STORYLINES

1. WEDNESDAY: Miami travels to face off with the UNC Asheville Bulldogs on Wednesday, Dec. 10 at 6 p.m. The Red and White enter this game with an 8-0 record, its best start to a season since the 1995-96 season. The best start to a season in program history is 10-0 (1917-18 and 1943-44). Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into this game, which includes being third in scoring margin (28.6), fourth in the country in effective field goal percentage (61.9%), sixth in field goal percentage (52.8%), sixth in scoring offense (95.4), 11th in free throw percentage (78.7%), 14th in threes per game (11.4), 18th in three-point percentage (39.7%), 20th in bench points per game (37.25), 26th in defensive rebounds per game (29.38) and 33rd in rebound margin (9.4).

2. RANKINGS: The Miami University men's basketball team received two votes in the most recent Associated Press Top 25 men's college basketball poll for the first time in the 2025-26 season on Monday. The Red and White also remained at its highest ranking of the 2025-26 season on the Mid-Major Top 25® Poll, as Collegeinsider announced its new poll Monday evening, with the RedHawks still ranked No. 4 overall. The RedHawks are just one of eight teams that are still undefeated at the Division I level (Duke, Iowa St., Nebraska, Oklahoma St., Vanderbilt, Arizona, Miami and Michigan).

ABOUT UNC ASHEVILLE: UNC Asheville is currently 4-5, as the Bulldogs most recently dropped to the NC State Wolfpack 63-75 on Saturday afternoon. UNC Asheville went 21-11 (11-5 Big South) last year. Head coach Mike Morrell is in his eighth season with the Bulldogs. Heading into the 2025-26 season, UNC Asheville was selected to finish second overall in the 2025-26 Big South Preseason Men's Basketball Poll.

Fifth-year guard Justin Wright (17.4), sophomore guard/forward Kameron Taylor (17.1), fifth-year forward Toyaz Solomon (16.3) and redshirt senior DJ Patrick (10.7/game) all lead the Bulldogs with double figures in scoring. Solomon leads the team in both rebounds (6.2/game) and blocks (1.0/game). Taylor has recorded the most assists (3.0/game), while Wright has brought in the most steals (1.78/game).

THE SERIES WITH THE BULLDOGS: This Wednesday's away contest against UNC Asheville will be the first meeting between the programs.

UP NEXT: Miami continues its four-game road trip at Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, Dec. 13 at 3 p.m.

RECENT ACTION: The Miami University men's basketball team dominated the Maine Black Bears by securing a 93-61 victory on Saturday afternoon at Millett Hall. Evan Ipsaro led the RedHawks with a career-high 24 points, while Eian Elmer (16), Almar Atlason (10) and Trey Perry (10) scored double digits. Ipsaro shot 9-of-13 from the field and 6-of-8 from behind the three-point line (the most field goals and triples made in a single game for Ipsaro). Atlason continued his stellar shooting from the free-throw line, as he is put in a pair of shots from the charity stripe to improve to 22-of-22 on the season.

RILEY DECKER SHOWCASE GAME: The Miami University men's basketball team secured an 82-71 comeback win over UNC Greensboro at Adams-Jenkins Complex in the Riley Decker Showcase Game. Peter Suder totaled a game-high 20 points, while Almar Atlason (18) and Brant Byers (11) added double figures in scoring. Suder also set the tone for the RedHawks with a season-high in rebounds (seven) and steals (four). Suder was named the Riley Decker Showcase Game MVP for his performance.

COLLEGIATE HOOPS ROAD SHOW: The Miami University men's basketball team edged past Mercyhurst 76-71 and rolled to a 111-84 victory over Arkansas - Pine Bluff in the Collegiate Hoops Road Show earlier this season. Almar Atlason, Brant Byers and Antwone Woolfolk were named to the 2025 Collegiate Hoops Roadshow All-Tournament Team, while Ipsaro was recognized as the MVP.

LEAVING THEIR MARK: 11 different RedHawks made at least one three-pointer in a 129-49 win over the Trinity Christian Trolls to total 21 on the evening, the RedHawks' third-best shooting performance all-time in Miami program history. Miami also shot a blistering 70% from the three-point line (tied for the fifth-highest percentage in Miami history) and finished the game shooting 68.3% from the floor (third-highest percentage in Miami history).

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE: With Miami's most recent home win over Maine (93-61), the Red and White extended its home win streak to 21 games. The RedHawks are looking to snap a Miami record of 23 straight home wins (1996-1998). Last season, the Red and White set a new record of 15 consecutive home wins over the course of one season.

NATIONAL & MAC RANKINGS

2025-26 ROSTER: The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

ALMAR ATLASON: The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

JUSTIN KIRBY: Justin Kirby is a freshman guard from Fishers High School who averaged 13.1 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior. He was named an Indiana All-Star in 2024-25 and was a 4A state champion in the 2023-24 season.

TREY PERRY: Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

TYLER ROBBINS: Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

LESHAWN STOWERS: Freshman guard Leshawn Stowers attended Peoria Central High School, where he served as team captain in his final two seasons. He was named First-Team All-Conference in his junior and senior seasons.

KYLE WALTZ: Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). Peter Suder was picked Preseason All-MAC First Team, and Eian Elmer was selected Preseason All-MAC Second Team.

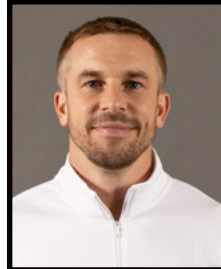

Head Coach Travis Steele



Travis Steele enters his fourth season as head men's basketball coach at Miami University.

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami

history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Sayler. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
