## TOP STORYLINES

► Michigan completes a two-game homestand on Thursday, hosting Illinois in the lone meeting between the teams this season.

► U-M knocked off Illinois, 78-69, last season in Champaign after ending the game on a 19-4 run. Illinois leads the all-time series, 41-38, but Michigan has won 21 of the last 23 games between the teams.

► Michigan is No. 6 in the latest NET rankings and No. 6 in WAB, two metrics used for the NCAA Tournament. U-M is listed at No. 8 in the Associated Press poll and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches poll, the first time Michigan is higher in the coaches poll this season.

► The Wolverines are first in the Big Ten in scoring offense, putting up 88.9 points per game after scoring 86 points against Wisconsin.

► No. 25 Illinois is Michigan's third ranked opponent of the season. U-M is 1-1 against top-25 teams this season, knocking off No. 18 Notre Dame, 93-54, and falling, 72-69, to No. 1 UConn.

► **Te'Yala Delfosse** recorded her second double-double of the season last time out, going for 18 points and 10 rebounds in her first career start. She leads U-M in rebounding at 5.9 boards per game.

► The Wolverines are first in the Big Ten and ninth nationally in forcing turnovers, turning their opponents over 24.7 times per game. U-M is second in the Big Ten in steals per game, swiping the ball 12.5 times per game.

► Michigan has four players scoring in double figures in sophomores **Olivia Olson** (17.9 ppg), **Syla Swords** (13.9 ppg), **Mila Holloway** (12.8 ppg) and **Te'Yala Delfosse** (11.3 ppg).

Last Time Out

The No. 9-ranked University of Michigan women's basketball team showed its offensive balance in a decisive 86-60 win over Wisconsin on Sunday afternoon (Jan. 11) at Crisler Center. Michigan had four players score in double figures as it defeated the Badgers, 86-60.

Michigan honored the career of Diane Dietz (1979-82) before the game, raising her No. 21 jersey to the rafters.

Olivia Olson led Michigan with 21 points and six rebounds, with Te'Yala Delfosse turning in a double-double of 18 points and 10 rebounds. Mila Holloway added 18 points, six rebounds and three assists in 26 minutes of action. Brooke Quarles Daniels joined the 1,000-point club for her career, recording eight points, eight rebounds, six assists and five steals. Kendall Dudley rounded out Michigan's double-figure scorers, contributing 11 points and eight rebounds off the bench. Michigan held a 48-26 advantage on the glass, turning 21 offensive rebounds into 19 points.

Michigan opened the game on a 16-0 run, holding the Badgers off the board until 1:39 left in the first quarter. Six different Wolverines scored during the spurt, with Michigan taking a 21-5 lead after 10 minutes of play behind seven points from Holloway.

Michigan pushed its lead to 20 points for the first time in the second quarter, 31-11, on an Olson layup with just under six minutes remaining before the half. The Wolverine defense continued its strong play, again holding Wisconsin scoreless for nearly four minutes in the middle stages of the quarter to extend the lead to 38-11.

Olson hit a 30-foot triple before the halftime buzzer, sending Michigan into the locker room with a 48-21 lead behind her 17 first-half points.

The Michigan lead grew to as many as 30 points in the second half, with all 13 available Wolverines seeing action. Wisconsin cut the deficit to 20 points midway through the fourth quarter but did not get any closer.

The Series

U-M knocked off Illinois, 78-69, last season in Campaign after ending the game on a 19-4 run. Illinois leads the all-time series, 41-38, but Michigan has won 21 of the last 23 games between the teams.

Canada Connections

Syla Swords and Mila Holloway competed with Illinois' Cearah Parchment for Canada Basketball this past summer, competing at the FIBA U19 World Cup in Czechia. In addition, Michigan general manager/assistant coach Natalie Achonwa served as a coach for that team.

14-2 Through 16 Games

Michigan is off to a 14-2 start, tying the best mark in program history through 16 games. The most recent 14-2 start came during the 2021-22 season, where Michigan eventually started with a 20-2 record en route to an Elite Eight appearance. The 2012-13 squad also started 14-2 through 16 games on the strength of a 10-game winning streak after a couple of early-season losses. The 2012-13 season was the first in Ann Arbor for head coach Kim Barnes Arico, with all three 14-2 starts coming under KBA.

