STARTING FIVE

» North Texas heads to Illinois in a true road test, looking to claim its second win over a Power Four program this season.

» **Megan Nestor** made NCAA history against Texas Southern, posting 34 points and 31 rebounds to become the third player with a 30-30 game in Division I since 1981 and broke the program and American conference single-game rebound record.

» **Jason Burton** became the fastest head coach in program history to reach 50 wins in UNT's win over Grambling State on Nov. 7.

» UNT's defense has been the key to a solid start, leading the conference in several categories, including scoring defense allowing just 56.3 points per game.

» The Mean Green have recorded the winningest season in program history in consecutive years. UNT's 48 wins over the last two seasons are the most of any team in the American Conference.

WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- North Texas will leave the state of Texas for the first and only time during the non-conference slate.
- Illinois will be the fourth Power Four opponent for the Mean Green this season. UNT took down SMU on the road earlier this season before falling to Texas Tech and OSU.
- **Megan Nestor** made national headlines with her 34-point, 31-rebound performance against Texas Southern, and earned the American Conference Player of the Week.

DEFENSIVE DATA

- UNT's defense has been solid to start the season, ranking inside the top 50 in Division I and leading American teams in field goal percentage defense (.356), scoring defense (56.3) and turnovers forced per game (22.8).
- The North Texas defense has allowed just 56.3 points per game, which is the second-lowest mark for the program through nine games since 2015.
- In three games against Power Four opponents this season, UNT has given up 66 points per game. Both SMU and Texas Tech were held under their season scoring average by 10+ points, while Oklahoma State was held to just 73 points after entering the game at 94.9 ppg.

MEGAN THE HISTORY MAKER

- Megan Nestor had one of the great performances in NCAA history on Dec. 6 against Texas Southern with 34 points and 31 rebounds. She also added four steals and went 17-of-22 from the field.
- Her 31 rebounds shattered the school record and the American Conference record for single-game rebounds.
- She became just the third player since 1981-82 to post a 30-point, 30-rebound game in Division I.
- Nestor outrebounded the Texas Southern team that entered the game No. 11 in the country in rebounding.

A WIN WOULD...

- Improve North Texas to 7-3 on the year
- Tie the series with Illinois at 1-1
- Mark UNT's first victory over a Big Ten school since defeating Michigan 85-72 on Dec. 4, 1993
- Give the Mean Green two wins over major conference teams in the same season for the first time since 2011-12

SERIES HISTORY

- North Texas will face Illinois for the second time in program history Saturday.
- Illinois won the only previous meeting 92-68 at the Fiesta Bowl Classic in 2002.
- The Mean Green are 2-12 all-time against Big Ten schools with their last win coming against Michigan in 1993.

INSIDE LOOK AT THE FIGHTING ILLINI

- Illinois is 9-1 on the season, coming off a 70-62 win at Missouri on Wednesday.
- The Fighting Illini have been excellent at home this season, posting a perfect 7-0 record with an average margin of victory of 32.1 points in those wins.
- Forward Berry Wallace is the leading scorer for Illinois, averaging 16.8 ppg. She is one of four players averaging double figures on the season.

THE MAGIC NUMBER IS 70

- Reaching 70 points has proven to be an accurate indicator of the Mean Green's success over the last two seasons.
- North Texas was 16-1 last season when scoring 70 or more points and is 40-2 overall under **Jason Burton** when hitting the mark.
- The Mean Green are a perfect 28-0 when scoring 70+ points at The Super Pit under Burton.
- The only losses came on Feb. 4, 2024 when UNT fell at Tulsa, 79-74, and in an 88-86 overtime loss to Troy to end the Mean Green's run in the 2025 WNIT.

SUPER AT THE PIT

- **Jason Burton** has led North Texas to a 32-5 record at home during his tenure. In victories at The Super Pit under Burton, the Mean Green have outscored their opponents by 21.5 points per game.
- UNT went 16-1 at home last season, smashing the program record for most home wins in a season.
- UNT had rattled off a 14-game win streak at home prior to a loss to ACU earlier this season. During that streak, North Texas outscored their opponents by 23.5 points per game.

MISSION (ACC)OMPLISHED

- The Mean Green bounced back from their first loss of the season to defeat SMU 58-55 in a major road victory on Nov. 22.
- **Aysia Proctor** led UNT with 16 points, which included four clutch free throws in the final minute to hold onto the lead.
- North Texas overcame an 0-for-4 night from 3-point land to secure its first ever win over an active ACC school and earn the first win under Burton when scoring less than 60 points.

