STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami University women's basketball team puts its five-game win streak on the line with a Wednesday, Jan. 13 home contest versus Eastern Michigan. Opening tip is set for 7 p.m.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Amber Tretter has 25 double-doubles (fourth-best in program history) in her career and is a near walking double-double in points (14.0) and rebounds (8.2) this season. She is also on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds and has scored 871 career points, which ranks 35th in program history. She has scored at least 14 points in eight-straight games.

BALANCED SCORING: Miami has four players averaging double-digits in scoring, led by Amber Tretter (14.0 ppg.). She is joined by Amber Scalia (13.5 ppg.), Ilse de Vries (11.4 ppg.) and Tamar Singer (10.8 ppg.).

RED-HOT REDHAWKS: Since Nov. 29, the RedHawks have lost just one contest and have won eight of their last nine games, including five-straight.

BY THE MARGINS: Miami is currently fourth in the MAC in scoring (72.0) and second in defense (59.4), which results in a 12.6 point margin of victory, best in the conference. The RedHawks are first in the MAC in field goal percentage (.452), three-pointers made (134), free throw percentage (77.8%), turnover margin (5.3) and assist/turnover margin (1.09).

AKRON RECAP: Miami used an 18-2 second quarter run and never looked back as they downed Akron 79-56 last Saturday. Amber Scalia led Miami with 18 points as the RedHawks improved to 4-0 in Mid-American Conference play for the first time since 2011-12. Miami shot 55.8% from the field as ten different RedHawks scored in the contest. The RedHawks also forced 25 turnovers total and allowed just 10 field goals over the final three quarters of play.

MAC MOMENTUM: Miami's 4-0 start in MAC play is one of the best starts in program history. The last time Miami started 4-0 was back in 2011-12. The best conference starts in program history include: 9-0 (1989-90), 5-0 (2001-02) and 5-0 (1988-89).

ABOUT EMU: The Eagles are 7-7 overall and 1-3 in MAC play. Sisi Eleko leads the way in scoring (17.8) and rebounding (9.7), while Peyton Hill (13.1 ppg.) and Fernanda Ovalle (12.8) are also scoring in double figures. Head coach Sahar Nusseibeh was an assistant with the RedHawks from 2019-21.

SERIES HISTORY: This will be the 71st meeting between the two programs, with the RedHawks holding a 45-25 series advantage. Miami has won three-straight against the Eagles, including the last two at home.

2024-25 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Last season Miami averaged 66.5 points per game, up 12.6 points/game from the 2023-24 season.
- Miami had the top scoring defense in the MAC, allowing 59.1 points/game.
- The 19-win season last year was Miami's best since the 2017-18 RedHawks won 21 contests.
- Miami's 10-win improvement from the previous year was the second-best single season turnaround in program history.

LONG RANGE BOMBERS: Miami ranks 39th nationally, connecting on 8.4 three-pointers per contest. The RedHawks have made double-digit three-pointers in six of 16 games this season, including 13 at Purdue, 12 against Marist, Coastal Carolina, WKU and UMass and 10 against Bellarmine. Seven different RedHawks are shooting at least 33% from distance and six RedHawks have already made 10+ three pointers this season (Ashton Elley has nine).

SAY YES TO NON-CONFERENCE WINS: As the RedHawks are early into MAC play, Miami has already had one of its most successful non-conference seasons. The last time Miami won eight non-conference games before Jan. 1 was all the way back in 2018-19 when Miami captured nine wins before the calendar change.

20+ LEAGUE: Four different RedHawks have already scored 20-plus points this season and the RedHawks are 5-1 on the year when someone puts up a 20-point effort. Amber Tretter and Tamar Singer have done it twice and Amber Scalia and Ilse de Vries have also posted 20-plus points.

HOME SWEET HOME: The RedHawks are a perfect 6-0 at home this season and have out-scored their opponents 463-307 (26.0/game). Miami is shooting 37.7% from long range and are averaging 19.2 assists per game on its home court.

THINGS CHANGE QUICKLY: The RedHawks rank 61st nationally in assist/turnover ratio (1.09 per game). This season the RedHawks have 274 assists compared to 252 turnovers. Last season Miami had 409 assists and 534 turnovers and in Coach Box's first year the RedHawks posted 336 assists and 547 turnovers. Miami has had more assists than turnovers in nine of 14 contests this season and currently rank 34th nationally with 17.2 assists per contest.

TURNING INTO WINS: Miami ranks 35th in the country in turnovers forced at 21.1 per game and are 8-2 this year when they force at least 20 turnovers in a contest. They also rank 40th nationally at 11.0 steals/contest.

NOTHING BUT NET: The RedHawks are only attempting 15.8 free throws per contest, but are making the most of their opportunities. Miami ranks 19th nationally at 77.8% from the foul line. Seven different RedHawks shoot at least 75% from the charity stripe.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES: Miami has eight new players this season, which includes five transfers, two freshmen and a red-shirt freshman. Joining the RedHawks via the portal include Amber Scalia (St. Thomas), Clara Gonzalez Planella (Jacksonville State), Macie Taylor (Wright State), Ashton Elley (UAB), and Brooke Blumenfeld (NIU). Coach Box also added two freshmen (Mio Sakano and Anna Hurst) and Emily VanTimmeren, who technically joined the RedHawks last December, has yet to see action with the Red and White.

NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG: Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 639 games and make 321 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 172 times.

SINGING HER PRAISES: Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 10.8 points and 7.4 assists, which ranks eighth nationally. She has surpassed 20 points twice this season (none last year) and has led the team in scoring five times in 2025-26 (once all of last year).

PASSING RECORDS: Tamar Singer is threatening nearly every passing record in program history. The school record for assists in a game is 13 (Courtney Osborn and D'Nelle Seiple) ... Singer has twice posted 12 assists (IU-Southeast and WKU). Versus the Lady Toppers she has six assists before the first media time out (which has to be a school record). The school record for assists in a season is 175 (Jenna Schone) ... With no postseason play, Singer is on pace for 229 assists this season. The career record for assists is 596 (Heather Cusick)...Singer is on pace for 347 assists through her first two years of play.

DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS: This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists. She has already posted nine double-digit scoring contests after just three in 2024-25.

108 AND COUNTING: Amber Scalia will be competing in her 108th career game on Wednesday. Prior to joining the RedHawks, Scalia played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. She has scored 1,321 points (12.3/game) in 107 career games.

WELCOME BACK: Prior to the Toledo game, Núria Jurjo had made just one of her last 18 shots. Over her past three games she has 35 points on 13-of-22 shooting overall and has made nine of 14 shots from behind the arc. She has raised her scoring average from 6.6 ppg. to 7.3 ppg. in a three-game span.

CHANDLER RETURNS: Head Coach Glenn Box may have a new assistant coach this year, but she is not new to the program. Maya Chandler, who played for the RedHawks last season, is in her first year as an assistant coach. Last season, Chandler averaged 11.6 points, 2.4 rebounds and 2.0 assists per contest.

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kemph became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kemph also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kemph, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.

Box earned his associate's degree in elementary education at Rend Lake in 1996 and went on to obtain his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Southeast Missouri State in 1998. He began his coaching career in the Cairo school district before entering the college ranks.

Box is married to Leah and has four children, two sons, Darius and William, and daughters, Auna and Bella.
