QUICK SHOTS

» North Texas is under the leadership of second-year head coach Ross Hodge who led the Mean Green to a 19-15, 10-8 AAC record last season and a second round appearance in the NIT. Hodge was named a finalist for the Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award, which is given to the nation's best rookie head coach. He was the only rookie head coach to lead his respective team to either the NCAA Tournament or NIT last season. Prior to being named UNT's head coach, Hodge served as its associate head coach from 2017-2023 under Grant McCasland.

» UNT's roster this season features 10 newcomers (7 transfers and 3 freshmen). The Mean Green lost their top six scorers from last season and four starters. Moulaye Sissoko is the team's top returning scorer (103 points) and is its only returning starter (34 starts). UNT returned just 10 percent of its scoring from last season.

» The Mean Green have featured one of the nation's top defenses over the last five seasons. Since 2020, North Texas is giving up on average just 59.2 points per game. Only Houston is giving up fewer points per game over the last five seasons combined (57.6).

» It hasn't just been UNT's defense this season that has carried the Mean Green to a 14-4 record. As of Saturday, UNT has the AAC's third-most efficient offense, averaging 1.11 points per pos.

» UNT enters Sunday's game undefeated at home (10-0). A win Sunday would be UNT's first 11-0 start at home since the 2010-11 season when they started 12-0 at home. UNT is 21-4 (.840) at home under Ross Hodge.

» This is the seventh year in a row North Texas has started league play with a 5-1 record. A win Sunday would mark UNT's best seven-game start to league play since 1989 (Southland Conf.).

» UNT enters Sunday on a four-game winning streak, tied for its longest win streak of the year. They beat Temple on Wednesday, 76-67, behind a heroic game by Brenen Lorient who matched his career-high with 20 points, grabbed a career-high 13 rebounds and blocked a career-high 5 shots.

MEAN JOE GREENE

While NFL Hall of Famer and North Texas Athletic Hall of Famer (1981) Joe Greene is one of the most beloved alums (1969) and most successful ones too, Joe Greene's nickname "Mean Joe Greene" is not how we got our nickname. It is a coincidence. Notice the difference in spelling in "Greene"

Our nickname began around when Greene was a student-athlete at North Texas in the late 1960s, however, it was in reference to the stout defense and team, which of course wore green uniforms. Joe Greene didn't earn his nickname until his professional playing career with the Pittsburgh Steelers.

Greene remains a constant presence on campus.



ROSS HODGE

Head Coach
2nd Season As Head Coach
8th Season At UNT Overall



Ross Hodge was named North Texas' 19th head men's basketball coach on April 2, 2023. He was elevated to head coach after six seasons as the Mean Green's associate head coach under Grant McCasland. He began his tenure with UNT in March of 2017 when he and McCasland came to Denton together.

In his first season as the Mean Green's head coach, Hodge and UNT overcame a ton of injuries to finish with a 19-15 overall record and reached the second round of 2024 National Invitation Tournament. North Texas was without two starters due to injuries for half of its league games and still finished with a 10-8 conference record in what was its first season in the American Athletic Conference. It was the most league wins (10) and best league winning percentage (.556) by a first-year UNT head coach.

During the season the Mean Green had notable wins over LSU, Memphis, SMU and Northern Iowa.

North Texas advanced to the quarterfinal round of the 2024 AAC Tournament after earning a first-round bye and defeating Tulane in its opener, 81-71. It was the third time UNT had beat Tulane that season.

The Mean Green were ranked No. 79 in the NET and earned a spot in the 2024 NIT. They defeated LSU 84-77 on the road in the first round.

In Hodge's first season North Texas' scoring defense held opponents to 63.8 points per game, which was the 12th-best in the nation and the best in the AAC. It marked the fourth year in a row UNT had been in the top 15 in the nation for scoring defense. The Mean Green were also a lethal shooting team as they made 284 3-point field goals and shot 37.7 percent from deep. It was tied for the second-most single season 3FGs in program history and their 3-point field goal percentage was the 14th best in the nation.

