KEY STORYLINES

ROSTER TURNOVER

Radford will feature plenty of new faces this season after losing seven seniors to graduation, including six four-year members. They are replaced on the roster by six newcomers, including three transfers and three freshmen. Fourth-year junior Justin Cousin and sophomore standout Ed Polite, Jr. lead the group of Highlander returners.

ED'S ENCORE

After garnering Big South All-Freshmen Team honors last year, Ed Polite, Jr. will look to make an even greater impact during his sophomore campaign. Polite, Jr., was named All-Big South Second Team in the preseason after being among the league leaders in rebounding and blocked shots last year.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the first-ever meeting between the programs. Radford is 20-13 vs. opponents in the Southern Conference at the time of the game. The Highlanders hold a 35-38 mark against current SoCon teams, with over half of those games coming against VMI.

TEAM NOTES

SCOUTING MERCER

- Mercer is coming off an 80-67 comeback victory over Georgia Southern on Sunday in front of a sellout crowd at home.
- The Bears closed the game on a 25-4 run over the final seven minutes and put all five starters in double figures.
- Ria'n Holland, a junior college transfer, had 18 points in the victory and has led the team in scoring in each game, including 21 in a loss to Florida.
- Holland is averaging 21.0 ppg, while shooting 51 percent from the field, including 12 of 28 3-pointers.
- Demetre Rivers, another junior guard, is second on the team with 11.0 ppg, while junior forward Stephon Jelks has contributed 10.0 ppg and a team-high 5.7 rebounds. Jelks was the team's second-leading scorer last year.
- Jordan Strawberry, son of former major league baseball standout Darryl Strawberry, leads the team with 15 assists.
- The Bears have limited their opponents to 35 percent shooting and 65.3 ppg in the three games.
- Mercer has had five straight winning seasons, including 20-plus win campaigns and 19 victories each of the last two years since moving from the Atlantic Sun to the SoCon.

Justin Cousin, Donald Hicks and Polite, Jr. are averaging 7.0 or higher.

- The quartet of Tanner, Cooper, Cousin and Hicks are a combined 29 of 32 from the free-throw line.
- Backcourt newcomers Hicks and **Christian Bradford** are shooting a combined 44 percent (17 of 39) from the field. Hicks also is tied for team-high honors with eight offensive rebounds.
- Radford holds a 0.0 rebounding margin so far, both grabbing and allowing 38.3 rebounds per game. 11.5, with a sixth just below at 9.5.

POLITE, JR. EARNS PRESEASON ALL-BIG SOUTH HONORS

- Coming off his impressive all-around rookie season in which he earned Big South All-Freshman Team honors, forward **Ed Polite, Jr.** was selected to the All-Big South preseason second team. He is just the second Highlander under head coach Mike Jones to garner preseason all-conference honors, joining **Javonte Green**, who did so in 2013 and 2014.
- Polite, Jr. ranked fourth in the Big South with 7.4 rebounds per game last year – second in conference play at 8.2 – and tied for second with 55 blocks. Further, he stood second in the league and 40th in the NCAA with 3.2 offensive rebounds per game, third among freshmen nationally.

- As the Highlanders leading returning scorer (8.7 ppg), Polite, Jr. will look to step up his offensive game even more this season and he has worked hard in the offseason on improving his shooting range.
- Meanwhile, he figures to continue to be a force on the defensive end. His 55 blocks last season were the sixth-most in single-season program history.

COUSIN NOW THE TEAM LEADER

- Redshirt junior **Justin Cousin** is the lone player on the roster that has been with the program for four years.
- As a result, along with increasing his production on both ends of the floor, Cousin will be counted on more than anybody else to provide leadership, both vocally and by example.
- In terms of the box score, Cousin showed he was capable of putting up numbers in spurts last year. He posted double figures in five games and went through a six-game stretch in December and January in which he tallied at least eight in every contest.
- Cousin then broke out in the regular-season finale, scoring a career-high 24 points with seven 3-pointers. He followed up with 13 points and a career-best six rebounds in the first round of the Big South Tournament.

