BEARS

PATRIOT POINTS

- ▶ Mason returns home to battle mid-major power Mercer on Saturday (Dec. 3) inside EagleBank Arena.
- ▶ The Patriots are in the midst of a four-game winning streak, highlighted by a 54-50 victory at then top-5 RPI team Northern Iowa Wednesday in Cedar Falls.
- ▶ Mason held the Panthers to season lows in FG% (.259) and 3pt FG% (.250) in the contest. The Patriots limited UNI to 1-of-17 shooting to start the game.
- ▶ UNI entered the contest 26-1 in November games in the McLeod Center. Mason now owns two of the 11 non-conference victories by opponents in McLeod since it opened in 2006. UNI is 56-11 against non-conference foes in the arena.
- ▶ Sophomore Jaire Grayer led Mason with 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds in the game. Freshman Justin Kier chipped in nine points and eight rebounds and hit all six of his free throws in the final five minutes (4-4 under 2 min).
- ► Senior Marquise Moore grabbed 13 rebounds at UNI, marking his fifth game with 10+ rebounds. He is the top rebounding guard in the nation (9.8 rpg) and joins Lonzo Ball (UCLA) as the only two guards in the country with 4+ double-doubles.
- ▶ Mason held a +24 (53-29) rebounding margin against the Panthers. The Patriots are 4-1 when they outrebound their opponent this season and are 38th nationally in rebounding margin (+7.3).

PROBABLE STARTERS

No.

- ▶ Mason is one of the best teams in the nation in drawing fouls and getting to the line. The Patriots are 38th nationally in free throw attempts and 41st in free throws made.
- ▶ Mason is 2-2 in home games this season and 4-1 in games away from EagleBank Arena.
- ▶ The Patriots are holding opponents to 39.3 percent shooting (92-234) and 29.4 percent (30-102) from beyond the arc during the current four-game win streak.
- ▶ Mason's nine-man rotation over the last four games has featured five freshmen and two sophomores. According to KenPom.com, Mason is 309th out of 351 Div. I teams in experience (1.25 years/player).
- ► Five Mason players are averaging at least four rebounds, while three are averaging at least two assists.
- ▶ Redshirt-senior Jalen Jenkins leads the Atlantic 10 in field goal percentage (.708) and offensive rebounds per contest (3.4). He is 43rd nationally in offensive board per game.
- ▶ Jenkins is 17th all time at Mason in career rebounds (555) while fellow senior Marguise Moore is 16th all time in assists (267).
- ► Four of the next six Mason games will be inside EagleBank Arena.
- ▶ The Patriots return nine letterwinners and three starters from the 2015-16 season.

Last Time Out - Mason 54, Northern Iowa 50 McLeod Center - Cedar Falls, Iowa | November 30, 2016

CEDAR FALLS, Iowa - The George Mason University men's basketball team crashed the glass and hunkered down on defense during an outstanding 54-50 road victory over Northern Iowa Wednesday night inside the McLeod Center.

The Patriots held a +23 (53-30) edge on the glass against the Panthers, despite playing a lineup for times in the game that did not feature a player over 6-foot-4 inches tall.

In an excellent defensive effort, the Patriots held Northern lowa (3-3) to 25.9 percent shooting, including a 25.0 percent (8-32) mark from the 3-point line. UNI had entered the game shooting 40 percent from beyond the arc.

Sophomore Otis Livingston II exploded to the rim and scored to put Mason in front (48-47) with 1:40 to play.

After a UNI miss, the Panthers fouled with 50 seconds to go. Freshman Justin Kier hit 2-of-2 free throws to put Mason up three (50-47), and the Patriots went 2-for-2 in an additional two trips to ice the game.

MEDIA COVERAGE

Saturday's game will be streamed live on the A10 Digital Network. Bill Rohland will call the game, with pregame radio coverage beginning at 3:45 p.m.

HISTORY vs. MERCER

Saturday's game marks the third ever meeting between George Mason and Mercer in men's basketball. The two teams have split the previous two meetings. Mason upended the Bears, 62-59, during the 2012 Paradise Jam, but Mercer won last season's meeting, 69-60, in Macon. Otis Livingston tallied 17 points and five assists in last season's meeting, while Jaire Grayer chipped in 10 points.

