STORYLINES

1. TUESDAY: The RedHawks get back on the road at Eastern Michigan Tuesday, Feb. 24 at 6:30 p.m. on ESPN+. The Red and White enter this Tuesday's game as the only remaining undefeated team in the country with a 27-0 (14-0 MAC) record, its best start to a season in program history. Miami holds a new program record for wins in a season, breaking the mark of 25 established last year. The RedHawks hold the program record for most consecutive road wins (11) in a season as well. The Red and White have also secured the best start for a program in MAC history (originally set by WMU in 1975-76 at 19-0) and the longest win streak in MAC history (originally set by Kent State in 2001-02 at 21-0).

2. NATIONAL RANKINGS: Miami improved to No. 21 overall in the AP Top 25 men's college basketball poll on Monday, Feb. 23. The Red and White moved into the national rankings for the first time since Feb. 15, 1999 on Monday, Jan 19. The RedHawks are the first team from the MAC selected in the poll since the 2018-19 Buffalo Bulls. Miami retained its highest ranking of the 2025-26 season on the Mid-Major Top 25® Poll, as Collegeinsider announced its newest poll last Monday, with the RedHawks ranked No. 2 overall.

3. MAC POTW: The MAC announced its weekly men's basketball awards this week, and Miami's Luke Skaljac was recognized as MAC Co-Player of the Week. The Brecksville, Ohio native propelled Miami to a pair of wins against UMass and Bowling Green to remain undefeated (27-0, 14-0 MAC). In 31.9 minutes per game, Skaljac averaged 20.0 points, 6.0 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.0 steal. He also shot 14-of-25 (56.0%) from the field, 6-of-13 (46.2%) from the three-point line and 6-of-7 (85.7%) from the free-throw line over the two games. Skaljac set a new career high with 24 points vs. BGSU.

ABOUT EASTERN MICHIGAN: Eastern Michigan is currently 10-18 (4-11 MAC), as the Eagles are coming off of a 75-94 loss at Toledo. Eastern Michigan went 16-16 (9-9 MAC) last year. Head coach Stan Heath is in his fifth season with the Eagles. Heading into the 2025-26 season, Eastern Michigan was selected to finish ninth overall in the 2025-26 MAC Coaches' Preseason Men's Basketball Poll. Redshirt freshman forward Mohammad Habhab (14.3) and redshirt senior forward Addison Patterson (13.7) lead the Eagles in points. Habhab also leads the team in rebounds (8.4/game), assists (3.2/game) and blocks (1.4/game). Patterson has recorded the most steals as well (1.2/game).

THE SERIES WITH THE EAGLES: This Tuesday's away contest versus Eastern Michigan will be the 88th meeting between the two programs. The RedHawks lead the series 57-30 all-time, as the Red and White are 22-18 when playing the Eagles in Ypsilanti. Miami is currently on a one-game winning streak versus EMU, as the RedHawks' last victory (81-75) came in the MAC Tournament on March 13, 2025.

RECENT ACTION: Luke Skaljac poured in a career-high 24 points, and Miami led for more than 36 minutes en route to a 91-77 victory over Bowling Green Friday in front of a crowd of 10,127 at Millett Hall. Eian Elmer added 21 points and a career-high five steals for the RedHawks, who move to 27-0 (14-0 MAC) and extend the best start to a season in conference history. Peter Suder and Antwone Woolfolk chipped in 10 points apiece to help Miami to its 30th consecutive home win.

NATIONAL LEADERS: Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into this game, which includes being first in the country in effective field goal percentage (0.624), first in field goal percentage (53.4), second in scoring offense (92.3), third in three-point percentage (40.3), eighth in scoring margin (17.8), 18th in threes per game (10.7), 28th in defensive rebounds per game (27.37), 35th in assist/turnover ratio (1.57), 40th in assists per game (16.8), 48th in turnover margin (2.7), 54th in free throw percentage (76.1) and 61st in bench points per game (27.33).

