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### STORY LINES

- Coming off a historic season that saw UNT win a program record 12 games, the Mean Green will kick off the 2026 season with a new man at the helm as the **Neal Brown** era begins in Bloomington, Indiana against the defending CFP National Champion Indiana Hoosiers on Sept. 5.
- Brown takes over after spending the 2025 season as the special assistant to the head coach under Steve Sarkisian at Texas. A veteran head coach, Brown comes to North Texas with 10 seasons of head coaching experience after spending the 2019-24 seasons at West Virginia and the 2015-18 seasons at Troy.
- In his head coaching career, Brown has compiled a 72-51 overall record and has led his team to bowl appearances in seven of his 10 seasons as a head coach.
- As has been the case each of the last three offseasons, North Texas underwent a complete roster overhaul as they added 72 new players to the roster including 54 transfer prospects.
- The matchup against Indiana will be the second time Neal Brown has opened his head coaching career at a program against Curt Cignetti. Brown's first career game at West Virginia was against James Madison in August of 2019 and saw Brown get the better of Cignetti in a 20-13 win in Morgantown.
- Despite the large amount of new players on the roster, UNT has a large contingent of players with significant playing experience. In total, 29 players on the roster have played in 20+ games in their career, 10 have appeared in 30+ games and two, DL **Davion Rhodes** (44) and LB **Aaron Alexander** (40), have seen action in 40+ games in their careers.
- Another player with significant experience who figures to play a big role in the offense is RB **Jahiem White**. A former Freshman All-American, White arrives having rushed for 1,819 yards and 14 touchdowns in 27 games at West Virginia.
- During fall camp, UNT named UCF transfer **Tayven Jackson** the starting quarterback. Jackson joins UNT with 16 career starts across time at Tennessee, Indiana and UCF. He has over 3,400 passing yards and 16 passing touchdowns as well as eight rushing scores in his career.
- Since 2021, UNT has been one of the most explosive offenses in college football regardless of head coach. Per Pro Football Focus, the Mean Green have produced 819 explosive plays in the last five seasons, good for the fourth-most in all of FBS and the most of any non-A4 program.
- Matt Powledge** was hired as defensive coordinator in the offseason after spending the 2023-25 seasons in the same role at Baylor. Powledge has been in a coordinator position every year since 2014.
- UNT added former American Conference Second Team honoree LB **Zakye Barker** to the defense in the offseason.
- The Mean Green have faced the defending National Champion four times in history, but just once previously to open a season. North Texas opened the 2006 season in Austin against Texas who had just defeated USC in the infamous 2005 Rose Bowl to win the National Title the season prior. UNT lost the game to Texas 56-7 on Sept 2, 2006
- Per Rotowire, UNT's average age of player on the roster of 21.01 makes it the second-oldest roster in FBS in 2026.

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## QUICK HITTERS

- In the last three offseasons North Texas has added at least 68 new players on its roster every year. In total, UNT added 70 new players in 2026, 68 in 2025 and 77 in 2024 for a total of 215 new players, the most of any FBS program in the nation in that span.
- Neal Brown takes over for former UNT head coach Eric Morris who left in December of 2025 to take the head coaching job at Oklahoma State. In addition, 20 former UNT players transferred to OSU including American Offensive Player of the Year Drew Mestemaker and Newcomer of the Year Caleb Hawkins.
- The Mean Green closed the 2025 season ranked as the No. 24 team in the nation in the final AP poll. It was the first time in program history the Mean Green ended the season as a ranked team.
- UNT scored 50+ points seven times in 2025, the most 50+ point games in FBS since Alabama in 2020.
- Since 2023, UNT is averaging 499.46 yards per game, the most of any team in FBS in that span.
- North Texas currently has a streak of four straight seasons with a player with at least 10+ receiving TDs joining Ohio State as one of only two FBS programs with that distinction.
- Since 2023, UNT has ranked inside the top six in FBS in total offense (2023-6th, 2024-3rd, 2025-1st), top 12 in passing (2023-12th, 2024-4th, 2025-2nd) and top 25 in scoring (2023-21st, 2024-23rd, 2025-1st).