RADFORD ROUNDUP

- Radford plays the second of its four-game road swing as it looks to rebound from Sunday's 88-41 loss at Akron.
- With several players battling injuries, the Highlanders have had a different starting five in each game.
- Through three contests, **Caleb Tanner** is leading the team in scoring, averaging 10.3 ppg off the bench. He has connected on 7 of 17 3-point attempts.
- **Ed Polite, Jr.** returned to the lineup against Akron after missing one game and posted his second eight-rebound outing of the season, while also recording all of five of the team's steals – one shy of his career high.
- **Devonnte Holland** is now 13 of 14 from the field and is second on the squad with 9.7 ppg, along with sharing second with 6.3 rebounds per contest.
- **Devin Cooper** is third in scoring at 8.7 ppg, while



CHRISTY'S RETURN

- Aside from Ed Polite, Jr. and Justin Cousin, redshirt sophomore **Sterling Christy** is the lone returning Highlander that started more than one game last season.
- Christy played in the first nine games and started three of them before suffering a season-ending ACL injury on Dec. 6 against Coastal Carolina.
- Prior to the injury, Christy had averaged 3.1 points and 2.6 rebounds in 14.0 minutes per game.
- With the loss of four-year frontcourt players **Brandon Holcomb** and **Kion Brown**, Christy will see a much more prominent role this year, likely starting the season at the power forward spot.

TRIO OF TRANSFERS

- To offset the graduation losses and provide experience to a team with just returning scholarship upperclassmen, Mike Jones brought in three junior transfers that will play large roles for the Highlanders this season.
- Center Randy Phillips averaged 8.4 ppg and 6.5 rpg at East Central CC and posted five double-doubles in his last seven games. He will likely open the season as the starter in the middle.
- Christian Bradford totaled 813 points in two seasons at Marion Military Institute, averaging 18.5 ppg. Bradford will see significant minutes in the backcourt.
- Dominique Williams contributed 6.9 ppg and 4.5 rpg with seven double-figures games at Florida International and will contribute for Radford on the wing.

TAKING ON THE CHALLENGE

- After picking up impressive non-conference wins at Georgetown and Penn State last year, Radford is

challenging itself even more with its pre-Big South slate this year.

- The Highlanders face road matchups at Wake Forest and defending national runner-up North Carolina of the ACC and the Big 12's West Virginia.
- Radford also will take on formidable mid-major foes, playing at Akron, Mercer and UNC Wilmington, play neutral-site games against Georgia Southern and Stetson and host Elon and VMI.

RU VOTED SIXTH IN BIG SOUTH

- Radford was picked sixth in the Big South Conference's preseason poll comprised of votes from head coaches and media members.
- Winthrop was the unanimous favorite in the league, earning all 30 first-place votes.
- The Highlanders placed seventh in tightly bunched conference last year with a 9-9 record.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN

- RU's 2015-16 roster features 14 players representing six different states and the District of Columbia.
- Virginia is home to five of the members of this year's squad. The remaining nine is comprised of three from Maryland, two from North Carolina and one each from Georgia, Ohio, Mississippi and the District of Columbia.

RADFORD SPORTS NETWORK

- Each RU men's basketball game can be heard live in the New River Valley on the RU Sports Radio Network on the campus flagship, WRVU 89.9-FM and on the commercial affiliate, Supersports 101.7-FM.
- Rick Watson handles the play-by-play for the Highlanders.

- The live stream can also be heard world-wide on www.radfordathletics.com.

PLENTY OF AIR TIME

- A total of eight Highlanders' games this season are scheduled for national or regional TV broadcasts, beginning with Friday's opener on ESPN3's ACC Extra.
- Other televised non-conference games include Mercer (ASN), North Carolina (Raycom) and West Virginia (Nexstar).
- Radford will have two Big South games on ESPN3 (at Gardner Webb and vs. Longwood) and two on ASN (vs. High Point and at UNC Asheville)

UP NEXT

- Radford travels to Savannah, Ga. to complete the road trip, playing games against Stetson on Friday and Georgia Southern on Saturday as part of the Savannah Invitational.

