» UNT is coming off the most successful season in program history. Last year, the Mean Green won a program record 31 games, tied the program record for conference wins with 16 and won the 2023 NIT championship.

» UNT is now led by first-year head coach Ross Hodge who was elevated to the position following last season. Hodge was UNT's associate head coach for all six seasons prior to being promoted.

» In each of the previous two seasons the Mean Green led the nation in scoring defense. They enter Sunday with the nation's No. 4 scoring defense (58.7).

» Since the start of the 2021-22 season, North Texas has the nation's 10th-best overall combined winning percentage (.772), FAU has the 12th-best winning percentage since 2021-22 (.753).

» UNT returns three starters from its NIT championship team, however, only returned 30 percent of its scoring. North Texas' top three scorers from last year are gone and five of their top seven scorers are gone. Aaron Scott is UNT's top returning scoring. The junior averaged 7.0 ppg last season.

» UNT defeated Metplex rival SMU at home on Thursday, 68-66. It was the first time the two schools played since 2002. UNT enters Sunday having won seven of its last eight games.

» Senior point guard Rubin Jones enters Sunday one win shy of becoming the winningest player in program history. Over his 3+ years he has won 86 games at UNT, led the Mean Green to two conference championships, an NCAA Tournament appearance and win and a NIT championship.

» UNT is off to a 5-1 start in conference. It is the third time in the last four years they've started league play 5-1. The last time they were 6-1 in conference was two years.

» North Texas on Sunday is looking for its first ranked road win since Feb. 27, 1971 when they won at No. 15 Louisville, 79-73. UNT has lost 36 straight to AP Top 25 opponents on the road.

While NFL Hall of Famer and North Texas Athletic Hall of Famer (1981) Joe Greene is one of the most beloved alums (1969) and most successful ones too, Joe Greene's nickname "Mean Joe Greene" is not how we got our nickname. It is a coincidence. Notice the difference in spelling in "Greene"

Our nickname began around when Greene was a student-athlete at North Texas in the late 1960s, however, it was in reference to the stout defense and team, which of course wore green uniforms. Joe Greene didn't earn his nickname until his professional playing career with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

Greene remains a constant presence on campus.

ROSS HODGE

Head Coach
1st Season As Head Coach
7th Season At UNT Overall



Ross Hodge was named North Texas' 19th head men's basketball coach on April 2, 2023.

He was elevated to head coach after six seasons as the Mean Green's associate head coach under Grant McCasland. He began his tenure with UNT in March of 2017 when he and McCasland came to Denton together. In his six seasons at UNT, Hodge has helped lead the Mean Green to a combined 135-65 overall record and 71-35 record in conference games. North Texas won the 2020 Conference USA regular season championship, 2021 Conference USA Tournament championship and 2022 Conference USA regular season title. In 2021, UNT earned an automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament where they received a program-best No. 13 seeding. In the first round they upset Purdue, 78-69 (ot), for the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament win.

In 2023, Hodge helped lead North Texas to the 2023 NIT championship. The program's first NIT title. In his first season in Denton Hodge helped guide the Mean Green to the 2018 CBI championship. Since arriving to Denton in 2017, UNT has gone 12-3 in NCAA national postseason games. They had never won a national postseason game prior to 2017.

Hodge is the mastermind of the Mean Green defense, which has been one of the nation's best over the last few years. In both 2021-22 and in 2022-23 UNT had the nation's No. 1 scoring defense holding opponents to 55.7 and 55.8 points per game, respectively. They are Conference USA's top two single-season scoring defenses in league history.

Prior to arriving in Denton, Hodge served as the associate head coach under McCasland at Arkansas State for the 2016-17 season. The Red Wolves made a 10-win improvement that season, which was the second-best turnaround in Division I basketball that year. Prior to Arkansas State, Hodge spent four seasons with head coach Larry Eustachy at Colorado State. Hodge served as the lead recruiter at Colorado State. During his time at Colorado State, the Rams advanced to postseason play twice, including the NCAA Tournament in 2013 where they reached the Round of 32 after defeating Missouri in the first round, 84-72. CSU lost to eventual national champ Louisville.

