THE GAME

- ▶ A win over Samford would be Mercer's first since 1932 (21-6 in Macon). Mercer is 0-3 in the modern era against Samford.
- ▶ Mercer came up short against Samford, 24-19, in Birmingham last year, rallying from a 21-point deficit with 19 straight points, only to see the Bulldogs seal the win with a field goal.
- ▶ For Senior Day, Mercer will honor its 10 senior student-athletes prior to kickoff.
- ▶ Mercer's three SoCon wins have come by an average of 21.6 points, while its three SoCon losses are by an average of 3.6 points.
- ▶ Mercer HC Bobby Lamb is two wins away from career victory No. 100.
- ▶ Lee Bennett is averaging 9.8 tackles per game this season, ranking second in the SoCon. He totaled 40 of his 78 tackles over three games in October.

TEAM QUICK HITS

- Bobby Lamb is two wins away from his 100th career victory as a head coach (98-63). Lamb also earned his 10th SoCon win at Mercer's helm with the 30-10 victory over Chattanooga on Oct. 14.
- A win Saturday vs. Samford would mark the second straight season Mercer has won at least four SoCon games.
- A win over Samford would be Mercer's second against an ranked FCS team this season.
- The Bears are in their fifth season since reintroducing football in 2013 and the 44th campaign in program history.
- Mercer doubled its SoCon win total in 2016 (4-4) for the third consecutive season.
- The Bears face two FBS teams in the 2017 season, taking road trips to Auburn and Alabama.

OFFENSE QUICK HITS

- Mercer is averaging 29.0 points per game, ranking 39th nationally and third in the SoCon.
- The Bears are second nationally and first in the SoCon in red zone offense (93.3 percent). They have converted 28 of 30 red zone trips into points, including 22 touchdowns.
- Mercer totaled 457 rushing yards on 101 attempts over a two-week stretch from Sept. 30-Oct. 7 (51-257 vs. VMI; 50-200 at The Citadel).
- Mercer is allowing only 1.25 sacks per game and ranks 25th nationally in that category.
- Mercer totaled 575 yards of offense against VMI (Oct. 7), the fourth most in a single game in program history.
- Mercer has scored in 58 straight games dating back to a 52-0 loss to Rollins on October 24, 1941.
- The Bears are 24-3 when scoring 30 points under head coach Bobby Lamb and 46-4 all-time as a program.
- Mercer is 19-7 when eclipsing 400 yards of total offense under head coach Bobby Lamb.

DEFENSE QUICK HITS

- Mercer has allowed an average of 11.2 points to opponents in its four wins this season.
- Mercer ranks sixth nationally in fumbles recovered (10) and ranks 21st nationally with 17 turnovers gained.
- The Bears rank second in the SoCon and 18th nationally in scoring defense (18.9 points per game).
- Mercer ranks first in the conference and 14th nationally in red zone defense (70.8 percent).
- Mercer's five forced turnovers at No. 15 Auburn are the most surrendered by the Tigers since Oct. 6, 2012 at Arkansas.
- Mercer has forced at least three turnovers in four of eight games this season.
- Mercer held Chattanooga to 15 yards or less on nine of 13 offensive drives last on Oct. 14. The Bears also held Chattanooga to 44 rushing yards, marking the seventh-fewest allowed in program history.
- The defense has held opponents under 300 yards of total offense 12 times since 2013, posting a 12-0 record in those contests. Three of those efforts have happened this season (241 vs. Jacksonville; 225 vs. VMI; 250 vs. Chattanooga).
- Mercer recorded 12.0 tackles for loss at ETSU, the second most in a single game in program history.
- Mercer limited foes to under 100 yards rushing 16 times since 2013, owning a 14-2 mark when doing so.

INDIVIDUAL QUICK HITS

- Tee Mitchell and CJ Leggett have both scored at least one rushing touchdown in each of the last five games.
- Kaelan Riley is 18th nationally in completion percentage (63.4). He completed 76 percent of his passes at Furman, marking the third-highest percentage in program history. He has completed 46 of his last 61 attempts for 521 yards.
- Alex Lakes needs one rushing touchdown to become the program's all-time leader (31).
- Chandler Curtis totaled 202 all-purpose yards at Furman, highlighted by a career-best 112 receiving yards on 11 receptions. He has caught four touchdowns in the last five games, pushing his career total to a program-best 16.
- Lee Bennett leads Mercer with 78 total tackles (20 solo, 58 assisted). He is 24th nationally and second in the SoCon with an average of 9.8 tackles per game. Bennett totaled 40 tackles in the month of October, thanks to career-best efforts of 16 and 17 tackles at The Citadel (Oct. 7) and at Furman (Oct. 21).
- Stephen Houzah needs one interception to break the program's all-time record with seven.