BQD Gets to 1,000 Points

Brooke Quarles Daniels reached the 1,000-point mark in Michigan's last game, putting up eight points, eight

rebounds, six assists and five steals. She is just the 17th player this season to hit those numbers in a game, according to Her Hoop Stats. On the season, she has appeared in all 16 games while starting 12 times. She is averaging 5.9 points and 5.2 rebounds in 22.7 minutes per game. BQD leads U-M with 36 steals, racking up eight games with at least three steals.

Big Time Wins

Michigan, ranked No. 6 in the latest NET rankings, picked up its third Quad 1 win against Minnesota. U-M rallied from as many as 12 down to beat Minnesota, 70-60, at Crisler on Jan. 5. U-M also has Quad 1 wins at Oregon (92-87, Dec. 29) and against Notre Dame (93-54, Nov. 15). Michigan is one of 12 schools nationally to have at least three Quad 1 wins.

Ranked Opponent

No. 25 Illinois marks Michigan's third ranked opponent of the season. U-M is 1-1 this season against top-25 teams, getting a 93-54 win over No. 18 Notre Dame in Detroit (Nov. 15) before falling, 72-69, to No. 1 UConn in the Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase (Nov. 21). Michigan is 3-5 all-time against the No. 25-ranked team, winning the last two games. This is Michigan's first ranked opponent at Crisler this season.

Steady Olson

Olivia Olson has scored in double figures in all 16 of Michigan's games this season, averaging 17.9 points per game on 47.7 percent shooting. She has recorded six 20-point games and a pair of double-doubles this season. Olson ranks ninth in the Big Ten in scoring as one of nine players to average at least 17.0 points per game. She was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List last week.

Delfosse Provides a Spark

Te'Yala Delfosse has thrived in an expanded role during her second season in Ann Arbor, most recently recording her second double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 rebounds against Wisconsin (Jan. 11). She has scored in double figures in 10 games this season with one 20-point game. She is averaging 11.3 points per game on 54.9 percent shooting and a team-high 5.9 rebounds per game.

Hitting the Century Mark

Michigan has topped the 100-point mark five times this season after recording 105 points against Penn State (Jan. 8). It was the second-most points Michigan has ever scored in a conference game and the second time U-M has reached 100 in a conference game this season. This is the first time in program history that U-M has had five 100-point games in a season after recording three during the 1996-97 and 2016-17 seasons. Michigan is averaging 88.9 points per game, good for second in the Big Ten and sixth nationally.

Mathurin Off the Bench

McKenzie Mathurin has seen action in 11 games off the bench, averaging 5.7 points and 0.9 rebounds in 13.5 minutes per game. She has three double-figure scoring games, the most recent coming at Penn State (Jan. 8) with a career-high 15 points on the strength of three triples. She is shooting 45.7 percent from the floor and 37.5 percent from three-point range with nine makes.

Rallying for the Win

Michigan was down by as many as 12 points before rallying for a 70-60 win over Minnesota last time out. It was the first time Michigan won a game that it trailed at the half this season, outscoring the Gophers, 42-31, in

the second 20 minutes. It was also the first time the Wolverines won a game this season when getting beat on the glass. Minnesota held a slim 35-33 advantage, but Michigan outrebounded the Gophers in the second half (16-12).

5-1 in the Big Ten

Michigan has started conference play with a 5-1 record, one of three teams that sit at 5-1 through six games.

Holloway Handing Them Out

**Mila Holloway** became the 31st Wolverine to reach the 200-assist mark for her career after handing out seven assists against Oakland (Dec. 21). On the season, she is averaging 4.4 assists per game, good for eighth in the conference.

Dudley Key Down the Stretch

**Kendall Dudley** was key in the second half of Michigan's win over Minnesota, scoring all seven of her points in the second 20 minutes as the Wolverines rallied to collect the win. She was 3-for-4 from the floor and 1-for-2 at the line in the second half, highlighted by making a layup on the final possession of the third quarter. She played a career-high 26 minutes in the contest and drew a team-best four fouls. Dudley recently recorded the second double-figure scoring game of her career with 11 points and eight rebounds against Wiconson.

Michigan in the NET

The NCAA released the first NET rankings of the 2025-26 season to start the month of December, with Michigan coming in at No. 5 in the first edition. U-M is listed at No. 6 in the Jan. 13 edition of the rankings and has been ranked as high as No. 2.