After the season, guard Jason Edwards was voted first team all-conference. Edwards scored 650 points, which was the fifth-most points in a single season in program history. The newcomer had five 30-point games, which was tied for the most in program history. He knocked down the sixth-most single season 3-pointers in program history with 84.

Hodge was a 2024 Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year Award finalist. The award is presented annually to the top rookie, first-year head coach in division I men's college basketball.

In his six seasons at UNT prior to being named the head coach, Hodge helped lead the Mean Green to a combined 135-65 overall record and 71-35 record in conference games. North Texas won the 2020 Conference USA regular season championship, 2021 Conference USA Tournament championship and 2022 Conference USA regular season title. In 2021, UNT earned an automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament where they received a program-best No. 13 seeding. In the first round they upset Purdue, 78-69 (ot), for the program's first-ever NCAA Tournament win. In 2023, Hodge helped lead North Texas to the 2023 NIT championship. The program's first NIT title. In his first season in Denton Hodge helped guide the Mean Green to the 2018 CBI championship.

Hodge is the mastermind of the Mean Green defense, which has been one of the nation's best over the last few years. In both 2021-22 and in 2022-23 UNT had the nation's No. 1 scoring defense holding opponents to 55.7 and 55.8 points per game, respectively. They are Conference USA's top two single-season scoring defenses in league history.

In 2022-23 the Mean Green won a single-season program record 31 overall games. It was the second straight season UNT had set the program record for single season wins. Additionally, UNT won 16 league games in both 2022 and 2023, which is a program record.

Prior to arriving in Denton, Hodge served as the associate head coach under Grant McCasland at Arkansas State for the 2016-17 season. The Red Wolves made a 10-win improvement that season, which was the second-best turnaround in Division I basketball that year.

Prior to Arkansas State, Hodge spent four seasons with head coach Larry Eustachy at Colorado State. Hodge served as the lead recruiter at Colorado State and helped the Rams to an 87-48 record over his four-year stint. During his time at Colorado State, the Rams advanced to post-season play twice, including the NCAA Tournament in 2013 where they reached the Round of 32 after defeating Missouri in the first round, 84-72. CSU lost to eventual national champ Louisville.

Hodge joined the Division I coaching ranks when he was hired by Eustachy as an assistant coach at Southern Miss prior to the 2011-12 season. The Golden Eagles posted a 25-9 record and finished second in Conference USA with an 11-5 mark. Southern Miss received an at-large berth in the NCAA Tournament as an eighth seed.

From 2006-11 Hodge was one of the nation's top junior college head coaches compiling a 146-24 (.858) overall record with stops at Paris JC and Midland College.

Hodge guided Midland to a 63-7 (.900) overall record in his two seasons at the helm of the Chaparrals (2009-11). Hodge took over the Midland head coaching job after McCasland left to be head coach at Midwestern St. Hodge saw his 2010-11 squad post a 33-4 record while winning the Western Junior College Athletics Conference Title, the Region V Tournament championship and advance to the NJCAA Championship game. In 2009-10 Hodge led Midland College to their best start in program history (26-0) and an appearance in the Region V Tournament title game.

Prior to taking the Midland job, Hodge spent four years at Paris JC with the last three as its head coach. Hodge led the Dragons to a 83-17 (.830) record. The Dragons won two Texas Eastern Athletic Conference regular-season championships and in 2006-07 he was named the conference coach of the year. The following season, Hodge earned Region 14 Coach of the Year honors after his team won the Region 14 Tournament and finished eighth in the NJCAA Tournament.

Between 2003 and 2005 Hodge served as the assistant men's basketball coach at Texas A&M University-Commerce, where he helped the Lions to the 2004-05 Lone Star Conference Championship, and a spot in the NCAA Division II Sweet 16.

Hodge is a native of Dallas, Texas. He and his wife, Shelly, have two children.

UNT VERSUS FAU

» Sunday will be the 26th all-time meeting between North Texas and Florida Atlantic. UNT leads the all-time series history 14-11, however, the Owls enter Sunday's game having won five in a row over the Mean Green and eight of the last 10.

» In their most recent matchup, FAU eliminated the Mean Green from the 2024 AAC Championship last year with a 77-71 win in the quarterfinals of the tournament.