## INDIANA SERIES HISTORY

- The week one contest on the road in Bloomington will be the third meeting all-time between the Hoosiers and the Mean Green. The teams have split the first two games.
- In 2011, North Texas played its first game in then-Apogee Stadium with a 24-21 victory over Indiana in the first meeting. UNT jumped out to an early 24-0 lead and had to hold on late for the 24-21 win.
- UNT Hall of Famer Lance Dunbar was a star in this game with 127 rushing yards on 24 carries while also catching seven passes for 152 yards and a touchdown. It is one of just two times in program history a player has rushed for 100+ yards and has 100+ yard receiving in the same game.
- Indiana got revenge in Bloomington in 2014 with a 49-24 victory. The Hoosiers jumped ahead 21-0 in the first quarter to cruise to the victory. For the Mean Green, WR Carlos Harris was the standout with 11 catches for 120 yards and a touchdown in the contest.
- It will be just the sixth time in program history UNT will have played a game against a Big Ten opponent with half coming against Indiana. The Mean Green have also faced off against Iowa twice and Nebraska once.

## HEAD COACH NEAL BROWN

- Neal Brown enters his first season at the helm of UNT football after spending the 2025 season as Special Assistant to Head Coach Steve Sarkisian at Texas.
- Prior to his time at Texas, Brown was the head coach for West Virginia from 2019-24 and held the same role at Troy from 2015-18.
- Brown holds a 72-51 overall record and has led his team to bowl appearances in seven of his 10 seasons as a head coach and is 5-1 when coaching bowl games.
- In his head coaching career, Brown has coached seven NFL Draft Picks and 24 total players in the NFL.
- From 2015-18 at Troy, Brown coached the Trojans to a 35-16 overall record including a remarkable 31-8 mark from 2016-18. In that span, Brown's .794 winning percentage was the third highest in FBS, trailing only Alabama's Nick Saban and Clemson's Dabo Swinney.
- Brown, who will also call plays for the offense, has also served as the OC at Troy, Texas Tech and Kentucky.

## FACING THE DEFENDING CHAMPIONS

- UNT has faced the defending National Champion in a season four times in history, but just once previously to open a season.
- North Texas opened the 2006 season against Texas who had just defeated USC in the infamous 2005 Rose Bowl to win the National Title the season prior. UNT lost the game to the Longhorns 56-7 on Sept 2, 2006 in the first career start for Texas QB Colt McCoy.
- Woody Wilson threw a touchdown pass to Brandon Jackson for the lone score of the game for UNT.
- In addition, North Texas also faced off with defending champions LSU in 2008, Oklahoma in 2001 and Arkansas in 1965. The Mean Green are 0-4 in those contests.

## ROSTER TURNOVER

- In the last three offseasons North Texas has added at least 68 new players on its roster every year. In total, UNT added 72 new players in 2026, 68 in 2025 and 77 in 2024 for a total of 218 new players, the most of any FBS program in the nation in that span.
- North Texas' 70 new players and 53 transfer prospects both rank inside the top-five for most in FBS.
- Despite the turnover, UNT has a large contingent of players with significant playing experience. In total, 29 players on the roster have played in 20+ games in their career, 10 have appeared in 30+ games and two, DL **Davion Rhodes** (44) and LB **Aaron Alexander** (40), have seen action in 40+ games in their careers.
- Contrastingly, the roster features just four fourth-year players who have spent their entire careers at UNT in CB **Taylor Starling**, S **Kamdon McFarland**, OL **Keon Johnson** and OL **Ryan Krueger**.



## “WHITE” LIGHTNING IN A BOTTLE

- Arguably the most notable add in the offseason was former Freshman All-American RB **Jahiem White** who spent three seasons as a productive back at West Virginia.
- In his time with the Mountaineers, White amassed 1,819 yards and 14 touchdowns in 27 games.
- White is a proven big-play threat averaging 6.47 yards per carry in his career. Among active FBS RBs with 200+ carries, White ranks fourth in yards per rush attempt trailing only Isaac Brown (Louisville, 7.73 ypc), Justice Haynes (Georgia Tech, 6.54 ypc) and former UNT RB Ayo Adeyi (Oklahoma State, 6.48 ypc).
- In addition, White's 1,819 career rushing yards ranks 17th among returning FBS running backs.
- In the first two games of 2025, White was on pace to eclipse the 2,000 career yard mark early in the year before a knee injury sidelined him for the remainder of the season.
- The 2026 season sees White reunite with his former head coach Neal Brown as well as running backs coach Chad Scott. In two years together (2023-24) at WVU, the trio helped the Mountaineers rushing offense rank 27th in the nation in 2024 and third in the nation in 2023.
- On3 ranked White as the No. 3 most impactful Group of 6 transfer this offseason.

