TEAM QUICK HITS

- Mercer is on a current two-game losing streak on the road, having last defeated Austin Peay, 41-34, in Clarksville, Tenn. on Oct. 22, 2016.
- Bobby Lamb is five wins away from his 100th career victory as a head coach (95-60).
- Mercer is 2-2 in the modern era and 10-30-1 all-time in road openers (did not play on the road in 1897 and 1906).
- Merce
- The Bears are in their fifth season since reintroducing football in 2013 and the 44th campaign in program history.
- Mercer doubled its Southern Conference win total in 2016 (4-4) for the third consecutive season.
- The Bears are receiving votes in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the STATS FCS Top 25.
- Mercer has been called for an average of only 28 penalty yards per game this season, sixth best in the FCS

OFFENSE QUICK HITS

- Mercer's 48 points against Jacksonville were the most scored in a season opener since the program was reintroduced
- Mercer has scored in 52 straight games dating back to a 52-0 loss to Rollins on October 24, 1941
- The Bears are 22-3 when scoring 30 points under head coach Bobby Lamb and 44-4 all-time as a program
- Mercer is 18-5 when eclipsing 400 yards of total offense under head coach Bobby Lamb
- The Bears are a perfect 11-for-11 on drives that reach the red zone

DEFENSE QUICK HITS

- Mercer ranked 21st nationally and second in the SoCon in total defense (304.0 yards allowed per game).
- The Bears lead the SoCon in tackles for loss (6.5)
- The Bears have forced a turnover in 29 of the last 34 games, including 13 in a row at one point
- Mercer ranks second nationally through two games played in passing yards allowed per game (94.0)
- The defense has held opponents under 300 yards of total offense nine times since 2013, posting a 10-0 record in those contests (held Jacksonville to 241 offensive yards on Aug. 31)
- Mercer ranks second in scoring defense (17.5) among SoCon teams
- Mercer limited foes to under 100 yards rushing 14 times since 2013, owning a 12-2 mark (3-0 in '16) when doing so
- Mercer's seven points allowed to Jacksonville in week one were the fewest allowed by a Southern Conference team.

INDIVIDUAL QUICK HITS

- Kaelan Riley leads the SoCon and ranks third in the FCS with three rushing touchdowns.
- Alex Lakes needs 21 rushing yards and two rushing touchdowns to eclipse former quarterback John Russ' (2013-16) program career records of 2,335 yards and 30 rushing touchdowns.
- Avery Ward tied the Mercer career record for receiving touchdowns (12) with his 15-yard score against Wofford on Sept. 9. He is in a three-way tie with teammate Chandler Curtis and former Bear JT Palmer.
- Five Mercer linebackers have combined for 10.0 of the Bears' 13.0 total tackles for loss. Kyle Williams (3.0) and LeMarkus Bailey (2.5) lead the unit.
- Rashad Haynes leads the SoCon with an average of 37.3 yards per kickoff return after he took the opening kickoff 90 yards against Wofford on Sept. 9.
- Chandler Curtis leads the SoCon with 17.3 yards per punt return, including a season-long 51-yard return against Wofford on Sept. 9.
- Cole Fisher connected for two field goals against Wofford on Sept. 9, giving him seven career games with multiple made field goals during his career.

LAMB VERSUS AUBURN

Mercer head coach Bobby Lamb has faced the Tigers once in his coaching career, as he led Furman into Jordan-Hare Stadium on Nov. 7, 2009. The Lamb-led Paladins were defeated 63-31. Auburn (8-5) went on to win the Outback Bowl over Northwestern.

HOMECOMING TRIP

Five Bears will return to their home state on the trip to Auburn. Marquise Irvin and Brandon Gurley (Huntsville), Andrew Robinson (Birmingham), Austin Wysor (Trussville) and Luke Ward (Atmore) all hail from Alabama.

RETURN TO THE RED ZONE

One of the biggest positives through two games this season has been the Bears' red zone efficiency on offense. Mercer is 11-for-11 when reaching the red zone, including nine touchdowns (five rushing, four passing). Mercer led the FCS in red zone efficiency in 2015 (.932).

WELCOME BACK, AVERY

Senior wide receiver Avery Ward returned to the field in impressive fashion on Sept. 9 after missing the previous five games dating back to last season due to injury.

Ward hauled in seven catches for 113 yards and a touchdown, marking his fourth career 100-yard game. The touchdown reception was the 12th of his career, tying him with teammate Chandler Curtis and former Bear JT Palmer for most in program history.