» Both UNT and FAU's respective rosters have had major overhaul since last season. Moulaye Sissoko and Rondel Walker are the only active UNT players who played for the Mean Green in the two team's most recent matchup. The only FAU player who played for the Owls last season against UNT is Brenen Lorient who is now playing for UNT.

» FAU's Tre Carroll did not play in the last matchup. However, he did play nine minutes off the bench in their Jan. 28 matchup in Denton. He scored two points.

» UNT's last win over FAU came on Feb. 17, 2022 in Boca Raton, 54-51.

» Since 2020, FAU is the only opponent to come to the Super Pit and be held to under 60 points and beat UNT. They beat UNT 50-46 on Dec. 29, 2022. FAU went on to reach the Final Four that season. UNT is 39-1 since 2020 when holding an opponent to under 60.

PLAYER TO WATCH: ATIN WRIGHT

North Texas newcomer Atin Wright is the Mean Green's most experienced player and has scored the most career points and made most career 3-pointers. Wright enters Sunday with 134 career games played, 115 career starts, 1,779 career points scored and 246 career made 3-pointers.



FIRST UNT PLAYER SINCE 2012

» UNT's Brenen Lorient on Wednesday had a career performance with 20 points, 13 rebounds and five blocks. All of which either set or tied single game career highs.

» Lorient is the first UNT player since Tony Mitchell in 2012 to put up a stat line of 20+ points, 13+ rebounds and 5+ blocks in a game. Mitchell in 2013 was drafted by Detroit Pistons.

OFFENSE COMING ONLINE

» While UNT is known for its defense, its offense has actually been exceptional as of late. In conference play, UNT's offense is averaging 1.18 points per possession, which ranks second behind UAB. Last year in conference, UNT's offense averaged a middle of the road 1.08 points per possession.

ELITE OFFENSE EFFICIENCY AT HOME

» In home games, UNT's offensive efficiency ranks 31st in the nation (1.181 points per possession at home). UNT's offense on the road though hasn't traveled as well this season. In road games, UNT's offense efficiency ranks 159th in the country (1.041 points per possession on the road). UNT is shooting 48.5% at home versus 41% on the road for the year and averages 4 less turnovers per home game than on the road.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 60

» Since 2020, UNT has held an opponent to 59 points or fewer 78 times, which is the second-most in the nation during that time-span.

» Since 2020, UNT is 72-7 (.911) in games where they hold its opponent under 60 points.

» When UNT is at home and holds an opponent to under 60 points, they are 38-1 since 2020. Florida Atlantic on Dec. 29, 2022 is the only road team since 2020 to come into the Super Pit and score under 60 points and beat the Mean Green. They won 50-46 and went on to reach the 2023 Final Four.

» UNT is 8-1 this season when scoring 70+ and have won five games in a row. The only loss was its 76-71 defeat at High Point.

» North Texas was 14-3 last season when scoring 70+ points and 5-12 when scoring less than 70. They averaged 69.2 points per game last season.

9 OR MORE

» UNT has won 11 straight games in which it made 9+ 3-pointers and is 6-0 this season when making 9+ 3-pointers.

» North Texas has won 17 straight games at home when making 9+ 3-pointers.

» Since the start of the 2019-20 season, UNT is 36-2 (.947) in home games where they make 9+ 3-pointers.

» Last season, the Mean Green were 13-2 in all games when they made 9+ 3-pointers.

» UNT made a season-low 3 3FGs on Wednesday in their 76-67 win over Temple.

SCORING DEFENSE

REPLACING A LOT OF SCORING

» North Texas lost 2,108 of its 2,353 total points scored last season. That's 90 percent of its scoring from last season is gone.

» UNT's top six scorers from last season are gone. Senior Moulaye Sissoko is the team's top returning scorer. Sissoko scored 103 total points last season. Among the five returners, Sissoko is the only one who scored 100+ points.

» From 3-point range, UNT only returned 23 of its 284 total 3-pointers made last season, that's just 8 percent back. Senior Matthew Stone was the top returning 3-point shooter as he made 13 deep balls last year.