## ANOTHER DEBUT AGAINST CIGNETTI

- The matchup against Indiana will be the second time Neal Brown has opened his head coaching career at a program against Indiana Head Coach Curt Cignetti.
- Brown's first career game at West Virginia was against No. 2 (FCS) James Madison in August of 2019 and saw Brown get the better of Cignetti in a 20-13 win in Morgantown.
- Austin Kendall threw for 260 yards and a pair of touchdowns and WVU forced three turnovers in the win.

## ACTION JACKSON

- During fall camp, UNT named UCF transfer **Tayven Jackson** the starting quarterback for the 2026 season.
- Jackson arrives at UNT with 27 games played and 16 starts in games at UCF, Indiana and Tennessee.
- The season opener will be a return to home for the Greenwood, Indiana, native who started six games across two seasons with the Hoosiers in 2023 and 2024.
- In his time at Indiana, Jackson threw for 1,263 yards and six touchdowns while also rushing for four more. He went 3-3 as the starting QB, including leading IU to a 31-17 win over Washington in 2023 en route to the program's first-ever College Football Playoff berth. He also was the starting QB for two of Indiana's three overall wins in the 2023 season.
- In his career, Jackson is 304 of 484 (.628 pct) for 3,451 yards, 16 TDs and 14 INTs. He started 10 games for UCF a season ago and amassed over 2,000 yards passing and accounted for 13 total TDs.
- Jackson will look to continue a string of impressive opening starts for UNT quarterbacks. Each of the last three QBs making their first start threw for 300+ yards and 2+ TDs.
- Jackson comes from a line of athletes as his brother, Trayce Jackson-Davis, was a second round pick in the NBA Draft in 2023 and is currently a member of the Golden State Warriors. His father, Ray Jackson, meanwhile, played cornerback for Washington State and was a member of the 1998 Pac-10 champion and Rose Bowl team. He also played for four years in the NFL with the Panthers, Rams, and Chiefs.

## OLD HEADS

- UNT's average player age of 21.01 is the second-oldest roster in FBS in 2026 per Rotowire.
- The American Conference was heavily represented on the list with four of the top five teams on the list coming from the league, including UTSA who is listed as the "oldest" team in the country with an average age of 21.02.
- Across all teams, the American had an average age of 20.59, the oldest of every FBS league.
- The data from Rotowire assigns every player on each 2026 roster an age from their listed eligibility class on a redshirt-aware scale, using published ages where available.
- Just over half (53 of 105) of the UNT roster is listed as either a senior or a 5th year.

## POWLEDGE EFFECT

- **Matt Powledge** was hired as the Defensive Coordinator for the Mean Green after the 2023-25 seasons in the same role at Baylor.
- Powledge has been in a coordinator position every year since 2015, working as the Defensive Coordinator at Baylor and Oregon while also spending time as the Special Teams Coordinator from 2014-21 at Baylor, Louisiana, ULM and Sam Houston.
- In 2025, Powledge helped lead the Bears to the No. 33 ranked passing defense in FBS and was tied for 30th in the nation in defensive touchdowns.

## FACING THE GIANTS

- The opening game against Indiana is set to become the 12th opener against a ranked opponent in program history and the first since starting the 2012 season at No. 3 LSU.
- The highest ranked team UNT has faced in a season opener happened in 2003 when the Mean Green faced No. 1 Oklahoma on August 30, 2003. The Sooners won 37-3, but UNT Hall of Famer Jonas Buckles picked off eventual 2003 Heisman Trophy winner Jason White in the contest.
- Of the 12 openers against ranked foes, nine were against Top-10 opponents including each of the last eight.
- North Texas holds a 1-11 all-time record against ranked teams in season openers with the lone win coming via forfeit against Mississippi State in 1977. The Bulldogs originally won the game 17-15 against the Mean Green but later forfeited the contest due to playing ineligible players.

## EXPLOSIVE OFFENSE HERE TO STAY

- Per PFF, North Texas has been one of the most explosive offenses in college football in the last five years under former head coaches Eric Morris and Seth Littrell.
- Since 2021, UNT has produced 819 explosive plays (10+ yard rush, 15+ yard pass) and trails only Ole Miss (905), Oregon (842) and Georgia (840) to rank as the fourth-most among all FBS programs.
- Explosive plays are expected to have a large role again under Brown. His WVU teams finished t-11th in 2024 and fourth in 2023 in 10+ yard rushing plays thanks in large part to White in the backfield who finished the 2023 season with nine 30+ yard rushes, tied for 16th-most in the nation.