On the Glass

Michigan has been effective on the glass this season, holding a +11.5 margin by grabbing 43.2 rebounds and allowing just 31.7 per contest. The Wolverines rank first in the Big Ten and eighth nationally in offensive rebounds per game at 17.1. U-M is 12-0 this season when winning the battle on the glass. Michigan grabbed 60 rebounds against Oregon, marking the 12th time the Wolverines have grabbed at least 60 in a game. U-M turned 28 offensive rebounds into 20 second-chance points while limiting Oregon to six offensive rebounds and zero second-chance points.

Michigan Moves to No. 8

Michigan moved to No. 8 in the latest Associated Press poll. It is the eighth straight week that Michigan has been in the top 10, the longest streak in the top 10 in program history. Michigan was in the top 10 for six straight weeks during the 2021-22 season. That streak started with the Jan. 17, 2022 poll and ran through the Feb. 21, 2022 poll.

U-M Bench Shows Out

Michigan's bench scored 44 points in its win at Penn State, with five Wolverines finding the scoring column. U-M is 13th nationally in bench points at 29.8 points per game.

Locking Down on Defense

Michigan is fourth in the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 36.4 percent from the field over the first 15 games of the season. U-M held UConn to 37.7 percent shooting from the floor in its 72-69 loss to the de-

fending national champions, marking the first time since Feb. 11, 2024 that the Huskies failed to shoot at least 40 percent from the floor.

What Can Brown Do For You?

**Macy Brown** has found a role for Michigan coming off the bench, recently playing a career-high 30 minutes at Oregon. She responded with seven points, seven rebounds and five assists - the latter two accounting for new career highs. She is averaging 14.2 minutes per game off the bench this season.

Racking Up the Points

Michigan scored 120 points against Binghamton (Nov. 18), the second-most points scored in program history and the most under 14th-year head coach **Kim Barnes Arico**. The Wolverines have topped the century mark five times and are averaging 88.9 points per game on 47.3 percent shooting from the floor. Michigan's program record for scoring offense is 78.6 points per game, set during the 2015-16 season.

Delfosse Breaks Out

**Te'Yala Delfosse** made a name for herself at the Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase, setting a host of new career bests across Michigan's games with UConn and Syracuse. Against the Huskies, she played a career-high 26 minutes and grabbed nine rebounds. She recorded the first 20-point game of her career against the Orange, putting up 21 points on 8-for-11 shooting for a new best. She joins her fellow sophomores **Syla Swords**, **Mila Holloway** and **Olivia Olson** as current Wolverines to score at least 20 points in a Michigan uniform. She followed that up with the first double-double of her career with 14 points and 10 rebounds at Detroit Mercy (Nov. 26).

Big Game Syla

**Syla Swords** had a game for the ages in Michigan's near-upset of No. 1 UConn (Nov. 21), going for 29 points and nine rebounds in all 40 minutes of action. She hit eight three-pointers in the game, including three in the final minute to pull Michigan within a point. She became the third Wolverine in program history to make at least eight in a game, joining Katelynn Flaherty and Elissa Brett. Swords has scored in double figures in 11 games this season after recording 12 points against Minnesota (Jan. 5). She is averaging 13.9 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.4 assists in a team-high 30.9 minutes per game.

The Straw That Stirs The Drink

**Mila Holloway** has elevated her game during her sophomore season, averaging 12.8 points per game on 45.9 percent shooting from the floor. She has handed out 71 assists through 16 games, good for 4.4 per game. She has scored in double figures in 10 games, matching a career high with 21 points in the season opener against Canisius (Nov. 4). She is also grabbing 3.6 rebounds per game, most recently matching a career high with seven rebounds against Minnesota (Jan. 5).

BQD Doing BQD Things

**Brooke Quarles Daniels** continues to be an integral part of Michigan's rotation, averaging 5.9 points, 5.2 rebounds, 3.2 assists and 2.3 steals in 22.2 minutes per game. In the first start of her Michigan career in the win over Notre Dame (Nov. 15),

she grabbed a game-high 10 rebounds. In Michigan's win at Detroit Mercy (Nov. 26), she had 11 points, seven rebounds, five assists, two blocks and a steal in 23 minutes. BQD has eight games with at least three steals this season.