BIG OPPORTUNITY

Mercer's clash with Auburn will be only the second time the Bears have faced an FBS or Power Five program since returning to the gridiron in 2013. Mercer played at Georgia Tech last year, falling to the Yellow Jackets 35-10.

Auburn, ranked No. 15 in the AP's latest FBS Top 25 Poll, will be Mercer's first nationally ranked FBS opponent.

HUMAN HIGHLIGHT REEL

Despite an impressive wide receiver corps at his disposal, Kaelan Riley's favorite target may be redshirt junior tight end Sam Walker.

The 2017 Preseason All-SoCon First Team selection caught two touchdowns among his five receptions for 47 yards in week one, providing a mismatch target for Riley. Walker owns seven career touchdown catches, good for the sixth-most by a player in program history.

LAMB CLOSING IN

Mercer head coach Bobby Lamb is in his 14th season as a head coach and is only five wins away from from cracking 100 career victories (95-60). Lamb ranks third among active SoCon coaches in career wins, trailing Wofford's Mike Ayers (210) and Samford's Chris Hatcher (135). Lamb is also fourth in SoCon history on the all-time wins list with 84.

RUNNIN' RILEY

Kaelan Riley has established himself as a quarterback who can beat teams with both his arm and legs through two career games. The redshirt freshman has tossed five touchdown passes but also found the end zone three times via the run.

Riley's 22 attempts lead the Bears while his three rushing touchdowns lead the So-Con and rank third in the FCS.

WELCOME TO THE L.O.C.

Here comes the boom. The Legion of Chaos, otherwise known as the Mercer defense, is off to a strong start through two games this season. Mercer held Jacksonville to seven points and forced three turnovers in week one before holding its own against one of the FCS' top rushing attacks in Wofford during week two.

Mercer ranks second in scoring defense (17.5 points per game) among SoCon teams.

SERIES HISTORY

Mercer and Wofford will clash for the fourth time since the Bears returned to the gridiron in 2013. Winless in that span, Mercer seeks to use home field advantage for what would be its second top-10 upset since 2015.

LAKES REWRITING THE RECORD BOOKS

Alex Lakes, the elder of the Mercer offensive backfield, is nearing a pair of career rushing records entering week three of the season. The redshirt senior needs two rushing touchdowns and 21 rushing yards to eclipse career records (2,335 rushing yards; 30 rushing touchdowns) held by former quarterback John Russ (2013-16).

Lakes' 29 rushing touchdowns and 2,315 rushing yards are the most by any Mercer running back. He is the only running back in program history with over 2,000 career rushing yards.

CALHOUN CONNECTION

Quarterback Kaelan Riley and wide receiver Chandler Curtis both hail from Calhoun, Georgia and are impressive prep products of Calhoun High School. The duo connected four times for 43 yards against Jacksonville in the season opener and will continue to utilize their backyard football days toward added chemistry.

MARCHMAN NAMED 2017 GOOD WORKS TEAM

Mercer senior offensive lineman Thomas Marchman was named a candidate for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team by the American Football Coaches Association this summer, making him eligible for one of the most prestigious off-the-field honors in college football. A native of Gainesville, Georgia, Marchman has served as a Young Life Leader at Stratford Academy in Macon since his sophomore year.

MERCER VS. SEC

While Mercer has not faced a SEC opponent since reintroducing its football program in 2013, the Bears have played 66 total games against current SEC programs. Those games have not been kind to Mercer, however. Mercer owns a 8-57-1 overall record against SEC programs, with six of those eight wins coming against Florida.

Five Bears will return to their home state on the trip to Auburn. Marquise Irvin and Brandon Gurley (Huntsville), Andrew Robinson (Birmingham), Austin Wysor (Trussville) and Luke Ward (Atmore) all hail from Alabama.

RETURN TO THE RED ZONE

One of the biggest positives through two games this season has been the Bears' red zone efficiency on offense. Mercer is 11-for-11 when reaching the red zone, including nine touchdowns (five rushing, four passing). Mercer led the FCS in red zone efficiency in 2015 (.932).

WELCOME BACK. AVERY

Senior wide receiver Avery Ward returned to the field in impressive fashion on Sept. 9 after missing the previous five games dating back to last season due to injury.

