TOP STORYLINES

► No. 17 Michigan returns home for the first of two meetings this season with Michigan State, hosting the Spartans at Crisler Center.

► Michigan has topped 80 points in each of the last three games, averaging 82.3 points per game over the stretch. It is just the second time in program history that U-M has reached 80 in three straight conference games. The Wolverines did it for three straight games during the 2016-17 season, coming against Nebraska (84), Northwestern (80) and Illinois (86).

► U-M and MSU split the season series last year, with each team winning at home. The Maize and Blue has won four of the last five games in the series.

► **Maddie Nolan** is one made three-pointer away from entering the top 10 in Michigan history. Nolan has 134 triples on 37.0 percent shooting for her career.

► **Leigha Brown** has scored at least 20 points in each of Michigan's last three games. She has seven 20-point games on the season and is 82 points away from reaching the 1,000-point mark of her Michigan career. She has 1,640 career points, ranking 37th among active NCAA Division I players.

► Michigan has a trio of double-figure scorers in **Emily Kiser** (17.4 ppg, 7.1 rpg), **Laila Phelia** (16.6 ppg) and **Leigha Brown** (15.9 ppg, 5.8 apg).




Last Time Out

The No. 17-ranked University of Michigan women's basketball team held Purdue to just nine points in the third quarter, extending a four-point halftime lead into a 16-point advantage en route to an 80-59 win over Purdue on Tuesday evening (Jan. 10) at Mackey Arena.

Michigan (14-3, 4-2 B1G) had three players in double figures, led by **Leigha Brown's** 21 points, four boards, four assists and two blocks. **Emily Kiser** went for 17 points and seven rebounds after missing the majority of the first quarter after getting hit in the face, with **Laila Phelia** going for 17 points of her own and four boards. U-M topped the 80-point mark for the third straight game, shooting an even 50.0 percent (28-for-56) from the floor and 41.2 percent (7-for-17) from deep. Michigan got 17 points from its bench, with nine Wolverines finding the scoring column.

After the teams exchanged scores to start, Michigan used an 11-0 run that was capped by a deep triple from Brown to force a Purdue timeout with 4:34 remaining in the first quarter and Michigan's lead at 13-2.

Purdue answered with back-to-back triples to get within 13-8 but **Chyra Evans** hit a triple to double up the Boilers at 16-8. The teams exchanged free throws before Purdue went on an 8-0 run to close Michigan's lead to 21-18 with six seconds remaining. **Ari Wiggins** went the length of the floor and found **Cameron Williams** for a layup to send Michigan to the quarter break with a 23-18 lead.

Michigan extended its lead to 29-23 off a **Greta Kamp-schroeder** jumper in transition at the 4:49 mark of the second quarter, but Purdue scored five straight to force a Michigan timeout with 4:07 to go and Purdue within a point at 29-28.

Evans found Kiser for the easy two out of the timeout, with Michigan's lead growing to as many as five in the final minutes of the second quarter. Michigan hit the half with a 39-35 lead after Brown found Kiser for the layup with just two seconds remaining.

After a slow start to the third quarter, Michigan put together an 8-0 run that featured five points from Brown and a **Jordan Hobbs** triple to force a Purdue timeout with 7:30 to go and Michigan's lead up to 46-37.

The Wolverines continued to keep their foot on the gas; eventually turning it into a 15-4 run that was capped by a Nolan triple off an offensive board and a Phelia free throw for a 58-41 advantage with a little over a minute remaining in the period. Purdue hit a triple on its next possession but was held to single-digit scoring in the period.

Michigan again scored at the end of the period, with Phelia grabbing the offensive board off a Nolan miss to beat the buzzer for a 60-44 lead after 30 minutes.

U-M scored seven of the first nine points of the final stanza, getting another triple from Nolan, two freebies from Phelia and an acrobatic three-point play from Brown with 6:32 to go, pushing Michigan's lead to 22.

The Maize and Blue led by as many as 23 points the rest of the way, getting its fourth Big Ten win of the season.

Rival Time!

Michigan and Michigan State are squaring off in the first of two meetings this season. The teams split the series last season, with each team winning at home.