RILEY NAMED TO JERRY RICE AWARD WATCH LIST

Kaelan Riley was named to the watch list for the STATS FCS Jerry Rice Award, which is awarded annually to the most outstanding freshman player in the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision (FCS). Riley is one of 17 true or redshirt freshmen named to the watch list, which will see players added or removed throughout the remainder of the season before 20 finalists are selected by a national panel of over 150 sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries following the regular season.

Riley ranks among the top-four in the SoCon in pass efficiency (145.3), passing yards per game (215.8), total offensive touchdowns (16), total offense (237.2), completion percentage (63.9) and passing touchdowns (13).

BACK AT THE BEAR'S DEN

THANK YOU, SENIORS!

Saturday also serves as Senior Day for Mercer, which will honor 11 student-athletes who have been members of the football program for at least four years. Mercer will honor Alex Lakes, Chandler Curtis, Avery Ward, Kyle Williams, Lee Bennett, Thomas Marchman, Caleb Yates, Jagger Lieb, Austin Barrett, Jalen Penn and Grant Reynolds.

WELCOME TO THE L.O.C.

Here comes the boom. The Legion of Chaos, otherwise known as the Mercer defense has established itself as a force. Mercer ranks sixth in the nation in fumble recoveries (10) and ranks 21st nationally with 17 turnovers gained this fall.

SOMETHING HAS TO GIVE

Mercer's defense is allowing opposing quarterbacks to throw for an average of 194.1 passing yards per game entering Saturday's contest. That will be tested against the SoCon's top arm in Samford junior Delvin Hodges, who is averaging 331.8 yards per game. A key to a Bears win will be finding how to slow down Hodges.

SPEAK HIGHLY ON RILEY

Kaelan Riley completed 26-of-34 passes for 289 yards and one touchdown in Mercer's loss at Furman on Oct. 21. Despite being in his first season of collegiate action, Riley has impressed this fall with 1,726 passing yards and 13 passing touchdowns.

Riley's effectiveness has been key, as he ranks 18th in the FCS in completion percentage (63.9 percent). His interception at the end of the Furman game was his first in 106 pass attempts dating back to Sept. 30.

RED MEANS GO

Consistency at its finest. Mercer ranks second in the FCS for red zone offense, scoring on 93 percent of its trips (28-of-30). Meanwhile, the defense ranks 14th in the FCS (70.8 percent). The Bears lead the SoCon in both categories.

HE DOES HIS OWN STUNTS

Linebacker LeMarkus Bailey, who earned the nickname "Stuntman" from his teammates, has been a force for the L.O.C. this year. Bailey already has a career-high 6.5 tackles for loss. He has also notched 51 total tackles, one interception, one sack, one forced fumble and one recovered fumble.

MITCHELL EARNS SOCON ACADEMIC HONOR

Junior running back Tee Mitchell was named SoCon Student-Athlete of the Week for his performance on Oct. 28 at Furman. Mitchell, an international business major, rushed for a season-best 93 yards and one touchdown on 12 carries in the loss. He leads Mercer with 416 total rushing yards this season and has added 191 receiving yards. He is a former CoSIDA Academic All-American First Team pick.

SERIES HISTORY

Mercer has been unable to defeat Samford in three tries since reviving its football program in 2013. The Bears are 0-3 dating back to 2014, with two of those losses being by five points or less. Samford's biggest win came the last time it visited Macon; a 47-21 win on Nov. 21, 2015. A Mercer win over Samford would be its third over a top-25 FCS program and second this season.

RECORD BREAKERS

Chandler Curtis' recent hot streak of four touchdowns in five games has earned him the program's all-time career touchdown receptions record (16). However, two of his teammates might have something to say about how long that record stands.

Avery Ward and Marquise Irvin (13) and Avery Ward (12) are close behind Curtis, ranking second and third on the all-time leaderboard. Irvin has caught touchdowns in the last two games vs. Chattanooga and at Furman, pushing his season total to four. Irvin also leads the team in receptions (36), receiving yards (442) and receiving yards per game (55.25). Ward leads the team in yards per catch (13.95). Expect the trio of talented wide receivers to maintain a friendly competition throughout the season – and for QB Kaelan Riley to have a good problem on his hands.

RESPECT THE TRENCHES

The flow of a football game is dictated at the line of scrimmage. Mercer has fortunately had good health on the offensive and defensive lines this season, helping the Bears set the tone. Isaiah Buehler, Dorian Kithcart and Jalen Penn have started all seven games on the defensive line. Thomas Marchman, Jake Flath, Austin Sanders and Caleb Yates have started all seven games on the offensive line, while Conner Krieger – the team's starting center – missed just two games due to injury.