NCAA INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Luke Skaljac ranks fourth in the MAC and 76th nationally in assist/turnover ratio. Skaljac leads the team with a ratio of 2.50. Peter Suder ranks fourth in the MAC and 52nd in the country from the field at 56.5%.

MAC INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Since the start of MAC play, Antwone Woolfolk is first in the conference in field goal percentage (67.9%). Eian Elmer is third in three-point field goal percentage (45.3%), and Brant Byers sits at 11th (41.7%). Justin Kirby is tied for the fourth spot in free-throw percentage (83.9%). Luke Skaljac holds the sixth spot in assists (5.2/game) and Peter Suder is eighth (4.7/game). Suder and Woolfolk stand at seventh in steals (1.6/game), while Skaljac trails just behind at eighth (1.5/game).

CENTURY CLUB: Miami's win over Kent State on Tuesday, Jan. 20 marked the second consecutive game that the RedHawks had taken down an opponent that scored 100 or more points (previously hadn't been done since a 110-102 victory against Evansville on Dec. 9, 1987). This was also the third game in a row that Miami had scored 100 or more points against a conference opponent (previously hadn't been done since Jan. 5, 2002 in a 100-94 double overtime victory at Central Michigan). This was the seventh time that the RedHawks have scored 100 or more points this season as well (the most in program history).

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE: The RedHawks extended their home win streak to 30 games (most consecutive home wins in program history) with their most recent home win against BGSU (91-77). The Red and White are currently tied with Duke (30) for the longest home winning streak in the nation. Miami has now matched the record of 15 straight home wins over the course of one season (originally set for the first time in the 2024-25 season).

TELEVISION: Miami's 28th game of the season will be aired on ESPN+.

RADIO: In its seventh year of its partnership with Van Wagner, the Miami Sports Network continues its coverage of Miami men's basketball.

UP NEXT: Miami continues its road trip at Western Michigan on Friday, Feb. 27 at 6 p.m. on CBSSN.

MAC TOURNAMENT: Miami has clinched a spot in the 2026 MAC Tournament and will play in a quarterfinal game on Thursday, March 12 at Rocket Arena in Cleveland.

SHARPSHOOTING: Miami is currently shooting 53.4% from the field, 40.3% from the three-point line and 76.1% from the free-throw line.

CAREER WATCH: Peter Suder is looking to top 1,500 career points, as the senior enters Tuesday's game with 1,489 points between Bellarmine and Miami. Eian Elmer is approaching 1,000 career points, as the junior has totaled 916 so far.

NEXT MAN UP: This season, eight different RedHawks have scored at least 20 or more points in a game. This includes Almar Atlason, Brant Byers, Eian Elmer, Evan Ipsaro (out for the season), Trey Perry, Peter Suder, Kyle Waltz and Antwone Woolfolk.

Not only did the 6-9 Cleveland native have several basketball opportunities to choose from, but he was also a highly-sought-after tight end prospect. FBS programs such as Boston College, Cincinnati, Marshall and Akron hoped the Brush High School standout would go the gridiron route when it came to his college athletics destination. SILVER WAVES MEDIA MOST IMPACTFUL MID MAJOR ASSISTANT LIST: Silver Waves Media announced its 7th annual Mid Major Assistant Coaches and GM's lists on Monday, Jan. 5, with Miami associate head coach Jonathan Holmes being named to the list.

2025-26 ROSTER: The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

ALMAR ATLASON: The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

JUSTIN KIRBY: Justin Kirby is a freshman guard from Fishers High School who averaged 13.1 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior. He was named an Indiana All-Star in 2024-25 and was a 4A state champion in the 2023-24 season.

TREY PERRY: Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

TYLER ROBBINS: Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

KYLE WALTZ: Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). Head Coach Travis Steele



Travis Steele enters his fourth season as head men's basketball coach at Miami University.

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Saylor. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
