, while his quarterback Antonio Pipkin was a Harlon Hill nominee and was named GLIAC Player of the Year. Pipkin tallied seven Tiffin career records and four GLIAC records, ranking 13th all-time in career total offense, 19th in total offense per game, 27th in career passing yards, and is only the third quarterback at the Division II level to ever accumulate at least 2,000 rushing yards and throw for 10,000 passing yards in a career. That season, Goff also had the program's first Academic All-American as 74 players finished the 2016 fall semester with a 3.0 grade point average or higher.

Prior to Goff's arrival in 2011, Tiffin University was a combined 2-31 from 2008-2010.

Goff joined Tiffin after a highly successful 2010 season at West Virginia Wesleyan where he was the offensive coordinator and quarterback coach. There, he helped guide the team to a massive turnaround as it was 2-8 in 2009 and went 9-2 in 2010, tying for the most wins in school history. The team was ranked nationally for the first time and broke 12 offensive school records.

Before West Virginia Wesleyan, Goff coached at Division I Princeton University where he was the pass game coordinator and receivers coach. He also served as co-offensive coordinator and receivers coach at New Mexico State for four seasons as he helped lead the team to second nationally in passing offense and total offense.

The Aggies broke 21 offensive school records, while ranking 15th nationally in scoring offense. Goff coached the nation's top receiver, two-time All-America selection Chris Williams, who signed with the Cleveland Browns.

Goff, who has served as offensive coordinator for three teams, also was offensive coordinator at Iowa Wesleyan University (2002-03) and coached at Southeastern Louisiana, helping it to lead the nation in total offense. He also had coaching stints at Woodstock (Ga.) High School and Cherokee (Ga.) High School.

He played for former Blazer head coach Hal Mumme and former offensive coordinator Mike Leach at Valdosta State and graduated in 1996. During his time in Tipton, Goff helped lead the Blazers to their first Gulf South Conference title in 1996 and the first two NCAA playoff seasons in program history in 1994 and 1996. Goff began as a walk-on for the Blazers in the spring of 1993 after transferring to VSU from the University of Mary in Bismarck, N.D. He then earned a scholarship culminating in being named a team captain in 1996. Goff and the Blazers went 35-13 during his career at VSU under Mumme earning letters in 1995 and 1996. While at VSU, Goff and his teammates helped lay the foundation for where the VSU football program is today.

Goff earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from VSU and holds a master's degree from Tiffin. Goff is a native of Picayune, Miss., and he and his wife Tiffanie have two children, Tyler and Audrey. Tyler is a redshirt freshman wide receiver for the Cowboys.

The 2024 season will mark the 60th year for McNeese to play in Cowboy Stadium, one of the most feared places to play for opponents.

Dubbed "The Hole" for its unique design and layout, the stadium was constructed in 1965 and renovated and expanded to a 17,410 seating capacity in 1975. Added in 1998 was a \$3 million, three tier press box. In 2005, a new scoreboard and sound system (\$1.1 million renovation) debuted. In 2008, seating increased to 17,610 with the completion of the renovated Jack Doland Field House that features 200 box seats (End Zone Club) that overlook the north endzone.

In 2018, a new Matrix Turf with Helix Technology artificial turf was installed, giving Louis Bonnette Field a new look. It was replaced in 2020 after damages caused by Hurricanes Laura and Delta.

The Cowboys also have a practice area (A.I. Ratcliff Field) that includes three football fields on the east side of the stadium.

Now in its 60th season, Cowboy Stadium has hosted several NFL Hall of Fame and other notable players such as Roger Staubach (Pensacola Navy, 1968), Terry Bradshaw (Louisiana Tech, 1967 and 1969), Jackie Smith (Northwestern State, 1960), Fred Dean (Louisiana Tech, 1971 and 1973), Kurt Warner (Northern Iowa, 1992), Mike Tomlin (William & Mary, 1993), Chad Pennington (Marshall, 1995), Daunte Culpepper (Central Florida, 1995), Malcolm Butler (West Alabama, 2013), just to name a few.

The Cowboys have had 15 unbeaten regular seasons at home with eight of those coming since the year 2000 (5-0 in 2017; 5-0 in 2015; 6-0 in 2009; 6-0 in 2007; 2-0 in 2005; 5-0 in 2003; 8-0 in 2002 and 5-0 in 2000).

Since 2000, McNeese is 94-39 (.707) in Cowboy Stadium.

Since the NCAA instituted overtime in 1996, McNeese has played in seven overtime games, posting a 5-2 overall record.