LAMB CLOSING IN

Mercer head coach Bobby Lamb is in his 14th season as a head coach and is only two wins away from cracking 100 career victories (98-63). Lamb ranks third among active SoCon coaches in career wins, trailing Wofford's Mike Ayers (214) and Samford's Chris Hatcher (137). Lamb is also fourth in SoCon history on the all-time wins list with 87.

LEE-N ON ME

Senior captain and linebacker Lee Bennett dominated the month of October, racking up 40 total tackles, including single-game efforts of 16 (at The Citadel) and 17 (at Furman). He ranks 24th nationally and second in the SoCon with 9.8 tackles per game. His 78 total tackles (20 solo and 58 assisted) are 18 more than the next closest Bear (Eric Jackson, 60 total).

LAKES REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

Alex Lakes, the elder of the Mercer offensive backfield, broke the program record for most career rushing yards with a 46-yard output vs. VMI on Sept. 30. Lakes broke former quarterback John Russ' record of 2,335 yards on an eight-yard scamper. The red-shirt senior also found the end zone once, tying him with Russ for the most career rushing touchdowns in program history.

Despite limited action all season, Lakes rushed 16 times for 79 yards in Mercer's upset at then-No. 17 The Citadel on Oct. 7. He has 234 total rushing yards this season and leads Mercer with 4.6 yards per carry.

#COMMUNITY

Beware the Bears Den. When the Bears are active, there is a deafening roar from its #comMUnity. The support has made Five Star Stadium one of the toughest places to play in the FCS. Mercer is an impressive 22-7 at Five Star Stadium since 2013.

CALHOUN CONNECTION

Quarterback Kaelan Riley and wide receiver Chandler Curtis both hail from Calhoun High School (Calhoun, Ga.) and played prep ball under Coach Lamb's brother, Hal. The duo has been Mercer's most effective passing game combo this season, as Curtis has 429 receiving yards and four touchdowns on 32 receptions. Curtis totaled 202 all-purpose yards at Furman (Oct. 21), highlighted by 11 catches for 112 receiving yards.

MR. EVERYTHING(S)

Chandler Curtis and Tee Mitchell rank third and 10th, respectively, for most all-purpose yards per game this season. Curtis, a dynamic return man, is averaging 97.4 all-purpose yards per game and leads the SoCon with 154 punt return yards. He also leads the SoCon with an average of 24.1 kick return yards per game. Curtis totaled 202 all-purpose yards at Furman on Oct. 28, the third-most in program history. Meanwhile, Mitchell averages 75.9 all-purpose yards per game, largely due to his consistent rushing attack. Mitchell owns 416 rushing yards and has added 191 receiving yards this season.

HOUZ'S HOUSE?

Stephen Houzah snagged two interceptions vs. VMI, tying him with the program's career record of six. He is the only Bear with one career multi-interception game; he has two for his career. Houzah needs one interception to become the program's all-time leader.

MARCHMAN NAMED TO 2017 GOOD WORKS TEAM

Mercer senior offensive lineman Thomas Marchman was named a candidate for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team by the American Football Coaches Association this summer, making him eligible for one of the most prestigious off-the-field honors in college football. A native of Gainesville, Georgia, Marchman has served as a Young Life Leader at Stratford Academy in Macon since his sophomore year.

BOBBY LAMB

HEAD COACH | FIFTH SEASON AT MERCER

Bobby Lamb enters his fifth season as head coach of Mercer football after guiding the Bears' through their first four seasons of football following a 72-year hiatus.

Named the 19th head football coach in program history in 2011, he led the Bears to immediate success, claiming the third 10-win season of his career and setting the NCAA Division I record for wins by a first-year program with a 10-2 campaign. The 2013 win total also set a school record for victories, surpassing the previous mark of seven wins by Lake Russell's 1931 and 1932 squads. For his efforts, he finished third in the PFL Coach of the Year voting and ranked among the top 11 finalists for FCS National Coach of the Year.

Mercer has doubled its Southern Conference win total in each of the three years it has been a member of the league under the guidance of Lamb as the Bears posted a 4-4 mark (6-5 overall) during the 2016 campaign. The Orange and Black compiled a record of 5-6 on the season and 2-5 in league play in 2015, the program's second season in the SoCon. The Bears season was highlighted by an upset victory over No. 3 Chattanooga by a score of 17-14 at Five Star Stadium. Five of Mercer's six losses came by seven points or less.