Hodge joined the Division I coaching ranks when he was hired by Eustachy as an assistant coach at Southern Miss prior to the 2011-12 season. The Golden Eagles posted a 25-9 record and received an at-large berth in the NCAA Tournament as an eighth seed.

From 2006-11 Hodge was one of the nation's top junior college head coaches compiling a 146-24 (.858) overall record with stops at Paris JC and Midland College.

Hodge guided Midland to a 63-7 (.900) overall record in his two seasons at the helm of the Chaparrals (2009-11). Hodge took over the Midland head coaching job after McCasland left to be head coach at Midwestern St. Hodge saw his 2010-11 squad post a 33-4 record while winning the Western Junior College Athletics Conference Title, the Region V Tournament championship and advance to the NJCAA Championship game.

In 2009-10 Hodge led Midland College to their best start in program history (26-0) and an appearance in the Region V Tournament title game. Prior to taking the Midland job, Hodge spent four years at Paris JC with the last three as its head coach. Hodge led the Dragons to a 83-17 (.830) record.

The following season, Hodge earned Region 14 Coach of the Year honors after his team won the Region 14 Tournament and finished eighth in the NJCAA Tournament.

Between 2003 and 2005 Hodge served as the assistant men's basketball coach at Texas A&M University-Commerce, where he helped the Lions to the 2004-05 Lone Star Conference Championship, and a spot in the NCAA Division II Sweet 16.

Hodge was a two-year starter at Paris Junior College. He finished his playing career at Texas A&M-Commerce. He led the nation in assists as a senior. Hodge is a native of Dallas, Texas. He and his wife, Shelly, have two children

UNT VS. FAU

» Sunday will be the 23rd all-time meeting between North Texas and Florida Atlantic. North Texas has won 14 of the previous 22 all-time meetings. Florida Atlantic has won two in a row over the Mean Green and five of the last seven meetings. UNT won seven in a row over the Owls between 2013 and 2018.

» Last year in Conference USA the Owls beat the Mean Green twice, each time by four points.

» In their most recent matchup, which was in Boca Raton, UNT trailed by two points in the final seconds. Former UNT guard Tylor Perry missed the go-ahead 3-pointer with nine seconds remaining. UNT led by as many as six in the second half of that contest.

» This time last year, FAU and UNT had already played each other twice. They played on Dec. 29 in Denton and then again on Jan. 14 in Boca Raton.

» North Texas head coach Ross Hodge and Florida Atlantic head coach Dusty May are close friends and talk regularly.

» UNT newcomer John Buggs III came to the Mean Green from UTSA where he also played versus FAU twice last season. Buggs scored 10 points and made a pair of 3-pointers at FAU last year. They lost 106-66.

» The most points an active UNT player has scored versus Florida Atlantic is Aaron Scott's 14 points last season at FAU. Scott scored his 14 points on 6-of-10 shooting and was 2-of-4 from deep.

CLOSING IN ON WINNINGEST PLAYER

» North Texas senior Rubin Jones enters Sunday just one win shy of becoming the winningest four-year player in program history. The guard has helped lead the Mean Green to so far 86 wins in his 3+ seasons in Denton. This includes his freshman season (2020-21) when they were limited to just 22 regular season games due to games being canceled, because of COVID. After UNT's win over SMU on Thursday he tied 2011 graduates Josh White, Tristan Thompson and Kedrick Hogans as the program's winningest UNT players ever. In high school at Jack Yates HS (Houston), Jones won 89% of all his games.

HOLDING OPPONENTS TO SEASON LOWS

» UNT has held three of its six conference opponents to season low scoring outputs.

