TOP STORYLINES

► Michigan concludes the month of January hosting Illinois at Crisler Center in the second meeting between the teams this season. Illinois is the first team Michigan is playing twice this season.

► The Wolverines recorded an 84-48 win over the Illini in Champaign on Dec. 10.

► Michigan is 9-1 this season at Crisler Center after recording a 79-77 overtime win over Maryland on Jan. 24. U-M is averaging 78.5 points per game on 45.8 percent shooting at Crisler while holding opponents to 55.8 points per game on 38.8 percent shooting.

► At the midway point of Big Ten action, Michigan is tied for fifth place with a 5-4 record. Seven teams are over .500 in conference play.

► Michigan and Illinois have not faced each other much over the last several seasons, playing just four times since the beginning of the 2019-20 season. U-M has won eight straight against the Illini.

► Michigan has a pair of double-figure scorers in **Laila Phelia** (16.0) and **Lauren Hansen** (11.2), with **Jordan Hobbs** (9.1) and **Elissa Brett** (7.8) each averaging at least 7.5 points per game.

Last Time Out

The University of Michigan women's basketball team dropped an 82-61 contest to Michigan State on Saturday (Jan. 27) afternoon at the Breslin Center.

Michigan State opened the second quarter on a 9-0 run that turned a four-point lead into a 13-point lead as Michigan could never close the gap the rest of the way. Michigan State took advantage of a doubling up the Wolverines in free throw attempts, 34-17, and scored 20 points off turnovers in the game.

Laila Phelia turned in a game-high 21 points but battled foul trouble in the contest, picking up three fouls in the first half and her fourth early in the third quarter. Jordan Hobbs joined her in double figures with 11, while Chyra Evans and Lauren Hansen each chipped in nine.

After a back-and-forth first few minutes, Elissa Brett picked up her second foul as the contest was tied at 11 with 5:19 remaining in the first quarter. MSU responded with five straight points for a 16-11 lead before a pair of Hobbs three throws stemmed the tide with just under five minutes left in the first.

With a 27-22 lead after the first 10 minutes of action, the Spartans scored the first nine points of the second quarter for a 36-23 advantage with 5:39 left in the period. A Cameron Williams layup trimmed the MSU lead to 11, 38-27, with 3:49 on the clock before halftime but the Spartans scored 10 of the final 13 points for a 48-30 halftime lead.

Michigan scored seven straight -- five from Hansen and an Elise Stuck layup -- to close the Michigan State lead to 13, 50-37, with 7:22 on the third-quarter clock. After a pair of Michigan State free throws, U-M got a layup from Evans a pair of free throws from Hobbs to close within 11, 52-41, with just over six minutes remaining in the third. Michigan had several chances to close the gap but could not sustain the run. An MSU three-point play with 4:56 left in the quarter pushed the lead back to 14, 55-41.

That three-point play ignited a 10-0 run for the Spartans to end the third quarter, giving MSU a 62-41 lead after 30 minutes of action.

The Wolverines used an 8-0 run and held the Spartans scoreless for more than two minutes in the middle stages of the fourth quarter to pull within 16 but could not get any closer.

Wrapping the Series

Michigan and Illinois are wrapping up their season series, the first time U-M is facing an opponent for the second time. Illinois is one of five teams that U-M will face twice, along with Michigan State, Rutgers, Ohio State and Nebraska.

Last Time vs. Illinois

Michigan recorded the sixth-best margin of victory in a Big Ten game in program history with the 36-point win and was one off a program record with 13 three-pointers in the 84-48 win over Illinois on Dec. 10. U-M had four players in double figures, paced by a career-best 22 points from Jordan Hobbs on the strength of four triples on 4-for-5 shooting from deep. Lauren Hansen and Laila Phelia each turned in 14 points, with Chyra Evans going for 10 points in the first start of her career. Michigan turned the ball over just six times in the contest with 20 assists. U-M has won eight straight against Illinois.

Hey, I Know You!

There is a connection between Michigan and Illinois, with Laila Phelia and Makira Cook playing together in high school. The duo played together at Mount Notre Dame High School in Cincinnati, winning the 2019 Division I state title together.

Midway Point of B1G Play

Michigan has hit the midway point of Big Ten action, holding a 5-4 record after nine games. U-M is one of seven teams to have a winning record in conference play and is tied with Nebraska and Michigan State in fifth place.

