Jeremiah JeanPierre - Coach's Comments: "Excited to have Jeremiah in the program. First off, Jeremiah is a phenomenal student. He gives us depth and physicality in the front court. I am looking forward to see him compete."

Elijah Mitchell - Coach's Comments: "My staff and I can't wait to get Elijah on the floor. He has a big time skill set and has a great feel for the game. He won a ton of games at the D-1 junior college level and you can tell he expects to win when he steps out on the floor. He has the ability to play and defend multiple positions. Excited for his experience and talent to blend with this group."
 Prior to Mercy: Attended Monroe College... Two-time Shore Conference champion and was named Shore Conference Championship MVP.

Justinas Norkus - Coach's Comments: "Justinas gives us size and length in our front court. He has a great skill set, runs the floor very well, and is always around the ball. I think Justinas has a ton of upside."

Kerwin Prince - Coach's Comments: "Kerwin has a very high motor and is fearless on the court. He plays with a chip on his shoulder which is essential in our conference. He gives us physicality and toughness in our front court."
 Prior to Mercy: Honor student at Notre Dame High School.

NEWCOMERS

Abdul Seck - Coach's Comments: "Excited for Abdul to join our program. He is a tough, hardworking young man and a great student. He is going to be pushing and challenging our guys every day."
 Prior to Mercy: Averaged over a 90 the last two years of high school... Averaged 18 points, 5 rebounds and 5 assists in high school.

James Taylor Jr. - Coach's Comments: "I am extremely excited for James Taylor. He has played against the top competition his whole life. Prepping at Fork Union Military and then the last two years at Neosho Community College playing in one of the top junior college conferences in the country. He can really shoot it, defend, but more importantly he is tough and a young man of high character."

Jay Turner - Coach's Comments: "Jay is a great addition to our program. I love his versatility to play on and off the ball. He has great size and athleticism allowing him to defend every guard position and also make plays on the offensive end for his teammates. Above all, he is a gym rat which we can never have enough of. I look forward to seeing him keep getting better and better."
 Prior to Mercy: Named All-City and All-League.

GAME NOTES: MERCY AT DAEMEN

- In their last game on Wednesday, Mercy dropped a 99-67 decision to No. 10/16 St. Thomas Aquinas. Mercy was led by freshman Kerwin Prince who had a game-high 24 points and nine rebounds.
- Mercy was picked to finish 5th in the ECC Preseason Poll released in January.
- The Mavericks are looking to pick up their first-ever win over Daemen.
- Mercy is currently 0-15 all-time against the Wildcats.
- The Mavericks are looking to pick up their first ECC road win since January 15, 2020 at Queens.
- Prince was named ECC Defensive Player and Rookie of the Week and was tabbed Metropolitan Basketball Writers Association Division II-III Player of the Week Honorable Mention earlier this week after averaging 17.3 points and a team-high 11.0 rebounds per game. The freshman is a two-time ECC Rookie of the Week and is currently averaging 20.8 points and 10.4 rebounds per game on the year on 61.0 percent shooting.
- Also contributing is junior James Taylor Jr. who was named to the ECC Honor Roll this week after posting 17.7 points per game in three games. The junior is currently averaging 14.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per game on the year. Sophomores Brandon Wilson and Garrett Kirkland also contribute with 9.4 and 9.2 points per game, respectively.
- The Mavericks win over Molloy on Sunday was their first over the Lions since 2018 and the 26-point margin of victory was Mercy's largest over Molloy since 2005.
- Mercy is currently ranked No. 18 nationally in fewest fouls (90) and is No. 29 in fewest turnovers (96). The Mavericks are also currently ranked No. 34 in turnovers forced per game (15.6), No. 29 in offensive rebounds per game (12.6), No. 48 in scoring offense (79.0) and No. 33 in blocks per game (3.6).
- Prince is currently ranked No. 11 nationally in rebounds per game (10.4), No. 6 in offensive rebounds per game (4.4), No. 26 in field goal percentage (61.0) and No. 28 in points per game (20.8).
- Daemen enters Saturday's game on a two-game winning streak and is coming off an 85-69 win over Roberts Wesleyan on Wednesday.
- The Wildcats were picked second in the ECC Preseason Coaches Poll.
- Daemen has won at least 19 games in each of the last nine seasons and is coming off back-to-back seasons with 24 wins that led to NCAA Tournament berths.
- The Wildcats are 2-1 at home this season after going 15-1 at home last year.
- Daemen is led by redshirt senior Andrew Sischo who became the program's all-time leading scorer in last Thursday's loss to Roberts Wesleyan. Sischo is one point shy of 2,000 for his career and is averaging 29.8 points and 14.8 rebounds per game on 59.0 percent shooting. He was named D2CCA First Team All-American and named to the NABC All-America Team last season. He was the ECC Player of the Week and First Team All-ECC selection in 2020. This season he has been named ECC Player of the Week once.
- Sischo currently leads Division II in points per game and rebounds per game. He also is first in offensive rebounds per game (6.67), No. 7 in defensive rebounds per game (8.17) and No. 9 in double-doubles (6).
- Graduate transfer Sean Fasoyiro is one of only four Daemen players who entered the season with at least 25 games of collegiate experience. He is averaging 14.3 points per game and 6.7 rebounds per game on 47.1 percent shooting. He had a season-high 19 points in the win over D'Youville on February 15th.
- Senior Kyle Harris and freshman Andrew Mason also average double figures with 13.0 and 12.3 points per game, respectively.
- Daemen is currently ranked No. 7 nationally in assists per game (18.3) and is No. 3 in rebound margin (9.0)

