Ria'n Holland added 15 points to go with eight rebounds and two steals as Mercer (3-1) remained perfect at home this season.







BEARS RETURN TO SAVANNAH FOR FIRST TIME IN A DECADE

Savannah – dubbed "The Hostess City of the South" – will play hostess to the Bears for the first time in a decade this weekend when Mercer plays in the inaugural Savannah Invitational. But when the Bears head towards the coast, they will be looking for a kinder reception from the hostess city as the last trip to Savannah did not result in the outcome Mercer was hoping for. Mercer has made four trips in all and has posted a 3-1 record in Savannah, falling in its last trip in the coastal town to Savannah State over a decade ago. The Bears have faced Savannah State in all four trips and this weekend's tournament will mark the first visit to the city for a neutral site game.

Mercer's defense has been suffocating this season and that has been problematic for opponents. The Bears, ranked 14th in the nation in field goal percentage defense entering this weekend's games (34.6 percent) have not allowed an opponent to shoot 40 percent or better this season. In fact, no team has shot 37 percent or better this season on the Bears.

NOT JUST A MERCER THING, IT'S A SOCON THING

Mercer's scoring defense is currently ranked 35th nationally as opponents are averaging 60.8 points per game on the Bears entering this weekend's contests but that does not seem to be limited just to the Bears. In fact, stellar scoring defenses are prevalent around the Southern Conference as, while Mercer is ranked 35th nationally, the Bears are just third in the league. The Missouri Valley Conference (4) is the only mid-major league with more teams ranked in the top 35 nationally in scoring defense than the Southern Conference (3). Also representing the SoCon in the category is Samford (ranked 21st, 58.7 ppg) and UNCG (23rd, 58.8).

RIA'N CHANNELS HIS INNER PETULA CLARK

Early in his first season in a Mercer uniform, Ria'n Holland has already established himself as a dangerous threat from downtown. He enters this game as one of the better shooters in the nation from beyond the arc.

LOCK DOWN D...

Mercer's defense has already made quite a statement early this season. The Bears enter this week's game ranked 14th in the nation (and first in the Southern Conference) in field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to only a 34.6 success rate in shooting the ball. That includes holding Florida - a perennial power house that averaged 42.6 percent shooting last year - to only 36.1 percent from the field on Nov. 13 against Mercer.

...STARTED AT THE BEGINNING...

Mercer's defense made an impressive showing in the second half of the season opener against Brewton-Parker on Friday, Nov. 11. The Bears made 22 consecutive defensive stops and held BPC scoreless over the final 12:25 in the game. Not a surprising performance, considering its numbers last year...

...INCLUDED A DEJA VU...

Had we seen that before? Mercer's defense went into lock down mode over the final seven minutes of the Bears' Nov. 20 game against Georgia Southern at Hawkins Arena, allowing only four points out of the opponents as Mercer ended the game on a 25-4 run. If that seems like a deja vu, maybe that's because it was...

...CONTINUED FROM LAST YEAR

The Bears held opponents to a combined shooting percentage of .402 from the field last season, the best mark in the SoCon. The Bears held 14 opponents to shooting under .400 percent from the floor. Mercer's defense has held four teams to 50 points or less last season (Alabama State, Alcorn State, Hiwassee and Samford).

JELKS RETURNS, WITH HONORS

An offseason after claiming All-Southern Conference honors, forward Stephon Jelks returns to Mercer for his junior season with fanfare. The Marietta, Georgia native was named to the 2016-17 Preseason All-SoCon Team by a vote of the league's coaches.

BOUNCING BACK

Mercer is 46-15 after a loss over the last five (entering six) seasons. That mark added two wins so far this year as the season opener followed last season's loss to Coastal Carolina while Mercer rebounded to the loss against Florida by beating Georgia Southern.

HOME, SWEET, HOME

Mercer is 73-12 at Hawkins Arena since the start of the 2011-12 season. The Bears have lost just once against a non-conference opponent in the regular season at Hawkins Arena since the beginning of the 2012 season, falling to Dartmouth, 67-51 on December 16, 2014.

NOT IN OUR HOUSE

Mercer excelled when playing in Hawkins Arena during the 2015-16 season. The Bears finished the regular season 11-3 at home with a scoring margin of +12.1 points in those games. The Orange and Black allowed opponents just 62.2 points per game and a field goal percentage of .376. That kind of success will look to be emulated as the 2016-17 season begins to get underway.

A PEACH OF A PROGRAM

Over the last five years Mercer has registered more wins overall and more wins per year than any other Division I program in Georgia.

BEST FANS IN THE LAND

The Bears set the Hawkins Arena single game attendance record on Jan. 16, 2016 against Wofford as 4,502 fans packed the house and then reset the record three weeks later with 4,772 spectators on hand. Mercer was third the SoCon in attendance last season, averaging 3,070 fans per game. The Bears recorded sellouts in 10-of-14 games last year, including eight of nine Southern Conference contests.

NON-CON EXCELLENCE

Last season Mercer finished with a non-conference record of 10-3, the best during head coach Bob Hoff man's eight-year tenure. The Bears previous best mark of nine wins came during the 2013-14 season that resulted in a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Mercer looks to match or best that this season.

GIANT SLAYERS

Mercer's win over Arkansas on Dec. 22, 2015 was head coach Bob Hoffman's 10th win against high-major competition in eight seasons with the Bears. Six of the victories have come against teams from the SEC. He's also led the team to wins over Alabama (twice), Auburn, Duke (2014 NCAA Tournament) Florida State, Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Seton Hall and Ole Miss.

Hoffman and the Bears will have multiple chances to slay more giants this year with games at Clemson (Dec. 10) and Auburn (Dec. 18).

With the win over Alabama State last season, Mercer head coach Bob Hoffman passed Robert Wilder (147) for second place on the Mercer all-time wins list with 148. Hoffman currently has 164 wins at Mercer while Bill Bibb currently ranks first in Mercer all-time coaching victories with 222.

REMEMBER, REMEMBER THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER

Last season Mercer finished it's best opening month in history, setting a program record for wins in November with six. Mercer was 6-1 and recorded wins over Allen, George Mason, Alabama State, Tulane, Appalachian State and Western Michigan.

STAIR CLIMBING

Last year then-freshman guard Ethan Stair has made an impressive debut in his first season at Mercer. Stair scored a career-high 15 points at Wofford (2/11), finishing 6-of-10 from the field, and is averaging 6.6 points per game. The freshman also excels in crashing the glass, posting a career-high nine rebounds against Western Michigan while averaging 4.1 rebounds per game.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Jordan Strawberry may have a famous name but he is using a different sport to prove he is his own man. The son of former New York Met Darryl Strawberry, Jordan is playing a different sport than his father but still finding a similar level of success. The 6-1 guard is in his junior season at Mercer and has the ability to be a game-changer on the court, just as his father was a game-changer on the diamond.




