STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami University women's basketball team returns to action Sunday, Nov. 23 with a trip to Purdue. Opening tip is slated for 12:30 p.m. and will be carried live on Big Ten Network.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Amber Tretter has recorded 21 double-doubles in her career, including 10 last season. Throughout her career she has averaged 10.7 points and 8.6 rebounds and has 558 rebounds through her first 65 games as a RedHawk. She is currently on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds. This season she is a walking double-double in points (10.4) and rebounds (10.0).

BALANCED SCORING: Miami has six players averaging at least nine points a contest. Amber Scalia is tops on the team at 15.6 ppg., and is followed by Ilse de Vries (11.8), Amber Tretter (10.4), Tamar Singer (9.4), Brooke Blumenfeld (9.2), and Núria Jurjo (9.0).

BY THE MARGINS: Miami currently is second in the MAC in scoring (79.4) and first in defense (56.0), which results in a 23.4 point margin of victory, tops in the conference. The RedHawks also lead the MAC in field goal percentage (.481), three-pointers made (40) and turnover margin (8.2).

REDHAWKS SHUTDOWN KNIGHTS: Miami forced 20 turnovers and connected on 10 three pointers en route to a 77-58 road victory last Sunday over Bellarmine. Amber Scalia had a game-high 26 points (20 in the first half), Ilse de Vries poured in 17 (all in second half) and Macie Taylor added nine points and a career-best seven assists.

ABOUT PURDUE: The Boilermakers are 2-2 on the season, but are coming off a 76-35 loss to No. 20 Kentucky on Tuesday night. Purdue averages 62.8 points per contest and are led by Hila Karsh (14.3 ppg.), Kiki Smith (12.0 ppg.) and Tara Daye (10.3 ppg.).

SERIES HISTORY: Miami is 2-8 all-time versus Purdue and 0-5 in West Lafayette. These same two teams competed in Millett Hall last season, with the Boilermakers walking away with a 67-51 victory.

VERSUS THE BIG TEN: Miami has not beaten a team from the Big Ten since downing Indiana 77-72 back on Nov. 22, 2011. Since then, the RedHawks have lost five-straight versus Big Ten programs.

ROAD WARRIORS: Miami is currently in a stretch of five-straight road games from Nov. 16-Dec. 3. Miami does not return home until Dec. 7 versus Western Kentucky.

2024-25 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Last season Miami averaged 66.5 points per game, up 12.6 points/game from the 2023-24 season.
- Miami had the top scoring defense in the MAC, allowing 59.1 points/game
- The 19-win season last year was Miami's best since the 2017-18 RedHawks won 21 contests.
- Miami's 10-win improvement from the previous year was the second-best single season turnaround in program history.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES: Miami has eight new players this season, which includes five transfers, two freshmen and a red-shirt freshman. Joining the RedHawks via the portal include Amber Scalia (St. Thomas), Clara Gonzalez Planella (Jacksonville State), Macie Taylor (Wright State), Ashton Elley (UAB), and Brooke Blumenfeld (NIU). Coach Box also added two freshmen (Mio Sakano and Anna Hurst) and Emily VanTimmeren, who technically joined the RedHawks last December, has yet to see action with the Red and White.

NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG: Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 511 games and make 266 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 137 times.

[Two Lives of Tamar Singer](#)
[de Vries Ready to Turn MAC Inside-Out](#)

SINGING HER PRAISES: Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 9.4 points and 6.2 assists per game, which ranks second-best in the conference.

PASSING RECORDS: Tamar Singer posted a career-high 12 assists versus Indiana Southeast to become the first RedHawk to secure double-digit assists in a game since Maddi Cluse did so back on Dec. 16, 2022. Her 12 dimes are the third-most by a RedHawk in Millett Hall history, behind Courtney Osborn and D'Nelle Seiple, who had 13 apiece.

DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS: This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists.

AMBER 2.0: Rightfully so, much has been made about the accomplishments of Amber Tretter, but Amber Scalia has also accomplished a lot in her time prior to joining the RedHawks. She played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. This past week she averaged 18.0 points, 3.7 assists and 3.7 rebounds over a three-game stretch.

THE KILLER B: Brooke Blumenfeld went scoreless in her opening contest as a RedHawks versus Coastal Carolina. Since then, the NIU transfer has scored 46 points over her last four games. She posted 14 points in 17 minutes of action against Cedarville and added another 14 at Oakland.

WINNING WITH DEFENSE: Last season Miami led the MAC in scoring defense, allowing 59.1 points per game (60th nationally), which was the second-best defensive effort in program history (The 1977-78 Miami team allowed 56.9 ppg.) The RedHawks were 13-4 on the year when they force their opponent into 20-plus turnovers and led the conference with 11.5 steals per game in 2024-25.

CHANDLER RETURNS: Head Coach Glenn Box may have a new assistant coach this year, but she is not new to the program. Maya Chandler, who played for the RedHawks last season, is in her first year as an assistant coach. Last season, Chandler averaged 11.6 points, 2.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per contest.

UP NEXT: Following the trip to Purdue, Miami will compete at the Paradise Jam in the Virgin Islands. The RedHawks will face Washington State on Friday, Nov. 28 and then either LSU or Marist the following day.

REDHAWKS PICKED SEVENTH IN PRESEASON POLL: Miami was picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll, voted on by the league's 13 head coaches.

Glenn Box Head Coach

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kempf became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kempf also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kempf, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.

Box earned his associate's degree in elementary education at Rend Lake in 1996 and went on to obtain his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Southeast Missouri State in 1998. He began his coaching career in the Cairo school district before entering the college ranks.

Box is married to Leah and has four children, two sons, Darius and William, and daughters, Auna and Bella.
