STORYLINES

1. TUESDAY: Miami hosts UMass on Tuesday, Jan. 27 at 9 p.m. The Red and White enter this game with a 20-0 (8-0 MAC) record, its best start to a season in program history. The RedHawks secured the best start for a program in MAC history at 20-0 with their last victory (originally set by WMU in 1975-76 at 19-0).

2. HOME COURT ADVANTAGE: With Miami's most recent home victory in overtime versus Buffalo (105-102), the Red and White extended its home win streak to 26 games (the most consecutive home wins in program history). Last season, Miami set a new record of 15 consecutive home wins over the course of one season.

2. NATIONAL RANKINGS: Miami was ranked No. 25 overall in the Associated Press Top 25 men's college basketball poll for the first time since Feb. 15, 1999 on Monday, Jan. 19. The RedHawks are now the first team from the MAC selected in the poll since the 2018-19 Buffalo Bulls. The Red and White also retained its highest ranking of the 2025-26 season on the Mid-Major Top 25® Poll, as CollegeInsider announced its new poll Monday as well, with the RedHawks ranked No. 2 overall. The RedHawks are just one of three teams that are still undefeated at the Division I level (Arizona, Miami and Nebraska). Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into its next game, which includes being first in the country in effective field goal percentage (0.634), first in field goal percentage (54.0), first in scoring offense (94.6), third in three-point percentage (41.2), eighth in scoring margin (19.9), ninth in threes per game (11.4), 25th in free throw percentage (77.3), 25th in defensive rebounds per game (27.90), 32nd in assist/turnover ratio (1.59), 38th in assists per game (17.5) and 41st in bench points per game (30.55).

ABOUT UMASS: UMass is currently 13-8 (4-5 MAC), as the Minutemen most recently defeated Buffalo on the road (68-67) Friday night and Toledo (84-82) at home on Tuesday night. UMass went 12-20 (7-11 A10) last year. Head coach Frank Martin is in his fourth season with the Minutemen. Heading into the 2025-26 season, UMass was selected to finish fifth overall in the 2025-26 MAC Preseason Men's Basketball Poll. Senior forward Daniel Hankins-Sanford was named to the Preseason All-MAC Second Team.

Graduate student forward Leonardo Bettoli leads the Minutemen in points (17.1/game) and rebounds (7.5/game). Freshman guard Danny Carbuccia has recorded the most assists (6.0/game), guard/forward Jayden Ndjigue has totaled the most steals (1.7/game), and Hankins-Sanford has produced the most blocks (0.8/game).

THE SERIES WITH THE MINUTEMEN: This Tuesday's home contest against the Minutemen will be the third meeting between the two programs. UMass leads in the series 2-0 all-time. The RedHawks fell 73-65 on Jan. 4, 2014 and dropped 70-69 on Jan. 2, 2013.

UP NEXT: Miami stays at home for a contest against Northern Illinois on Saturday, Jan. 31 at 3:30 p.m.

RECENT ACTION: The Miami University men's basketball team outlasted Kent State in a 107-101 overtime victory Tuesday night. A layup by Luke Skaljac with six seconds remaining in the second half forced overtime for the Red and White. Peter Suder led the RedHawks with 27 points and 10 rebounds, while Eian Elmer followed closely behind in points with 25. Skaljac (18), Brant Byers (11) and Antwone Woolfolk (10) added double digits for Miami. The Red and White shot 50% (38-of-70) or better from the field for the 16th time this season. Miami committed only six turnovers (the sixth time this season the RedHawks have recorded under 10 turnovers in a game) and forced 16 turnovers by the Golden Flashes. Miami is now 8-0 to start conference play for the first time since the 1994-95 season. The RedHawks have now tied the program record for most consecutive road wins in a season and now hold the new program record for most consecutive road wins overall. With Tuesday's overtime win over the Golden Flashes, Miami now holds 700 MAC victories, the most in MAC history.

CENTURY CLUB: Tuesday's win marks the second consecutive game that Miami has taken down an opponent that scored 100 or more points (previously hadn't been done since a 110-102 victory against Evansville on Dec. 9, 1987). This is the third game in a row that Miami has scored 100 or more points against a conference opponent (previously hadn't been done since Jan. 5, 2002 in a 100-94 double overtime victory at Central Michigan). This is the seventh time that the RedHawks have scored 100 or more points this season (the most in program history).

NCAA INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Sophomore guard Luke Skaljac ranks first in the MAC and 25th nationally in assist/turnover ratio. Skaljac leads the team with a ratio of 3.32. Senior guard Peter Suder ranks fourth in the MAC and 47th in the country from the field at 57.6%.

MAC INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Since the start of MAC play, senior forward Antwone Woolfolk is first in the conference in field goal percentage (71.2%) and three-point field goal percentage (61.5%). Woolfolk also stands at ninth in blocks (1.1/game) and seventh in steals (1.8/game). Elmer ranks ninth in blocks (1.1/game) and Suder stands at seventh in steals (1.8/game) as well. Sophomore guard Luke Skaljac holds the sixth spot in assists (5.3/game) and senior guard Peter Suder follows closely behind at ninth (5.0/game).

TELEVISION: Miami's 21st game of the season will be aired on ESPNU.

RADIO: In its seventh year of its partnership with Van Wagner, the Miami Sports Network continues its coverage of Miami men's basketball.

OVERTIME SUCCESS: The RedHawks are coming off of back-to-back overtime wins for the first time since the 2014-15 season. Miami has now recorded two consecutive overtime wins on four separate occasions in its history (1998-99, 2004-05, 2014-25 and 2025-26).

SHARPSHOOTING: The RedHawks are currently shooting 54.0% from the field, 41.2% from the three-point line and 77.3% from the free-throw line.

NEXT MAN UP: This season, eight different RedHawks have scored at least 20 or more points in a game. The RedHawks that have met this mark are Almar Atlason, Brant Byers, Eian Elmer, Evan Ipsaro (out for the season), Trey Perry, Peter Suder, Kyle Waltz and Antwone Woolfolk.

SILVER WAVES MEDIA MOST IMPACTFUL MID MAJOR ASSISTANT LIST: Silver Waves Media announced its 7th annual Mid Major Assistant Coaches and GM's lists on Monday, Jan. 5, with Miami associate head coach Jonathan Holmes being named to the list.

2025-26 ROSTER: The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

ALMAR ATLASON: The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

JUSTIN KIRBY: Justin Kirby is a freshman guard from Fishers High School who averaged 13.1 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior. He was named an Indiana All-Star in 2024-25 and was a 4A state champion in the 2023-24 season.

TREY PERRY: Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

TYLER ROBBINS: Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

KYLE WALTZ: Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). 

Head Coach Travis Steele



Travis Steele enters his fourth season as head men's basketball coach at Miami University.

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Sayler. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