The Wolverines have won four of the last five against the Spartans.

Points, Points, Points

Michigan has topped 80 points in each of the last three games, averaging 82.3 points per game over the stretch. It is only the second time in program history that U-M has strung together three consecutive 80-point games in conference action. Michigan last accomplished the feat during the 2016-17 season, going for 84 against Nebraska (1/22/17), 80 against Northwestern (1/25/17) and 86 against Illinois (2/1/17). U-M is 6-1 this season when scoring at least 80 points.

The Straw that Stirs the Drink

Leigha Brown has taken her game to another level in her final season in the Maize and Blue. Primarily playing the point guard position for the Wolverines, she already has 92 assists this season (5.8/game) to top last year's total of 81. She has tallied two games this season with at least 10 assists, notching the first point-assist double-double of her career with 10 points and a career-best 11 dimes against Northwestern (Dec. 4). She had a point-rebound double-double against Penn State (Jan. 3) with 22 points, 10 boards and eight assists to become the first Wolverine since Siera Thompson (2016-17) to record both varieties of a double-double in the same season. Brown has recorded three straight 20-point games after going for 21 points on 7-for-13 shooting at Purdue. She is 82 points away from recording 1,000 points in her Michigan career, with her 1,640 career points ranking 37th among active NCAA Division I players.

Brown is one of three players nationally to average at least 15.0 points and 5.0 assists per game on better than 50.0 percent shooting.

Jordan Breaks Out

Jordan Hobbs had a breakout game against Iowa (Jan. 7), going for a career-best 21 points on 5-for-7 shooting in 15 minutes of action. She is the seventh Wolverine to record a double-figure scoring game this season and bumped her average up to 3.4 points per game on 43.6 percent shooting. Hobbs followed that up by playing a career-high 18 minutes at Purdue (Jan. 10), finishing with five points, three boards and two assists while going +16 in her minutes. She is fourth on the team with 10 three-pointers made, coming at a 38.5 percent clip. Hobbs is averaging 3.5 points per game on 45.2 percent shooting from the floor.

Kiser Hits the Glass

Emily Kiser, who was just added to the Wooden Awards Midseason Top 25 Watch List, is up to 489 rebounds for her career after grabbing seven at Purdue (Jan. 10). She is 11 boards away from becoming the 27th member of the 500-rebound club. She has three double-doubles this season, bringing her career total to seven - with all seven happening the last two seasons. If her scoring average holds, she can become a member of the 1,000-point club later this season.

Maddie Nylon!

Maddie Nolan has found her shooting stroke since the holiday break, reaching double figures three of Michigan's five games. Nolan went for a season-high 17 points against Penn State (Jan. 3), hitting five triples for her fourth career game with at least five three-pointers. On the season, Nolan leads the Maize and Blue with 32 three-pointers to move her career total to 134. She is one away from moving into the top 10 in Michigan history.

PLAYER & TEAM NOTES**Brown Named To Big Ten Honor Roll Again**

Leigha Brown was named to the Big Ten Player of the Week Honor Roll after recording a pair of 20-point games in Michigan's 1-1 week. Against Penn State (Jan. 3), Brown recorded her second double-double of the season with 22 points, 10 rebounds and eight assists in 36 minutes of action. She followed that up with 20 points, three boards and six assists in 31 minutes against No. 16 Iowa. For the week, she averaged 21.0 points per game on 55.2 percent shooting with 7.0 assists and 6.5 rebounds per contest.

Back to Big Ten Play

Michigan finished its non-conference season with a 10-1 record, marking the sixth time in program history and the first since the 2017-18 season that U-M made it to double figures in the non-con. U-M has 12 Big Ten games remaining after getting a win at Purdue last time out (Jan. 10). U-M will face Nebraska, Ohio State, Michigan State, Rutgers and Indiana in home-and-home series over the next few months, while facing each of the other schools just once.

Williams Double Dips for the First Time

Cameron Williams turned in the first double-double of her career at No. 3 Ohio State (Dec. 31), setting new career highs in both points (18) and rebounds (10). It was her fourth double-figure scoring effort of the season. She was joined in the double-double club by **Emily Kiser**, who had 10 points and 10 boards. It was the first time this season and the first since Jan. 24, 2022 against Purdue that Michigan had two players with double-doubles in the same game.