## RUN THE DAMN BALL

- In his head coaching career Neal Brown has found success in the win/loss column when his teams run the ball effectively.
- Across 10 seasons as a head coach, Brown coached teams are 28-2 when rushing for over 200 yards and are 49-10 when rushing for 150+ yards.
- Conversely, when held to under 150 yards Brown teams hold a 23-41 record.
- In a similar fashion, in 2025 North Texas was 10-0 when running for 150+ yards and 2-2 when rushing for less than 150.

VETERAN OFFENSIVE LINE

- Along the offensive line, UNT has five players who have appeared in 20+ career games led by projected starting center **Chandler Strong**.
- Strong, a former Freshman All-American, transferred to UNT after spending the 2022-25 seasons at Georgia Southern. He was a stalwart for the Eagles with 32 career starts in 36 career appearances.
- Along with Strong, returning 4th-year player **Keon Johnson** (25 GP), Virginia Tech transfer **Jahzari Preister** (24 GP), Texas transfer **Neto Umeozulu** (26 GP) and Missouri transfer **Johnny Williams IV** (21 GP) and have all played in at least 20 games in their careers.

LINEBACKER CORE

- The Mean Green brought in a wealth of talent in the LB room adding four players who have played in 20+ FBS games to the room in **Aaron Alexander**, **Zakye Barker**, **Chantz Johnson** and **Cedric Roberts**.
- Alexander, who was chosen to represent UNT at the American Kickoff event, arrives at UNT after a productive 2025 season at Arkansas State that saw him rack up 91 tackles, 3.0 TFLs and an interception. He has played in 40 career games across time at UMass, Michigan State and Arkansas State.
- Barker returns to the American after spending the 2025 season at SMU. Prior to playing for the Mustangs, Barker had a standout season at East Carolina in 2024 where he was a Second Team All-Conference player after producing 86 tackles, 12 TFLs, 2.0 sacks and a pair of forced fumbles for ECU.
- Roberts also had a productive 2025 season at Alcorn State where he produced 72 tackles and 9.0 TFLs. He made 21 appearances in his first two collegiate seasons with the Braves.
- Returners **Jaden Manning** and **Brenden Reese** also figure to play roles in the defense. Both players appeared in 12 games for UNT a season ago and were productive members of the special teams units.

DEEP AT WIDE RECEIVER

- North Texas will have a myriad of players vying for playing time at the wide receiver position including returners **Dalton Carnes**, **Kyle Koch**, **Baron Tipton** and along with standout transfers **TJ Chukwurah**, **Josiah Martin**, **Corri Milliner**, **Grayson O'Bara**, **Justin Stevenson** and **James Tyre**.
- Carnes is the returner with the most production from last season after catching seven passes for 80 yards in 2025 while Tipton and Koch each had two catches apiece but are poised for big steps in 2026.
- Chukwurah joins the roster as the most productive WR. In four seasons at Black Hills State (DII), he produced 122 catches for 2,347 yards and 28 TDs including 16 in 2025 to lead all Division II players.
- Milliner was the leading WR at UAB in 2025 through three games before injury. He racked up 24 catches for 341 yards and three scores on the year in just five games.
- Both Tyre and O'Bara had productive seasons at the FCS level in 2025 as Tyre caught 68 passes for 832 yards and 11 TDs at Western Carolina while O'Bara finished with 44 receptions for 590 yards and a pair of scores at Dartmouth.

