## CLEMSON (5-2) vs. MERCER (5-4)

- Clemson returns to action following final exams to take on Mercer. It is the first meeting between the two programs since 1994-95.
- The Tiger offense has averaged 76.9 points per game, and has reached 74 or more points in five of the seven games. Clemson averaged 69.6 points per game a season ago.
- Clemson has doubled its opponents from the free throw line (122-61). The Tigers have made 42 more free throws than their opponents have attempted on the young season.

### TIGER TRACKS

- Avry Holmes surpassed the 1,000-point mark of his career last time out against Coppin State. Holmes scored over 600 points his first two seasons at San Francisco, and has averaged double figures in 38 games as a Tiger.
- Jaron Blossomgame produced his first double-double of the season against Coppin State, with 15 points and a season-best 11 rebounds. It was the Tiger senior's 13th career double-double.
- Shelton Mitchell reached double figures with 12 points in his first start as a Tiger. Mitchell hit six of eight field goal attempts against Coppin State.
- Gabe DeVoe has posted nine or points in each of Clemson's games so far this season, and is third on the team in scoring at 11.6 points per game. DeVoe started the Tigers' first six games before Mitchell reassumed his role as the starting point guard.
- Scott Spencer sustained a concussion in practice leading up to the Coppin State game and missed the contest with the Eagles. He returned to practice Friday, and is available against the Bears.

Dallas, Texas • Lancaster HS

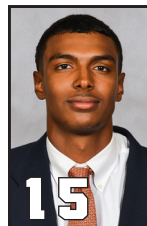
- Transfer from Texas A&M will be eligible in mid-December

## HEAD COACH BRAD BROWNELL

- Named the 21st men's basketball head coach in Clemson history on April 13, 2010.
- Is coaching his 15th season in Division I, having previously coached four years each at UNC Wilmington and Wright State before coming to Clemson.
- Set Clemson records for total wins (22) and ACC wins (9) by a first-year head coach in 2010-11.
- Led Clemson to first NCAA Tournament win in 14 years when the Tigers topped UAB in the first round in 2011.
- Has taken three different schools to the NCAA Tournament.
- Took the Tigers to the 2014 NIT semifinals.
- Winningest coach in history on a percentage basis against ACC competition, and needs just eight wins to pass Cliff Ellis for the career record (59) at Clemson.
- Coached K.J. McDaniels (2014) and Jaron Blossomgame (2016) to first-team All-ACC honors. McDaniels was ACC Defensive Player of the Year, while Blossomgame won the ACC's Most Improved Award.
- Named Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year in 2003 and 2006. He coached CAA Player of the Year Brett Blizzard in 2002-03, his first season.
- Took over Wright State in 2006-07 and guided the school to a record 23 wins in his first season and an NCAA Tournament bid.
- Played Division III ball at DePauw University in Greencastle, Ind.
- He and his wife, Paula, have two daughters, Abby (18), a freshman at Clemson, and Kate (16).

## LITTLEJOHN COLISEUM BACK IN BUSINESS

- Clemson held a ribbon-cutting for the newly renovated Littlejohn Coliseum on Friday, October 14.
- The opener against Georgia on Nov. 11 served as the 'grand reopening' of the facility, complete with all the bells and whistles.
- The \$63.5 million project was completed after 16 months of renovation, which began almost immediately after the 2014-15 season.
- Renovation features include:
  - Newly configured seating bowl, with court rotating 90 degrees from its prior layout
  - Swann Pavilion, a newly designed operations complex and practice facility connected to the arena
  - Burton Gallery, a new 10,000 square foot main entrance space
  - Expanded portals, allowing for a more accessible in-game atmosphere from the concourse level
  - Nation's largest centerhung curved videoboard, as well as ribbon boards atop each portal in the seating bowl
  - Coliseum club & courtside club premium seating areas
  - Coaches offices overlooking the practice gym
  - Expansive space for staff conferences
  - Locker room for players, coaches and staff
  - Team film and meeting room
  - Players lounge
  - Recruiting lounge
  - Weight room connecting the players lounge to the practice gym
  - Athletic training room

## TIGERS COMPLETE 'EARN YOUR ORANGE' CHALLENGE

- Brad Brownell took his team through a five-week series in the preseason entitled 'Earn Your Orange,' where players were given a weekly challenge that included mile runs, campus runs, hill runs, football field lengths, learning the alma mater, and a community service project with ClemsonLIFE.
- Clemson also practiced five sessions with the women's rowing staff, learning how to compete together as a team on Lake Hartwell.