Head Coach :: Sixth Season at Radford

On June 14, 2011, Radford University officials announced the hiring of former VCU assistant coach Mike Jones as the Highlanders' seventh head men's basketball coach.

After taking over a program with just one win in the season prior to him arriving on campus, Jones has Radford contending again in the Big South while competing against the nation's top conferences.

Last year, the Highlanders posted a double-overtime season-opening win at Georgetown and followed up with a victory at Penn State, the program's first over a Big 10 opponent.

During the 2013-14 and 2014-15 campaigns, Jones guided Radford to back-to-back 22-win seasons and its first-ever postseason victories in the CBI.

The recent success can be attributed to the foundation laid in year one with Big South All-Freshmen selections Javonte Green and R.J. Price. Green, who was Jones' first All-Big South performer, and Price spearheaded the Highlanders' resurgence to the top of the league.

Under Jones' tutelage, Green developed into one of the all-time greats in Radford men's basketball history. He finished his career second in scoring, first in rebounding, first in steals, second in free throws made, second in field goals made. Price left RU ranked fourth all-time in scoring.

Jones spent the 2009-10 and 2010-11 seasons at VCU, which included a magical run to the 2011 Final Four with wins over USC, Georgetown, Purdue,

Florida State and Kansas. While on Shaka Smart's staff, the Rams posted 55 wins over the final two seasons Jones was on the staff. Akron 88, Radford 41, (11/16/16)

AKRON, Ohio - The Radford men's basketball team got off to a rough start on its four-game road trip Sunday night, falling to perennial Mid-American Conference power Akron 88-41.

Playing in front of a hostile environment, the youthful Highlanders started the game with five missed shots and five turnovers before getting on the board on a jumper by Devin Cooper at the 13:38 mark of the half. By the point, Akron led 7-0 and the Zips steadily built on their advantage from there, led by 11 points from leading scorer Isaiah Johnson. Radford trailed 29-14 at halftime after connecting on just 5 of 23 field-goal attempts and committing 11 turnovers in the opening 20 minutes.

The second half also began poorly for Radford as Akron scored the first 10 points as part of a 17-3 run in the first six minutes for a 49-17 margin. The Zips went on to shoot 67 percent in the second half, including 8 of 15 3-pointers, en route to their second straight victory.

INSIDE THE BOX SCORE

- Caleb Tanner and Christian Bradford each scored eight points to lead Radford. Tanner had the team's only two 3-pointers, while Bradford made 4 of 10 shots.
- Devonnte Holland, who entered the game 10 of 10 from the field on the season, was 3 of 4 in the game for seven points, to go along with six rebounds. He connected on a putback basket on his first attempt before his first miss in three games came late in the first half.
- After missing one game, Ed Polite, Jr. returned to the lineup and totaled a team-high eight rebounds, while grabbing all five of the team's steals. He scored three points on 1 of 4 from the field.
- The Highlanders' shooting improved to 40 percent in the second half to finish at 31 percent for the game.
- The 41 points scored is the lowest for Radford since Clemson limited the 1998 team to 38.
- Sterling Christy sat out for the second straight contest.
- Johnson led four Akron players in double figures with 15 points.
- The Zips shot 57 percent from the field overall, totaled 13 3-pointers and scored 24 points off of 22 Radford turnovers.

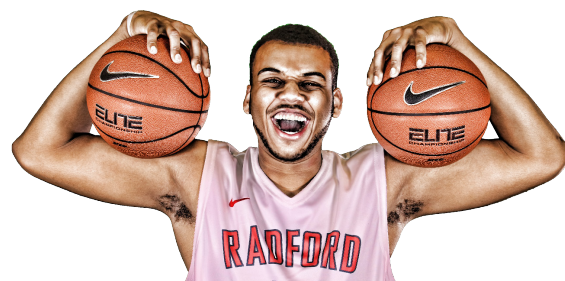
