OPENING TIPOFF

Mercer will play just its second true road game of the season Saturday when the Bears visit Clemson for the first time in over 22 years.

SERIES HISTORY

Mercer and Clemson will meet for the 11th time overall and first time since 1994 in a series that dates back to the 1921-22 season.

Mercer won the first four meetings with Clemson taking the last six in the series.

SCOUTING CLEMSON

Clemson enters the game with a 5-2 mark, having won their last three. In the lone common opponent, CU defeated Davidson 95-78 on Nov. 17.

The Tigers are led by Jaron Blossomgame's 17.4 points per game and Clemson has five players currently averaging double-digit points. Sidy Djitte is averaging 10.4 rebounds per game.

LAST TIME OUT

Demetre Rivers scored career highs with 30 points and 5 of 9 3-pointers and Mercer cruised past Division III Oglethorpe 98-41 on Wednesday night.

Rivers, who turned 21 Wednesday, scored 20 points and made four 3s in the first half, including back-to-back 3-pointers amid a game-breaking 17-2 run, and the Bears (5-4) led 45-25 at halftime.





REMEMBER US?

The players probably don't. Saturday's game will mark the first time in 22 years (and five days, to be exact) that Mercer and Clemson have met on the hardwood. That is longer that most of the players on both sides have been alive (Mercer's Demetre Rivers just turned 21 on Wednesday).

Despite the proximity (the two campuses are separated by 165 miles) this will only mark the 11th meeting between the Bears and the Tigers (but no lions, oh my!). The two teams met five times between 1922 and 1935 but were never conference mates as Mercer entered the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association in 1921, the year after Clemson left for the Southern Conference. Mercer joined the SoCon starting with the 2014-15 season.

LAST TIME OUT VS. THE ACC

RALEIGH, N.C. (AP) -- Dunk City is long gone. Make way for the next bunch of bracket busters from the little-known Atlantic Sun Conference: Mercer.

Daniel Coursey scored 17 points as the 8,300-student school from Macon, Ga., delivered the biggest shocker in an already topsy-turvy NCAA tournament on Friday, going into Duke's backyard and knocking off the No. 3 seed Blue Devils, 78-71.

"This," Atlantic Sun player of the year Langston Hall said, "is what March Madness is all about."

The 14th-seeded Bears -- with a starting lineup of five seniors -- came back from five points down in the last 4:52 as Duke's offense collapsed.

They sent home one of the true blue-blood programs, coached by Hall of Famer Mike Krzyzewski and starring freshman Jabari Parker, who might have played his last game before heading to the NBA.

Mercer is coached by former Oklahoma Baptist player Bob Hoffman, who has banged around the coaching ranks from women's teams to the American Basketball Association to the Rio Grande Valley Vipers of the NBA Developmental League.

Next up: 11th-seeded Tennessee, which beat sixth-seeded Massachusetts 86-67, on Sunday in the third round.

Jakob Gollon scored 20 points and Daniel Coursey scored 17, helping the Bears overcome a season-high 15 3-pointers from Duke.

Mercer qualified for its first NCAA tournament since 1985 by winning the Atlantic Sun conference championship over Florida Gulf Coast, nicknamed "Dunk City" for the team's above-the-rim offense. A year earlier, the Bears lost that game and watched FGCU advance to the Sweet 16.

"When they were going on their run, we were sitting at home thinking, 'Man, that could have been us," Anthony White Jr. said.

Now it is.

Mercer scored 11 straight points during the late 20-5 run that clinched the biggest victory in school history and sent the Blue Devils to their second first-game exit in three years.

Quinn Cook scored 23 points and Rasheed Sulaimon added 20 for Duke.

TAKING CARE

Early this season Mercer is one of the better teams in the nation in taking care of the ball. Entering this week's games, the Bears are ranked 29th nationally and first in the Southern Conference in turnovers per game. Mercer is only giving away the ball at a rate of 11.2 per game, one of the best marks in the nation.

DOES IT GET ANY EASIER?

Bob Hoffman claimed before the season started that this might be Mercer's toughest schedule yet in his nine years in Macon. He might be right. Mercer's strength of schedule currently ranks 46th in the nation (tied with Texas A&M). Bears opponents have accumulated a record of 32-19 so far this season, a .627 winning clip ranking 46thth nationally and first in the Southern Conference.

RIA'N CHANNELS HIS INNER PETULA CLARK

Early in his first season in a Mercer uniform, Ria'n Holland has already established himself as a dangerous threat from downtown. He enters this game as one of the better shooters in the nation from beyond the arc.

What a Mercer debut for Ria'n Holland. The redshirt junior that previously played at Wichita State by way of Indian Hills CC made his inaugural game in a Bears uniform a memorial one as he scored a game-high 24 points and was 5-for-11 from behind the arc.