Looking for a Bounce Back

Michigan is looking for a bounce back after dropping a road contest at Michigan State last time out (Jan. 27). U-M is 5-1 following a loss this season, most recently getting a 56-50 win at Rutgers (Jan. 21) in the first of back-to-back conference wins.

Finding a Way

Michigan won its fourth-ever contest against Maryland (Jan. 24), rallying from a 16-point deficit to defeat the Terps at home, 79-77 in overtime. The Wolverines never led in regulation and only held a lead for 2:22 of the 45-minute game. It snapped a streak of 62 straight wins for the Terrapins when they were leading with five minutes remaining. It was Michigan's first overtime win since a 74-68 victory over No. 5 Baylor on Dec. 19, 2021. U-M did not play an overtime game during the 2022-23 season.

Back at Crisler

Michigan is 9-1 this season at Crisler Center after recording a 79-77 overtime win over Maryland on Jan. 24. U-M is averaging 78.5 points per game on 45.8 percent shooting at Crisler while holding opponents to 55.8 points per game on 38.8 percent shooting.

Evans Breaks Out

Chyra Evans did it all in Michigan's win over Maryland (Jan. 24), finishing with career highs in points (17), assists (5) and minutes (41) to go with eight rebounds. She joins Iowa's Caitlin Clark as the only Big Ten players in conference play to record at least 17 points, eight rebounds and five assists. Evans has started the last 12 games and is averaging 5.9 points and 4.0 rebounds in 20.8 minutes per game.

Phelia Reaches 1,000

Junior Laila Phelia became the 31st Wolverine to reach the 1,000-point mark in Michigan's win over Maryland (Jan. 24), finishing with 14 points for 1,003 in her illustrious career in the Maize and Blue. Michigan now has four 1,000-point scorers on its roster in Phelia, Elissa Brett (1,498), Lauren Hansen (1,321) and Taylor Williams (1,103).

Three-Pointers in Bunches

Michigan has already had five games this season with at least 10 three-pointers, tying a school record with 14 against SIUE (Nov. 29), hitting 13 twice (at Illinois, Dec. 10; vs. Miami, Dec. 16) and putting in 10 twice (Eastern Michigan, Nov. 24; Maryland, Jan. 24). It is the first time since the 2017-18 season that Michigan has had multiple games with at least 10 three-pointers. U-M had three instances in that season, including a game in which Katelynn Flaherty set a school record by hitting 10 three-pointers against Penn State (Dec. 28, 2017). On the season, U-M is averaging 7.1 three-point field goals per game on 35.4 percent.

PLAYER & TEAM NOTES

Welcome Back, Brett!

After missing two games due to injury, **Elissa Brett** returned to action in Michigan's win at Rutgers (Jan. 21). She saw 27 minutes of action off the bench, hitting a key pair of free throws in the closing seconds to hold off the Scarlet Knights. She finished with two points, five rebounds and an assist, going a team-high +7 in the contest. She followed that up with nine points, four boards and eight fouls drawn in Michigan's win over Maryland (Jan. 24). She returned to the starting lineup at Michigan State (Jan. 27). On the season, she is averaging 7.8 points and 4.1 rebounds per game. Brett is second on the team with 27 three-pointers on 37.5 percent shooting from deep.

Lockdown Defense...Again

A year after ranking second in the Big Ten in scoring defense (63.4 ppg), Michigan has continued to find success on the defensive end during the 2023-24 season. U-M is first in the league scoring defense, allowing just 59.9 points per game. Michigan has held 10 of its opponents under 60 points and 16 under 70 points this season. The Wolverines are just as effective on the defensive end in conference play, remaining in the top spot by allowing just 65.9 points per game.

Williams Times Two

Michigan's Williams duo - **Cameron Williams** and **Taylor Williams** - combined for 29 points in Michigan's win over Wisconsin (Jan. 13). Cameron recorded her second double-double of the season in her first start since Dec. 6, going for a season-high 16 points and 10 rebounds. Taylor had 13 points on 5-for-7 shooting in 17 minutes off the bench for her fourth double-figure scoring effort of the season. Between the two of them, they have Michigan's three double-doubles this season.