# GAME NOTES & MISCELLANEOUS STATS

## CLEMSON FACES MERCER FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 1994-95

- For the first time in over 20 years, Clemson and Mercer face one another in men's basketball.
- The Tigers own the all-time series lead, 6-4, having won the last six.
- Clemson played Mercer three straight from 1992-95 during the Sharone Wright era. Wright, who left after his junior season in 1994, was a native of Macon, the town where Mercer University is located.

## MERCER SCOUTING REPORT

- Head coach Bob Hoffman brings the Bears into Saturday's game with a 5-4 record. Hoffman coached previously at the ABA and NBDL level, as well as head coaching stints at Oklahoma Baptist and UT Pan American.
- The Tiger program will face former Major League Baseball star Darryl Strawberry's son, Jordan, on Saturday. He averages 8.1 points and 4.2 assists per game.
- Atop the Mercer offensive output is guard Ria'n Holland, who sat out the Bears' game against Oglethorpe earlier this week with an injury. Holland leads Mercer in scoring at 18.4 points per game.

## CLEMSON UP TO NEBRASKA'S CHALLENGE

- The Tigers posted the program's first win in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge in five years when Clemson held off Nebraska, 60-58 in Littlejohn Coliseum on November 30. It was Clemson's 10th win in the challenge.
- Clemson fell behind by as much as nine points and trailed 31-27 at half, but overcame it to rally to a 60-58 win over the Cornhuskers.
- The Tiger defense came up big, holding Nebraska to five of its last 24 field goal attempts in the game.

## CLEMSON OPENS LITTLEJOHN COLISEUM WITH WIN OVER GEORGIA

- The Tigers long anticipated a return to their home arena, which finished a 16-month renovation in October 2016.
- Clemson did not disappoint in its return before a capacity crowd. The Tigers beat nearby rival Georgia, avenging a 23-point loss the year before

with a 74-64 win to open the season November 11.

- The win was the program's first over a team currently in a "Power 5" conference to open a season since 1996-97, when the Tigers shocked the world by beating defending NCAA champion Kentucky in Indianapolis, Ind.

## TIGERS SCORE 95 POINTS IN WIN OVER DAVIDSON

- Clemson recorded the best offensive output in the Brad Brownell era when it scored 95 against Davidson in the first round of the Tire Pros Invitational.
- The previous high by a Brownell coached Clemson team was 92 against The Citadel on Jan. 1, 2013.
- It was the highest point total by a Tiger team since December 2009 when Oliver Purnell's final team scored 102 against Winthrop.

## NO FOUL PLAY

- Clemson has committed the fewest fouls per game of any team in the country at just 14.3 per contest.
- The Tigers have had 11 or less fouls in their last three games.

## FREE THROW DISPARITY HAS BEEN BIG FOR THE TIGERS

- Not only has Clemson gotten off to a good start from the free throw line, shooting 75 percent as a team, the Tigers have doubled their opponents through seven games.
- Clemson has made 122 free throws, compared to just 61 for the opposition. In fact, the Tigers have made 42 more at the foul line than their opponents have attempted.
- Clemson has made at least four more free throws than each opponent this year, with a high disparity of +13 against both Davidson and Nebraska.

# GAME NOTES

## SPECIAL SEASONS HAVE ENDED IN THE YEAR '7

- In one of the oddest coincidences in Clemson men's basketball history, some of the program's best seasons end in the number seven.
- Dating 50 years to the 1966-67 season, Clemson has a combined record of 112-41 (.732) ever since (1976-77, 86-87, 96-97, 06-07).
- Clemson also won 60 percent of its ACC games during those five seasons, compared to the program's career 36 percent standard.

## BROWNELL CLEMSON'S WINNINGEST COACH VS. ACC COMPETITION

- Head coach Brad Brownell carries a career record of 278-174 overall, 111-89 at Clemson.
- Brownell is Clemson's career winning percentage leader against ACC competition, and has led the Tigers to 10 regular-season wins in two of the past three seasons.
- Brownell owns 52 career wins over ACC teams, second-most in school history behind Cliff Ellis (59). He needs eight to move atop the recordbooks.

## BLOSSOMGAME OPTS TO RETURN FOR SENIOR SEASON

- Senior forward Jaron Blossomgame announced his return to Clemson on May 25 following a serious flirtation with the NBA Draft.
- Blossomgame attended the NBA Draft Combine in Chicago, and also worked out privately for seven teams, before deciding to return to school.
- Blossomgame has the opportunity to become the only two-time, first-team All-ACC player in Clemson history.

