STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami women's basketball team puts its nine-game win streak on the line with a Wednesday, Jan. 28 contest at Northern Illinois. Opening tip is scheduled for 12 p.m.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Amber Tretter has 25 double-doubles (fourth-best in program history) in her career and is a near walking double-double in points (13.9) and rebounds (7.9) this season. She is also on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds and has scored 926 career points, which ranks 31st in program history. She has scored in double figures in 15 straight games.

BALANCED SCORING: Miami has four players averaging double-digits in scoring, led by Amber Tretter (13.9 ppg.). She is joined by Amber Scalia (13.7 ppg.), Ilse de Vries (12.4 ppg.) and Tamar Singer (10.3 ppg.). Singer and de Vries have led Miami in scoring a team-high five times, while Tretter and Scalia have done it four times each.

RED-HOT REDHAWKS: Since Nov. 29, the RedHawks have lost just one contest and have won 12 of their last 13 games, including nine-straight.

BY THE MARGINS: Miami is currently third in the MAC in scoring (71.0) and first in defense (57.9), which results in a 13.1 point margin of victory, tops in the conference. The RedHawks are second in the MAC in field goal percentage (.454), three-pointers made (164), and free throw percentage (77.5%). The RedHawks are first in turnover margin (5.5).

BALL STATE RECAP: Miami used a 27-9 third quarter to roll past the Ball State Cardinals, 72-52 last Saturday afternoon. Ilse de Vries scored a career-high 23 points and was joined by Amber Tretter (18), Amber Scalia (16) and Tamar Singer (11) in double figures as the RedHawks won at Ball State for the first time since Dec. 3, 1998. The 52 BSU points were a season low for the Cardinals.

MAC MOMENTUM: Miami's 8-0 record in MAC play is the second-best conference start in program history, trailing just the 1989-90 Miami team that opened the year 9-0. Long way to go, but Miami's last MAC regular season championship was back during the 2007-08 campaign.

CHASING HISTORY: The 16-4 overall start is the third-best start in program history, behind 2018-19 (started 21-4) and 1989-90 (started 23-4).

HISTORIC RUN: Miami's nine-game win streak is eighth-best in program history, trailing: 1982-83 (14), 1981-82 (13), 1989-90 (12), 2003-04 (12), 2018-19 (11), 1980-81 (11) and 2011-12 (10).

ABOUT NIU: The Huskies are 4-15 overall, 2-6 in MAC play and have lost four of their last five contests. Nadechka Laccen leads the way in scoring (12.1 ppg.), and is joined by Nevaeh Wingate (11.3 ppg.) and Emille Sorenson (10.5 ppg.) in double figures.

SERIES HISTORY: This will be the 52nd meeting between the two programs, with Miami holding a 26-25 all-time series advantage. The RedHawks are 10-15 all-time in Dekalb, which includes a 73-52 victory last season.

MID-MAJOR MONSTER: Miami currently ranks 20th in the Collegelnsider.com Mid-Major poll, which was last updated on Tuesday, Jan. 20.

COMBINING FORCES: Miami basketball has reached heights not seen in a long time in Oxford, Ohio. Combined with the women's 16-4 record and the men's perfect 20-0 record, Miami basketball is 36-4 overall in 2025-26. The 36 combined wins are third-most in the nation, behind UConn (40) and Vanderbilt (37).

LONG RANGE BOMBERS: Miami ranks 42nd nationally, connecting on 8.2 three-pointers per contest. The RedHawks have made double-digit three-pointers in six games this season, including 13 at Purdue, 12 against Marist, Coastal Carolina, WKU and UMass and 10 against Bellarmine. Seven different RedHawks are shooting at least 30% from distance and six RedHawks have already made 10+ three pointers this season (Ashton Elley has nine).

20+ LEAGUE: Four different RedHawks have already scored 20-plus points this season and the RedHawks are 6-1 on the year when someone puts up a 20-point effort. Amber Tretter, Tamar Singer and Ilse de Vries have done it twice, while Amber Scalia has also posted 20-plus points.

HOME SWEET HOME: The RedHawks are a perfect 8-0 at home this season and have out-scored their opponents 608-414 (24.3/game). Miami is shooting 36.9% from long range and are averaging 19.0 assists per game on its home court.

TURNING THE TIDE: Miami ranks 23rd in the country in turnovers forced at 21.6 per game and are 11-2 this year when they force at least 20 turnovers in a contest. They also rank 35th nationally at 11.1 steals/contest. The RedHawks have forced an average of 23.4 turnovers in MAC play.

NOTHING BUT NET: The RedHawks are only attempting 14.5 free throws per contest, but are making the most of their opportunities. Miami ranks 22nd nationally at 77.5% from the foul line. Five different RedHawks shoot at least 75% from the charity stripe.

NEW FACES, NEW PLACES: Miami has eight new players this season, which includes five transfers, two freshmen and a red-shirt freshman. Joining the RedHawks via the portal include Amber Scalia (St. Thomas), Clara Gonzalez Planella (Jacksonville State), Macie Taylor (Wright State), Ashton Elley (UAB), and Brooke Blumenfeld (NIU). Coach Box also added two freshmen (Mio Sakano and Anna Hurst) and Emily VanTimmeren, who technically joined the RedHawks last December, has yet to see action with the Red and White.

NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG: Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 679 games and make 341 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 186 times.

SINGING HER PRAISES: Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 10.3 points and 7.6 assists, which ranks third nationally. She has surpassed 20 points twice this season (none last year) and has led the team in scoring five times in 2025-26 (once all of last year).

PASSING RECORDS: Tamar Singer is threatening nearly every passing record in program history. The school recorded for assists in a game is 13 (Courtney Osborn and D'Nelle Seiple) ... Singer has twice posted 12 assists (IU-Southeast and WKU). Versus the Lady Toppers she has six assists before the first media time out (which has to be a school record). The school record for assists in a season is 175 (Jenna Schone) ... With no postseason play, Singer is on pace for 236 assists this season. The career record for assists is 596 (Heather Cusick)...Singer is on pace for 351 assists through her first two years of play.

DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS: This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists. She has already posted 12 double-digit scoring contests after just three in 2024-25.

112 AND COUNTING: Amber Scalia will be competing in her 112th career game on Saturday. Prior to joining the RedHawks, Scalia played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. She has scored 1,378 points (12.4/game), connected on 183 three pointers and is a career 41% shooter from the field over her career. Her 1,378 points ranks 127th among active scorers in the country.

WELCOME BACK: Prior to the Toledo game (Jan. 3), Núria Jurjo had made just one of her last 18 shots. Over her past seven games, she has 64 points (9.1 ppg.) on 23-of-38 (60.5%) shooting overall and has made 12 of 20 shots (60%) from behind the arc. She has raised her scoring average from 6.6 ppg. to 7.3 ppg. in a seven-game span.

REDHAWKS PICKED SEVENTH IN PRESEASON POLL: Miami was picked to finish seventh in the preseason poll, voted on by the league's 13 head coaches.

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kempf became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kempf also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kempf, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.