### Dudley Fits in Nicely

**Kendall Dudley**, a 2024 McDonald's All-American who joined the program in the offseason after spending her freshman season at UCLA, has fit in well in the maize and blue. After appearing in two games off the bench, she earned the first start of her Michigan career against Binghamton (Nov. 18). She responded with six points, six rebounds and two assists in just 11 minutes of action. She recorded the first double-figure scoring game of her career in Michigan's win over Purdue (Dec. 7), scoring 10 points on 5-for-6 shooting. Appearing in 15 games, she is averaging 5.0 points and 4.1 rebounds per game.

### Defense, Defense, Defense

Michigan forced 45 turnovers against Canisius in the season opener (Nov. 4). Canisius had more turnovers than points scored (40), marking the second time in as many seasons that Michigan has forced more turnovers than points allowed. LIU had 32 turnovers and 31 points in a 96-31 Michigan win last season on Nov. 20, 2024. Michigan is ninth nationally in turnovers forced per game, forcing 24.7 per game.

### Holloway, Quarles Daniels Swipe Away

**Brooke Quarles Daniels** and **Mila Holloway** each set new career highs in steals against the Golden Griffins (Nov. 4), with BQD going for eight and Holloway for seven. Quarles Daniels' eight steals is tied for the fifth-most by a player in program history, with Holloway ranking 14th.

### Sofilkanich Hits 1K

**Ashley Sofilkanich** joined the 1,000-point club for her career in the season opener, scoring just four seconds into the game to reach the mark. She scored 998 points during two seasons at Bucknell and is up to 1,136 for her career. She has started all 16 games and is averaging 9.1 points and 3.6 rebounds in 16.3 minutes per game.

### KBA In 14th Year

J. Ira and Nicki Harris Family Head Women's Basketball Coach **Kim Barnes Arico** is in her 14th season in Ann Arbor as the winningest coach in Michigan basketball history - men or women. With 12 of Michigan's 16 all-time 20-win seasons, she is first all-time in winning percentage (.671) with a 298-146 record in Ann Arbor. KBA is two wins away from becoming the first coach to record 300 victories in Ann Arbor.

### Watch List SZN

Michigan has been well-represented on various watch lists during the preseason. **Syla Swords** (Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard), **Olivia Olson** (Cheryl Miller Small Forward) and **Ashley Sofilkanich** (Lisa Leslie Center) were each named to the Basketball Hall of Fame positional watch lists. In addition, Swords and Olson were each named to the Naismith Trophy Watch List and the Wooden Top 50.

### About Last Season

Michigan is coming off a 23-11 season in 2024-25, making the NCAA Tournament for the 13th time in program history. U-M knocked off Iowa State in the first round, winning its first-round contest for the seventh time in eight tries under KBA. U-M has made appearances in the last seven NCAA Tournaments, dating back to the 2018 edition. It is the longest streak in program history.

### Stacked Schedule

For the second straight season, Michigan will face the defending champion and preseason No. 1-ranked team during the non-conference portion of the season. Last season, U-M dropped a 68-64 decision to No. 1 South Carolina, with the Maize and Blue facing No. 1 UConn in the opening game of the Basketball Hall of Fame Women's Showcase (Nov. 21) at Mohegan Sun.

### Conference Schedule

Michigan will once again play 18 Big Ten games, facing 16 schools once and playing a home-and-home series with Michigan State. U-M will host Purdue in its early Big Ten contest on Dec. 7 and head to the Pacific Northwest following the holiday break. In addition to Purdue, U-M will host games against Minnesota, Illinois, Wisconsin, Maryland, UCLA, USC, Michigan State and Nebraska. Following its trip to Oregon and Washington, Michigan will also hit the road for games at

Rutgers, Indiana, Michigan State, Iowa, Penn State, Ohio State and Northwestern.

### Staff on the Sidelines

Michigan welcomes new assistant coaches **Jordann Reese** and **Danielle Rauch** to the sidelines this season. Reese had been on the coaching staff at Creighton, with Rauch returning to her alma mater after a year on the sidelines at Western Carolina. **Justine Raterman** enters her second season, along with **Natalie Achonwa**, who added General Manager to her title. **Melanie Moore** is in her third season as an assistant coach in her second stint at Michigan. Amy Mulligan is in her 14th year as the director of operations, with Dillon Carson (Director of Video and Analytics) and Makayla Daniels (Graduate Manager) entering their first seasons on staff.

### Catch Us On TV

Michigan will appear on national television 19 times during the upcoming season. U-M will play on the Big Ten Network five times, with four games slated to air on Peacock. The Wolverines play at least four times each on FS1 and FOX, with the Feb. 22 game at Iowa to appear on one of the networks. Michigan's neutral-site contest against Notre Dame will air on NBC.

