Series Preview

- Dating back to 1971, McNeese holds an all-time series advantage over Southern 24-15-1, winning the last five meetings.
- When playing Southern on the road, McNeese is 6-4 in Baton Rouge.
- Poke Nation has plated 251 runs in the series, averaging 6.28 runs a game.
- When the teams met in March 2023, the Cowboys took a 12-5 victory.
- Of the last five games, three have been in Baton Rouge.

McNeese Notes

- The Cowboys had a stretch of winning eight of nine matchups, starting against New Mexico State through LCU before facing #2 Arkansas.
- Westenburg is second amongst the Southland in doubles and sits 16th in the nation with eight on the season.
- Braden Duhon owns the team's longest hitting streak at seven games.
- The blue and gold sit 38th in the nation with five triples, eight behind conference foe and national leader UIW at 13.
- The team's 32 doubles put them 69th at the highest level of collegiate baseball.
- Cooper Hext has reached base in 11 consecutive games this season.
- The Cowboys have earned at least six hits in 15 of 16 games this season.
- The Cowboys have 23 returners on the squad with 17 newcomers for the season.
- McNeese has made 11 straight appearances in the SLC Tournament, qualifying each year under the tutelage of Coach Hill.
- With nine appearances under his belt, Kainin Morrow sits tied for sixth in the nation for most pitching appearances.
- Morrow is further 13th in the nation and atop the conference in victories, collecting three on the mound.
- JT Moeller holds the 22nd best strikeout-to-walk ration in the nation at 10.00.
- Cameron LeJeune owns the 15th most saves in D1 baseball at three on the season.
- The NCAA ranks McNeese as having the second-hardest strength of schedule in the nation.

Scouting the Opponent

- Southern is coming off a series loss to Alabama State 2-1.
- Southern has defeated Alcorn (1), Alabama State (2), and Dillard University (1) thus far this season.
- Nicholls outscored the Jaguars 31-5 through a three-game series to kick off March.
- Kyle Radcliffe leads the team with a .364 average, playing all 13 games on the season and starting 12.
- KJ White is behind him, batting .360 on the season through eight starts and 10 appearances.

Last Time Out

- McNeese faced the second-ranked Razorbacks of Arkansas in a three game series.
- The Razorbacks took all three games, winning 3-1, 11-1 (8), 18-5 (7).
- By holding Arkansas to a two-run game in the series opener, McNeese held a Top 5 opponent to the second-closest game in program history. The best was a 2-1 loss to #1 LSU.
- Easton Dowell and Braden Duhon had a team-leading four hits each against Arkansas over the weekend.

Season Hits

- McNeese swept New Mexico State 4-0 during its home opening weekend and Prairie View a week later 3-0.
- Excluding the games against McNeese, the Cowboys' Division I opponents have a combined record of 57-21 for a winning percentage of .731.
- Parker Stroh hit his first home run of the season against Arkansas.
- Hitting 2-for-4 against LCU, Cole Plowman became the 10th unique Cowboy to earn a multi-hit game this season.
- After batting .579 with six doubles and a home run for eight RBIs through four games, Conner Westenburg was named the SLC Hitter of the Week during the second week of the season. His slugging percentage reached 1.053 during the same timespan.
- Over the course of the season, the Pokes are scheduled to face three teams ranked in the Top 10 in the nation by D1Baseball. (Texas A&M 8, Arkansas 2, LSU 3)
- The three ranked opponents is the most since 2016 when the Cowboys faced four, playing Houston, UL-Lafayette, LSU, and Lamar.

One of the Deans of the coaching fraternity in the Southland Conference, Justin Hill enters 11th season at the helm of the McNeese Cowboys in 2024. He recently had a three-peat in SLC championship seasons from 2019-21, claiming four Southland titles in six seasons.

During the 2023 campaign, Hill recorded his 300th victory on May 23, surpassing Tony Robichaux's former mark of 263 set on May 20, 2022. Entering the 2024 season with 301 all-time wins, Hill is looking to add more hardware to a trophy case that already includes two SLC Coach of the Year Awards (2017, 2022), two SLC Tournament Championships (2019, 2021) and two SLC regular season titles (2017, 2022).

His teams have won 30 or more games in eight of his 10 years with one season, 2020, cut short due to the Covid pandemic. Most recently, Hill guided the Cowboys to a 35 win season in 2023. In his first season in 2014, Hill guided the Cowboys to 30 wins and followed that up with three more 30-win seasons to become the first coach in school history to win at least 30 games in his first four seasons. By doing so, he became the second-fastest coach in program history to tally 60+ wins in his first two seasons.

Hill quickly made a name for himself in his initial season after becoming the first head coach since Mike Bianco in 1998 to win 30 or more games in his first season as the skipper for the Cowboys. He also was the first coach since Todd Butler to win in his debut, defeating Chicago State. Five school records, six NCAA records and one Southland Conference record were either tied or broken by Hill's first McNeese team.

Throughout his young career, Hill has coached or recruited 38 players that have gone on to play in the professional ranks (31 drafted and 5 signing as free agents), 12 All-Americans, two conference players of the year, a conference hitter of the year, two NCBWA Stoppers of the Year, a conference pitcher of the year, relief pitcher of the year, freshman of the year, conference tournament MVP, and a Louisiana pitcher of the year.

Hill's accomplishments at McNeese include defeating six nationally-ranked opponents during his tenure as skipper. One notable victory came in the form of a 7-0 shutout of Hill's alma matter at LSU in Baton Rouge. Spanning from 2019-2022, he oversaw a 12-game win streak in the Southland Conference Tournament, going 4-0 in in 2019 and 2021 (no 2020 tournament) before winning four more in the 2022 championships before falling to the SLC Tournament Champion Southeastern.

Prior to joining the Pokes, Hill made stops at West Monroe High School as an assistant, Northwestern State, LSU, Sam Houston State, Southeastern, and UL-Monroe before making his head coaching debut.

Hill began his playing career at Mississippi Delta Community College before transferring to Bossier Parish Community College. During his playing days, Hill pitched at LSU for the legendary Skip Bertman. A two-year letterwinner and academic All-SEC performer in 2001, Hill was also part of the Tigers' 2001 and 2002 NCAA Regional Championship teams. Hill appeared in 19 games in his final season at LSU, throwing 19 innings while compiling a 1-1 record with two saves and 27 strikeouts before a shoulder injury ended his season.

Hill has learned from some of the best head coaches in college baseball, including legendary coaches Skip Bertman and Mark Johnson, former Southeastern Louisiana head coach Jay Artigues, and Mitch Gaspard.

The West Monroe native graduated from LSU in 2002 and earned his master's degree from Northwestern State in 2005. Hill is married to the former Melissa Rawls. The couple has two daughters Lily and Rylie.