D1 EXPERIENCE

» UNT's roster this season enter the year having played an average of 2.9 years at the D1 level. That makes them the 11th most experienced D1 team according to KenPom. They are the third most experienced team in the American Athletic Conference behind Memphis (3.05) and Wichita State (2.96). The national average is 1.75 years of experience.

1,000-POINT SCORERS

» Johnathan Massie scored his 1,000th career point on Dec. 18 in his team's 83-42 win over Mississippi Valley. Massie joins teammates Atin Wright (1779) & Latrell Jossell (1167) as members of the 1K point club.

HELD THEM TO 6-OF-37 SHOOTING

» In UNT's last two games, they faced two of the league's most prolific scorers in Primo Spears (UTSA) and Jamal Mashburn Jr. (Temple). UNT's defense held Spears to 1-14 shooting and Mashburn Jr. to 5-23 shooting. Combined Spears and Mashburn Jr. who each entered the game averaging more than 20 points per game were held to 6-37 shooting (16.2%) by UNT's defense.

DELIBERATE TEMPO

» UNT averages 61.4 possession per 40 minutes this season. That's the most deliberate tempo in the AAC and 5th most deliberate tempo in the nation. Their average offensive possession length is 20.3 seconds, which is the 6th longest in the nation. Another reason for their more deliberate tempo is because of how long they typically defend. On average UNT defends a possession for 18.2 seconds, that's the longest average in the AAC.

MOST POSSESSIONS IN A WIN

» In Wednesday's win over Temple, UNT had 66 offensive possessions. It was the second-most offensive possessions the Mean Green have had in a game this season but the most they've had in a win this year. Aka, it was UNT's second-most uptempo offensive game of the year and the most in a win.

» UNT averages 61.4 possessions per 40 minutes this season.

IMPROVING ON 2 POINTERS

» After a sluggish offensive start to the season where the Mean Green shot just 45.4% (134-295) on 2-pointers through their first nine games of the year, UNT has slowly improved on that blemish.

» UNT has shot 56.2% (154-274) on 2-pointers over its last nine games entering Sunday.

» Through 18 games, North Texas is now shooting a slightly more respectable 2-point percentage of 50.2% for the year.

» UNT on Sunday faces an FAU defense that ranks fourth in the AAC in 2-point field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to just 48% shooting on 2s.

» At home UNT is shooting 56.6% on 2-pointers, which ranks in the top third in the nation.

» In conference, UNT has had easily the league's top 2-point field goal percentage defense. They are holding league opponents to 42.3% on 2s. The next best is Rice (46.2%).

SISSOKO'S LAST SEVEN GAMES

» Over the last seven games, Moulaye Sissoko is averaging 10.6 PPG, shooting 76.9% from the floor and grabbing 6.9 RPG. Prior to this seven-game stretch, the veteran senior with over 120 games played had only scored 10 or more points four times

GROWING ATTENDANCE

Last season North Texas had an average home attendance at the Super Pit of 4,132. It was its largest average home attendance since 1977. The Super Pit, which was opened in 1973 has only had two seasons of greater average attendance than last season's mark.



DURING THE WIN STREAK

» During UNT's current four-game win streak the Mean Green are outscoring their opponents by an average of +13.8 points per win.

» UNT is shooting 49.7% from the floor and outshooting their opponents by 10.8%

» Jasper Floyd has a +3.5 assist/to ratio.

» Brenen Lorient is averaging 17.5 PPG and 7.0 RPG.

» Moulaye Sissoko is shooting 80% (16-20) from the floor.

» Atin Wright is averaging 18.5 PPG and shooting 57.1% (16-28) from 3

31 WINS IN FIRST 50 GAMES

» Last week's game at East Carolina was Ross Hodge's 50th game as UNT's head coach. It was also his 31st win, which is tied for the most wins by a UNT head coach in their first 50 games since Bill Blakeley in 1977 and tied for the second most in program history. His 31 wins through first 50 games tied with his predecessor Grant McCasland.

» Hodge is 1 of 26 active head coaches who are in their 2nd overall season as a DI head coach. Only 4 earned 31 wins in their first 50 games.