Statement Win

Michigan picked up its second win over a ranked opponent this season before the holiday break, knocking off No. 6-ranked North Carolina, 76-68, behind a 35-point first quarter. Michigan is now 2-0 this season against ranked teams and 2-0 against the ACC. The win over the Tar Heels was Michigan's ninth top-10 win in program history, with head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** accounting for five of them.

KBA Reaches 500 Career Wins

Head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** grabbed career win No. 500 at Nebraska (Dec. 28), making her the fifth active Big Ten coach to reach the mark. She joins the Big Ten's active 500-win club, which includes Iowa's Lisa Bluder, Northwestern's Joe McKeown, Maryland's Brenda Frese and Michigan State's Suzy Merchant.

Brown Named Big Ten Co-Player of the Week

Leigha Brown was named the Co-Big Ten Player of the Week on Dec. 27 after helping Michigan to a 76-68 win over No. 6 North Carolina at the Jumpman Invitational (Dec. 20). It is the second weekly honor of her career and first this season from the conference. Brown turned in a game-high 25 points on 9-for-15 shooting, eight rebounds, four assists and two steals as Michigan recorded its second top-25 win of the season. Brown scored 13 of her points on 4-for-4 shooting from the floor and a 3-for-3 showing from distance in the first quarter as Michigan put up a program-record 35 points in the first 10 minutes to essentially put the game out of reach for the Tar Heels.

Evans Makes an Impact

After dealing with an injury in the preseason that kept her out of the first several games, **Chyra Evans** has made an impact off the bench. Since finding herself in the rotation, she led U-M in plus-minus against both Northwestern (+18 in 15 minutes) and Toledo (+14 in 14 minutes). She scored a career-best eight points on 4-for-5 shooting against App State (Dec. 17). Evans recently went for seven points, nine rebounds and four blocks against No. 6 North Carolina (Dec. 20). She has now appeared in 11 games and is averaging 2.7 points per game on 63.6 percent shooting.

Greta Contributes All Over the Floor

Greta Kampschroeder has found ways to contribute all over the floor, recently recording a career-best five steals, along with four points, three rebounds and an assist in 19 minutes at Nebraska (Dec. 28). She became the first Wolverine since Naz Hillmon (March 21 vs. Villanova) to record five steals in a contest. She scored 11 points in Michigan's win over App State (Dec. 17), marking her first double-figure scoring game in a Michigan uniform and the sixth of her collegiate career. She has appeared in all 17 games, averaging 4.2 points and 3.0 rebounds in 18.0 minutes per game.

Checking in at No. 17

The Wolverines came in at No. 17 in this week's Associated Press poll. Michigan has appeared in the last 45 AP polls, the ninth-longest active streak.

Kiser Keeps Getting Better

After a breakout senior season a year ago, **Emily Kiser** has gotten even better during her fifth year of action. Kiser has upped her scoring by more than eight points, going from 9.3 points per game a season ago to 17.4 points per game this season. She has scored in double figures in 16 games, reaching the 20-point mark six times - marking the first 20-point games of her career. She is shooting 58.1 percent from the floor and 77.4 percent from the line, while also grabbing 7.1 boards in 33.8 minutes per game. Kiser, who has scored 295 points this season, has already topped her total points from her first three seasons - 163 - and did it in just nine games.

Phelia Making a Leap

Laila Phelia is making a leap during her sophomore season after a successful freshman campaign. As a freshman, Phelia appeared in 29 games and started 14 times. In her sophomore season, she has already surpassed her three-point total (15) from last year with 23 triples on 40.4 percent shooting through 17 games this season. Phelia, who has scored in double figures in all but two games, has nearly doubled her scoring output from 8.8 points per game last season to 16.6 points per game this season. She also is second on the team in steals with 26 and is shooting 45.5 percent from the floor. She is also tasked with the toughest defensive assignment on the other side of the floor.