HEAD COACH MICHAEL MACZKO

FOURTH SEASON

Michael Maczko was named Head Men's Basketball Coach on September 14, 2017.

During the 2019-20 campaign, Maczko guided the Mavericks to five wins and senior Bryan Griffin was named First Team All-ECC, First Team All-Met and D2CCA Second Team All-Region. Under Maczko's leadership, Griffin was crowned the NCAA Division II Statistical Champion in Rebounds Per Game, set a school record for single-season and career rebounds, career blocks and recorded his 1,000th career point.

In 2018-19, Maczko led the Mavericks to eight wins and junior Bryan Griffin was named First Team All-ECC after setting a new single-season record for rebounds. Griffin was also named First Team All-Met and Second Team All-District by the NABC.

In his first season at the helm, Maczko led the Mavericks to five times more wins than the 2016-17 season and nearly guided Mercy to their second ECC Tournament appearance in three years.

"I would like to thank President Hall and Director of Athletics Matt Kilcullen for the tremendous opportunity to lead the men's basketball program at Mercy College. I am looking forward to get to work, to talk with the student-athletes and to meet the community. Mercy is a terrific college, in an excellent conference, and located in a beautiful area with great basketball talent. I am very excited to join the Mavericks family," stated Maczko.

Maczko brings a wealth of experience to the Mercy sidelines, having coached at various levels since 2011 after an impressive playing career. The native of Bel Air, Maryland joins the Mavericks after serving as the Assistant Men's Basketball Coach and JV Head Coach at Post University during the 2016-17 season. Maczko assisted the head coach in all aspects of the program, including recruiting, scheduling, scouting, player development, academic progress, travel arrangements and practice plans.

Prior to his stint at Post, Maczko was the Graduate Assistant for Men's Basketball at Georgia Tech during the 2015-16 season. While at Georgia Tech, Maczko assisted the coaching staff in the breakdown of film for team and opponents, the preparation of scouting reports and for working out student-athletes in the offseason.

During the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons, Maczko was the Assistant Men's Basketball Coach at Johns Hopkins University where he assisted the head coach in all aspects of the program. During the 2014-15 season, Maczko was part of the staff that led Johns Hopkins to a regular season conference championship and an appearance in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, ending the season with a record of 25-5.

Maczko also was an assistant for the Baltimore NIKE Elite 16U team from 2012-14 and was a Volunteer Assistant Coach at his alma mater Salisbury University during the fall of 2012. Maczko has also served and currently serves as a camp counselor at the Hoop-Group Skills and HoopGroup Elite basketball camp.

Maczko brings an impressive playing resume as well to Dobbs Ferry, having starred in high school, college and in a semi-professional league. Maczko played three years of varsity basketball at the John Carroll School before heading to NJIT on a full athletic scholarship. While at NJIT, Maczko started three games and averaged 12.5 minutes per game as a freshman. After playing a year at NJIT, Maczko went on to Salisbury University where he started every game (77) in his three years, serving as team captain during his junior and senior year. He was a Capital Athletic Conference All-Conference selection in 2011-12 and ended his career with 11.3 points per game and 7.5 rebounds per game. After graduating from Salisbury in 2012, Maczko played for the Bay Area Shuckers in the American Professional Basketball League (APBL) from 2013-15.

Maczko graduated from Salisbury in 2012 with a Bachelor of Arts in Communications with a minor in Business Administration before earning a Master of Science in Sports Management from California University of Pennsylvania in 2016.
