Wildcat Tidbits

- Davidson will continue its stretch of seven out of eight away from home with a 7 p.m. tip at Mercer Tuesday evening.
- Winners of three straight, the Wildcats enter 4-1 following a 79-57 victory over cross-county rival Charlotte on Saturday.
- Jack Gibbs leads Davidson in scoring, averaging 21.0 points per outing.
- Fellow preseason all-conference selection Peyton Aldridge is second on the club at 19.8 points per game, while leading the way in rebounding (7.6).
- Through their first five contests, the Wildcats are holding opponents to just 36.9 percent from the floor.
- In addition, Davidson comes in with a +6.4 margin on the glass.

Last Meeting (vs. Mercer; 11/23/15)

- Peyton Aldridge scored 23 points and Jordan Barham recorded a double-double (19 pts, 11 rebs) to lead Davidson past Mercer, 77-71, on Nov. 23, 2015 at Belk Arena.
- Oskar Michelsen added 17 points, including five of Davidson's nine 3-pointers, while Brian Sullivan had 12 points to go along with a career-high 9 assists in 40 minutes.
- The Wildcats shot just 37.1 percent overall, but

connected on 22-of-28 from the charity stripe. Davidson also turned 14 Mercer (3-1) miscues into 26 points at the other end.

- Stephon Jelks led the Bears with 18 points and 11 rebounds, while Jestin Lewis finished with 10 points.
- The Wildcats opened the second half on a 14-5 run and stretched their lead to as many as 16, 55-39, with 12:49 to play.
- After a Jordan Strawberry trey with 1:03 left capped a 16-5 Mercer streak to cut the deficit to 69-67, the Wildcats got four straight from Nathan Ekwu to put the game out of reach.
- The Bears also struggled offensively shooting just 40 percent from the floor.
- Davidson, which got 12 points from Michelsen



in the first 20 minutes, used a 10-3 spurt late in the period to break a 26-26 tie, before going to the half up, 36-31.



Last Time Out (vs. Charlotte; 11/26/16)

- Jordan Watkins led five Davidson players in double figures with a game-high 22 points and the Wildcats claimed the Hornets' Nest Trophy for the fourth straight season, with a 79-57 victory over cross-county rival Charlotte, Saturday afternoon at John M. Belk Arena.
- A junior from Charlotte, Watkins finished 7-of-9 from the floor and drilled six of Davidson's nine 3-pointers.
- Preseason all-conference selections Peyton Aldridge and Jack Gibbs scored 13 points each, Will Magarity recorded his first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds and Jon Axel Gudmundsson added 11 points.
- Davidson (4-1), which held the 49ers to just 27.9 percent from the field, raced out to a 28-8 advantage before going to the half up, 43-28.
- The Wildcats began the second half on a 21-4 spurt to stretch the margin to as many as 32 with 10 minutes to play.

'Cats to Play in 2017 Diamond Head Classic

• The field is set for the 2017 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic at the Stan Sheriff Center in Honolulu. The field for the eighth annual event – to be played Friday, Saturday and Monday, Dec. 22, 23 and 25, 2017 – includes Akron, Davidson, Miami, Middle Tennessee, New Mexico State, USC, Utah State and tournament host school Hawai'i.

A Looonnng-Range Streak

- The Wildcats have canned at least one 3-pointer in 709 consecutive games.
- The last time the Wildcats failed to hit a three-pointer in a contest came on January 15, 1994, in a 65-63 victory at ETSU (0-for-0).

- Jack Gibbs has been named to the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Wendy's® Preseason Top 50, as announced Nov. 15 on ESPN's SportsCenter and on ESPN.com.
- Chosen by a preseason poll of national college basketball experts, the list is comprised of 50 student-athletes, who are early front-runners for

- college basketball's most prestigious individual honor.
- Gibbs has also been named to the Naismith, Bob Cousy and Lute Olson Award watch lists (See Below).

Gibbs on Naismith Preseason Watch List

- Senior Jack Gibbs has been named to the James Naismith Trophy Preseason Watch List, as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club on Nov. 10, 2016.
- Gibbs is the first Wildcat named to the list since Stephen Curry in 2008-09.
- The mid-season list of 30 will be announced February 9, 2017.

Gibbs Named Cousy Award Candidate

- On Oct. 17, 2016, The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced Monday that Davidson's Jack Gibbs is one of 20 candidates for the 2017 Bob Cousy Award, which is given annually to the top point guard in Division I men's college basketball.
- Gibbs is the first Davidson Wildcat named to the list since Jason Richards (2008) and Stephen Curry (2009) were recognized in consecutive years.

Olson Preseason Watch List

- For the second straight season Jack Gibbs has been named to the Lute Olson watch list.
- Named in honor of Hall of Fame coach Lute Olson, the award is presented annually to the nation's top Division I player who has played at least two seasons.