» As of Saturday, six of UNT's 18 opponents this season respective lowest scoring outputs are against UNT: ECU, Temple, Tulane, UT Arlington, Towson & St. John's.

BACK FROM INJURY

» Thursday in North Texas' 68-66 win versus SMU, North Texas starting guard Rubin Jones and John Buggs III returned from injuries. Buggs had missed the previous five games to a shoulder injury and Jones had missed the previous three games to a hamstring injury. Jones returned to the starting lineup. Buggs, who had started every game prior to his injury, came off the bench on Thursday versus SMU.

» Buggs scored 12 points versus SMU and was 4-of-4 from deep. He made two clutch 3-pointers in the final four minutes. Jones had six points and four assists in 20 minutes of action.

PLAYER TO WATCH: RUBIN JONES

North Texas' point guard and captain Rubin Jones is currently averaging 11.7 points, 3.8 assists and 3.0 rebounds per game. Jones is widely thought of as one of the best on-ball defenders in the country by metrics and outlets. The reigning CUSA All-Defensive honoree is holding opponents to making less than 22 percent of 3-point attempts when guarded by him over the last two years (per Snyergy). Head coach Ross Hodge has stated he feels most comfortable when Jones is on the floor.

REIGNING NIT CHAMPIONS

» North Texas won the 2023 NIT championship last year. They defeated UAB in the title game in Las Vegas, 68-61. It was the program's first NIT championship in just its second-ever appearance.

BEST IN THE NATION

» UNT led the nation in scoring defense in each of the previous two seasons. In 2021-22 the Mean Green held their opponents to 55.7 points per game. Last year the Mean Green held their opponents to 55.8 points per game. Since 2013, only three different teams have led the nation in scoring defense: Virginia (7x), North Texas (2x) and Wichita St. (1x).

» Entering Sunday, North Texas is holding opponents to 58.7 points per game, which ranks 4th in the country and first among AAC teams.

PROGRAM RECORD VICTORIES

» North Texas won a program record 31 games last year. The previous record was 25 set by the 2021-22 team. The Mean Green were one of 11 teams last year to win 30+ games. UNT finished the year with a .816 winning percentage, which was the 10th highest in the nation. North Texas won 16 league games last year, which tied the program record.

HIGHEST NET/RPI RANKING

» After the conclusion of last season, UNT earned a No. 30 NET ranking. It's the highest the Mean Green have ever finished a season ranked in the NET or RPI in program history. They enter Sunday ranked 74 in the NET this season.

SEVEN NEWCOMERS

» Seven of North Texas' 14 players on its roster this season are newcomers. It's the most newcomers they've had in a single season since 2015.

» Of UNT's nine regular contributors, five are newcomers.

NEW CONFERENCE

» On July 1, 2023, North Texas Athletics moved to the American Athletic Conference after 10 seasons in Conference USA. In addition to UNT, UAB, Charlotte, FAU, Rice and UTSA moved from CUSA to the AAC this summer. North Texas had won two of the last four men's basketball regular season titles in CUSA in addition to winning the 2021 CUSA Tournament title.

» North Texas enters Sunday 5-1 in the AAC this season and having won 15 of its last 17 conference games dating back to last year in the CUSA.

NEW HEAD COACH

» Immediately following the conclusion of last season, then head coach Grant McCasland took the head coach job at Texas Tech. Two days later, UNT elevated associate head coach Ross Hodge to replace McCasland. Hodge and McCasland got to UNT together in 2017 and Hodge had been his right-hand man. This is Hodge's first NCAA head coaching job. He was a JC head coach from 2006-11. Hodge has been the mastermind of the UNT defense that has been one of the best in the nation. The only other UNT assistant coach who remains from the McCasland era is Andre Shaw.

DEFENSE TRAVELS

» In games played on the road, UNT's defense over the last three seasons is holding opponents to 58.7 points per game (27 games).

» No other program in the country is holding opponents to less than 62 points per game on the road over the last three years.