### Strong Non-Con

The Wolverines will play 11 non-conference games, facing four Power Four opponents in No. 1 UConn, No. 15 Notre Dame, No. 19 Vanderbilt and Syracuse. U-M will play all four of those games away from Ann Arbor, with six non-conference games slated for Crisler Center.

### Olson, Swords Historically Great as Freshmen

Since the 2009-10 season, there have only been eight players in Big Ten history (school was in the Big Ten at the time) to average at least 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game as freshmen. **Olivia Olson** (16.3 ppg, 5.3 rpg) and **Syla Swords** (16.0 ppg, 6.2 rpg) joined that list last season. Other players to have accomplished that are Caitlin Clark, Jessica Shepard, Rachel Banham, Nia Coffey, Amanda Zahui B. and Cotie McMahon.

### Three McDonald's All-Americans in A2

For the second straight season, Michigan has multiple McDonald's All-Americans on its roster in **Kendall Dudley**, **Olivia Olson** and **Syla Swords**. All three were named McDonald's All-Americans in 2024. Swords and Olson are the first high school players to sign with Michigan who earned the honor. Dudley joins Michigan this season after playing last season at UCLA.

### Wolverines in the W

Michigan has had three players see action in the WNBA during the last three seasons in **Naz Hillmon** (Atlanta), **Leigha Brown** (Connecticut) and **Cyesha Goree** (Washington). All three saw action in 2023, with Hillmon playing the last two seasons (2024, 2025) with Atlanta and winning 2025 WNBA Sixth Player of the Year honors. During 2023, it marked the first time Michigan has ever had three active players in the W at the same time.

### Simple Enough...Just Score

J. Ira and Nicki Harris Family Head Women's Basketball Coach Kim Barnes Arico finished her 13th season as the head coach in 2024-25, relying on stellar freshman class and a pair of veteran returners to win 23 games and reach the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Throughout her 13-year tenure, she has guided the Wolverines to at least 20 wins in 12 seasons, eight NCAA Tournament appearances, an NCAA Elite Eight appearance (2022), an NCAA Sweet 16 appearance (2021) and the 2017 WNIT Championship. She was announced as the ninth head coach in the history of the program on April 20, 2012 and is the longest tenured coach in program history.

Barnes Arico is the winningest coach in program history with 284 wins, the only coach to ever eclipse 200 victories. With 12 of Michigan's 16 all-time 20-win seasons, she is first all-time in winning percentage (.664) with a 284-144 record in Ann Arbor. Barnes Arico holds a 167-43 (.795) record at Crisler Center after the first-ever undefeated mark (16-0) in 2021-22. KBA eclipsed the 500-win mark of her coaching career in a 76-59 win at Nebraska on Dec. 28, 2022. She is one of 29 active coaches with at least 500 career victories, entering the 2025-26 season with 554 victories.

KBA has taken Michigan women's basketball to new heights since taking over prior to the 2012-13 campaign, more than doubling U-M's NCAA Tournament appearances and making at least the second round seven times. Michigan has advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 twice under KBA, including a trip to the Elite Eight in 2021-22, as she holds a 10-8 record in the NCAA Tournament at Michigan. The Wolverines have won at least 20 games in 12 of her 13 seasons, only missing the mark during the 2020-21 season as U-M played just 22 total games. Michigan has made the postseason in every season that had a postseason contested (missing 2019-20 due to pandemic) under Barnes Arico, winning at least one game in all but one postseason appearance.

U-M has found itself back in the national spotlight as well during KBA's tenure, returning to the Associated Press poll in January 2013 for the first time in 10 years. Michigan was ranked in every Associated Press and USA Today Coaches poll for three straight seasons (2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23), peaking at No. 4 in both for the highest ranking in program history during the 2021-22 season. Michigan has been ranked for 89 weeks since the 2012-13 season, accounting for 87 percent of its overall appearances (102).

Barnes Arico is a two-time Big Ten Coach of the Year (2017, 2022) and was a semifinalist for the 2022 Werner Ladder Coach of the Year honor. Her players have combined to earn 12 All-Big Ten first-team honors from the coaches, 10 first-team honors from the media, 11 second-team honors from the coaches, 11 second-team honors from the media and a third-team honor from both before the teams were consolidated to two teams. She has had seven players earn Big Ten All-Freshman honors and three different players grab a spot on the defensive team. Five players have been named to the WBCA All-District team since 2012-13, each earning at least All-America honorable mention.