STARTING DOESN'T REALLY MEAN MUCH

» Over the last few seasons the Mean Green have almost never changed their starting lineup throughout a season unless injuries require them to. Head coach Ross Hodge says its mostly just about the rotation and most of UNT's bench could start. UNT's bench this season is averaging 31.0 ppg (20th highest average in nation). FAU is the only team in the AAC with a bench averaging more points per game.

» UNT's bench is outscoring its opponents' bench 558-332 for the year.

» UNT's bench has outscored its own starters in seven games this year.

» Three of UNT's top four scorers come off the bench.

AIMING FOR 6-1 START

» This is the seventh straight year UNT has started league play with a 5-1 record. A win Sunday would improve their league record to 6-1. It would be the first time since 1989 when UNT played in the Southland Conference that the Mean Green had won six of their first seven league games to a season. That year UNT won eight of its first nine Southland Conference games. They finished that season with a 10-4 Southland record and were the league's regular season champion.

14 WINS FIRST 18 GAMES

» UNT's 14-4 overall record is tied for its fourth-best 18-game start to a season in program history.

» This is the third time in the last four years UNT has won 14 of its first 18 games to a season. In addition to this season they also recently started 14-4 in 2021-22 and 2022-23 (Grant McCasland's final two years at UNT).

» A win Sunday would improve UNT's record to 15-4. They also started 15-4 two years ago in 2022-23 & three years ago in 2021-22.

WHEN WALKER SCORES 6+

» Over the last two seasons UNT is 10-2 in games where Rondel Walker scores at least six points. They have won seven of the last eight times he reaches at least 6 points. In his five-year career, when Walker scores 6+ points in a game his team is 30-8 (.789).

DOESN'T SHOOT IT OFTEN BUT...

» UNT forward Brenen Lorient has only attempted 10 3FGs on the year but he is 7-10 (.700) on the year and has made 7 of his last 9 attempts from 3 entering Sunday.

GETTING TO THE LINE

» No one in the AAC has been better at getting to the free throw line than UNT forward Brenen Lorient entering Sunday. In conference, Lorient leads the league in fouls drawn per 40 minutes (7.2) and has a league leading free throw rate of 88.0. *Free throw rate measures a player's ability to get the line using the number of free throws shot per 100 field goal attempts.*

» Lorient has attempted at least six free throws in each conference game this season and is shooting 77.3% at the line in league play.

AVERAGING 15.7 OVER LAST 10

» Since the start of December Brenen Lorient has found his groove as he's averaging a team-leading 15.7 points per game over the last 10 games entering Sunday and shooting 60.7% from the floor. He averaged just 8.6 points per game in the eight games prior to this 10-game stretch.

SHOT CLOCK VIOLATION

» UNT's defense has forced 20 shot clock violations through 18 games this season. However, they haven't forced a shot clock violation in their last four games.

ONE OF JUST TWO IN THE COUNTRY

» UNT senior Jasper Floyd was just one of two players in the country last year to average at least 6.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game. The only other player was Seton Hall's Kadary Richmond who is now at St. John's. Floyd averaged 9.5 ppg, 6.0 rpg, 4.1 apg and 2.3 spg per game last year at Fairfield. Richmond averaged 13.8 ppg, 9.4 rpg, 6.4 apg and 2.1 spg.

NJCAA NATIONAL CHAMPION

» UNT newcomer Jasper Floyd began his college career at Northwest Florida State College. He helped lead them to the 2022 NJCAA National Championship. In the championship game, he came off the bench and scored four points and had four rebounds.

HIS ONLY DI OFFER WAS TO KANSAS

» UNT newcomer Latrell Jossell comes to the Mean Green after three seasons at Stephen F. Austin. Prior to SFA, Jossell played his freshman season at Kansas in 2020-21 where he was recruited out of nearby Keller Central HS.

But Jossell's recruitment process was not that simple. The undersized guard who battled through injuries in high school had no DI offers going into his senior season at Keller Central in 2019 and had just one DII offer from Dallas Baptist. Despite that his AAU coach and high school coach knew he was too good to not have any DI offers. The two coaches worked together and used their connections to try and get him what they felt he deserved.