Leigha Brown = Playmaker

Thrust into playing point guard this season, **Leigha Brown** is thriving in a playmaking role. She leads Michigan with 94 assists on the season, handing out 5.8 per contest to rank fourth in the Big Ten. In Michigan's come-from-behind win over South

PLAYER & TEAM NOTES

Florida (Nov. 26), Brown scored or assisted on 12 of Michigan's final 14 points. She found **Maddie Nolan** for three consecutive triples, accounting for three of her four assists in the game. Brown also added a game-high 23 points. Against No. 21 Baylor (Nov. 27), she scored eight of her 11 points in the fourth quarter. Brown assisted on Michigan's go-ahead three-pointer from **Laila Phelia** with 48.5 seconds remaining - one of her two assists in the final period. After going for a season-high 26 points at Miami (Dec. 1), Brown handed out a career-best 11 assists - nine in the second half - against Northwestern (Dec. 4).

Brown had 25 points, eight boards, four assists and two steals against No. 6 North Carolina (Dec. 20) before following that up with 20 points, eight boards and seven assists at Nebraska (Dec. 28).

Fast Start...Again

For the second time in the last three seasons, Michigan won its first nine games. U-M started with a 10-0 record in 2020-21, marking the best start in program history.

Stingy on D

Michigan is third in the Big Ten in scoring defense at 60.9 points per game. Michigan has held 13 of its 17 opponents under 70 points this season.

Michigan's Big Three

Emily Kiser (17.4 ppg), **Laila Phelia** (16.6 ppg) and **Leigha Brown** (15.9 ppg) have combined to form a very effective trio for the Maize and Blue. Kiser has scored in double figures in 16 games, topping the 20-point mark six times. Phelia has 15 double-figure scoring games, with Brown reaching double figures 13 times. Both Phelia and Brown have reached the 20-point mark seven times. They are accounting for 63.4 percent of Michigan's scoring.

Ranked Wins Under KBA

Michigan has 25 wins against ranked opponents since head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** took over in Ann Arbor before the 2012-13 season. Her 25 wins account for 50.0 percent of Michigan's all-time wins (50) over top-25 teams. U-M went 8-2 last season against teams in the AP top 25, highlighted by the program's first-ever win over a top-five team (No. 5 Baylor), the first win at No. 8 Maryland and its second win over a top-five team (No. 5 Indiana). Michigan is 2-2 against ranked teams this season after knocking off No. 21 Baylor for the second straight season and No. 6 North Carolina at the Jumpman Invitational (Dec. 20).

Perfect at Line x2

Leigha Brown was perfect from the free throw line against Miami (Dec. 1), going 12-for-12 from the charity stripe, marking the fifth time a Wolverine went 12-for-12 at the line and the first since Jennifer Smith against Wisconsin on Jan. 22, 2004. It was the third time in her Michigan career that Brown was perfect from the line on double-digit attempts. It took just one more game for a Wolverine to equal the feat again, as **Emily Kiser** went 12-for-12 against Northwestern (Dec. 4).

Shooting the Rock

Michigan is shooting 48.2 percent from the floor this season, ranking fourth in the Big Ten and 10th nationally. The Wolverines have shot better than 50 percent seven times this season, hitting at a season-best 58.6 percent clip against Western Michigan (Nov. 16) and most recently reaching the mark with a 50.0 percent showing at Purdue (Jan. 10). Individually, **Emily Kiser** is fourth in the Big Ten in field goal percentage at .581, with Leigha Brown ranking sixth (.506) and **Laila Phelia** ranking 14th at .455.

Race to a Triple-Double?

Michigan has already had several players flirt with recording a triple-double this season. **Emily Kiser** had 25 points, 14 rebounds and eight assists against Western Michigan (Nov. 16) to record the double-double. **Maddie Nolan** had nine points, seven rebounds and seven assists in the same game. In her first start of the season at Fairfield (Nov. 20), **Leigha Brown** turned in 17 points, seven rebounds and six assists in just 27 minutes of action. Brown had 10 points, 11 assists and five boards against NU (Dec. 4) for Michigan's first point-assist double-double since 2016. LB also has been close the last several games against North Carolina (25-8-4), Nebraska (20-8-7) and Penn State (22-10-8). U-M has had only one triple-double recorded in program history, coming courtesy of Trish Andrew's 12 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against Old Dominion on Dec. 30, 1992. Michigan has never had a points-rebounds-assists triple-double recorded in program history.