She coached U-M's first All-American and Big Ten Player of the Year, Naz Hillmon, along with all-time leading scorer and three-time All-Big Ten first-teamer, Katelynn Flaherty. Hillmon was named the 2021 Big Ten Player of the Year, making her just the second Big Ten player in conference history to earn Player, Freshman and Sixth Player of the Year honors during a career. Hillmon was a two-time WBCA All-American, while also earning honors twice by the Associated Press, USBWA, Sports Illustrated and the Athletic. The 2017-18 Michigan Female Athlete of the Year, Flaherty also earned three consecutive WBCA All-America honorable mentions (2016, 2017, 2018). Nicole Elmlad also earned back-to-back Academic All-America honors (2014, 2015) and was the recipient of the 2015 Big Ten Medal of Honor.



Michigan has had players picked in three of the last four WNBA drafts, with Hillmon going 15th to the Atlanta Dream in 2022, Leigha Brown going in the exact same slot to the Dream in 2023 and Jordan Hobbs picked 34th by the Seattle Storm in 2025. Brown and Hillmon are tied for the highest WNBA draft picks in program history.

She also is building quite the coaching tree as five of her former assistant coaches are now head coaches: Joe Tartamella (St. John's), Megan Duffy (Virginia Tech), Toyelle Wilson (Texas A&M Corpus Christi), Carrie Moore (Harvard) and Erin Bath (Providence).

With just four returners, five freshmen and three transfers, Michigan did not miss a beat in 2024-25 en route to winning 23 games and reaching the second round of the NCAA Tournament. Olivia Olson and Sylva Swords became the first freshman teammates in Big Ten history to each score 500 points in the same season, with Olson setting a new freshman program record with 553 points. Fellow freshman Mila Holloway set a new Michigan assists record for a freshman, handing out 148 assists on the season. Olson was named the Big Ten Co-Freshman of the Year, with her and Swords each earning a spot on the all-freshman team and the Big Ten second team. Michigan's 23 wins is tied for the third-most in program history, with the Wolverines making the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament for the second straight season. In a 70-67 win over Indiana (Feb. 12), Barnes Arico picked up her 279th win at Michigan - moving past John Beilein as the winningest coach in Michigan basketball history - men or women.

The Wolverines won 20 games in 2023-24, going 20-14 and making the NCAA Tournament for the sixth straight season after returning just a pair of starters from the season before. The Wolverines made a run to the semifinals of the Big Ten Tournament to cement their NCAA Tournament berth, punctuated by a 69-56 win over No. 12-ranked Indiana in the quarterfinals.

Michigan went 23-10 in 2022-23, weathering the departure of Hillmon to the WNBA and some tough injuries by relying on a balanced attack. U-M was ranked in each poll during the season, won the Gulf Coast Showcase and grabbed a top-10 win over North Carolina in the Jumpman Invitational. Brown and Emily Kiser grabbed All-Big Ten first-team honors from the coaches, with Laila Phelia honored with a second-team selection. U-M put four on the CSC Academic All-District team and nine on the Academic All-Big Ten team. Michigan knocked off UNLV in the first round of the NCAA Tournament before falling to eventual national champion LSU in Baton Rouge.

The 2021-22 season was full of highlights for the Maize and Blue, who advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament. U-M went 25-7 on the season, the second-best win total and highest winning percentage in program history. The Wolverines picked up eight wins over ranked teams, again setting a new program standard. Michigan was ranked in both polls throughout the season, garnering the first top-five and top-10 rankings in school history. U-M finished No. 12 in the AP poll and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches poll, both program highs. The Wolverines hosted the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament for the first time as a No. 3 seed, recording wins over American and Villanova to punch their Sweet 16 ticket for the second straight season before knocking out South Dakota to advance. U-M went 16-0 at Crisler Center, the first undefeated home season in program history while averaging 3,676 fans.

Hillmon was a unanimous and consensus All-Big Ten first teamer, making her the first player in program history to earn four first-team nods. She also earned All-America first-team honors from the WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, The Athletic, Sports Illustrated and the Wooden Award. Brown was named to the All-Big Ten second team, with Phelia grabbing a spot on the freshman team. The Wolverines put 10 on the Academic All-Big Ten team, while Brown, Maddie Nolan, Danielle Rauch and Kiser were named CoSIDA Academic All-District.

