STORYLINES

1. TUESDAY: Miami stays home for a conference contest versus Western Michigan on Tuesday, Jan. 6 at 7 p.m. The Red and White enter this game with a 15-0 record, its best start to a season in program history. Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into this game, which includes being first in the country in effective field goal percentage (0.634), first in field goal percentage (53.6), second in three-point percentage (42.8), fifth in threes per game (11.7), ninth in scoring offense (93.7), 10th in scoring margin (21.7), 13th in free throw percentage (78.3), 32nd in defensive rebounds per game (28.27), 38th in bench points per game (33.00), 40th in assists per game (17.7) and 45th in assist/turnover ratio (1.57).

2. HOME COURT ADVANTAGE: With Miami's most recent win at home over Akron (76-73), the Red and White extended its home win streak to 23 games. The RedHawks are looking to surpass the record of 23 straight home wins that was originally set in 1996-1998 with a win over Western Michigan Tuesday night. Last season, Miami set a new record of 15 consecutive home wins over the course of one season.

ABOUT WESTERN MICHIGAN: Western Michigan is currently 6-8 (0-2 MAC), as the Broncos dropped to Toledo 84-79 last Tuesday night. Western Michigan went 12-20 (9-9 MAC) last year. Head coach Dwayne Stephens is in his fourth season with the Broncos. Heading into the 2025-26 season, Western Michigan was selected to finish 10th overall in the 2025-26 MAC Preseason Men's Basketball Poll.

Junior guard Jalen Griffith (15.5/game) and senior guard Jayden Brewer (13.0/game) lead the Broncos offense in points. Griffith also leads the team in assists (4.5/game) and steals (1.3/game), while Brewer averages the most rebounds (7.5/game) and blocks (1.1/game).

THE SERIES WITH THE BRONCOS: This Tuesday's home contest against the Broncos will be the 144th meeting between the two programs. Miami leads the series 90-53 all-time, as the Red and White are 55-13 when playing in Oxford against the Broncos. Miami is currently on a one-game losing streak against the Broncos, as the RedHawks dropped 78-70 in Kalamazoo on Feb. 15, 2025.

UP NEXT: Miami heads to Toledo on Friday, Jan. 9 at 6 p.m. on CBSSN.

RANKINGS: The Miami University men's basketball team received 22 votes in the most recent Associated Press Top 25 men's college basketball poll on Monday, Jan. 5. The Red and White retained its highest ranking of the 2025-26 season on the Mid-Major Top 25® Poll, as Collegeinsider announced that the RedHawks ranked No. 3 overall on Monday, Dec. 29. The RedHawks are just one of six teams that are still undefeated at the Division I level (Arizona, Iowa State, Miami, Michigan, Nebraska and Vanderbilt).

SILVER WAVES MEDIA MOST IMPACTFUL MID MAJOR ASSISTANT LIST: Silver Waves Media announced its 7th annual Mid Major Assistant Coaches and GM's lists on Monday afternoon, with Miami associate head coach Jonathan Holmes being named to the list. Holmes is currently in his fourth season with the RedHawks and his third year as an associate head coach.

RECENT ACTION: The RedHawks edged past Akron for a 76-73 win at Millett Hall on Saturday. Brant Byers poured in a game-high 26 points, and Eian Elmer followed closely behind with 19 points of his own. Luke Skaljac and Antwone Woolfolk also added 11 points each. Byers made 11-of-12 (91.67%) shots from the free-throw line (the most free throws made in a single game in his career). Peter Suder led all players with nine assists. The RedHawks made 25-of-30 (83.3%) shots from the foul line as a team. Miami recorded 15 points off turnovers.

INDIVIDUAL PLAY: Sophomore Luke Skaljac (third in MAC/36th nationally) leads the RedHawks in assist turnover ratio. Skaljac leads the team with a ratio of 3.21. Redshirt sophomore Brant Byers leads the team from beyond the arc, as he ranks 28th in the country in three point-percentage (44.2%).

NEXT MAN UP: This season, seven different RedHawks have scored at least 20 or more points in a game. The RedHawks that have met this mark are Almar Atlason, Brant Byers, Eian Elmer, Evan Ipsaro, Trey Perry, Peter Suder and Kyle Waltz.

SHARPSHOOTING: The RedHawks are currently shooting 53.6% from the field, 42.8% from the three-point line and 78.3% from the free-throw line.

NATIONAL & MAC RANKINGS

RILEY DECKER SHOWCASE GAME: The Miami University men's basketball team secured an 82-71 comeback win over UNC Greensboro at Adams-Jenkins Complex in the Riley Decker Showcase Game. Peter Suder totaled a game-high 20 points, while Almar Atlason (18) and Brant Byers (11) added double figures in scoring. Suder also set the tone for the RedHawks with a season high in rebounds (seven) and steals (four). Suder was named the Riley Decker Showcase Game MVP for his performance.

COLLEGIATE HOOPS ROAD SHOW: The Miami University men's basketball team edged past Mercyhurst 76-71 and rolled to a 111-84 victory over Arkansas - Pine Bluff in the Collegiate Hoops Road Show earlier this season. Almar Atlason, Brant Byers and Antwone Woolfolk were named to the 2025 Collegiate Hoops Roadshow All-Tournament Team, while Ipsaro was recognized as the MVP.

2025-26 ROSTER: The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

ALMAR ATLASON: The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

TREY PERRY: Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

TYLER ROBBINS: Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

KYLE WALTZ: Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). Peter Suder was picked Preseason All-MAC First Team, and Eian Elmer was selected Preseason All-MAC Second Team.

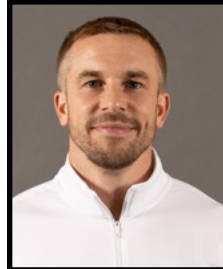

Head Coach Travis Steele



Travis Steele enters his fourth season as head men's basketball coach at Miami University.

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Saylor. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