Conference Play Suits Phelia

Laila Phelia has broken out as Big Ten play has resumed, upping her scoring average to 18.2 points per game against conference opponents. She is fourth in the conference in scoring in Big Ten games, recording four 20-point games. Phelia has also increased her field goal percentage to .449 in Michigan's nine conference contests. She had her best game of the season against No. 17 Ohio State (Dec. 30), scoring a career-best 26 points. She scored 17 of her points in the second half, including nine in the final period as U-M rallied for the win. Phelia followed that up with 23 points at No. 14 Indiana (Jan. 4), marking her fifth 20-point game of the season. She recently went for 25 points on 8-for-16 shooting at Rutgers (Jan. 21) and 21 points at Michigan State (Jan. 27). In an expanded role during her junior season, Phelia is averaging 16.0 points per game and has scored in double figures in all but three games.

Hitting the Glass

U-M is second in the Big Ten in offensive rebounding (13.9 per game), turning those into 12.9 second-chance points per game. U-M also is third in the conference in rebounding margin at +6.4, taking advantage of the offensive rebounds and holding opponents to just 31.2 caroms per game. The Wolverines have outrebounded their opponent in all but seven games, going 13-1 when grabbing more. U-M is 1-6 when being outrebounded, picking up their first win in the game against Rutgers

(Jan. 21) after the Scarlet Knights held a 34-33 advantage on the glass.

Junior Year Jordan

Jordan Hobbs has become a regular starter in her third year in the Maize and Blue, averaging a career-best 9.1 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. She has 192 points on the season, eclipsing last year's total of 147 points (4.9 per game). She is one of three Wolverines to start all 21 games. Hobbs is playing a career-high 26.8 minutes per game, ranking third on the team in that category and in rebounding (4.0 rpg). She had 15 points against Maryland (Jan. 24), hitting four triples on 50 percent shooting to help Michigan rally for the win.

Just Score

It's been a simple equation for Michigan this season - scoring leads to winning. U-M is averaging just 55.6 points per game in its seven losses, down from its season average of 69.6 points per game. Michigan has also allowed 73.9 points per game in its losses, up from its season average of 59.8 points per game. In wins, U-M is up to 76.6 points per game while allowing just 52.9.

Ranked Win

Michigan picked up its first win over a ranked team in the final game of 2023, knocking off then-No. 17 Ohio State, 69-60, at Crisler (Dec. 30). U-M has 27 wins over ranked opponents under 12th-year head coach **Kim Barnes Arico**, which accounts for 51.9 percent of U-M's 52 all-time wins. The victory over the Buckeyes marked Michigan's first win over a ranked Big Ten team since a 71-59 win over No. 13 Maryland during the 2021-22 season (Feb. 20, 2022). Michigan has recorded at least one win over a ranked team in each of KBA's 12 seasons in Ann Arbor.

Hansen Finding Her Groove

Lauren Hansen found her scoring groove in the month of December, averaging 14.3 points per game over the those seven games on 50.0 percent shooting from the floor. Hansen scored in double figures in five of those seven games, highlighted by her first 20-point game in a Michigan uniform with 21 points against Florida (Dec. 20) and a 5-for-7 showing from deep against Florida A&M (Dec. 22) for 19 points. She is up to double-figure scoring on the season now at 11.2 points per game.

Everyone Steps Up

Michigan has been led in scoring 11 times by **Laila Phelia** this season, five times by **Lauren Hansen** and twice by Chyra Evans, with five other Wolverines taking scoring honors once. **Cameron Williams**, **Taylor Williams**, **Alyssa Crockett**, **Jordan Hobbs** and **Elissa Brett** have all led Michigan in scoring during a game at different points in the season.

Brett Catches Fire

Elissa Brett tied a career high against Miami (Ohio) (Dec. 16), pouring in 27 points with seven boards and a pair of assists. In her second start in a Michigan uniform, she hit eight three-pointers to tie the third-best single-game mark in program history. It was the most three-pointers made in a game by a Wolverine not named Katelynn Flaherty. Brett's eight triples were the most by a Big Ten player this season for about eight hours until Caitlin Clark

made nine against Cleveland State.

