STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami University women's basketball team wraps up a three-game road swing with a Monday evening tip at Kent State. Game is scheduled to begin at 7 p.m.

ROAD WARRIOR: Following this three-game road trip, Miami returns home for a pair of contests before once again hitting the road for three more contests.

HUNGRY LIKE A WOLF: In the loss to Toledo, freshman Ivy Wolf scored 20 points, her first 20-point effort since opening the year with 23 at home versus Valpo. The freshman is currently averaging 10.5 points per game and leads the team with 32 three pointers made. She added 16 points in the win at Kalamazoo on Saturday.

MOVIN' ON UP: With 17 points at WMU on Saturday, junior guard Peyton Scott moved up to 14th all-time at Miami with 1,253 career points. She is just 96 points shy of cracking the top-10 in Miami school history.

REDHAWKS SNAP FIVE-GAME LOSING STREAK WITH WIN AT WMU: Behind a season-low six turnovers and balanced scoring from Edyn Battle (20 points), Peyton Scott (17 points) and Ivy Wolf (16 points), the RedHawks downed Western Michigan 80-67 on Saturday. The Broncos, who came into Saturday's contest third in the conference, were led by Lauren Ross with 16 points. Miami led 47-46 with 4:06 to play in the third quarter before erupting for a 27-8 run over the next 11 minutes of action.

TAKE CARE: In Miami's first 17 games they averaged 19.6 turnovers per contest and had a season-low of 14 turnovers two different times. In the last two games versus Toledo and WMU, Miami has committed just 17 total turnovers, establishing season bests in back-to-back games (had 11 at Toledo and 6 at WMU). The backcourt duo of Peyton Scott (2) and Ivy Wolf (2) have committed just four total turnovers in a combined 141 minutes over the past two contests.

BALANCING ACT: While Peyton Scott (19.0) is getting a majority of the offensive attention, Miami has a total of eight players averaging at least 3.7 points per game this season. Last year, just four RedHawks averaged over 4.0 points per game.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES: Miami has six additions to the RedHawks in 2021-22 that are contributing numbers to Miami's success. In all, Ivy Wolf, Maddi Cluse, Edyn Battle, Tajah Foster-Walker, Jordan Tuff and Katey Richason are combining for 35.9 points and 18.2 rebounds per game.

ABOUT THE FLASHES: Kent State is 12-7 on the year and 4-6 in Mid-American Conference play. The Flashes are one of the better defensive teams in the MAC, allowing just 60.2 points per game. Offensively, they have five players averaging between 9.5 and 12.8 points per game. Nia Blackford nearly averages a double-double at 10.9 points and 9.5 rebounds per contest.

SERIES WITH KSU: This will be the 96th meeting between the two schools with Kent State holding a 48-47 all-time series advantage. These two teams split last year's results, which included a 61-58 win for the RedHawks on a buzzer beater from Peyton Scott in Millett Hall. Scott finished that game with 25 points, 12 rebounds and eight assists.

LIKE A FINE WINE: No easy way to put it, but the RedHawks have struggled offensively in the first half this season, averaging 28.8 points in the first 20 minutes of action. As the game goes on, the offense improves. The RedHawks average 38.7 points per game in the second half and have outscored their opponents 401-361 in the fourth quarter.

GREAT SCOTT: Junior guard Peyton Scott has accomplished a ton since arriving in Oxford, all while maintaining a 3.73 grade-point average and majoring in sports leadership and management.

- She has scored 1,253 points and ranks 14th all-time on Miami's scoring list. She is just 96 points shy of cracking Miami's top-10 scoring list.
- She currently ranks fifth in the MAC in scoring (18.9), 15th in rebounding (6.1), 11th in assists (3.8) and seventh in steals (1.8).
- Has made 41 of her last 44 free throw attempts (93.2%).
- Last season alone, she scored 30-plus points in five different games, including 39 versus Ball State, a new Millett Hall record. She has surpassed 30-plus points six different times in her career.
- She had a stretch last season from Feb. 3-Feb. 13 in which she scored 30-plus points in four straight games, the first RedHawk in school history to accomplish such a feat.
- In her last 46 contests, Scott has more 30 point games (6) than under 10 point games (3).
- She has scored in double figures in 41 of her last 43 contests.

GOING TO BATTLE: The RedHawks have leaned heavily on Edyn Battle lately. After surpassing 10-plus points just once in her first six games, Battle has scored in double figures in 10 of her last 13 contests, including a career-high 20 points in the win over Western Michigan on Saturday.

DeUnna Hendrix completed her second season as head coach of the Miami University women's basketball team during the 2020-21 campaign.

Miami battled injuries for much of the 2020-21 campaign as the RedHawks went 4-20 overall, but Hendrix did coach Peyton Scott, who earned Second-Team All-MAC honors after finishing the year averaging 21.2 points, 6.7 rebound and 5.1 assists per game.

In 2019-20, the RedHawks finished with an 11-20 overall record and a 4-14 conference record as they were fifth in the MAC East. The Red and White picked up a power-five win with an 80-71 decision at Pittsburgh on Dec. 17.

Three Miami players received all-conference honors following the conclusion of the regular season as Lauren Dickerson was named All-MAC Second Team, Savannah Kluesner was named All-MAC Third Team and Peyton Scott was named MAC All-Freshman Team. Dickerson became Miami's all-time leading scorer in addition to breaking five other Miami career records and one single-season record. Kluesner broke the program record for single-season double-doubles (14) and Miami's single-game block record (7).

Hendrix came to Oxford from High Point University, where she was the head coach for seven seasons. She ranks third among Panther women's basketball coaches with 125 wins and amassed an 89-43 mark in the Big South. The 67.4 conference winning percentage is the best in program history.

In 2018-19, Hendrix led High Point to a 22-9 record and a 15-3 record in Big South competition, earning an invite to the WNIT for the second time during her tenure.

During Hendrix's time with the Panthers, the Kokomo, Indiana-native has coached three Big South Players of the Year, five All-Big South First Team members, 15 all-conference players and five players that earned all-freshman accolades, including one Big South Freshman of the Year honoree. She also has won one regular season championship (2013-14), earning Big South Coach of the Year that same season.

Hendrix served as an assistant coach for one year with HPU before earning the top job in May of 2012.

"After a national search it was clear that DeUnna was the right choice with strong Midwest ties to lead our women's basketball program," said Sayler. "Her success on and off the court, combined with seven years of successful head coaching experience makes her the ideal fit to continue to move this program in a championship direction."

Hendrix joined High Point in 2011 after four years as an assistant coach at Jacksonville University. The Dolphins advanced to the Atlantic Sun championship game in three of her four seasons, including 2011. The team went 23-9 in 2007-08, the best overall record in program history.

Prior to Jacksonville, Hendrix played at the University of Richmond from 2003-07. Hendrix was a two-time team captain her junior and senior year. She also helped the Spiders to an NCAA Tournament appearance (2004-05) as well as the WNIT semifinals in 2003-04.

Hendrix was a three-sport athlete during her prep career at Kokomo High School. She was a First-Team All-State selection as a senior, leading the Lady Kats to an undefeated season, a state championship and a No. 14 national ranking.

Hendrix went on to play professionally for the Jacksonville Cougars of the Women's Blue Chip Basketball League in the summer of 2008. It was the league's inaugural season and Hendrix was elected team captain.

Hendrix earned her bachelor's degree in rhetoric and communications from Richmond in 2007.