» This season, North Texas' defense is giving up 61.5 points per road game but has only played four true road games.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 60

» Since 2020, North Texas has held an opponent to 59 points or fewer 69 times, which is the second-most in the nation during that timespan.

DELIBERATE TEMPO

» UNT enters Sunday averaging 60.7 possessions/40 mins this season. That's the most deliberate tempo in the country.

» UNT has had the nation's most deliberate tempo in each of the previous two seasons. Last year, the Mean Green averaged 59.1 possessions/40 mins

» While yes North Texas' offense is deliberate, these slower numbers are also because of how long the Mean Green defend. On average this season the Mean Green defend for 18.1 seconds per possession. That's the 33rd longest average defensive possession in the nation.

REPLACING A LOT OF SCORING

» North Texas only returned 30 percent of its scoring from last year. Five of its top seven scorers are gone including its top three scorers. Aaron Scott is UNT's top returning scorer. He averaged 7.0 points per game last season. Scott and Rubin Jones are the only returners who scored over 100 points last season for the Mean Green.

» This year five of UNT's top seven average per game scorers are newcomers.

152 CAREER GAMES PLAYED

» North Texas senior Robert Allen has played in 152 career games entering Saturday. That's the third-most in the nation by an active player.

» On Thursday versus SMU, North Texas missed a season-high 11 free throws and was 8-of-19 (.421) at the line.

» The poor free throw shooting came out of no where as UNT entered Thursday as the AAC's top free throw shooting team at 75.3 percent.

» The 11 missed free throws are the most by a UNT team in a game in two years.

SEASON HIGH ASSISTS

» On Thursday vs SMU, UNT had a season-high 16 assists. They had 10 assists in the first half of the game. They had more assists at the first media timeout (4) on Thursday than they had in the entire game at Charlotte (2), which they lost 56-44.

WHEN UNT DISTRUBTES IT WINS

» In all 12 of UNT's wins they have had 10 or more assists.

» In all six of UNT's losses they have had less than 10 assists.

THE SUPER PIT 50TH ANNIVERSARY

This season marks the 50th anniversary of the opening of the UNT Super Pit. The first game played at the Super Pit was on Tuesday Dec. 4, 1973. The Mean Green defeated TCU in the opening game 109-93. North Texas' Tony Wright scored the first field goal and Bobby Iverson had a magnificent performance as he scored 30 points and grabbed 16 rebounds to lead his team to victory. UNT's head coach was Gene Robbins and TCU's head coach was Johnny Swain.



GAME WINNER

» North Texas beat ECU on Jan. 17 on a full-court inbound pass from Aaron Scott to Robert Allen who would lay in the go-ahead basket with 1.3 seconds to go. The assist from Scott was UNT's 10th of the game (see previous note on 10+ assists).

» Aaron Scott entered the top in program history for career blocks on Wednesday.

FINDING HIS SHOOTING TOUCH

» John Buggs III has made 12 of his last 18 (.667) 3-point attempts. Prior to this stretch, the 3-point specialist had made just 15 total 3-pointers on the year and was shooting just 33.3 percent from deep.

» Coach Hodge has stated he believes Buggs similar to the other newcomers is learning how to shoot while also defending so hard.

» Buggs was 4-of-4 from deep on Thursday versus SMU.

» Buggs has made exactly four 3-pointers in each of his last three games played and scored 12 points in each of the games.

FIRST HALF VS SECOND HALF

» In the first half of games, North Texas is shooting 45.8 percent from the field. But in the second half of games UNT is shooting just 39.9 percent from the field.

» The most glaring difference between halves, though, is UNT's three-point shooting. In the first half of games, North Texas is shooting a blistering 43.4 percent from deep. But in the second half of games they are shooting just 26.3 percent from deep.

» North Texas is outscoring opponents in the first half of games on average by 7.4 points. However, in the second half of games they are only outscoring opponents on average by a much tighter 1.1 points.