Double-Figure Scoring

Michigan has had 10 players record a double-figure scoring game thus far, with **Laila Phelia** scoring at least 10 points in 17 games. **Lauren Hansen** (13), **Jordan Hobbs** (10), **Elissa Brett** (5), **Chyra Evans** (4), **Taylor Williams** (4), **Cameron Williams** (4), **Greta Kampschroeder** (1), **Macy Brown** (1) and **Alyssa Crockett** (1) have each reached double figures in scoring this season.

Different Lineups

U-M has already used four different starting lineups this season, with **Laila Phelia**, **Jordan Hobbs** and **Lauren Hansen** starting all 21 games. **Cameron Williams** has 13 starts, with **Taylor Williams** (6), **Elise Stuck** (3), **Chyra Evans** (12) and **Elissa Brett** (8) each earning starts. KBA Gets to 250 in A2

Head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** recorded her 250th win as the Michigan head coach this season, moving her record to 255-125 in Ann Arbor. KBA is the program's winningest coach in both total wins and winning percentage (.671). The only other U-M basketball coach to reach 250 wins in Ann Arbor is John Beilein (278).

All About the Balance

Michigan has a pair of double-figure scorers in **Laila Phelia** (16.0) and **Lauren Hansen** (11.2), with **Jordan Hobbs** (9.1) and **Elissa Brett** (7.8) each averaging at least 7.5 points per game.

Hanging 100

Michigan reached the century mark for the first time since the 2017-18 season, scoring 103 points against SIUE (Nov. 29). It is the seventh time in 12th-year head coach **Kim Barnes Arico**'s tenure that the Wolverines have hit the 100-point mark and is tied for the 11th-most points in a single game in program history.

Feeling It From Deep

Michigan tied a school record in its win over SIUE (Nov. 29), hitting 14 three-pointers at a 56.0 percent clip. It tied the mark set on Nov. 13, 2009 when U-M hit 14 triples against Ball State.

Michigan's Bench Shows Out

U-M got 67 points from its bench in its 103-59 win over SIUE (Nov. 29), outscoring the entire Cougar team. The bench accounted for 28 of Michigan's first 30 points of the game and 39 of its 50 first-half points. Leading the way in scoring for the first time in her career was **Alyssa Crockett**, who turned in 16 points in her first-ever double-figure scoring game. Michigan's freshman duo of **Macy Brown** (12) and **Taylor Woodson** (8) also notched career bests as they find their footing early in their first season in the Maize and Blue. Also contributing off the bench were **Chyra Evans** (9), **Greta Kampschroeder** (8), **Elise Stuck** (8), **Whitney Solom** (4) and **Elissa Brett** (2) as all 13 Wolverines found the scoring column.

Double Dips

Cameron Williams recorded Michigan's first double-double of the season and the second of her career with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Oakland (Nov. 14). Her fellow Williams, **Taylor Williams**, recorded the 28th of her career after going for 19 points and 18 rebounds against South Dakota (Nov. 19). All of the other double-doubles came during her three years on the court at Western Michigan.

Where We Left Off

Michigan is coming off a 23-10 season in 2022-23, reaching the second round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to eventual-national champion LSU in Baton Rouge. U-M has made appearances in the last five NCAA Tournaments, dating back to the 2018 edition. The Wolverines are one of seven teams nationally to advance to at least the second round in each of the last five NCAA Tournaments held (Baylor, Louisville, Maryland, Michigan, South Carolina, Stanford, Connecticut).

Phelia Ready for Junior Season

Junior **Laila Phelia** was a consensus Preseason All-Big Ten selection, earning a unanimous pick from the coaches. Phelia also won a silver medal this past summer with USA Basketball at the AmeriCup and grabbed spots on the Ann Meyers-Drysdale, Naismith Trophy and Wooden Award Watch Lists. In her second season in Ann Arbor, Phelia earned All-Big Ten second-team honors after missing the month of February with an injury. Phelia appeared in 26 games, starting 24 times en route to averaging 16.7 points and 4.2 rebounds in 33.1 minutes per game. She scored in double figures 23 times and topped the 20-point mark 11 times. She was named to the all-tournament team at the Gulf Coast Showcase and to the Big Ten Honor Roll one time. Phelia upped her scoring from 8.8 points per game in her first season to 16.7 points per game last season, also more than doubling her three-pointers from 15 to 35.