Then one day during the fall of his senior season, Jossell's AAU coach told him that Kansas' assistant coach Jarrance Howard (now at Arizona St) would be by Keller Central to meet him and watch him at practice. It was a complete shock to Jossell.

Then a few weeks later on the Monday before National Signing Day, Howard and the entire KU staff including head coach Bill Self went back to Keller Central to watch and meet Jossell.

They offered what would be his first and only DI offer in high school. He committed on the spot.

BEST FROM DEEP

» In league play, UNT's Atin Wright is averaging a league leading 3.2 made 3FGs per game. He's shooting 46.3% from deep in league play, which is the third-best percentage. Wright is only one of three AAC players shooting above 40 percent from deep in league play. Toney Tony (UAB) and Marcus Millender (UTSA) are the other two.

AIMING FOR 5 IN A ROW IN LEAGUE

» A win Sunday versus Florida Atlantic would be UNT's fifth win in a row and all against AAC opponents. It would be UNT's longest conference win streak since joining the AAC last year and would be their longest conference win streak since 2023 (8 games).

BILL SELF ON LATRELL JOSSELL

» While at Kansas as a freshman in 2020-21, Latrell Jossell built a great relationship with head coach Bill Self. The Hall of Fame head coach is quoted multiple times that season praising Jossell.

"He's got range, he's got some quickness, he's tough. There's a lot of things that he can do well."

"I love Latrell to death. I think he's a great player. I love his swagger. I think you guys are going to get to see that. And he sparks confidence in players that play with him. He's just continuing to get better."

However, the injuries he dealt with in high school continued in college and limited him during his freshman season. He had surgery on his heel right after the season.

The next season as a sophomore at SFA, Jossell and the Lumberjacks played at KU and battled the eventual national champs in a 80-72 defeat. In the loss, Jossell made three 3FGs. After the game Self said this...

"He's the best kid ever. He's back in our locker room now (visiting former KU teammates after game)...You know what, I'm happy we won the game. But I'm happy he did well. It was good to see that. He's a class kid. And you guys (media) can see now if he was healthy last year he could have helped us because he has great range."

HIGH MAJOR WINS

» UNT this regular season has beaten both Minnesota (Nov. 13) and Oregon State (Nov. 25). It marks the first time since 2010 the Mean Green have beaten two high major programs in the same regular season. In 2010 the Mean Green beat Texas Tech at home and LSU on the road. UNT has had recent postseason success beating opponents such as LSU, Oklahoma State, Purdue and Wisconsin but not during the regular season.

10-0 AT HOME

» UNT is 10-0 at home so far. It is the first time they've been 10-0 at home since the 2018-19 season. The last time they started a year 11-0 at home was 2010-11.

MEMBER OF HISTORIC TEAM

» UNT newcomer Brenen Lorient was a freshman on the historic 2022-23 Florida Atlantic squad that won 35 games, won the CUSA regular season and tournament title and reached the Final Four of the 2023 NCAA Tournament.

» Lorient who played in 52 games over two seasons at FAU, played behind veteran all conference big Vlad Goldin (now at Michigan).

HAITIAN ROOTS

» UNT newcomer Brenen Lorient was born and raised in Ocala, FL near Orlando. His parents were born in Haiti and immigrated to the United States soon before Lorient was born. Lorient, whose last name in French "l'Orient" translates to "the east" doesn't speak French but does know Haitian Creole, which is his parents' native language.

TURNOVER MARGIN TREND

» UNT defeated UTSA last Saturday 72-57 despite having a season worst -10 turnover margin. UNT had a season-high 16 turnovers in the win and only forced UTSA into 6 turnovers, which is the fewest the Mean Green defense has forced in a game all year.

» 12 of UNT's 16 turnovers last Saturday at UTSA came in the second half, which was a huge anomaly as North Texas was averaging less than 4 turnovers per second half in conference entering the game.

» A troubling trend to keep an eye on is the lack of turnovers UNT's defense has been forcing as of late. Entering conference UNT's defense was forcing its opponents into an elite average of 15.2 turnovers per game. Through six games in conference, UNT's defense is forcing an average of just 9.8 turnovers per game. Over its last four games UNT is only forcing 7.8 turnovers per game.