» North Texas' assist/turnover ratio in the first half of games is 1.1. North Texas' assist/turnover ratio in the second half of games is 0.7.

» Head coach Ross Hodge has stated he believes all of this is because many of the newcomers took time getting familiar with having to work so hard on the defensive end and are getting familiar with playing that style.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDERS

» Robert Allen and Moulaye Sissoko are two of the best offensive rebounders in the country. Allen grabs 19.6 percent of all possible offensive rebounds when he is on the floor, which ranks 2nd in the nation. Sissoko grabs 16.9 percent of all possible offensive rebounds when on the floor, which ranks 12th in the nation.

» UNT is the only team in the country that has two players that rank in the top 50 in offensive rebounding percentage.

ALSO GREAT AT DEFENSIVE REBOUNDING

» While offensive rebounding is generally thought of as more impressive, Robert Allen is also one of the nation's top defensive rebounders in addition to his offensive rebounding skills. Allen grabs 24.4 percent of all possible defensive rebounds while on the floor, which ranks 50th in the nation.

THE BEST COMING OFF THE BENCH

» North Texas big man Robert Allen has come off the bench in each of UNT's 18 games this season. He leads the nation in total rebounds by a reserve (150).

MUCH IMPROVED FREE THROW SHOOTER

» UNT junior wing Aaron Scott enters Sunday as one of North Texas' leading free throw shooters at 83.3 percent (35-42). Entering this season, Scott was shooting just 66.6 percent for his career at the line.

» In the second half of games this year, Aaron Scott is shooting 95.2 percent at the free throw line. He has missed just one second half free throw all year (20-21).

SINCE BEING INSERTED IN STARTING 5

» With UNT's injuries, Jason Edwards has started the last six games after coming off the bench in every game prior. Since being inserted in the starting lineup, Edwards is averaging 20.5 ppg and shooting 42.9 percent from the floor (42-98). He has scored 15+ points in five of the six games.

HELLO RONDEL WALKER

» On Dec. 14 the NCAA announced that two-time transfers for winter sports would be immediately eligible without a waiver. Thus North Texas' Rondel Walker is now available. He made his Mean Green debut on Dec. 23 with seven points in just 14 minutes of action. He also had three rebounds and two steals.

» Walker began his college career in 2020 at Oklahoma State where he helped lead the Cowboys to the NCAA Tournament. He transferred to TCU in 2022 and again helped lead them to a NCAA Tournament. While at OSU, Walker was one of the most versatile defenders but also a threat to score. For example, he scored 20 points at Iowa State. Walker will have another year of eligibility next year too.

» Since Walker made his UNT debut on Dec. 23, the Mean Green are 7-1.

» Walker is childhood best friends with Detroit Pistons' guard and 2021 NBA first overall draft pick Cade Cunningham. They played AAU basketball together with the Texas Titans and then at Oklahoma St.

TOP 100 RECRUITS

» UNT guard CJ Noland was ranked by ESPN as the nation's No. 98 overall high school recruit in 2021 and Rondel Walker was the nation's No. 55 overall high school recruit in 2020. They are the first top 100 high school recruit to join the Mean Green since Tony Mitchell in 2011.

» This is the first time in program history UNT has had multiple top 100 high school recruits on the same team.

» Walker was the No. 2 ranked Oklahoma recruit in 2020 and also held offers from Kansas State and Virginia Tech in addition to Oklahoma State.

» Noland was the No. 7 ranked Texas recruit in 2021. As a senior, Noland led Waxahachie High School to a No. 1 state ranking. Noland was named all state after his senior season. Noland's dad Belvis Noland played college basketball at Kansas State from 1993-95 and averaged 10 points per game in Manhattan, Kansas.

NOT A SUPER TALL TEAM

» UNT this season doesn't feature a player who is 6-10 or taller. This is the first time in over a decade UNT haven't had a player on its roster listed at 6-10 or taller.