One Shy of 100

Michigan put up 99 points against Western Michigan (Nov. 16), its most points since scoring 105 against Delaware State on Dec. 21, 2017. Michigan has topped the 90-point mark twice already this season after scoring at least 90 just four times last season.

Williams in the Starting Lineup

Junior forward **Cameron Williams** has earned starts in Michigan's first 17 games, scoring in double figures four times. In Michigan's season-opening win over Delaware State (Nov. 9), Williams went for 13 points before following it up with 12 points against Saint Francis (Nov. 11). She also contributed eight rebounds and two assists against the Red Flash. She pulled down a pivotal defensive rebound with Michigan clinging to a three-point lead against South Florida (Nov. 26), hitting the ensuing free throws with eight seconds left to seal Michigan's five-point win. Williams followed that up with 10 points against No. 21 Baylor (Nov. 27). She turned in the first double-double of her career at No. 3 Ohio State (Dec. 2) with 18 points and 10 boards. Williams is averaging 7.1 points and 4.2 rebounds in 19.1 minutes per game.

Crockett Stuffs the Stat Sheet

Freshman **Alyssa Crockett** has made quite an impact off the bench, stuffing the stat sheet. In her Maize and Blue debut (Nov. 9), she led the team with eight rebounds while also contributing six points and a steal. Against Saint Francis (Nov. 11), Crockett paced the Wolverines with six assists and four blocks. She followed that up with four points, five assists, four rebounds and three steals in 16 minutes against Western Michigan (Nov. 16). She canned a pair of triples in just 3:18 of game time in Michigan's win over No. 6 North Carolina (Dec. 20).

Michigan Made, Presented by Meijer

With its media rights partner Learfield, the University of Michigan Athletic Department made an all-access documentary series that profiles the 2022-2023 Michigan Women's Basketball team as they look to build off their historic Elite Eight run last season. It delivered an unparalleled look into a program on the rise, and the players and coaches committed to building the next championship team at the University of Michigan. All five episodes can be seen on YouTube or at MGoBlue.com/MichiganMade.

Ranked to Begin 2022-23

Michigan earned a preseason ranking from both the Associated Press (No. 25) and the USA Today Coaches (No. 23) polls. It marked the fourth straight season that Michigan has been ranked in the first AP poll of the season. U-M was one of six Big Ten schools to be ranked in the preseason.

Welcome, Erin Batth!

The Wolverines have one new face on the sidelines this season in assistant coach and recruiting coordinator, **Erin Batth**. She spent the previous four seasons at NC State and played collegiately at Clemson. She takes over for Carrie Moore, who was named the head coach at Harvard following last season. Head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** has had four assistant coaches get head coaching positions since 2017 in Megan Duffy (first at Miami, now at Marquette), Melanie Moore (Xavier), Toyelle Wilson (SMU) and Carrie Moore (Harvard).

Replacing 00

The big question of Michigan's offseason revolved around replacing arguably the best player in program history - **Naz Hillmon**. Hillmon was the first player to earn All-America honors in program history, along with becoming the only Wolverine in school history (man or woman) to record 2,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in a career. She was drafted No. 15 by the Atlanta Dream and set the Dream rookie rebounding record by grabbing 172 boards.

Welcome to 200 in A2, KBA!

With a pair of wins at the Daytona Beach Invitational last season, head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** became the first women's basketball coach in school history to win 200 games at Michigan. She is now 230-111 (.674) on the sidelines in Ann Arbor as she is in her 11th year. She is the program's all-time winningest coach and has the highest winning percentage. She is just the third basketball coach at Michigan - men's or women's - to reach 200 wins, joining John Beilein (278 from 2007-19) and Johnny Orr (209 from 1968-80).

Simple Enough...Just Score

U-M is 89-8 under head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** when scoring at least 80 points. Michigan has topped the 80-point mark in seven games this year.

