Kathy Tepe—1987 | Wendy Tepe—1987 Hall of Fame Class of 1994

Kathy Tepe Bessler and Wendy Tepe Tobergte were among the six inducted into Miami University's Athletics Hall of Fame in 1994. Twin sisters, Kathy and Wendy were an explosive combination for the Red and White from 1983-86. Among the honors they shared were winning Miami's Leann Grimes Davidge Memorial Award in 1987 and being named co-Female Athletes of the Year for the 1986-87 academic year.

Kathy, a dietetics major, ended her senior year as Miami's all-time leader in kills with 1,398 and currently ranks second for career kills. She holds Miami single-season record for most kills per game (4.26 in 1985). She ranked 17th in the country in attack percentage her senior year (.353). Kathy was named all-MidEast Region in 1986 and earned all-MAC honors three years, including first-team distinction in 1985

and 1986. In 1986, she was selected as a Third-Team GTE Academic All-American.

Wendy, an elementary education major, is Miami's all-time leader in solo blocks (108), attack percentage (.325) and blocks per game average (1.07). She also holds Miami's single-match record with 30 kills and is among the top five in seven other categories. She ranked 16th in the country in attack percentage her senior year (.355). Like her sister, Wendy was named to the all-MidEast Region team in 1986 and was a three-time all-MAC selection, earning first-team recognition in 1985 and 1986. In 1986, Wendy was named a Second-Team GTE Academic All-American.

The duo helped the Red and White to a 95-39 record over their four seasons with Miami, a .709 winning percentage.

Karen Lepley—1989 Hall of Fame Class of 1999

As Miami's first MAC Player of the Year in volleyball, Karen Lepley Irons set a standard that only four other Miami volleyball players have lived up to by earning the MAC's top individual award: Lori Reinart in 1996, Jessica Stout in 1997, Alissia Thompson in 1998 and Olivia Rusek in 2017. The four-year letterwinner still owns the best single-season dig per game average (3.89) and has the second-best single-season dig total (451). Her name remains on eight-of-nine season Top-10 lists and seven-of-ten career Top-10 charts. Lepley became the first athlete in the history of the program to surpass the 1,000-kill and dig marks, amassing 1,188 kills and 1,154 digs during her career. She was a First-Team All-MAC and AVCA all-region selection in 1988 and garnered second-team all-conference recognition in 1987. In 1987 and '88, Lepley was chosen to participate in the prestigious Olympic Sports Festival where she won a gold and bronze medal, respectively. She was the first of only two Miami volleyball players to participate in an Olympic Sports Festival.



Elaine Hieber—Coach/Administrator Hall of Fame Class of 1999

Elaine Hieber helped pioneer women's athletics at Miami University. During her tenure as associate athletics director, she established seven women's varsity sports to compete at the AIAW Division I level, while instituting and expanding grant-in-aids for female student-athletes. The first full-time women's coach at Miami and in the state of Ohio was hired during Hieber's stint, and she was instrumental in the expansion of the women's staff to include four full-time head coaches, one part-time coach, one part-time assistant coach, one full-time assistant athletic trainer, a full-time equipment manager and a full-time assistant sports information director. In addition to her administrative efforts, Hieber served as the head coach for four sports, including sitting at the helm of the basketball, volleyball and softball programs for the 1974 and '75 seasons. In 1976, she took the reigns of the tennis program and produced a 43-21 record and boasted second-place showings in the Ohio College Women's Tennis Tournament in 1976, '78 and '79. Hieber left the Miami Athletic Department in 1979 to take a position as the associate athletic director at Iowa State. She lives in Ames, Iowa, and recently retired as the senior associate athletic director and senior woman's administrator for the Cyclones.

Carolyn Condit—Coach Hall of Fame Class of 2002

Carolyn Condit has directed Miami's volleyball program since 1984, winning nine Mid-American Conference championships and mentoring five MAC Players of the Year along the way. A six-time MAC Coach of the Year, Condit won her 600th match at Miami during the 2017 campaign. In 2017, Condit led Miami to the NCAA Tournament for the ninth time, guiding the Red and White to the MAC's regular-season and tournament championships. She led Miami to its third straight MAC regular season crown in 2018. The 1998 team finished with 27 wins, including the program's first NCAA Tournament victory. She is the winningest coach in Miami history and also ranks among all-time Division I coaches in wins. Along with her success on the court, Condit has guided her student-athletes to success in the classroom, producing six academic All-Americans.



Sandy Secoy—1982 Hall of Fame Class of 2003-04

Sandy Secoy became the first player in Miami volleyball history to earn First-Team All-MAC honors, garnering the award in 1980. She helped Miami to back-to-back MAC titles and postseason tournament appearances in 1980 and 1981, the first championships in the program's history. During her career, she helped Miami compile 132 wins and a .727 winning percentage. She was a two-year captain for the Red and White, serving in the position as a junior and senior. Secoy returned to Miami in 1983 to serve as an assistant coach for one season.