LOCK DOWN D...

Mercer's defense has already made quite a statement early this season. The Bears enter this week's game ranked 52nd in the nation (and first in the Southern Conference) in field goal percentage defense, holding opponents to only a 39.0 success rate in shooting the ball. That includes holding Florida - a perennial power house that averaged 42.6 percent shooting last year - to only 36.1 percent from the field on Nov. 13 against Mercer.

...STARTED AT THE BEGINNING...

Mercer's defense made an impressive showing in the second half of the season opener against Brewton-Parker on Friday, Nov. 11. The Bears made 22 consecutive defensive stops and held BPC scoreless over the final 12:25 in the game. Not a surprising performance, considering its numbers last year...

...RESPONSIBLE FOR DRY SPELLS...

If at first you don't succeed, try again. Surely that is Mercer opponents' mantra this season as the Bears defense is leaving other teams plenty of rebound opportunities. A stingy defense forced East Carolina on Nov. 25 to not make a field goal in two long stretches that combined for 12 minutes and then even held Davidson on Nov. 29 to a 5 1/2 minute stretch without a field goal.

The Bears held opponents to a combined shooting percentage of .402 from the field last season, the best mark in the SoCon. The Bears held 14 opponents to shooting under .400 percent from the floor. Mercer's defense has held four teams to 50 points or less last season (Alabama State, Alcorn State, Hiwassee and Samford).

A PEACH OF A PROGRAM

Over the last five years Mercer has registered more wins overall and more wins per year than any other Division I program in Georgia.

BOUNCING BACK

Mercer is 47-17 after a loss over the last five (now six) seasons. That mark added two wins so far this year as the season opener followed last season's loss to Coastal Carolina while Mercer rebounded to the loss against Florida by beating Georgia Southern.

HOME, SWEET, HOME

Mercer is 78-10 at Hawkins Arena since the start of the 2011-12 season. The Bears have lost just twice against a non-conference opponent in the regular season at Hawkins Arena since the beginning of the 2012 season, falling to Dartmouth, 67-51 on December 16, 2014 and then to Davidson, 78-57, on November 29, 2016.

NOT IN OUR HOUSE

Mercer excelled when playing in Hawkins Arena during the 2015-16 season. The Bears finished the regular season 11-3 at home with a scoring margin of +12.1 points in those games. The Orange and Black allowed opponents just 62.2 points per game and a field goal percentage of .376. That kind of success will look to be emulated as the 2016-17 season begins to get underway.

BEST FANS IN THE LAND

There is little doubt that Mercer fans are some of the best in the region. Entering games early in December, Mercer has a league-lead in average attendance over its home games in Hawkins Arena.

That's not surprising as new attendance records at Hawkins Arena were set twice last season. Mercer was third in the SoCon in attendance last season, averaging 3,070 fans per game. The Bears recorded sellouts in 10-of-14 games last year, including eight of nine Southern Conference contests.

NON-CON EXCELLENCE

Last season Mercer finished with a non-conference record of 10-3, the best during head coach Bob Hoffman's eight-year tenure. The Bears previous best mark of nine wins came during the 2013-14 season that resulted in a trip to the NCAA Tournament. Mercer looks to match or best that this season.

GIANT SLAYERS

Mercer's win over Arkansas on Dec. 22, 2015 was head coach Bob Hoffman's 10th win against high-major competition in eight seasons with the Bears. Six of the victories have come against teams from the SEC. He's also led the team to wins over Alabama (twice), Auburn, Duke (2014 NCAA Tournament) Florida State, Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Seton Hall and Ole Miss.

Hoffman and the Bears will have multiple chances to slay more giants this year with games at Clemson (Dec. 10) and Auburn (Dec. 18).

MOVING ON UP

With the win over Alabama State last season, Mercer head coach Bob Hoffman passed Robert Wilder (147) for second place on the Mercer all-time wins list with 148. Hoffman currently has 169 wins at Mercer while Bill Bibb currently ranks first in Mercer all-time coaching victories with 222.

STAIR CLIMBING

Last year then-freshman guard Ethan Stair has made an impressive debut in his first season at Mercer. Stair scored a career-high 15 points at Wofford (2/11), finishing 6-of-10 from the field, and is averaging 6.6 points per game. The freshman also excels in crashing the glass, posting a career-high nine rebounds against Western Michigan while averaging 4.1 rebounds per game.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Jordan Strawberry may have a famous name but he is using a different sport to prove he is his own man. The son of former New York Met Darryl Strawberry, Jordan is playing a different sport than his father but still finding a similar level of success. The 6-1 guard is in his junior season at Mercer and has the ability to be a game-changer on the court, just as his father was a game-changer on the diamond.