Elite Company

- With his 43-point performance against UMass (Jan. 16, 2016), Jack Gibbs joined Stephen Curry (6), John Gerdy (3) and Fred Hetzel (3) as the only Wildcats with at least three 40-point games.
- Curry (2,635 points), Gerdy (2,483) and Hetzel (2,032) are the only players in school history to score over 2,000 career points.

Gibbs and Curry

- Dating back to 1979, Jack Gibbs and Stephen Curry are the only Davidson players to score at least 40 points in a contest.
- Gibbs has accomplished the feat three times, while Curry reached the 40-point plateau 6 times (1 2007-08; 5 2008-09).
- In addition, Curry hit the 35-point plateau 13 times, while Gibbs has done it seven, including six times last season.

Roster Breakdown

- The 2016-17 men's basketball roster will feature four seniors, seven juniors (1 redshirt) and six freshmen (2 redshirt).
- 11 players hail from the United States.
- Davidson also has six players with international roots Nathan Ekwu (Enugu, Nigeria), Manu Giamoukis (Thessaloniki, Greece), Jon

• Peyton Aldridge, Jack Gibbs, Will Magarity and Rusty Reigel will serve as team captains for the 2016-17 season.

Belk Arena - Home Sweet Home

- Davidson has won 36 of 38 home games dating back to 2013-14 at Belk Arena.
- The building record is 26 consecutive wins (1/27/07 2/7/09).
- The program record for consecutive home wins is 59, a mark that was established from 1962-71 at Johnston Gymnasium, which is now the student center.
- After posting a 9-17 record in Belk Arena its first two seasons, Davidson has recorded a 278-60 mark there in the last 26 seasons, including two undefeated campaigns.
- Overall, Davidson boasts a 289-77 (.789) record in Belk Arena.

Atlantic 10 Firsts

- On Jan. 3, 2015, Davidson played its first-ever Atlantic 10 contest against Richmond.
- The Wildcats defeated the Spiders 81-67 for their first A-10 victory.
- Davidson recorded its first-ever A-10 road win on Jan. 14, 2015 at UMass.
- With their win over Duquesne (3/7/15), the 'Catts captured their first-ever A-10 regular season title.
- Davidson's last-second win over La Salle in the 2015 quarterfinals was its first A-10 Tourney triumph.

Against Top-25 Foes

- With its win over No. 22/22 Dayton on Jan. 20, 2015, Davidson is 15-103 all-time against nationally-ranked teams.
- It was the Wildcats' first-ever win over a ranked team at Belk Arena.
- All-time against ranked foes, Davidson is 1-12 at home, 3-46 on the road, 11-45 at home and 3-9 in the NCAA Tournament.

Southern Conference Success

• Davidson, which joined the Atlantic 10 in July of 2014, won 28 of its last 29 Southern Conference games and 35 of 37 dating back to 2011-12.

- The Wildcats were 124-22 (.849) in their last 146 regular-season Southern Conference contests, dating back to 2006-07.
- Davidson also won 30 of its last 31 conference games at home dating back to 2010-11.
- In addition to winning 14 straight league games away from home, the Wildcats went 61-12 (.835) in their last 73 SoCon road games.
- Davidson had a 43-game conference win streak snapped at home against College of Charleston Feb. 7, 2009. It was one win away from tying the record held by West Virginia and 8th-longest in college basketball history.
- McKillop led the Wildcats to double-digit league wins 20 times, including the last 13 years.
- Davidson won 23 Southern Conference regular-season championships in school history.

2016-17 Preseason Notes

- The 2016-17 season marks the 109th in the history of Davidson men's basketball.
- The Wildcats, who were picked fourth in the Atlantic 10 Preseason Poll, return four starters from last year's team that finished 20-13 overall, 10-8 in the Atlantic 10 and advanced to the Postseason NIT.
- ◆ Head Coach Bob McKillop is in his 28th season at the helm.
- The 10-time Conference Coach of the Year has won more games in Davidson and league history than any other coach.
- Entering the 2016-17 campaign, his victory total ranks 24th on the NCAA's list of Division I winningest active coaches.
- McKillop also ranks sixth among active coaches on the NCAA's list of most seasons with their current school.
- Davidson is led by two-time all-conference performer Jack Gibbs, who ranked sixth nationally in scoring a year ago, averaging 23.7 points per game.
- Gibbs also ranked among league leaders in scoring (1st), assists (4th), steals (5th), 3-point field goals per game (T-6th) and free-throw percentage (7th).
- In 2015-16, Gibbs scored at least 40 points in a game three times, 35 or more seven times and hit the 30-point mark 10 times.
- The only player with more 40-point games in a season over the last six years is Jimmer Fredette (BYU; 2010-11).
- The Wildcats also welcome back junior Peyton Aldridge, who averaged 15.5 points and led the team in rebounding (6.5 rpg) and free-throw percentage (.847).
- Gibbs (first team) and Aldridge (third team) were selected preseason all-conference.
- Boston College transfer Will Magarity (R-Jr., 6-11, 240 lbs) will be eligible for the 2016-17 season.
- In addition, Dusan Kovacevic (R-Fr., 6-10, 245 lbs) and KiShawn Pritchett (R-Fr., 6-6, 230 lbs) return from season-ending injuries that were suffered prior to last season.
- The Wildcats also welcome freshmen Jon Axel Gudmundsson, Michael Brown, Cal Freundlich and Malcolm Wynter to this year's team.
- This year's roster features six international players.
- Four members of McKillop's staff are Davidson graduates.
- Davidson has advanced to postseason play 21 times (13 NCAA, 7 NIT, 1 CBI) in school history.
- The Wildcats have advanced to postseason play six straight years and 11 of the last 12.