J. Ira and Nicki Harris Family Head Women's Basketball Coach **Kim Barnes Arico** finished her 10th season as the head coach in 2021-22, leading the Maize and Blue to 25 wins and the first NCAA Elite Eight appearance in program history. Throughout her 10-year tenure, she has guided the Wolverines to at least 20 wins in nine seasons, five NCAA Tournament appearances, an NCAA Elite Eight appearance (2022), an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance (2021) and the 2017 WNIT Championship. She was announced as the ninth head coach in the history of the program on April 20, 2012.

Barnes Arico is the winningest coach in program history with 218 wins, the only coach to ever eclipse 200 victories. With nine of Michigan's 13 all-time 20-win seasons, she is first all-time in winning percentage (.667) with a 218-109 record in Ann Arbor. Barnes Arico holds a 134-32 (.807) record at Crisler Center after the first-ever undefeated mark (16-0) in 2021-22. She is on the cusp of reaching 500 career wins, entering the 2022-23 season just 12 victories away.

KBA has taken Michigan women's basketball to new heights since taking over prior to the 2012-13 campaign, doubling U-M's NCAA Tournament appearances and making at least the second round in all five trips. Michigan has advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 twice under KBA, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 2021-22, moving her record to 8-5 in the NCAA Tournament at Michigan. The Wolverines have won at least 20 games in nine of her 10 seasons, only missing the mark during the 2020-21 season as U-M played just 22 total games. Michigan has made the postseason in all but one of Barnes Arico's seasons, only missing the 2019-20 postseason due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Michigan has won at least one game in every postseason appearance under KBA.

U-M has found itself back in the national spotlight as well during KBA's tenure, returning to the Associated Press poll in January 2013 for the first time in 10 years. Michigan has been ranked in every Associated Press and USA Today Coaches Polls over the last two seasons (2020-21, 2021-22), peaking at No. 4 in both for the highest ranking in program history.

Barnes Arico is a two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2017, 2022) and was a semi-finalist for the 2022 Werner Ladder Coach of the Year honor. She has coached 20 players to earn postseason conference honors, highlighted by U-M's first All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year, Naz Hillmon, along with all-time leading scorer and three-time All-Big Ten first-teamer, Katelynn Flaherty. Hillmon was named the 2021 Big Ten Player of the Year, making her just the second Big Ten player in conference history to earn Player, Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year honors during a career. Hillmon was a two-time WBCA All-American, while also earning honors twice by the Associated Press, USBWA, Sports Illustrated and the Athletic. The 2017-18 Michigan Female Athlete of the Year, Flaherty also earned three consecutive WBCA All-America honorable mentions (2016, 2017, 2018). Nicole Elmlblad also earned back-to-back Academic All-America honors (2014, 2015) and was the recipient of the 2015 Big Ten Medal of Honor.

She also is building quite the coaching tree as five of her former assistant coaches are now head coaches: Joe Tartamella (St. John's), Megan Duffy (Marquette), Melanie Moore (Xavier), Toyelle Wilson (SMU) and Carrie Moore (Harvard).

The 2021-22 season was full of highlights for the Maize and Blue, who advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. U-M went 25-7 on the season, the second-best win total and highest winning percentage in program history. The Wolverines picked up eight wins over ranked teams, again setting a new program standard. Michigan was ranked in both polls throughout the season, garnering the first top-five and top-10 rankings in school history. U-M finished No. 12 in the AP poll and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches poll, both program highs. The Wolverines hosted the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament for the first time as a No. 3 seed, recording wins over American and Villanova to punch their Sweet 16 ticket for the second straight season before knocking out South Dakota to advance. U-M went 16-0 at Crisler Center, the first undefeated home season in program history while averaging 3,676 fans.

Hillmon was a unanimous and consensus All-Big Ten first teamer, making her the first player in program history to earn four first-team nods. She also earned All-America first-team honors from the WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, The Athletic, Sports Illustrated and the Wooden Award. Leigha Brown was named to the All-Big Ten second team, with Laila Phelia grabbing a spot on the freshman team. The Wolverines put 10 on the Academic All-Big Ten team, while Brown, Maddie Nolan, Danielle Rauch and Emily Kiser were named CoSIDA Academic All-District.