Ward hauled in seven catches for 113 yards and a touchdown, marking his fourth career 100-yard game. The touchdown reception was the 12th of his career, tying him with teammate Chandler Curtis and former Bear JT Palmer for most in program history.

BIG OPPORTUNITY

Mercer's clash with Auburn will be only the second time the Bears have faced an FBS or Power Five program since returning to the gridiron in 2013. Mercer played at Georgia Tech last year, falling to the Yellow Jackets 35-10.

Auburn, ranked No. 15 in the AP's latest FBS Top 25 Poll, will be Mercer's first nationally ranked FBS opponent.

HUMAN HIGHLIGHT REEL

Despite an impressive wide receiver corps at his disposal, Kaelan Riley's favorite target may be redshirt junior tight end Sam Walker.

The 2017 Preseason All-SoCon First Team selection caught two touchdowns among his five receptions for 47 yards in week one, providing a mismatch target for Riley. Walker owns seven career touchdown catches, good for the sixth-most by a player in program history.

LAMB CLOSING IN

Mercer head coach Bobby Lamb is in his 14th season as a head coach and is only five wins away from from cracking 100 career victories (95-60). Lamb ranks third among active SoCon coaches in career wins, trailing Wofford's Mike Ayers (210) and Samford's Chris Hatcher (135). Lamb is also fourth in SoCon history on the all-time wins list with 84.

Kaelan Riley has established himself as a quarterback who can beat teams with both his arm and legs through two career games. The redshirt freshman has tossed five touchdown passes but also found the end zone three times via the run.

Riley's 22 attempts lead the Bears while his three rushing touchdowns lead the So-Con and rank third in the FCS.

WELCOME TO THE L.O.C.

Here comes the boom. The Legion of Chaos, otherwise known as the Mercer defense, is off to a strong start through two games this season. Mercer held Jacksonville to seven points and forced three turnovers in week one before holding its own against one of the FCS' top rushing attacks in Wofford during week two.

Mercer ranks second in scoring defense (17.5 points per game) among SoCon teams.

Bobby Lamb enters his fifth season as head coach of Mercer football after guiding the Bears' through their first four seasons of football following a 72-year hiatus.

Named the 19th head football coach in program history in 2011, he led the Bears to immediate success, claiming the third 10-win season of his career and setting the NCAA Division I record for wins by a first-year program with a 10-2 campaign. The 2013 win total also set a school record for victories, surpassing the previous mark of seven wins by Lake Russell's 1931 and 1932 squads. For his efforts, he finished third in the PFL Coach of the Year voting and ranked among the top 11 finalists for FCS National Coach of the Year.

Mercer has doubled its Southern Conference win total in each of the three years it has been a member of the league under the guidance of Lamb as the Bears posted a 4-4 mark (6-5 overall) during the 2016 campaign. The Orange and Black compiled a record of 5-6 on the season and 2-5 in league play in 2015, the program's second season in the SoCon. The Bears season was highlighted by an upset victory over No. 3 Chattanooga by a score of 17-14 at Five Star Stadium. Five of Mercer's six losses came by seven points or less.

Lamb led the Bears into the Southern Conference in 2014, a familiar league for the 27-year veteran of the coaching ranks as he is fifth on the conference's all-time wins list. Despite featuring a roster of primarily underclassmen, Lamb helped Mercer to a 6-6 campaign in its first year in one of the nation's oldest and most prestigious conferences, including the program's first SoCon victory in a 27-24 triumph at VMI.

Boasting one of the SoCon's most dynamic offenses and a defense that ranked among the nation's leaders in forced turnovers in 2014, Lamb's team once again was well represented in both conference and national postseason awards. The Bears had seven players garner all-conference recognition, including first team selections Chandler Curtis and Alex Lakes. The freshmen duo were each named Jerry Rice Award finalists, joining 2013 honorees John Russ and Payton Usher on a list of four Bears who have received the honor in the last two years alone. Curtis' honors did not stop there, as he became the first player in program history to garner FCS All-America honors while also receiving College Football Performance Awards' FCS Returner of the Year recognition.

In 2013, Mercer ranked second in the FCS in rushing, using a balanced attack to pour in 277.9 yards rushing per contest. The Bears had three players gain over 750 yards on the ground, led by freshman John Russ. The dual threat quarterback was named to a Jerry Rice Award finalist and an All-PFL Second Team selection following an impressive year that saw him compile 1,916 yards through the air and 903 yards on the ground to go along with 33 total touchdowns.