VOLUNTEER ON CHRISTMAS

» Rondel Walker's mom runs a nonprofit that helps the homeless in the Oklahoma City area. Walker and his mom spend every Christmas Day delivering backpacks full of clothes and toiletries to people in need.

CAREER HIGH FROM DEEP

» UNT's Aaron Scott has made 23 3-pointers so far this season. The junior had never made more than 20 in a season prior to this year.

» Scott enters Sunday just one 3-pointer away from 50 for his career.

» National publication *Field of 68* did an anonymous AAC head coaches poll and 13 of the 14 head coaches picked UNT as the league's "Sleeper Team."

BIG GUARD

» In addition to basketball, UNT guard CJ Noland played football at Waxahachie High School as a tight end. The 2021 graduate held a football scholarship offer from Baylor.

BLUE COLLAR TEAM

» Since Ross Hodge and former head coach Grant McCasland arrived to Denton in 2017, the Mean Green have been built on a blue collar mentality. Hodge, as well as McCasland, got their start at the junior college ranks and were some of the top coaches in the country. Now at UNT, Hodge has woven in that junior college DNA into the Mean Green to build one of the toughest programs in the country. Every year since 2017, UNT on average has had three starters who came from junior college. Some of their most notable players like 2020 conference player of the year Javion Hamlet and 2023 conference player of the year Tylor Perry all came up through junior college programs. Every single one of UNT's coaches this season has spent time as either a junior college or NCAA assistant.

INTERNATIONAL DREAM

» North Texas big man Moulaye Sissoko was born in Bamako, Mali. He grew up playing soccer in the capital city and never played basketball until he was 15 years old. He came to the United States as a 16-year-old by himself with one suitcase and no jacket. He knew absolutely no English but he had always dreamed of living the American Dream. He lived with a host family in Arkansas while attending a prep school. He is now fluent in English as well as three other languages. He is a practicing Muslim. During UNT's NIT championship run last season, Ramadan overlapped during the end of the tournament. Sissoko fasted during the day and despite not eating or drinking he averaged 8 points and 10 rebounds over the final three rounds. He is one of the most beloved teammates.

MALI NATIONAL TEAM

» This summer UNT big man Moulaye Sissoko played for his home country of Mali in the African Olympic qualifiers. Mali didn't advance past the group stage but they did defeat African power Nigeria in Lagos, Nigeria, 77-68. The win eliminated Nigeria from the 2024 Olympics. It will be the first time since 2008 that Nigeria missed an Olympics. Sissoko scored eight points and four rebounds in the win over Nigeria.

NORTH TEXAS GRADUATE

» Moulaye Sissoko on Dec. 15 graduated and received his UNT bachelor's degree in Applied Arts and Sciences.

BIG 12 ALL FRESHMAN

» UNT newcomer CJ Noland transferred to North Texas from Oklahoma where he played two seasons. After his freshman season Noland was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman team. That season the guard shot 53.6 percent from the floor (52-97) and 43.6 percent from deep (17-39).

NJCAA FIRST TEAM ALL AMERICAN

» North Texas newcomer Jason Edwards comes to the Mean Green as one of the top NJCAA recruits in the nation. Edwards was junior college's second-leading scorer in the nation with 765 points. He made 96 3-pointers and led Dodge City CC to a 25-10 overall record. Edwards was named a 2023 NJCAA First Team All-American and the 2023 Kansas Jayhawk Community College Player of the year. He led Dodge City to the national tournament where he was named to the all-tournament team. He was one of just two freshmen named first team all-American.

DEFENDS WITHOUT FOULING

» UNT's Jason Edwards commits just 1.1 fouls per game. That's the 12th lowest average in the country according to KenPom.

» Edwards committed a season-high three fouls on Jan. 20 at Charlotte. It was only the third time this year he committed more than 1 foul in a game.