From 2018-21, U-M made three NCAA Tournament appearances, only missing the 2020 Tournament due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Wolverines won at least one game in all three tournaments, making the program's first-ever Sweet 16 appearance in 2021.

Barnes Arico led Michigan to its first postseason championship in 2016-2017, as the Wolverines captured the WNIT Championship after being left out of the NCAA Tournament despite a third-place finish in the Big Ten. Michigan went 11-5 in conference play to finish alone in third place, its highest finish since 2011 and the second-most Big Ten wins in program history. The Wolverines regrouped during the WNIT, reeling off six straight wins for the title. U-M held off Georgia Tech in three overtimes in the championship game to hang its first banner in Crisler.

During KBA's first five seasons in the Maize and Blue, the Wolverines racked up at least 20 wins in each year and advanced to the postseason each time. In 2013-14, U-M weathered losing 88 percent of its scoring from the season before to still reach 20 wins and the third round of the WNIT with four new starters.

Barnes Arico also completed a two-year stint with USA Basketball (2014-15), serving as an assistant coach alongside Dawn Staley (South Carolina) and Jeff Walz (Louisville) for the U18 (2014) and U19 (2015) teams. She won a pair of gold medals at the FIBA U19 World Championships in 2015 and at the FIBA U18 America's Championship in 2014.

Prior to joining the Maize and Blue, she spent 10 seasons at the helm of the St. John's women's hoops program, building the Red Storm into a national power. She guided St. John's to four NCAA Tournament appearances, with the Red Storm advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2012.

Barnes Arico compiled a 176-133 overall record and five 20-win campaigns at St. John's. She was a two-time Big East Coach of the Year (2006, 2012) and had 11 players earn All-Big East honors, with six receiving all-rookie team nods.

In 2011-12, St. John's posted a 24-10 overall record and finished second (13-3) in the Big East standings. St. John's finished No. 15 in the final USA Today Coaches poll and reached its highest-ever ranking of No. 13 by the Associated Press. The highlight of the season was when Barnes Arico and her Red Storm ended Connecticut's 99-game home winning streak with a 57-56 win on Feb. 19, 2012 at Gampel Pavilion. It was also UConn's first home loss to an unranked opponent in nearly 19 years.

Prior to accepting her position at St. John's, Barnes Arico was extremely successful at NCAA Division II Adelphi (1999-2002). She led the Panthers to three consecutive postseason appearances, posting a 65-24 overall record and a 51-13 league mark. She was inducted into the Adelphi Hall of Fame in 2014.

In 2001-02, Adelphi won its first New York Collegiate Athletic Conference (NYCAC) championship and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Panthers finished with a 28-3 record and earned the school's first national ranking in school history, finishing No. 12. Barnes Arico was named the NYCAC, NIT/Metropolitan Basketball Writers Division II and Nassau County Sports Commission Outstanding Female Coach of the Year.

Barnes Arico started her head-coaching career at Fairleigh Dickinson-Madison, a Division III university in New Jersey. She led the Devils to a 13-11 record during the 1996-97 season before accepting the head coaching post at New Jersey Institute of Technology for two seasons (1997-99). Helping the program transition from Division III to Division II, Barnes Arico was named the New Jersey Coach of the Year after taking the program from the five-win total in her first season to 11 victories in year two.

A native of Mastic Beach, N.Y., Barnes Arico helped lead Stony Brook University to the 1989 NCAA Division III Tournament as a freshman. She spent her final three seasons at Montclair State University, serving as captain during her junior and senior seasons. Barnes Arico led the team to back-to-back ECAC Tournament appearances in 1991 and 1992 and was the team's leading scorer both seasons. A scholar-athlete award recipient, Barnes Arico graduated from Montclair State in 1993 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and health.

Barnes Arico went into teaching after graduation, accepting a position as a physical education and health teacher at the Academy of Saint Aloysius in Jersey City, N.J., during the 1993-94 academic year. She left Saint Aloysius and moved into an identical position at Chatham High School from 1994-96 in Chatham, N.J.

Barnes Arico and her husband, Larry Arico, are the parents of a son, Trevor, and daughters Emma and Cecelia.
