STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami women's basketball team hosts Ball State on Saturday, Feb. 21 at 1 p.m. It will be Miami's Love.Honor.Care game as the top two seeds in the MAC standings square off.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Amber Tretter has 27 double-doubles (third-best in program history) in her career and is a near walking double-double in points (14.7) and rebounds (8.0) this season. She is on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds and has scored 1,030 career points, which ranks 27th in program history. She has scored in double figures in 22 of 26 games this season.

BALANCED SCORING: Miami has four players averaging double-digits, led by Amber Tretter (14.7 ppg.). She is joined by Amber Scalia (14.1 ppg.), Ilse de Vries (13.0 ppg.) and Tamar Singer (10.3 ppg.). Tretter has led the team in scoring seven times, while de Vries and Scalia have done it six times apiece. Singer, who is fourth in the nation in assists (7.4), has led Miami in scoring five times.

NUMBER WATCH: Tamar Singer is seven assists shy of 200 for the season and would become the 22nd player in MAC history to accomplish that feat. Amber Scalia if sitting at 196 career three pointers, four away from 200.

BY THE MARGINS: Miami is currently fourth in the MAC in scoring (71.1) and first in defense (58.1), which results in a 13.0 point margin of victory, second-best in the conference. The RedHawks are second in the MAC in field goal percentage (45.2%), three-point percentage (34.5%), and free throw percentage (77.0%). Miami is first in turnover margin (5.2), second in blocks (3.7) and third in steals (10.7).

CMU RECAP: Four RedHawks scored in double figures as Miami picked up a 65-53 win over Central Michigan on Wednesday evening. Miami was led by 18 points from Amber Scalia, while Núria Jurjo finished with 16. Amber Tretter added 13 points and Ilse de Vries chipped in with 11. The RedHawks forced 21 turnovers and held the Chippewas scoreless from behind the arc.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: Back on Jan. 31, the RedHawks played in front of 5,034 fans, the largest crowd to ever see a women's basketball game in Millett Hall. The previous high was 2,876 versus BGSU back on Feb. 23, 2019.

MAC MOMENTUM: Miami opened conference play at 11-0, the best start in program history before UMass downed the RedHawks 65-64 on Feb. 14. The loss also snapped a 13-game win streak, one shy of the all-time school record, set by the 1982-83 squad.

CHASING HISTORY: The 21 wins this season rank sixth-best in program history. A win over Ball State on Saturday would give the RedHawks 22 wins, fifth-most for Miami women's basketball. The all-time record is 24 wins, set back during the 1981-82 campaign.

ABOUT BALL STATE: Since falling to the RedHawks back on Jan. 24, the Cardinals have responded with seven-straight wins and sit atop the MAC standings at 22-5 overall and 13-1 in conference play. Bree Salenbien leads the team in scoring (15.9 ppg.) and is second in rebounding (7.4 rpg.).

SERIES HISTORY: This will be the 77th meeting between the two programs with Miami holding a 42-34 all-time series advantage. Miami snapped an eight-game losing streak to the Cardinals earlier this year, but have not downed BSU at home since Jan. 19, 2019.

TOUGH STRETCH: The RedHawks, who are currently second in the MAC standings, are in the middle of a three-game stretch against the other top teams in the conference. Miami fell to No. 3 UMass last Saturday and beat No. 4 Central Michigan earlier this week. The contest with No. 1 Ball State wraps up the difficult three-game stretch.

PROGRAM BUILDER: While some may be shocked to see Miami's 20-5 record, since Coach Box's arrival, the RedHawks have seen improvement each year. In his first year the RedHawks went 9-20 (6-12 MAC) and followed that up with a 19-12 (11-7 MAC) record, the second-best single-season turnaround in program history. This season the RedHawks are three wins away from matching the program record for wins in a season.

50-PLUS LEAGUE: A win on Saturday would be Glenn Box's 50th of his career in just 87 games coached. The only Miami coaches to win 50 games faster were Linda Wunder, 1988-90 (50 wins in 73 games) and Lisa Bradley, 1993-95 (50 wins in 79 games).

MID-MAJOR MONSTER: Miami currently ranks 14th in the Collegelinsider.com Mid-Major poll, which was last updated on Tuesday, Feb. 17.

COMBINING FORCES: Miami basketball has reached heights not seen in a long time in Oxford, Ohio. Combined with the women's 21-5 record and the men's perfect 26-0 record, Miami basketball is 47-5 overall in 2025-26. The 47 combined wins are second-most in the nation, behind UConn (52).

LONG RANGE BOMBERS: Miami ranks 39th nationally, connecting on 8.2 three-pointers per contest. The RedHawks have made double-digit three-pointers in seven games this season, including a program record 17 in the win over Ohio back on Jan. 31. Eight different RedHawks are shooting at least 30% from distance and six RedHawks have already made 10+ three pointers this season (Ashton Elley and Clara Gonzalez Planella have nine).

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS: Coach Box has preached defense since the day he has arrived on campus and this year is no different.

- RedHawks ranks 40th in the country, allowing 58.1 points per contest.
- The RedHawks have held all 13 MAC opponents under their season scoring average.
- Miami is holding opponents to 38.3% shooting for the season.
- Miami is 32nd nationally in turnovers forced per game (20.6).
- Are 42nd in the country in steals per game (10.7).
- Miami is forcing 21.0 turnovers per game in MAC play.

HOME SWEET HOME: The RedHawks are a perfect 11-0 at home this season and have outscored their opponents 841-604 (21.5/game). Miami is shooting 39.4% from long range and are averaging 18.9 assists per game on its home court.

NOTHING BUT NET: The RedHawks are only attempting 15.4 free throws per contest, but are making the most of their opportunities. Miami ranks 26th nationally at 77.0% from the foul line. Six different RedHawks shoot at least 75% from the charity stripe.

NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG: Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 743 games and make 371 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 206 times.

SINGING HER PRAISES: Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 10.3 points and 7.4 assists, which ranks fourth nationally. She has surpassed 20 points twice this season (none last year) and has led the team in scoring five times in 2025-26 (once all of last year).

PASSING RECORDS: Tamar Singer has 193 assists this season, which is a single season record for the RedHawks. She has posted 12 assists in a game twice (school record is 13) and is currently on pace to finish her sophomore campaign with 351 career assists (school record is 596 assists).

DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS: This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists. She has already posted 17 double-digit scoring contests after just three in 2024-25 and was named MAC Player of the Week on Jan. 27. She also leads the MAC in blocks/game (1.9).

118 AND COUNTING: Amber Scalia will be competing in her 118th career game on Saturday. Prior to joining the RedHawks, Scalia played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. She has scored 1,472 points (12.5/game), connected on 196 three pointers and is a career 41% shooter from the field over her career. Her 1,472 points ranks 125th among active scorers in the country.

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kempf became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kempf also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kempf, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.

Box earned his associate's degree in elementary education at Rend Lake in 1996 and went on to obtain his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Southeast Missouri State in 1998. He began his coaching career in the Cairo school district before entering the college ranks.

Box is married to Leah and has four children, two sons, Darius and William, and daughters, Auna and Bella.