IN THE SECONDARY

- The North Texas secondary hit the transfer portal hard in the offseason bringing in A4 transfers, **Cameren Jenkins** (Baylor), **Keshawn Davila** (Arkansas) and **Jaden Allen** (Arkansas).
- The Mean Green also added talent at other levels as well including **Peyton Taylor** (Emporia State), **Brandon Jones** (McNeese), **CJ Coombes** (Wofford).
- Jones is set to be a staple at the safety position for UNT. He had 31 tackles, two interceptions and a PBU at McNeese a season ago. At Summer Creek High School, Jones, who is also set to return punts for the Mean Green, was a pick-six machine in 2024 returning seven of his 10 total INTs for touchdowns which set a national single-season pick-six record and was tabbed as "Mr. Pick-Six".
- Taylor was one of the most productive DII CBs in the nation in 2025 ranking 13th with 12 PBUs.
- Davila, who played all 12 games for Arkansas a season ago primarily on special teams, was the No. 2 ranked Juco player in the class of 2024 by On3 after two productive seasons at Northwest Mississippi CC.
- Coombes was a standout in the secondary at Wofford in both 2024 and 2025 where he started 17 total games before missing the final seven games of the 2025 season with injury. Prior to going down, Coombes racked up 119 tackles, 6.0 TFLs, five PBUs and two INTs in his time with the Terriers.
- Chase Canada returns to UNT and is set to start at CB. The Illinois transfer appeared in seven games for the Mean Green a season ago.

OH, CANADA

- Prior to the season running back **Nick Osho**, a product of Burnaby, British Columbia, Canada, was named the No. 3 rated CFL prospect in the 2027 prospect rankings from the CFL Scouting Bureau.
- Osho joined UNT in the offseason after spending the 2024 and 2025 season at Indiana State. Last season, Osho produced over 700 yards of total offense and nine touchdowns.
- Osho joins former UNT LB Jaylen Smith who was ranked 20th in 2025 as one of two UNT players to be ranked in the top-20 in the last three years. Smith was later drafted 15th overall in the CFL Draft by the Winnipeg Blue Bombers where he has seen action in over 25 games in his first two seasons in the CFL.
- Much like Smith, Osho prepped at St. Thomas More in Canada prior to entering college.

## DEFENSIVE LINE BUILT WITH SIZE

• The 2026 UNT defensive line, much like the rest of the roster, is set to be dominated by transfer portal prospects including Cal transfer **Curlee Thomas IV**, Georgia Southern transfer **Davion Rhodes**, ECU transfer **Justin Benton**, Central Oklahoma transfer **Wesley Hudson**, UMass transfer **David Onuoha** and UTEP transfer **Udoka Ezeani**.

- Rhodes has been the most productive player in the group with 100 tackles, 18.0 TFLs and 4.0 sacks in his career while starting 33 games across five seasons at Georgia Southern.
- Ezeani is coming off a productive season in 2025 at UTEP that saw him rack up 46 tackles and was second on the team with 11.0 TFLs while starting 12 games along the defensive line.
- Terrell Washington also returns to the roster after appearing in all 14 games for the Mean Green in 2025. His 13 total tackles last season are the most among any returner on UNT's roster in 2026.

## FORMER FRESHMAN ALL-AMERICANS

- The North Texas roster features three players who earned Freshman All-American honors in their respective careers. RB **Jahiem White**, OL **Chandler Strong**, and CB **Caden Jenkins** all were recognized for stellar seasons in 2023.
- White, while playing at WVU, picked up honors from The Athletic, PFF and On3 after rushing for 842 yards and averaging 7.7 yards per carry in his first season in Morgantown.
- Strong also earned Second Team accolades from College Football News after starting all 13 games at center as a redshirt freshman at Georgia Southern and helped lead them to a bowl appearance.
- Jenkins, meanwhile, was named a Second Team honoree by The Athletic after producing 37 tackles, three interceptions, three PBUs and a fumble recovery in his first year at Baylor. He unfortunately was lost for the entire 2026 season due to injury in training camp.

## BROTHERLY LOVE

- The UNT secondary features a pair of brothers in S **BJ Allen Jr.** and CB **Jaden Allen** along with S **Cameren Jenkins** and CB **Caden Jenkins**.
- The Allen brothers both have arrived at UNT through different paths as BJ is set for his third season with the Mean Green after transferring from Texas in 2023 while Jaden joined the roster after spending the 2025 season at Arkansas.
- The Jenkins brothers, meanwhile, joined the Mean Green roster alongside DC Matt Powledge as the twin brothers both played at Baylor in 2024 and 2025.
- In addition, Saturday's contest against Indiana will feature one more set of brothers as TE **Max Reese** is set to face off against his brother Garrett Reese who plays safety for the Hoosiers.