PRODUCES POINTS

» North Texas guard John Buggs III has a UNT team-leading 130.1 offensive rating. That means he creates an average of 130.1 points per 100 possessions.

» Buggs' 130.1 offensive rating as of Saturday is the third-highest individual offensive rating among all players in the American Athletic Conference.

5-1 START TO CONFERENCE

» North Texas is off to a 5-1 start in conference play. It is the fourth time in the last six years the Mean Green have started conference with a 5-1 record.

» UNT is aiming to improve to 6-1 in league play with a win Sunday at FAU. The last time they were 6-1 in conference was two years ago. They also were recently 6-1 in conference in 2020.

37-POINT PERFORMANCE

» UNT guard Jason Edwards scored a career-high 37 points on Jan. 6 versus Tulane in their 70-56 win.

» It was and still is the most points scored by an AAC player this season & tied for the seventh-most points scored by an AAC player in the league's 10-year history.

» Edwards is the 15th different North Texas men's basketball player to score 37+ points in a game. The last was Abou Ousmane last season on Dec. 22, 2022 at UTSA. Ousmane also scored 37 in a 78-54 win in San Antonio.

» Edwards was 8-of-10 from deep versus Tulane and made his first eight 3-point attempts before missing his final two. His eight made 3-pointers are the most by an AAC player this season and tied for the seventh-most by an AAC player in the league's 10-year history. He is just the seventh UNT player in program history to make eight 3-pointers in a single game. Had Edwards finished the game 8-8, he would have set the record for best single-game 3-point performance in program history as no one has ever finished a game going 8-8 or better. However, he missed his final two 3-point attempts.

27 OFFENSIVE REBOUNDS LAST 5 GAMES

» UNT's Robert Allen has grabbed 27 offensive rebounds over the previous five games.

» Over the last five games, Allen has grabbed more offensive rebounds (27) than defensive rebounds (23).

» Allen enters Sunday with 64 offensive rebounds this season. He is 7 offensive rebounds from a single season career high.

» Allen had a season-high seven offensive rebounds on Jan. 6 versus Tulane.

» Allen's single-game career high for total rebounds is 18.

17 STRAIGHT HOME WINS

» North Texas has won 17 straight home games. They last lost at home on Jan. 19, 2023 when they fell to Rice, 72-60.

» They have tied the program record for consecutive home wins set in 2011 (Jan. 21, 2010-Jan. 22, 2011)

FACING RANKED TEAMS ON THE ROAD

» North Texas faces No. 22 Florida Atlantic in Boca Raton, Florida on Sunday.

» UNT last beat a ranked team on the road on Feb. 27, 1971 when they upset No. 15 Louisville on the road, 79-73.

» UNT enters Sunday having lost 36 straight games on the road to ranked opponents.

» North Texas is 2-60 (.032) all-time on the road versus ranked opponents. In addition to the win at No. 15 Louisville in 1971, the Mean Green beat No. 8 Wichita State on the road on Jan. 25, 1963.

» Only twice during this current 36-game losing streak to ranked opponents has North Texas lost by single digits. They lost by 3 (59-56) at No. 25 VCU in 2019 and they lost by 8 (64-56) at No. 8 Missouri in 1987.

» During this current 36-game losing streak to ranked teams on the road, the Mean Green have lost by an average of 23.6 points per game.

» The last time North Texas faced a ranked opponent on the road was in 2020 when they lost at No. 11 West Virginia, 62-50. Rubin Jones, then a freshman, came off the bench and scored nine points.

» The last time UNT played a conference opponent who was ranked was No. 20 Western Kentucky on March 2, 2002. UNT lost 82-68. It was in the second round of 2002 Sun Belt Tournament in New Orleans.

» Even less fun, on Dec. 23, 1998 North Texas lost at No. 5 Maryland, 132-57. As of Saturday it is the 12th largest margin of defeat (75) in NCAA D1 history.