Lamb led the Bears into the Southern Conference in 2014, a familiar league for the 27-year veteran of the coaching ranks as he is fifth on the conference's all-time wins list. Despite featuring a roster of primarily underclassmen, Lamb helped Mercer to a 6-6 campaign in its first year in one of the nation's oldest and most prestigious conferences, including the program's first SoCon victory in a 27-24 triumph at VMI.

Boasting one of the SoCon's most dynamic offenses and a defense that ranked among the nation's leaders in forced turnovers in 2014, Lamb's team once again was well represented in both conference and national postseason awards. The Bears had seven players garner all-conference recognition, including first team selections Chandler Curtis and Alex Lakes. The freshmen duo were each named Jerry Rice Award finalists, joining 2013 honorees John Russ and Payton Usher on a list of four Bears who have received the honor in the last two years alone. Curtis' honors did not stop there, as he became the first player in program history to garner FCS All-America honors while also receiving College Football Performance Awards' FCS Returner of the Year recognition.

In 2013, Mercer ranked second in the FCS in rushing, using a balanced attack to pour in 277.9 yards rushing per contest. The Bears had three players gain over 750 yards on the ground, led by freshman John Russ. The dual threat quarterback was named to a Jerry Rice Award finalist and an All-PFL Second Team selection following an impressive year that saw him compile 1,916 yards through the air and 903 yards on the ground to go along with 33 total touchdowns.

Lamb guided the Bears, who were picked to finish 11th in the Pioneer Football League Preseason Coaches' Poll, to a 6-2 record in conference play en route to a third-place finish in the league. For his efforts, he finished third in the PFL Coach of the Year voting and ranked among the top 11 finalists for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears showed immediate success in the classroom as well under Lamb, compiling a team GPA above 3.0 during both semesters in 2013-14. The team featured 46 players on the Pioneer Football League's Academic Honor Roll for

the 2013 fall semester, while Caleb Brown, Rob East and John Russ were named Academic All-PFL.

Lamb's Furman teams posted outstanding academic credentials. In the seven seasons since the NCAA instituted the Academic Progress Rate (APR) monitoring system – which tracks eligibility, retention and graduation – Furman's program produced the highest APR scores among Southern Conference schools. Likewise, Furman football had the SoCon's top results on the NCAA's Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a score of 97 percent in 2009-10.

During his tenure guiding Furman's program, Lamb had a 67-40 record (.626) as its head coach. He led the Paladins to winning records in eight of his nine seasons and made four trips to the NCAA I-AA (now Football Championship Series) playoffs, reaching the quarterfinals in 2004 and the semifinals in 2005. His 2004 squad won the SoCon championship and Lamb was tabbed as the league's Coach of the Year. He also produced three runner-up, two third-place and two fourth-place SoCon finishes during his tenure. Lamb's Paladins achieved national rankings of No. 5 in 2004 and No. 3 in 2005.

Including his 16 seasons as an assistant coach – where he spent the majority of his time as the passing game coordinator and working with quarterbacks – Lamb's Furman teams compiled a composite record of 193-105-3 (.646) in 25 seasons. When you factor in Lamb's four seasons as a quarterback for the Paladins from 1982 to 1985, when Furman was 39-10-1, his aggregate won-loss record jumps to .667. In 29 seasons on the collegiate gridiron, Lamb has only been involved with three below .500 campaigns.

As a player at Furman, Lamb was a part of three SoCon championship teams and three NCAA I-AA playoff berths. As a senior, he was the SoCon Player of the Year, the NCAA I-AA passing efficiency national leader and led the Paladins to an NCAA I-AA national runner-up finish. He is also a member of Furman's Athletics Hall of Fame.

"I have been very impressed with President Underwood and Athletic Director Jim Cole and the vision and leadership they are providing at Mercer," said Lamb of his decision to come to the Macon institution. "One of the qualities that most attracted me to Mercer was their emphasis on the true student-athlete. I have spent the past 29 years at an institution with very similar expectations.

"Sometimes the term student-athlete is used nonchalantly. People forget that it is student first and athlete second. I have always stressed the importance of academics before athletics as a player, coach, and father. I believe my philosophy for building strong men who will become leaders in their communities, will be a perfect fit with Mercer.

"God has provided this tremendous opportunity for me to assist in the reinstatement of football at Mercer. I look forward to leading Mercer football to the top."

Lamb is a 1982 graduate of Commerce (Ga.) High School and went on to earn his B.A. in health and exercise science from Furman in 1987. He also earned his M.Ed. degree from Furman in health and exercise science in 1992. Lamb, who was born on Christmas Eve in 1962, is married to Allyson Acker. The couple has two children: a daughter, Sallie (24), and a son, Taylor (22), who plays quarterback at Appalachian State University (Boone, N.C.).