HISTORY vs. SOCON OPPONENTS

Mason has posted a 5-6 (.454) all-time record against current members of the Southern Conference. The Patriots' most common foes are UNCG (3-0), Mercer (1-1), VMI (1-1) and East Tennessee State (0-2).

A LOOK AT THE BEARS (4-3, 0-0 SOCON)

Mercer was picked to finish 4th out of 10 teams in the 2016-17 Southern Conference preseason poll. A perennial mid-major power, the Bears have made a postseason appearance in each of the past five seasons, highlighted by an upset of third-seeded Duke (78-71) during the 2014 NCAA Tournament. This season the Bears are 4-3, with Div. I victories over Georgia Southern (80-67), Radford (58-47) and East Carolina (70-66). Junior guard Ria'n Holland ranks fourth in the SoCon in scoring (18.6 ppg) and is shooting 42.3 percent (22-52) from 3-point range. Fellow junior Demetre Rivers chips in 11.0 ppg while junior guard Jordan Strawberry averages 7.6 points and dishes out a team-high 4.0 assists/contest (t-8th in the SoCon).

UP NEXT

Mason hits the road for the first game of a two-game road swing. The Patriots will head to State College to take on Penn State on Wednesday (Dec. 7) at 7 p.m. The game will air live on the Big Ten Network.

50 YEARS OF MASON HOOPS

The George Mason men's basketball program plans to celebrate a significant milestone all season long. The Patriots will be recognizing 50 years of George Mason men's basketball. Since Mason first took the court on Dec. 6, 1966, the Patriots (first called the Marauders) have played more than 1,400 games.

OTIS AT THE FOUL LINE

Otis Livingston is shooting a team-high 95.0% (19-20) from the charity stripe. The lone miss came in the game against Lebanon Valley College. He has made his last 12 attempts from the line.

SEEING DOUBLE

Senior starters Jalen Jenkins and Marquise Moore have led the Patriots young team of 11 underclassmen in the first eight games with six double-doubles between them. Moore got his fourth vs. Bradley (11/23). Jenkins recorded 11 boards in two games with 10 and 23 points.

Moore is second in the A-10 in defensive rebounds per game (8.3/ game) and is second in overall rebounding (9.8/game). The Queens, N.Y., product also is one of only 26 players nationally to have posted at least four-double doubles in 2016-17. Moore and UCLA's Lonzo Ball are the only two guards in the nation with 4+ double-doubles.

MADNESS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Moore was named College Sports Madness Atlantic 10 Player of the Week on Monday (11/28). He led the Patriots in three four games on the week, averaging 18.7 points, including a career-high tying 23 points against Kent State. He recorded two of his four double-doubles on the season during that span, against Kent State (23 points, 14 rebounds) and Bradley (17 points, 15 rebounds), both wins. He shot 48.8% from the field and got to the foul line 37 times, making 25, and dished out 12 assists.

TEAM EFFORT

In the first eight games, the 4-3 Patriots have three players scoring in double figures. Marguise Moore is averaging 16.9 points and a teamhigh 9.8 rebounds. Sophomore Otis Livingston II has contributed 13.8 points and a team-high 3.1 assists per game. Guard Jaire Grayer is at 10.0 points and has a team-high 12 blocks.

FRESHMEN MINUTES

Several freshmen have earned some time on the court. Guards Justin Kier started the last seven games and is averaging 6.5 points and 5.6 rebounds including 10 boards against Bradley (11/23). Ian Boyd (15.5), Karmari Newman (14.8) and Troy Temara (11.4), each have come off the bench.

IMPROVED SHOOTING

Mason's four-game winning streak can be attributed in part to an improved shooting touch and contributions from a number of players on the roster. Leading up to the streak, Mason was shooting 19.7 percent (12-61) from 3-point range and 64.7 percent (55-85) from the free throw line. Those numbers have increased to 30.9 percent (21-68) from deep and 74.8 percent (77-103) from the line.

In addition, freshman guard Justin Kier averaged 4.8 points and 3.8 rebounds over the season's first four games, but is up to 8.3 points and 7.5 rebounds/game during the 4-game winning streak. Fellow freshman Karmari Newman also has jumped up from 2.5 ppg (.091 3pt FG%) to 5.3 ppg (.313 3pt FG%)