TK'S OPENING ACT

- **TK Hammond** had a memorable debut for the Mean Green against Oklahoma Christian, posting career highs in points (22) and assists (5). She led the way making six of her seven 3-point attempts on the night.
- She is the first player since DesiRay Kernal in 2024 to record a 20-point game with 5+ assists for North Texas.
- Hammond is one of 12 players in the country to record a game with a 3FG% higher than 85% on 7+ attempts this season.

DIAPER DANDY

- True freshman **Cherie Spencer** had a solid start to her college career against OC. The No. 2 ranked prospect in her class out of Louisiana posted 12 points, four rebounds and one assist in the win.
- Her 12 points are the most in a game by any UNT freshman since 2022 and the most in a collegiate debut by a freshman since Tommisha Lampkin in 2020.

ALL-AROUND ANDI

- **Andi Schissler** played a complete game on both ends of the floor in the win over Grambling State, posting 6 PTS, 6 REBS, 5 ASTS, 3 STLS and 2 BLKS.
- She is just the second UNT player in the last 40 seasons to record a statline with at least five points, rebounds and assists, as well as two or more steals and blocks.

BIG MEG POSTING BIG NUMBERS

- **Megan Nestor** has been a difference maker in the frontcourt, averaging 13.2 points and 12.1 rebounds per game this season. She is the only player in the American Conference averaging a double double.
- She ranks in the top 10 in the country in total rebounds per game, offensive rebounds per game and is No. 17 with four double doubles on the year. She is also one of just three players to record three games with 15 rebounds or more this year.

NESTOR ON NATIONAL WATCH LIST

- **Megan Nestor** is one of 20 Division I players on the Preseason Watchlist for the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Award, an annual honor given to the nation's best center in women's college basketball by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Nestor is one of just two players on the list from non-Power Four schools alongside South Dakota State's Brooklyn Meyer, who was a WBCA HM All-American last season.
- This marks the second straight season UNT has been represented on the Lisa Leslie Center of the Year Preseason Watchlist. Tommisha Lampkin was selected prior to the 2024-25 season. North Texas is one of nine schools to have a player on the list in each of the last two seasons.

CAUSE YOU'RE LOOKING AT WINNERS

- The North Texas staff made it an offseason priority to target players who have won at previous schools, especially in the transfer portal.
- Two guards have won championships in the American Conference with **Jazzy Owens-Barnett** winning the 2024 American Tournament title at Rice, while **Aysia Proctor** won the 2024-25 regular season title as a member of UTSA.
- The Mean Green also feature a pair of former NJCAA national champions. **Mekhia Chase** captured a championship with Northwest Florida State College last season. In addition, **TK Hammond** won the title during the 2022-23 season at CCBC Essex before transferring to Coppin State.
- **Tionna Lidge** also won a conference championship while at Southern, leading the Jaguars to the first round of the NCAA Tournament after winning the SWAC Championship.

NEW CONFERENCE, NO PROBLEM

- **Jason Burton** and the Mean Green have made the transition to the American Conference look seamless.
- Through two completed seasons in the conference, UNT ranks among the top-tier programs in terms of wins during their first two seasons as members of the conference.

TAC IS BACK

- Adhel Tac made her long awaited return to the floor against Oklahoma State on Dec. 3. It was her first game action since suffering a season-ending injury on Jan. 13, 2024, while at UTEP.
- Despite playing limited minutes, Tac has been impactful to the Mean Green and scored six points in the win over TXSO.

PACKING THE PIT

- In UNT's first season under **Jason Burton**, the program saw an average attendance of 1,693 at home, which was the highest on record dating back to the 2000-01 season.
- Following the 2024 American Conference title, UNT's average attendance grew to 1,714 for the 2024-25 season.
- During the Burton era, North Texas has played 22 games in front of crowds that fall in the 50 largest attendances at The Super Pit for UNT women's basketball games.

SEVEN STATES ON THE ROSTER

- UNT's roster is composed of players from seven different states and two countries.
- The Mean Green have largely been made up of Texans over the past few years with seven states represented being the most since the 2017-18 season.

Jason Burton embarks on his third year with the Mean Green after he was hired on March 27, 2023, as the ninth head women's basketball coach in UNT history. Burton arrived at North Texas following nine seasons as the head coach at East Texas A&M, formerly known as Texas A&M-Commerce.

Since taking over the Mean Green program, Burton has guided UNT to its two winningest seasons in program history, a conference championship and back-to-back appearances in national postseason tournaments.