## GONE BOWLING

- After making just seven bowl appearances from 1914-2012, North Texas has now appeared in nine bowl games since 2013 and made eight appearances in the last 10 seasons.
- Since 2016, North Texas is one of just nine non-A4 programs to appear in at least eight bowls in the last 10 years and just one of two teams in the American (Memphis) with that claim.
- In that span, the Mean Green had previously lost each of their last seven bowl games but snapped the streak in 2025 with a 49-47 win over San Diego State in the Isleta New Mexico Bowl.

## APP STATE SPECIALISTS

- In the offseason, UNT hired Special Teams Coordinator **Jeff Crosby** from App State and he brought along with him three special teams player who all figure to play a big role for the Mean Green.
- K **Dominic De Freitas**, P **Ian Ratliff** and LS **Jacob Poff** all transferred to UNT from App State with Crosby in the offseason and are all set to start at their respective positions.
- De Freitas, more affectionately known as "Dom the Bomb", was a Third Team All-Sun Belt selection as a freshman for the Mountaineers. He connected on 21 of 27 field goals and hit all 33 of his extra points in 2025.
- Ratliff, meanwhile, averaged 43.8 yards per punt a season ago and had 50 punts downed inside the opponents' 20 yard line and seven punts of 50+ yards.

## GETTING IT DONE IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Mean Green excelled in the classroom in the Spring semester under Brown with a 3.345 team GPA, the highest spring semester GPA in program history.
- In total, five players on the roster were named to the President's List (4.0 GPA), 30 earned Dean's List honors (3.5-3.99) and 44 landed on the Honor Roll (3.0-3.49).
- The spring marked the sixth consecutive semester with a team GPA over 3.0.
- Additionally, 15 players on the roster have already received their college degrees who are listed in the column on the left.

NARROW MARGINS IN THE AMERICAN

- In the first 24 league games in the American for North Texas, nearly half (11) have been decided by one score (8 points or fewer).
- UNT 5-6 in those games after going 1-0 in one-score games in 2025, 2-2 in 2024 and 2-4 in 2023.

RELOAD, NOT REBUILD

- The 2026 season in its first year under head coach Neal Brown is an opportunity for the Mean Green to reload after a historic 2025 season.
- In 2025, UNT posted a school-best 12-2 overall record, advance to the American Conference Championship game and won the Isleta New Mexico Bowl for the program's first bowl win since 2013.
- The Mean Green closed 2025 as the No. 1 overall and No. 1 scoring offense in FBS while QB Drew Mestemaker led the nation in passing and RB Caleb Hawkins led the country in rushing touchdowns.
- North Texas will have an opportunity to finish back-to-back seasons above .500 for the first time since 2017-18.

MEAN GREEN FROM ALL OVER

- While the majority of the 2026 roster is from the state of Texas, the 2026 roster for UNT features players from a large contingent of states throughout the country.
- Of the 105 players on the roster, 65 hail from Texas while the remaining 40 arrived from outside the state. The 40 non-Texan players is the largest contingent of players from outside the state in program history. Despite this, UNT still has the 14th-largest percentage of players from its home state in the country.
- The largest portion of players from outside of the state come from Florida and Georgia who both have seven players on the 2026 roster. In addition, the Mean Green will also feature multiple players from Illinois (2), Indiana (2), New Jersey (2), Oklahoma (2) and Pennsylvania (3).
- The home-grown talent does originate from local places around UNT, however, with 40 of the 65 players from Texas coming from the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

- The 2025 season put UNT on the national stage in a way never seen before in program history.
- After setting a new program best with seven games on linear TV in 2024, the Mean Green bested that in one year with 10 linear contests in 2025.
- The final home game of the 2025 season against Temple was the first regular season contest for North Texas on ESPN in program history. North Texas has played on ESPN 11 times in history and all 10 of the other contests were either bowl games or conference championship contests.
- UNT has played four home games on ESPN2 (Tulane and Army, 2024 | USF and Navy, 2025) in the last two seasons. The Mean Green had not had a Saturday home game on ESPN2 prior to the 2024 season.
- North Texas looks to continue the trend in 2026 as six of the seven announced TV broadcasts for the season are set to be on linear networks, including North Texas first ever appearance on Big Noon Kickoff against Indiana in week one.

STONE COLD CELEBRATION

- Starting in 2023, when the defense creates a turnover a "Stone Cold" celebration begins on the sidelines.
- In honor of WWE Superstar Steve Austin, who played linebacker and defensive end at North Texas in the 1980s, players bang together two bottles of water while holding a wrestling belt to mimic the famous celebration of "Stone Cold" Steve Austin.
- In the 2025 win over Army, a video of Keviyen Huddleston's fumble recovery celebration generated over 10 million views on social media over the first 24 hours after posting. "And that's the bottom line."