2023-24 Schedule Breakdown

In Big Ten Conference action, U-M will face rivals Ohio State and Michigan State in home-and-home series, along with Illinois, Rutgers and Nebraska. The Wolverines will host Maryland, Minnesota, Purdue and Wisconsin at Crisler Center during the 2023-24 conference season. Michigan will travel to Indiana, Iowa, Northwestern and Penn State to complete the 18-game slate. The Wolverines will play 12 non-conference games, highlighted by their first-ever trip to the Battle 4 Atlantis and the second edition of the Jumpman Invitational in Charlotte against Florida.

Moore, Dunston Return to A2

Michigan welcomed two familiar faces back to the sidelines as **Melanie Moore** and **Jillian Dunston** joined the coaching staff. Moore spent the last four seasons as the head coach at Xavier after serving on the coaching staff at Michigan from 2012-19. Dunston returns to her alma mater, this time as an assistant coach after spending three seasons as an assistant coach at Drexel. Dunston ranks fourth all-time at Michigan in both games played (138) and rebounds (862).

Atkins Added as Assistant Coach for Player Development

Ariel Atkins was named the Assistant Coach for Player Development on Oct. 27. She has been part of the USA Basketball family since 2014, earning three gold medals during her time. She was part of the 2020 Olympic gold medal squad, seeing action in five games during the tournament as the United States won the gold. Atkins also has gold medals from the 2022 FIBA World Cup and the 2014 FIBA Americas U18 Championship. She teamed up with Barnes Arico at the latter, as KBA served as an assistant coach for that team.

Atkins currently plays for the Washington Mystics, helping them to the 2019 WNBA Championship. She is a two-time WNBA All-Star (2021, 2022) and grabbed a spot on the 2022 WNBA All-Defensive first team. She was named to the 2018 WNBA All-Rookie Team and has spent all five of her seasons in D.C. after being drafted No. 7 in the 2018 WNBA Draft. This past season, she helped the Mystics to the first round of the playoffs, averaging 11.5 points, 3.1 rebounds and 2.3 assists in 25.2 minutes per game.

Wolverines in the W

Michigan had three players see action in the WNBA during the 2023 season in **Naz Hillmon** (Atlanta), **Leigha Brown** (Connecticut) and **Cysha Goree** (Washington). It marked the first time Michigan has ever had three active players in the W at the same time.

Wolverines on TV

The Wolverines will be featured on national television at least 10 times during the 2023-24 regular season. Half of Michigan's 18 conference contests will appear on Big Ten Network, FS1, Peacock and FOX networks throughout the Big Ten slate. U-M's Dec. 30 contest at home against Ohio State will be the first of five Big Ten women's basketball games this season to appear on FOX, marking the second appearance for the Wolverines on the network in as many seasons.

KBA Reaches 500 Career Wins

Head coach **Kim Barnes Arico** grabbed career win No. 500 at Nebraska (Dec. 28, 2022), making her the fourth active Big Ten coach to reach the mark. She joins the Big Ten's active 500-win club, which includes Iowa's Lisa Bluder, Northwestern's Joe McKeown and Maryland's Brenda Frese.

J. Ira and Nicki Harris Family Head Women's Basketball Coach **Kim Barnes Arico** finished her 11th season as the head coach in 2022-23, stringing together another 20-win season and an appearance in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Throughout her 11-year tenure, she has guided the Wolverines to at least 20 wins in 10 seasons, six NCAA Tournament appearances, an NCAA Elite Eight appearance (2022), an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance (2021) and the 2017 WNIT Championship. She was announced as the ninth head coach in the history of the program on April 20, 2012 and is the longest tenured coach in program history.

Barnes Arico is the winningest coach in program history with 241 wins, the only coach to ever eclipse 200 victories. With 10 of Michigan's 14 all-time 20-win seasons, she is first all-time in winning percentage (.669) with a 241-119 record in Ann Arbor. Barnes Arico holds a 144-36 (.800) record at Crisler Center after the first-ever undefeated mark (16-0) in 2021-22. KBA eclipsed the 500-win mark of her coaching career in a 76-59 win at Nebraska on Dec. 28, 2022. She is one of 29 active coaches with at least 500 career victories, entering the 2023-24 season with 511 victories.