Lamb guided the Bears, who were picked to finish 11th in the Pioneer Football League Preseason Coaches' Poll, to a 6-2 record in conference play en route to a third-place finish in the league. For his efforts, he finished third in the PFL Coach of the Year voting and ranked among the top 11 finalists for FCS National Coach of the Year.

The Bears showed immediate success in the classroom as well under Lamb, compiling a team GPA above 3.0 during both semesters in 2013-14. The team featured 46 players on the Pioneer Football League's Academic Honor Roll for

the 2013 fall semester, while Caleb Brown, Rob East and John Russ were named Academic All-PFL.

Lamb's Furman teams posted outstanding academic credentials. In the seven seasons since the NCAA instituted the Academic Progress Rate (APR) monitoring system — which tracks eligibility, retention and graduation — Furman's program produced the highest APR scores among Southern Conference schools. Likewise, Furman football had the SoCon's top results on the NCAA's Graduation Success Rate (GSR) with a score of 97 percent in 2009-10.

During his tenure guiding Furman's program, Lamb had a 67-40 record (.626) as its head coach. He led the Paladins to winning records in eight of his nine seasons and made four trips to the NCAA I-AA (now Football Championship Series) playoffs, reaching the quarterfinals in 2004 and the semifinals in 2005. His 2004 squad won the SoCon championship and Lamb was tabbed as the league's Coach of the Year. He also produced three runner-up, two third-place and two fourth-place SoCon finishes during his tenure. Lamb's Paladins achieved national rankings of No. 5 in 2004 and No. 3 in 2005.

Including his 16 seasons as an assistant coach — where he spent the majority of his time as the passing game coordinator and working with quarterbacks — Lamb's Furman teams compiled a composite record of 193-105-3 (.646) in 25 seasons. When you factor in Lamb's four seasons as a quarterback for the Paladins from 1982 to 1985, when Furman was 39-10-1, his aggregate won-loss record jumps to .667. In 29 seasons on the collegiate gridiron, Lamb has only been involved with three below .500 campaigns.

As a player at Furman, Lamb was a part of three SoCon championship teams and three NCAA I-AA playoff berths. As a senior, he was the SoCon Player of the Year, the NCAA I-AA passing efficiency national leader and led the Paladins to an NCAA I-AA national runner-up finish. He is also a member of Furman's Athletics Hall of Fame.

"I have been very impressed with President Underwood and Athletic Director Jim Cole and the vision and leadership they are providing at Mercer," said Lamb of his decision to come to the Macon institution. "One of the qualities that most attracted me to Mercer was their emphasis on the true student-athlete. I have spent the past 29 years at an institution with very similar expectations.

"Sometimes the term student-athlete is used nonchalantly. People forget that it is student first and athlete second. I have always stressed the importance of academics before athletics as a player, coach, and father. I believe my philosophy for building strong men who will become leaders in their communities, will be a perfect fit with Mercer.

"God has provided this tremendous opportunity for me to assist in the reinstatement of football at Mercer. I look forward to leading Mercer football to the top."

Lamb is a 1982 graduate of Commerce (Ga.) High School and went on to earn his B.A. in health and exercise science from Furman in 1987. He also earned his M.Ed. degree from Furman in health and exercise science in 1992. Lamb, who was born on Christmas Eve in 1962, is married to Allyson Acker. The couple has two children: a daughter, Sallie (24), and a son, Taylor (22), who plays quarterback at Appalachian State University (Boone, N.C.).

MACON, Ga. (AP) — Kaelan Riley threw for three touchdowns and ran for two more in his first career game to lead Mercer to a 48-7 win over Jacksonville in a season opener on Thursday night.

The redshirt freshman was 18 of 26 for 206 yards and ran 10 times for 54 yards. Riley replaced John Russ, who started every game in his four years, which coincided with Mercer bringing back football in 2013 after dropping the sport in 1942. It was the Bears' largest season-opening win since beating Georgia Southern 77-0 in 1937.

Riley connected with Sam Walker for 8- and 18-yard scores and scored on a 4-yard run as the Bears led 27-0 at halftime. He added a 58-yard strike to Edmond Graham and a 13-yard scoring run in the third quarter as the lead reached 48-0. LeMarkus Bailey had 10 tackles and an interception for the Mercer defense. Caysaun Wakeley had 15 tackles for Jacksonville, which turned it over three times.