In his first season at the helm in Denton, Burton led North Texas to its first conference title since 1986 and an appearance in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament. He pioneered the Mean Green to the third best turnaround in Division I and the best among first-year head coaches with a 23-9 record in the program's first year in the American Conference.

He was named the American Conference Coach of the Year and set program records for conference wins (13), regular season wins (23), scoring average (74.3), field goal percentage (.463) and single-season points (2,379). The Mean Green also set a school record for points in a game in a 117-42 victory over UNT Dallas in the season opener.

The Mean Green built off their success in the 2024-25 campaign, setting the program record for wins, home wins and conference wins for the second consecutive season. North Texas went 25-9 on the season with a 15-3 mark in league play. Burton's team continued its success at The Super Pit, posting a 16-1 home record in his second season and went unbeaten at home during the conference slate.

Burton once again led UNT back to the postseason, earning a berth in the WNIT. The Mean Green advanced to the Round of 16, capturing the program's first ever win in the tournament with a 78-67 victory over UTA.

Under Burton, North Texas has received nine postseason accolades from the American Conference, which includes Tommisha Lampkin being on the All-American Conference First Team in consecutive years. Former players under Burton at Texas A&M-Commerce, DesiRay Kernal and Dyani Robinson also garnered all-conference honors in the 2024. In 2025, Desiree Wooten and Aniyah Johnson joined Lampkin on the conference's awards list.

The all-time winningest coach in TAMUC program history, Burton's Commerce teams produced five All-Americans, three Lone Star Conference player of the year honorees, one South Central Region Player of the Year along with three all-region players and 25 all-conference picks and five all-defensive selections.

Burton guided the Lions through its first season of NCAA Division I competition in 2022-23 with the program reaching the semifinals of the Southland Conference tournament following a 10-8 record in the Southland Conference regular season. In Commerce's last three seasons in Division II, the Lions were 69-12 (.852) with two NCAA Regional Semifinals appearances.

Burton guided the Lions to a program-best ranking of No. 2 in the WBCA poll and No. 1 in the D2SIDA rankings during the 2021-22 season. The Lions advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight season and played in the LSC Championship game for the third year in a row.

His squad downed the Colorado School of Mines in the NCAA Tournament to advance to the South Central Regional Semifinal. A&M-Commerce finished the season leading the country in free throws made and third in rebounding.

The Lions won 27 games that season, the second most in program history.

During the COVID-impacted 2020-21 season, the Lions posted a 14-4 record and were ranked in the Top 25 all season while winning the LSC North Division crown and earning the program's first NCAA tournament win since 2008. Robinson and Kernal were named honorable mention All-Americans by the WBCA, the program's fourth and fifth All-Americans under Burton's leadership.

Burton led the Lions to their most successful season under his tenure in 2019-20, earning LSC Coach of the Year honors for the first time in his career. The team went 28-3, tying the program's record for most wins in a single season. The team qualified for the NCAA Tournament for the second year in a row, the first time in program history the team had made back-to-back appearances before the tournament was canceled due to the pandemic.

The team set records for wins in a season (28), wins in a regular season (26), conference wins (20), most consecutive victories (25), best scoring margin (+18.4), lowest scoring defense (56.8) and the then highest national ranking (3rd). The team won its first 25 games of the year and finished the season as the No. 1 seed in the LSC with a 20-2 record in conference games. The Lions earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA tournament before the event was canceled due to the pandemic.

During the 2018-19 season, Burton led the Lions to their first berth in the NCAA Regional Tournament since the 2006-07 season, and just the program's second-ever appearance. The team won 20 games for the second time in three seasons, and for only the third time in program history.

In his first four seasons as head coach from 2014-18, TAMUC showed steady improvement posting win totals of 14, 16, 20 and 18. The 20 victories during the 2016-17 season marked only the second 20-win campaign in Commerce history.

The Plano, Texas native has won 66 percent of his games as a head coach and holds a 194-99 record overall in 10 seasons including wins in nearly 70 percent of his league games for a 123-55 record.

Burton returned to TAMUC in 2014 following a three-year stint away that included two years as a men's basketball assistant coach at Texas State and one year as head boys coach at McKinney Boyd High School.

He previously served as an assistant men's coach and later associate head coach for the Lions men's program from 2007 through 2011. He helped the program compile a 68-43 record during that time while recruiting a trio of All-Americans.

Burton earned a BA in Business Administration and Management from Austin College in 2007 and an MBA from A&M-Commerce in 2009. He is married to the former Alexyandra Guiton. The couple has two children, Braylon and Jalen.