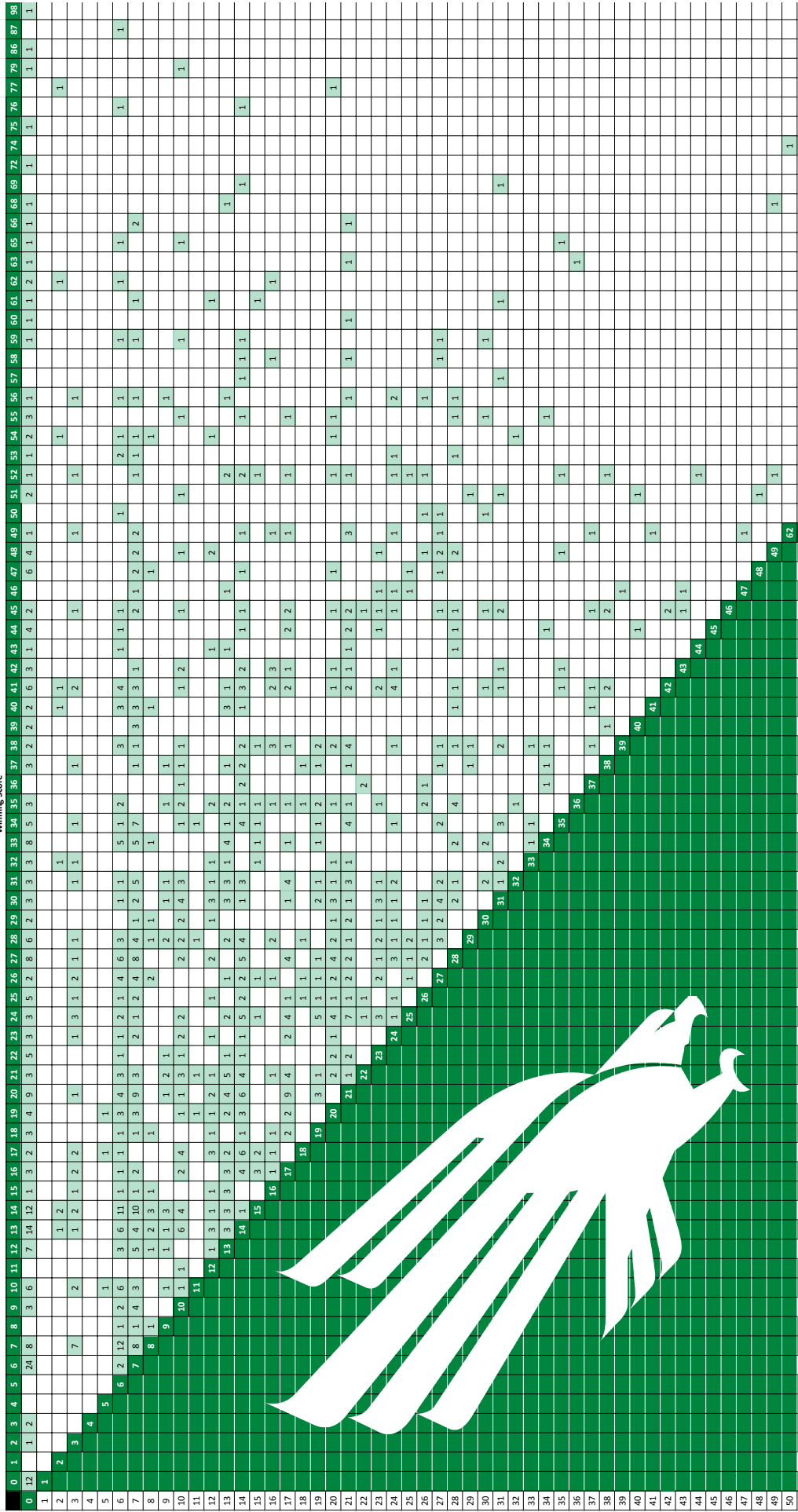

The bottom half is all dark green because the losing team can not score more points than the winning team. The number in the green square represents the amount of UNT games with that final score. Scores bordered in black are results from the 2025 season.