From 2018-21, U-M made three NCAA Tournament appearances, only missing the 2020 Tournament due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Wolverines won at least one game in all three tournaments, making the program's first-ever Sweet 16 appearance in 2021.

Barnes Arico led Michigan to its first postseason championship in 2016-2017, as the Wolverines captured the WNIT Championship after being left out of the NCAA Tour-

nament despite a third-place finish in the Big Ten. Michigan went 11-5 in conference play to finish alone in third place, its highest finish since 2011 and the second-most Big Ten wins in program history. The Wolverines regrouped during the WNIT, reeling off six straight wins for the title. U-M held off Georgia Tech in three overtimes in the championship game to hang its first banner in Crisler.

During KBA's first five seasons in the Maize and Blue, the Wolverines racked up at least 20 wins in each year and advanced to the postseason each time. In 2013-14, U-M weathered losing 88 percent of its scoring from the season before to still reach 20 wins and the third round of the WNIT with four new starters.

Barnes Arico also completed a two-year stint with USA Basketball (2014-15), serving as an assistant coach alongside Dawn Staley (South Carolina) and Jeff Walz (Louisville) for the U18 (2014) and U19 (2015) teams. She won a pair of gold medals at the FIBA U19 World Championships in 2015 and at the FIBA U18 America's Championship in 2014.

Prior to joining the Maize and Blue, she spent 10 seasons at the helm of the St. John's women's hoops program, building the Red Storm into a national power. She guided St. John's to four NCAA Tournament appearances, with the Red Storm advancing to the Sweet 16 in 2012.

Barnes Arico compiled a 176-133 overall record and five 20-win campaigns at St. John's. She was a two-time Big East Coach of the Year (2006, 2012) and had 11 players earn All-Big East honors, with six receiving all-rookie team nods.

In 2011-12, St. John's posted a 24-10 overall record and finished second (13-3) in the Big East standings. St. John's finished No. 15 in the final USA Today Coaches poll and reached its highest-ever ranking of No. 13 by the Associated Press. The highlight of the season was when Barnes Arico and her Red Storm ended Connecticut's 99-game home winning streak with a 57-56 win on Feb. 19, 2012 at Gampel Pavilion. It was also UConn's first home loss to an unranked opponent in nearly 19 years.

Prior to accepting her position at St. John's, Barnes Arico was extremely successful at NCAA Division II Adelphi (1999-2002). She led the Panthers to three consecutive postseason appearances, posting a 65-24 overall record and a 51-13 league mark.

She was inducted into the Adelphi Hall of Fame in 2014.

In 2001-02, Adelphi won its first New York Collegiate Athletic Conference (NYCAC) championship and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament. The Panthers finished with a 28-3 record and earned the school's first national ranking in school history, finishing No. 12. Barnes Arico was named the NYCAC, NIT/Metropolitan Basketball Writers Division II and Nassau County Sports Commission Outstanding Female Coach of the Year.

Barnes Arico started her head-coaching career at Fairleigh Dickinson-Madison, a Division III university in New Jersey. She led the Devils to a 13-11 record during the 1996-97 season before accepting the head coaching post at New Jersey Institute of Technology for two seasons (1997-99). Helping the program transition from Division III to Division II, Barnes Arico was named the New Jersey Coach of the Year after taking the program from the five-win total in her first season to 11 victories in year two.

A native of Mastic Beach, N.Y., Barnes Arico helped lead Stony Brook University to the 1989 NCAA Division III Tournament as a freshman. She spent her final three seasons at Montclair State University, serving as captain during her junior and senior seasons. Barnes Arico led the team to back-to-back ECAC Tournament appearances in 1991 and 1992 and was the team's leading scorer both seasons. A scholar-athlete award recipient, Barnes Arico graduated from Montclair State in 1993 with a bachelor's degree in physical education and health.

Barnes Arico went into teaching after graduation, accepting a position as a physical education and health teacher at the Academy of Saint Aloysius in Jersey City, N.J., during the 1993-94 academic year. She left Saint Aloysius and moved into an identical position at Chatham High School from 1994-96 in Chatham, N.J.

Barnes Arico and her husband, Larry Arico, are the parents of a son, Trevor, and daughters Emma and Cecelia. Emma is currently a sophomore on the women's lacrosse team and Trevor is a graduate manager for the men's basketball program.