» FAU enters Sunday averaging 11.7 turnovers per game.

NOT TURNING IT OVER IN 2ND HALF

» Despite the second half turnover fiasco at UTSA last Sunday, UNT is still only averaging 4.6 turnovers per 2nd half in conference entering Sunday. They had just 2 second half turnovers on Wednesday versus Temple.

50+ 3FGS IN A SEASON

» UNT guard Atin Wright enters Sunday two made 3-pointers shy of his 50th of the season. When he reaches that mark he will become the 27th different UNT player to make 50+ 3-pointers in a season.

» Wright, who has made 246 career 3s, has had three different seasons with 50+ 3FGs and two seasons with 60+ 3FGs.

» In conference Wright is averaging 3.2 made 3FGs per game, and he's averaging that despite being held scoreless at Memphis on Jan. 5 and making just one 3FG on Wednesday versus Temple.

FIRST 25 HOME GAMES

» Wednesday versus Temple was Ross Hodge's 25th home game as the Mean Green's head coach. The second-year head coach has a 21-4 all-time home record and 10-0 record this season at home.

» Hodge's home record through the first 25 games at home is the second best in program history.

NOT GIVING UP OFFENSIVE BOARDS

» UNT opponents are only averaging 7.6 offensive rebounds per game.

» UNT's defense is only giving up an offensive rebound 26.5 percent of the time. That's the 48th best percentage in the nation.

» Last season, UNT gave up an offensive rebound 32.0 percent of the time, which was one of the worst percentages in the nation.

» Last Saturday at UTSA, the Roadrunners were limited to just four total offensive rebounds and they only scored 2 second chance points the entire game. UTSA entered the game averaging 12 offensive rebounds per game.

MOST 20-POINT LEAGUE GAMES

» UNT's Atin Wright has had four 20-point games in conference so far this season. Entering Sunday it is tied for the 13th most in a single season in program history.

AAC HONORABLE MENTION

» UNT guard Atin Wright was named AAC Player of the Week Honorable Mention on Monday after leading the Mean Green to a pair of road victories last week and averaging 22 points and 5 rebounds per game while knocking down 11 total 3-pointers.

MASSIE CONFERENCE HIGH

» UNT guard Johnathan Massie scored 13 point son Wednesday in the Mean Green's nine-point win over Temple. It was the third time this year he's scored in double figures against a conference opponent but was the most points he's scored against a AAC opponent.

» He also had seven rebounds in the win over Temple, which matched his conference high for the year.

WHEN MASSIE SCORES 10+

» UNT is 8-1 this season when Johnathan Massie scores 10+ points in a game. They have won seven in a row when Massie scores 10+.

» In those nine total games where Massie has scored 10+ points, he's averaged 5 made free throws per game.

DUE

» After scoring 20 points and making 6-9 from deep versus UAB in the conference opener, Latrell Jossell has scored just 21 total points in the five games since.

» Jossell has scored 20+ points twice this year and scored in double figures six times this year.

ELITE HIGH SCHOOL TEAM

» UNT newcomer Brenen Lorient graduated high school from prep powerhouse Calvary Christian Academy in 2022. As a senior at CCA, he helped lead his team to the 2022 Florida 4A state championship, a No. 3 end of season national ranking and a 26-2 overall record. During his senior season Lorient played alongside four other players who would earn DI scholarships: Greg Glenn (Tulane), Marvel Allen (Dayton), Carl Cherenfant (Memphis) and Taylor Hendricks who after one season at UCF would be the No. 9 overall pick by the Utah Jazz in the 2023 NBA Draft.

FIRST CAL FRESHMAN SINCE BROWN

» UNT newcomer Grant Newell played his first two seasons at California. During his freshman season at Cal, Newell had a 21-point, 10-rebound performance at Washington and a 13-point, 12-rebound performance versus Colorado. He became the first Cal freshman since Jaylen Brown in 2015-16 to have multiple double doubles in a season. After his freshman season, Newell was voted to the Pac-12 All-Freshman team.