Angel Miller—1992 Hall of Fame Class of 2007-08

Angel Miller was a two-time First-Team All-MAC volleyball selection in 1990 and 1991, earning AVCA All-District II accolades and Second-Team Academic All-MAC honors in 1991. Twice Miller earned MAC All-Tournament Team honors (1990 and '91), being named the 1990 MAC Tournament MVP after leading Miami to its first tournament title in nearly 10 years and just the second NCAA Tournament berth in program history. She helped Miami to the 1991 NIVC semifinals. Miller remains Miami's career record holder for kills per game (3.33) and its single-season record holder for kills (527 in 1991). She finished her career as the Red and White's career record holder in digs (1,157) and was second in career kills (1,344). She currently ranks fifth in career kills and digs and is one of just eight players in program history to amass 1,000 kills and digs in a career. Additionally, Miller ranks among Miami's career top 10 in digs per game, service aces and hitting percentage, while also ranking among the top 10 in single-season digs, kills per game and service aces. She participated in the Olympic Sports Festival in 1990 and '91, earning bronze medals each year.



Stephanie Otten—1995 Hall of Fame Class of 2009-10

Stephanie Otten was one of the best all-around players in Miami history. She is the RedHawks all-time leader in kills with 1,528, and is tops in digs among non-liberos with 1,467. She was a two-time All-MAC selection, earning second-team honors in 1994 and first-team honors in 1995. She was also a two-time MAC All-Tournament team selection (1994 and 1995) and was named Miami's Leann Grimes Davidge Award winner in 1995. During her senior season, she led the RedHawks to a 24-7 record and a MAC regular-season championship with a 15-2 conference mark. That team finished 24th in the RPI rankings and was the first in school history to earn an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Renee DeGraff—1984 **Hall of Fame Class of 2011-12**

Renee DeGraff became the first Miami volleyball player to earn All-MAC honors three times in a career, being named to the All-MAC First Team in 1981 and 1982 and the All-MAC Second Team in 1983. She is one of just eight Miami volleyball players to twice earn First-Team All-MAC honors. DeGraff helped Miami capture its first two MAC Championship as the Red and White took home the title in 1980 and 1981. In 1980, Miami earned a spot in the AIAW Tournament and advanced to the MAIAW Regional Championship while posting a 38-11 record. The 1981 team boasts the most wins in program history, amassing a 41-10 mark, and made the first NCAA Tournament appearance in program history. During her four-year stint at Miami, DeGraff spearheaded Miami to a 129-53 record, which included two 30-win seasons and a 40-win season.



Jessica Stout—1998 **Hall of Fame Class of 2013-14**

Amassing 5,794 assists, Jessica Stout finished her career as the MAC record holder in assists and ranked among Division I career leaders. Still the Miami record holder, she ranks second among all-time MAC leaders. Stout also owns Miami records for career assists per game (12.43) and single-season assists per game (13.23 in 1996). A three-time All-MAC selection, earning first-team distinction in 1997, Stout also garnered First-Team AVCA All-District II recognition. She was named the MAC Player of the Year as a senior in 1997, Miami Female Athlete of the year in 1997-98, MAC Tournament MVP in 1996 and MAC Freshman of the Year in 1994. A two-time MAC All-Tournament Team selection, Stout paced Miami to a MAC Tournament title in 1996 as well as three regular-season MAC crowns (1995, 1996, 1997). She participated in the postseason all four years,



Jill Kohrs—1983 **Hall of Fame Class of 2015-16**

Jill Kohrs was a powerful left-side attacker who lifted Miami volleyball to its first two MAC titles in 1980 and 1981. Competing for the Red and White from 1980-83, Kohrs was a two-time All-MAC selection, earning first-team distinction in 1982. Kohrs and the 1980 team advanced to the Midwest Association of Intercollegiate Athletics for Women (MAIAW) regional championship and amassed a 41-10 record, which continues to stand as the most wins in program history. The following year Kohrs and the Red and White again made history, earning the program's first NCAA Tournament bid.



