After falling behind 50-45 to FGCU, the Gators allowed just nine points over the final 16 minutes, a stretch that began with a 15-0 Gator run. UF posted a 35-9 advantage after the 16-minute mark of the second half.

Five was a good number for Kevarrius Hayes in the season opener, as the sophomore set career highs in blocks, free throws made and free throws attempted with five in each category. Dating back to last season, Hayes has made 11 consecutive free throws.

Florida posted a +12 turnover margin in the season opener. UF committed just seven turnovers, marking the ninth time in 37 games under Mike White the Gators have had seven or fewer. The 19 turnovers forced matches the second-most under White

Canyon Barry scored his 900th career point in his Gator debut. Barry came to UF with 893 points scored at College of Charleston.

Four players made their Gator debut on Friday. In addition to Barry, redshirt freshman Keith Stone and true freshmen Eric Hester and Gorjok Gak saw the floor in orange and blue for the first time.

- Florida looks for a sweep of its opening weekend in Jacksonville, facing Mercer following Friday's season-opening 80-59 win vs. FGCU.
- The Gators closed strong in the win vs. FGCU on Friday, going on a 15-0 run to sieze control of the game. Over the final 16 minutes of the game, UF outscored the Eagles, 35-9.
- Florida is 5-7 all-time against Mercer, but the teams have only played twice since 1937, splitting a pair in the 1970s.
- While the Gators' home is renovated, their first seven games and nine of their first 11 will be neutral-site contests this season, with road games at Florida State and North Florida.
- Preseason All-SEC guard KeVaughn Allen is UF's top returning scorer, averaging 11.6 points per game last season and posting 12.3 per game in SEC action.
 The lone underclassman starter, Allen is plenty experienced in his own right, starting 34 of 36 games his freshman campaign.
- Preseason All-SEC center John Egbunu led the Gators in blocked shots (48), ranked second in rebounds (6.5) and third in scoring (11.5) last season. After suffering a torn ligament in his hand late last season, Egbunu returned fully healthy for the start of fall practice.
- Senior point guard Kasey Hill returns with a chance to join the 1,000-point club and reach UF's top five list in career assists. Hill also led the Gators in steals (53) last season.
- Junior wing man Devin Robinson started fast and led UF in scoring in the season opener, tallying 14 points after knocking down a pair of 3-pointers in the first two minutes of the game.
- Chris Chiozza emerged as Florida's assist leader last season (156), splitting point guard duties with Hill.
- Senior Justin Leon made his way into Florida's rotation as a hustle guy and ended the season with the team's best 3-point percentage (.373).
- Backup center Kevarrius Hayes started strong this season, blocking a careerbest five shots vs. FGCU in just 14 minutes.
- Freshman forward Keith Stone will constribute after redshirting last season to improve his game and spend time in the weight room.
- Graduate transfer wing Canyon Barry comes to Florida from College of Charleston, where he averaged 12.8 points per game, including 19.7 last season.
- Freshmen Eric Hester comes to Florida from Oldsmar Christian in the Tampa area. Hester is a long guard who is a plus defender.
- Gorjok Gak, who stands 6-foot-11 with a 7-foot-4 wingspan will provide frontcourt depth during his freshman season.
- Walk-on Schuyler Rimmer returns for his senior season, providing minutes at the center position.
- Sitting this season for Florida are Jalen Hudson (transfer, Virginia Tech) and Dontay Bassett (injury).

The University of Florida hired Mike White as head men's basketball coach, on Thursday, May 7 2015

In his first season at the helm, White guided Florida to a 21-15 record, one of three active SEC coaches to post a 20-win season in their first year on the job. It also matched a Florida record for most wins by a first-year head coach.

Under White, the Gators returned to the postseason, advancing to the quarterfinals of the NIT before falling to eventual tournament winner George Washington.



The Gators enter the second year under White's leadership with a unique challenge in front of them, playing the first 11 games of the season away from home as the renovation of Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center finishes. Florida has a total of just 10 home games this season and is scheduled to re-open the building following the \$64.5 million project on Dec. 21.