MVC ALL TOURNAMENT TEAM

» UNT newcomer Atin Wright played last season at Drake. He led the Bulldogs to the 2024 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament title and was voted to the MVC All-Tournament team. Over the three games in the tournament, Wright averaged 16.3 points per tournament game and averaged three 3-pointers per game. In the championship game against MVC regular season champion Indiana State, Wright poured in 17 points.

20 IN THE BIG DANCE

» UNT newcomer Atin Wright last season for Drake scored a game-high 20 points in their NCAA Tournament game against Washington State on 8-14 shooting. Drake lost 66-61 to the seventh-seeded Cougars.

56 STRAIGHT STARTS

» UNT big man Moulaye Sissoko enters Wednesday having made 56 straight starts. The Mali native was inserted into the starting lineup during the Mean Green's 2023 NIT championship run and hasn't left since.

CSU NORTHRIDGE SCHOOL RECORD

» UNT newcomer Atin Wright began his college career at Cal State Northridge, playing at CSUN for three seasons. As a junior at CSUN, the Southern California native set the program's single game scoring record with 42 points on 14-25 shooting in a game at UC Davis on Feb. 15, 2023. Wright was 7-11 from deep in the game.

ONE OF JUST SEVEN TEAMS

» UNT is just one of seven schools in the country who has won a national postseason game in each of the last four years: Baylor, Creighton, Gonzaga, Houston, Kansas, Oregon and UNT.

LED LONGWOOD TO BIG DANCE

» UNT newcomer Johnathan Massie played last season at Longwood where he led the Lancers to the Big South conference tournament title. In the NCAA Tournament the Lancers faced Houston in the first round and Massie led Longwood in scoring with 10 points. Last year Massie had a 31-point performance in a win over Winthrop.

TOP 100 RECRUIT

» UNT guard Rondel Walker was the nation's No. 55 overall high school recruit in 2020. He is the first top 100 high school recruit to join the Mean Green since Tony Mitchell in 2011.

» Walker went to Oklahoma State out of high school where he played with childhood friend and was freshman dorm roommates with eventual NBA top draft pick Cade Cunningham.

» Walker was the No. 2 ranked recruit from the state of Oklahoma in 2020 and also held offers from Kansas State and Virginia Tech in addition to Oklahoma State.

SOUTHLAND FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

» UNT newcomer Johnathan Massie was voted the 2022 Southland Conference Freshman of the Year while he was at McNeese State.

» Massie had 67 assists as a freshman at McNeese State to go along with 35 steals.

MALI NATIONAL TEAM

» In the summer of 2023 UNT big man Moulaye Sissoko played for his home country of Mali in the African Olympic qualifiers. Mali didn't advance past the group stage but they did defeat African power Nigeria in Lagos, Nigeria, 77-68. The win eliminated Nigeria from the 2024 Olympics. It was the first time since 2008 that Nigeria missed an Olympics. Sissoko scored eight points and four rebounds in the win over Nigeria.

INTERNATIONAL DREAM

» UNT's Moulaye Sissoko was born in Bamako, Mali. He grew up playing soccer in the capital city and never played basketball until he was 15 years old. He came to the US as a 16-year-old by himself with one suitcase and no jacket. He knew absolutely no English but he had always dreamed of living the American Dream.

BORN IN FRANCE BUT DOESN'T SPEAK FRENCH

» UNT freshman Tyran Mason's father Timothy played professional basketball in Europe and played in Vichy, France when Tyran was born in 2006. Mason and his family moved to Timothy's hometown of Dallas a year after Mason was born.

» Mason's father Timothy played college basketball at SMU. He graduated in 1993 and was the Mustangs' leading scorer as a senior averaging 16.1 points per game. He helped lead the Mustangs to the 1993 NCAA Tournament.

JUNIOR OLYMPIAN

» UNT'S Jasper Floyd finished 16th at the 2011 AAU Junior Olympics in the 1500-meter run bantam with a time of 5:19.88. He placed 64th in at the 2011 AAU Junior Olympics in the 800-meter run bantam with a time of 2:44.15.

ONE OF THE BEST AT THE LINE

» UNT guard Atin Wright is shooting 94.6 percent at the free throw line, which is the best among AAC players and as of Saturday second in the nation.