KBA has taken Michigan women's basketball to new heights since taking over prior to the 2012-13 campaign, more than doubling U-M's NCAA Tournament appearances and making at least the second round in all six trips. Michigan has advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 twice under KBA, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 2021-22, as she holds a 9-6 record in the NCAA Tournament at Michigan. The Wolverines have won at least 20 games in 10 of her 11 seasons, only missing the mark during the 2020-21 season as U-M played just 22 total games. Michigan has made the postseason in every season that had a postseason contested (missing 2019-20 due to pandemic) under Barnes Arico, winning at least one game in every postseason appearance.

U-M has found itself back in the national spotlight as well during KBA's tenure, returning to the Associated Press poll in January 2013 for the first time in 10 years. Michigan has been ranked in every Associated Press and USA Today Coaches poll over the last three seasons (2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23), peaking at No. 4 in both for the highest ranking in program history during the 2021-22 season. Michigan has been ranked for 83 weeks since the 2012-13 season, accounting for nearly 87 percent of its overall appearances (96).

Barnes Arico is a two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2017, 2022) and was a semi-finalist for the 2022 Werner Ladder Coach of the Year honor. Her players have combined to earn 11 All-Big Ten first-team honors from the coaches, nine first-team honors from the media, nine second-team honors from the coaches, nine second-team honors from the media and a third-team honor from both before the teams were consolidated to two teams. She has had five players earn Big Ten All-Freshman honors and three different players grab a spot on the defensive team. Four players have been named to the WBCA All-District team since 2012-13, each earning at least All-America honorable mention.

She coached U-M's first All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year, Naz Hillmon, along with all-time leading scorer and three-time All-Big Ten first-teamer, Katelynn Flaherty. Hillmon was named the 2021 Big Ten Player of the Year, making her just the second Big Ten player in conference history to earn Player, Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year honors during a career. Hillmon was a two-time WBCA All-American, while also earning honors twice by the Associated Press, USBWA, Sports Illustrated and the Athletic. The 2017-18 Michigan Female Athlete of the Year, Flaherty also earned three consecutive WBCA All-America hon-

orable mentions (2016, 2017, 2018). Nicole Elmlad also earned back-to-back Academic All-America honors (2014, 2015) and was the recipient of the 2015 Big Ten Medal of Honor.

Michigan has had players picked in each of the last two WNBA drafts, with Hillmon going 15th to the Atlanta Dream in 2022 and Leigha Brown going in the exact same slot to the Dream in 2023. They are the highest WNBA draft picks in program history.

She also is building quite the coaching tree as five of her former assistant coaches are now head coaches: Joe Tartamella (St. John's), Megan Duffy (Marquette), Toyelle Wilson (SMU), Carrie Moore (Harvard) and Erin Batth (Providence).

Michigan went 23-10 in 2022-23, weathering the departure of Hillmon to the WNBA and some tough injuries by relying on a balanced attack. U-M was ranked in each poll during the season, won the Gulf Coast Showcase and grabbed a top-10 win over North Carolina in the Jumpman Invitational. Brown and Emily Kiser grabbed All-Big Ten first-team honors from the coaches, with Laila Phelia honored with a second-team selection. U-M put four on the CSC Academic All-District team and nine on the Academic All-Big Ten team. Michigan knocked off UNLV in the first round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to eventual national champion LSU in Baton Rouge.

The 2021-22 season was full of highlights for the Maize and Blue, who advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. U-M went 25-7 on the season, the second-best win total and highest winning percentage in program history. The Wolverines picked up eight wins over ranked teams, again setting a new program standard. Michigan was ranked in both polls throughout the season, garnering the first top-five and top-10 rankings in school history. U-M finished No. 12 in the AP poll and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches poll, both program highs. The Wolverines hosted the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament for the first time as a No. 3 seed, recording wins over American and Villanova to punch their Sweet 16 ticket for the second straight season before knocking out South Dakota to advance. U-M went 16-0 at Crisler Center, the first undefeated home season in program history while averaging 3,676 fans.

Hillmon was a unanimous and consensus All-Big Ten first teamer, making her the first player in program history to earn four first-team nods. She also earned All-America first-team honors from the WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, The Athletic, Sports Illustrated and the Wooden Award. Brown was named to the All-Big Ten second team, with Phelia grabbing a spot on the freshman team. The Wolverines put 10 on the Academic All-Big Ten team, while Brown, Maddie Nolan, Danielle Rauch and Kiser were named CoSIDA Academic All-District.