White, the 2014-15 Conference USA Coach of the Year, came to the Gators after leading Louisiana Tech to a 101-40 record (.716) over past four seasons, including three straight conference championships. Born in Dunedin, Fla., White brought a wealth of SEC experience to the Gators, as a four-year starter at Ole Miss and later an assistant coach for seven seasons under two different head coaches on the Rebels' bench.

QUOTABLE WHITE

On the first several days of practice (10/6, UF Media Day):

"It was as good of a first practice as I've been a part of as an assistant or a head coach. Day two and day three were pretty good. Day one was really good. So obviously when you go for a long time for the first time and you go bone on bone at that length for the first time, fatigue's going to set in, not only physically, but mentally. I think our guys were pretty beat up the last couple days, but fought through it."

On the team's strengths this season (10/6, UF Media Day):

"I think this team has good experience. We've got really good depth. In my opinion, we've got really good length. And those would be three of the biggest strengths that stick out with this team, so I think we can be really good defensively and that will be the challenge to this team just like it was last year. Just like it was last year, but I think we can be better this year defensively."

On grad transfer Canyon Barry (10/6, UF Media Day):

"Canyon came here to have a chance to play in an NCAA Tournament, to play with high-level players. Canyon wants to win, and I expect him to maintain that mentality more than anything else, whether that means he scores 21 a night or scores 4. That goes for everyone on our team. He's very capable of scoring the ball, but I think he's underrated in other areas. He's a great communicator. He's always talking. He's a quick thinker. He's a very good passer. He's probably our best post passer right now in evaluating three practices. Kind of sees things before he catches the ball, he's always checking the defense, very good vision. I think he's going to be a good scouting report guy."

MEDIA INFORMATION

The University of Florida appreciates the media coverage from all local, regional and national outlets. The Communications Office believes in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the media and we emphasize a positive and professional working environment with all entities. The ultimate goal of the Communications Office is to provide accurate and timely information about our athletic teams and to ensure that we assist the media to the best of our abilities while they cover our program.

GAME COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Denver Parler. To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystems.com/florida. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision on your request is made, you will receive an email with further information. Requests must be made by the day prior to a game (noon for afternoon games or 4:30 p.m. for evening games).

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: Credentials will be mailed up until 10 days prior to the event or held at the Press Will Call window at Gate One of the O'Connell Center, which opens for pick-up 90 minutes prior to each game. Credentials can be overnighted at the expense of the media organization within 10 days of the event (by request).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces exist and can be requested online with your credential application. Please note that if you request to pick up your credentials at Press Will Call, we will be unable to provide a parking pass as you will have to park before visiting Press Will Call. Free parking is available in the deck next to the O'Connell Center and is generally still available 75-90 minutes before the game.

MEDIA ROOM/INTERVIEW AREA: Located between Gates 1 & 4 in the Martial Arts room near the loading dock, the media room includes work space, necessary electrical outlets, a television and wireless internet. A pre-game meal, snacks and soft drinks are also available in the media room. The pre-game meal begins 1:15 before tip. Post-game coach and player press conferences are also conducted in this area.

FLORIDA LOCKER ROOM: The Gator locker room is closed to the media with the exception of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments. Coach White and selected players will be available to the media following games in the media room/interview area. At Florida home games, players are available first while Coach White will follow with a post-game press conference in the Martial Arts/Media Room. If the visiting team chooses to utilize the media room, they will do so either directly before or after Florida players. Coach White will typically go last.

VISITOR LOCKER ROOM: Interview policies and procedures will be determined by visiting Sports Information Directors and coaches. Those procedures will be announced on game days.

GENERAL GAME DAY MEDIA SERVICES: Game program/scorecard, game notes, play-by-play, complete halftime and final statistics, coaches' & player quote sheets and post-game notes are all regular services on game days.

SEATING: Press seating is assigned, and all media members are asked to utilize their assigned seat. A limited number of front-row courtside press seats are available and will be provided to national publications, major daily newspapers and/or those who cover Florida basketball regularly. Additional seating will be at the front row table in the baseline bleachers near Gate 2 and in the second row courtside behind the press table. Photographers are restricted to two baseline locations closest to the team benches.