Davidson's Record

- Davidson has hit the 20-win plateau 14 times under Bob McKillop, including 10 of the last 12
- In just two seasons in the Atlantic 10, the Wildcats are 24-12 against league competition.
- Davidson has finished with double-digit conference wins 22 times under McKillop.

- Now in his 28th season, Bob McKillop is the sixth longest-tenured coach in the country. His 520 career victories rank him 24th on the NCAA's list of Division I winningest active coaches.
- Along with hitting the 20-win plateau 23 times in school history, Davidson has posted 20 wins in a season 14 times under McKillop, including 10 of the last 12 years.
- In addition, McKillop ranks sixth among active coaches on the NCAA's list of most seasons with their current school.

- McKillop picked up career win No. 500 in his 800th game coached, an 83-70 victory over Denison on November 28, 2015.



2015 ATLANTIC 10 CONFERENCE Regular Season Bob McKillop is in his 28th season as the head coach of the Davidson Wildcats.

Picked to finish 12th in the preseason poll, McKillop led the Wildcats to the 2015 Atlantic 10 Regular Season Title in their first season, earning him his 10th (9 - SoCon, 1 A-10) conference coach of the year honor.

In two seasons in the Atlantic 10, the Wildcats have totaled 24 wins, while reaching the tournament semifinals both years.

The 2007-08 NABC National Coach of the Year led Davidson to the 2008 NCAA Tournament Midwest Regional Championship game with victories over Gonzaga, Georgetown and Wisconsin. The Wildcats' unbelievable run ended with a two-point loss to eventual champion Kansas, and Davidson finished the campaign with a final ranking of ninth in the ESPN/USA Today Poll.

To go along with tying the school's single-season record for wins with 29, McKillop and the Wildcats strung together 25 consecutive victories, the longest streak in the nation, before falling to the Jayhawks on the doorstep of the Final Four.

Five of the last 10 campaigns have seen the Wildcats collect 25 or more victories, including a 25-8 mark in 2011-12 and 26-8 record in 2012-13.

The Wildcats' 2016 NIT appearance marks the 15th postseason berth under McKillop — the NCAA Tournament in 1998, 2002, 2006-08, 2012, 2013, 2015 and the NIT in 1994, 1996, 2005, 2009, 2014 and 2016. McKillop-coached teams have now reached the 20-win plateau 14 times, and six have won 25 or more games.

The 10-time Conference Coach of the Year has won more games in Davidson and league history than any other coach thanks to an all-time mark of 520-314. Entering the 2016-17 campaign, his victory total ranked 24th on the NCAA's list of Division I winningest active coaches. McKillop also ranks

sixth among active coaches on the NCAA's list of most seasons with their current school and is one of six on that list who has spent their entire careers at that school.

McKillop's teams have been successful off the court as well. He has had a perfect Academic Progress Rate of 1,000 each year since the NCAA began tracking it in 2003, and all 90 of his seniors have graduated. During his 26 years coaching against league competition, he has guided the Wildcats to at least 10 wins in conference play 22 times.

The Wildcats went undefeated in the SoCon with a 20-0 record in 2007-08, the third time Davidson accomplished the feat under McKillop (14-0, 1995-96; 16-0, 2004-05). Davidson had a 43-game conference win streak from 2007-09. It was one away from tying the SoCon record and the eighth longest in college basketball history.

A 1972 graduate of Hofstra, McKillop guided the Wildcats to 13 SoCon divisional titles, including 10 of the last 13 they were in the league.

Fifty-three of his players have gone on to play professionally, including Stephen Curry, the seventh pick in the 2009 NBA draft, who led the Golden State Warriors to the 2015 NBA Championship while earning back-to-back NBA MVP honors.

An inductee into the Hofstra Basketball and NYC Basketball Hall of Fame, McKillop was signed and then cut by the Philadelphia 76ers before beginning his coaching career at Holy Trinity HS.

A native of Queens, N.Y., McKillop and his wife Cathy have three children — Kerrin, a 2002 Davidson graduate, Matt, a member of the 2006 NCAA Tournament team and 2006 graduate, and Brendan, a member of the 2008 Elite Eight team and a 2011 graduate. The McKillop's have three grandchildren, Maggie, Claire and Jack.