Dona Layman—1977 **Hall of Fame Class of 2017-18**

Dona Layman '77 was an exceptional three-sport athlete for Miami at the inception of women's intercollegiate athletics. From 1973-77, Layman was a standout in women's basketball and softball for four seasons and in volleyball for three seasons. She is noted as a gritty competitor and a truly gifted athlete who helped lay a foundation of excellence in women's athletics at Miami University. Layman was a four-year starting point guard for the women's basketball team, captaining the squads her junior and senior seasons. She was a part of the 1977 softball team that posted a 22-4 record and placed second in the OAIWS. Following her undergraduate stint, Layman served as a graduate assistant and continued her involvement with Miami Athletics, helping to coach the volleyball, women's basketball and softball programs. Layman went on to an impressive coaching career and was inducted into Miami's Cradle of Coaches Association in 2015. She has been inducted into the Valley View High School, Ohio High School Fast Pitch Coaches Association, Western Brown High School and Brown County Athletics halls of fame

Lisa Dankovich—1986 and Assistant Coach Hall of Fame Class of 2018-19

Lisa Dankovich was a three-time All-MAC selection for Miami volleyball from 1983 to 1986. She continues to hold the Mid-American Conference record for service aces in a season (99) and is the Miami record holder for career service aces (207), which currently ranks fourth among MAC leaders. Dankovich finished her career as Miami's record holder for assists and assists per game and currently ranks fourth all time in assists per game and fifth in assists. During her playing career, she helped Miami to a 95-39 record, a .709 winning percentage. Dankovich returned to her alma mater two years after graduating, going on to serve as an assistant coach for the Red and White for 16 seasons. During her coaching tenure, Miami experienced remarkable success, including five MAC regular-season titles, three MAC tournament titles and seven postseason appearances, including five NCAA Tournament berths. The 1995 team became the first in MAC volleyball history to earn an at-large berth to the NCAA Tournament and finished the season with an NCAA RPI of #24 in the country. Dankovich continued her association with Miami University following her coaching stint, and recently retired as Director of University External Relations. She also is an analyst for Miami volleyball's ESPN3 broadcasts.



Lori Reinart—1996 Hall of Fame Class of 2021-22

Lori Reinart helped lead Miami into an era of dominance. She led the team to the 1995 and 1996 Mid-American Conference Championships, winning the MAC Tournament in 1996 and going to the NCAA Tournament both seasons. In 1996, Reinart was named MAC Player of the Year as well as an American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) All-District Player. She earned All-MAC honors three times (1994-96). Reinart still ranks fourth all-time with 1,372 kills. Her 3.30 kills per set average ranks third, while her .290 career hitting percentage ranks 10th. Reinart is fifth all-time with 331 block assists. Her 14 against Ohio on Nov. 2, 1996 remains Miami's single-match record. Reinart has two of the top 10 single-season kill totals in school history.



Barb Ramsey—1976 Hall of Fame Class of 2022-23

Barb Ramsey excelled in three sports during her time at Miami, and was part of the first intercollegiate athletic seasons in softball, volleyball, and basketball. On the diamond, she hit .523 as a senior with six home runs and 30 RBI. She led Miami Softball to a 23-3 record over her final two seasons (including a 15-1 mark in 1976), and was known as not only a power hitter but also a gritty defensive player and strong leader. In all, Ramsey amassed 11 letters during her Red and White athletic career: four in softball, four in volleyball and three in basketball.

Entering the Mid-American Conference Tournament with the No. 3 seed, the RedHawks cruised to a MAC Tournament Championship by sweeping Central Michigan, Eastern Michigan and No. 15 Ohio, earning its fourth MAC Tournament crown and its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 1998. Miami was selected to play against Michigan, a team that had beaten Miami in three games at the end of August. The RedHawks got off to a slow start and dropped the first two games, 16-30, 18-30. In game three, the Wolverines had an eight-point lead on three occasions, before a kill by Megan Griffin, two kills by Carli Reihman and seven Michigan errors brought the RedHawks within one point, 21-22. The RedHawks remained within one point as late as 27-28, but the Wolverines went on to take the third and final game, 30-27. In her final match as a RedHawk, Reihman registered 14 kills on 20 attempts with no errors en route to a .700 hitting percentage. Reihman also collected 11 digs as she became the fifth Miami player to record a kill/dig double-double in a NCAA Tournament game.

For the third time in school history, the RedHawks earned an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament. It was the first time Miami was selected without first winning the MAC regular season crown. Sent to West Lafayette, Ind., the RedHawks drew Middle Tennessee State out of the Sun Belt Conference. The Blue Raiders rallied from a 10-18 deficit to take set one 25-23. Miami took an 18-9 lead in set two, but once again Middle Tennessee came from behind to take a 22-21 lead of its own. However, this time the RedHawks would regain their focus and took three of the last four points to win 25-23. Set three was back and forth until the teams found themselves tied at 20. Miami closed out that set with a 5-1 run to take a 2-1 lead in the match. The RedHawks made a great comeback in set four after falling behind 4-11. They actually had two match points at 27-26 and 28-27, but the Blue Raiders fought them off both times and eventually took the set 30-28.