## BLOSSOMGAME, MCGILLAN EARN DEGREES

- Two members of the Tiger team will begin play in their final seasons with an undergraduate Clemson degree already in hand, Jaron Blossomgame and Riley McGillan.
- The two roommates both graduated this year, McGillan with a marketing degree in May and Blossomgame with a sociology degree in August.
- A third, Avry Holmes, is on track to join them in December.

## BLOSSOMGAME MOVING TOWARD TOP 20

- Senior forward Jaron Blossomgame needs just 38 points to place himself among Clemson's top 20 career scorers. He has 1,271 points heading into Saturday's contest with Mercer.
- When he achieves the mark, he will be one of 10 players in school history to rank in the top 20 all-time in both points and rebounds. Blossomgame is already 17th in school history with 664 boards. He needs two rebounds to pass Donnie Mahaffey (1961-64) for 16th in school history.

## DeVOE IMPROVED OFFENSIVELY

- Junior guard Gabe DeVoe opened the season with 15 points in the win over Georgia, and he has continued to excel offensively.
- As Clemson's second-leading scorer, DeVoe has posted nine or more points in six of the Tigers' seven games.
- DeVoe also leads Clemson with 23 assists through seven contests.

## DJITTE AVERAGING NEAR A DOUBLE-DOUBLE

- Senior center Sidy Djitte put together arguably the top effort of his career. on November 20 when he amassed 14 points and 14 rebounds, with two blocks and two steals, playing all 40 minutes against Oklahoma in the Tire Pros Invitational.
- Djitte's minute and rebound totals both set career highs, while his point total tied his previous best of 14 set last season against Florida State.
- Djitte ranks fourth among all NCAA players with 4.9 offensive rebounds per game, accumulating 23 over the last four games alone.
- He averages near a double-double at 9.3 points and 10.4 rebounds per game.

## HOLMES ACHIEVES 1,000 CAREER POINTS

- Senior guard Avry Holmes went past the 1,000 career point plateau in Clemson's game against Coppin State on Dec. 4, becoming the second active Tiger to reach 1,000, along with Jaron Blossomgame.

- Holmes scored 607 points his first two seasons for the University of San Francisco, and added 311 in his first year of eligibility at Clemson.

## MITCHELL WORKS WAY INTO STARTING LINEUP

- Sophomore point guard Shelton Mitchell, one of Clemson's most anticipated newcomers, sustained a knee injury in practice on Monday, November 7. He underwent a minor procedure the following day to clean up the affected area, and missed Clemson's first four games.
- Mitchell returned to game action Nov. 25 against High Point, logging 11 minutes. He looked significantly more comfortable five days later when he posted seven points in 27 minutes against Nebraska.
- Mitchell entered the starting lineup for the first time against Coppin State, posting 12 points on 6-8 shots.

## REED IMPRESSIVE IN CLEMSON DEBUT

- Marquise Reed, former Robert Morris standout and 2015 Northeast Conference Rookie of the Year after scoring 15.1 points per game for the Colonials, did not disappoint in his Clemson debut.
- Reed scored a team-high 19 points, hitting five of 11 field goal attempts and all six of his free throws. He was 3-6 behind the three-point arc.
- Reed's point total was the highest by any Clemson player in a debut since Elden Campbell also scored 19, as a freshman in 1986-87.
- No Clemson player has scored at least 20 points in his debut since Larry Middleton in 1985-86.

## SPENCER SUFFERS CONCUSSION, RETURNS TO PRACTICE

- Freshman wing Scott Spencer sustained a concussion in practice leading up to the Coppin State game, and missed the game against the Eagles on Dec. 4. He returned to practice Friday and is cleared to dress against Mercer.

## FOUR SIGNEES ADDED FROM CLASS OF 2017

- Clemson enjoyed a fruitful early signing period, adding A.J. Oliver, Aamir Simms, Clyde Trapp Jr. and Malik William from the class of 2017.
- Oliver is a four-star guard whose mother, Audra Smith, is the head women's basketball coach at Clemson.
- Simms is a top-100 prospect by Rivals and is a former teammate of Scott Spencer, now a freshman at Clemson, at the Blue Ridge School in Virginia.
- Trapp played AAU basketball for former Clemson guard Edward Scott, an All-ACC selection in 2003 and ACC Legend choice in 2017.
- William played at First Academy in Orlando, Fla., averaging a double-double in his first season with the school.