From 2018-21, U-M made three NCAA Tournament appearances, only missing the 2020 Tournament due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Wolverines won at least one game in all three tourneys, making the program's first-ever Sweet 16 appearance in 2021.

Barnes Arico led Michigan to its first postseason championship in 2016-2017, as the Wolverines captured the WNIT Championship after being left out of the NCAA Tournament despite a third-place finish in the Big Ten. Michigan went 11-5 in conference play to finish alone in third place, its highest finish since 2011 and the second-most Big Ten wins in program history. The Wolverines regrouped during the WNIT, reeling off six straight wins for the title. U-M held off Georgia Tech in three overtimes in the championship game to hang its first banner in Crisler.

During KBA's first five seasons in the Maize and Blue, the Wolverines racked up at least 20 wins in each year and advanced to the postseason each time. In 2013-14, U-M weathered losing 88 percent of its scoring from the season before to still reach 20 wins and the third round of the WNIT with four new starters.

Barnes Arico also completed a two-year stint with USA Basketball (2014-15), serving as an assistant coach alongside Dawn Staley (South Carolina) and Jeff



Walz (Louisville) for the U18 (2014) and U19 (2015) teams. She won a pair of gold medals at the FIBA U19 World Championships in 2015 and at the FIBA U18 America's Championship in 2014.

Prior to joining the Maize and Blue, she spent 10 seasons at the helm of the St. John's women's hoops program, building the Red Storm into a national power. She guided St. John's to four NCAA Tournament appearances, with the Red Storm advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2012.

Barnes Arico compiled a 176-133 overall record and five 20-win campaigns at St. John's. She was a two-time Big East Coach of the Year (2006, 2012) and had 11 players earn All-Big East honors, with six receiving all-rookie team nods.

In 2011-12, St. John's posted a 24-10 overall record and finished second (13-3) in the Big East standings. St. John's finished No. 15 in the final USA Today Coaches poll and reached its highest-ever ranking of No. 13 by the Associated Press. The highlight of the season was when Barnes Arico and her Red Storm ended Connecticut's 99-game home winning streak with a 57-56 win on Feb. 19, 2012 at Gampel Pavilion. It was also UConn's first home loss to an unranked opponent in nearly 19 years.

Prior to accepting her position at St. John's, Barnes Arico was extremely successful at NCAA Division II Adelphi (1999-2002). She led the Panthers to three consecutive postseason appearances, posting a 65-24 overall record and a 51-13 league mark. She was inducted into the Adelphi Hall of Fame in 2014.

In 2001-02, Adelphi won its first New York Collegiate Athletic Conference (NYCAC) championship and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Panthers finished with a 28-3 record and earned the school's first national ranking in school history, finishing No. 12. Barnes Arico was named the NYCAC, NIT/Metropolitan Basketball Writers Division II and Nassau County Sports Com-

mission Outstanding Female Coach of the Year.

Barnes Arico started her head-coaching career at Fairleigh Dickinson-Madison, a Division III university in New Jersey. She led the Devils to a 13-11 record during the 1996-97 season before accepting the head coaching post at New Jersey Institute of Technology for two seasons (1997-99). Helping the program transition from Division III to Division II, Barnes Arico was named the New Jersey Coach of the Year after taking the program from the five-win total in her first season to 11 victories in year two.

A native of Mastic Beach, N.Y., Barnes Arico helped lead Stony Brook University to the 1989 NCAA Division III Tournament as a freshman. She spent her final three seasons at Montclair State University, serving as captain during her junior and senior seasons. Barnes Arico led the team to back-to-back ECAC Tournament appearances in 1991 and 1992 and was the team's leading scorer both seasons. A scholar-athlete award recipient, Barnes Arico graduated from Montclair State in 1993 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and health.

Barnes Arico went into teaching after graduation, accepting a position as a physical education and health teacher at the Academy of Saint Aloysius in Jersey City, N.J., during the 1993-94 academic year. She left Saint Aloysius and moved into an identical position at Chatham High School from 1994-96 in Chatham, N.J.

Barnes Arico and her husband, Larry Arico, are the parents of a son, Trevor, and daughters Emma and Cecelia.
