### STORYLINES

**ON TAP:** The Miami women's basketball team makes a road trip to face the Eastern Michigan Eagles on Wednesday, Feb. 25. Opening tip is at 6:30 p.m.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Amber Tretter has 27 double-doubles (third-best in program history) in her career and is a near walking double-double in points (14.2) and rebounds (8.0) this season. She is on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds and has scored 1,030 career points, which ranks 27th in program history. She has scored in double figures in 22 of 27 games this season.

**BALANCED SCORING:** Miami has four players averaging double-digits, led by Amber Tretter (14.2 ppg.). She is joined by Amber Scalia (14.1 ppg.), Ilse de Vries (13.0 ppg.) and Tamar Singer (10.8 ppg.). Tretter has led the team in scoring seven times, while the other three have done it six times each this season.

**NUMBER WATCH:** Tamar Singer is four assists shy of 200 for the season and would become the 22nd player in MAC history to accomplish that feat. Amber Scalia is sitting at 1,485 career points and 197 career three pointers.

**BY THE MARGINS:** Miami is currently fourth in the MAC in scoring (71.0) and first in defense (58.3), which results in a 12.7 point margin of victory, second-best in the conference. The RedHawks are second in the MAC in field goal percentage (45.1%), first in three-point percentage (34.8%) and second in free throw percentage (76.5%). Miami is first in turnover margin (5.1), second in blocks (3.6) and third in steals (10.9).

**BALL STATE RECAP:** Behind a 19-3 second half run, Miami upended Ball State, 68-64, to claim the top spot in the Mid-American Conference standings. Tamar Singer had a career-high 25 points and eight steals to lead the RedHawks to their 12th straight home win. Ilse de Vries added 14 points and nine rebounds, while Amber Scalia chipped in with 13 points. Miami finished the contest with 12 baskets from behind the arc and forced Ball State into 22 turnovers. Combined with the road win earlier this season, the RedHawks swept the home-and-home season series for the first time since 1998-99.

**MAC MOMENTUM:** Miami opened conference play at 11-0, the best start in program history before UMass downed the RedHawks 65-64 on Feb. 14. The loss also snapped a 13-game win streak, one shy of the all-time school record, set by the 1982-83 squad.

**CHASING HISTORY:** The 22 wins this season rank fifth-best in program history, two shy of the program record (24), set by the 1981-82 team. Miami's 13 conference wins rank fourth-best in program history.

**ABOUT EASTERN MICHIGAN:** The Eagles are 12-13 overall and 5-9 in conference play, currently ninth in the MAC standings. Sisi Eleko is tops on the team in scoring (18.1 ppg.) and rebounding (10.1 rpg.).

**ROUND TWO WITH EMU:** Miami downed the Eagles 69-55 back on Feb. 14. Amber Tretter and Núria Jurjo led the way with 16 points apiece, while Amber Scalia added 15 points and Tamar Singer posted 10 assists.

**SERIES HISTORY:** This will be the 72nd meeting between the two programs, with the RedHawks holding a 46-25 series advantage. Miami has won four-straight against the Eagles and are 22-13 all-time away from Millett Hall in the series.

**PROGRAM BUILDER:** While some may be shocked to see Miami's 22-5 record, since Coach Box's arrival, the RedHawks have seen improvement each year. In his first year the RedHawks went 9-20 (6-12 MAC) and followed that up with a 19-12 (11-7 MAC) record, the second-best single-season turnaround in program history. This season the RedHawks are two wins away from matching the program record for wins in a season and are on the verge of capturing their first MAC regular season title since 2007-08.

**50 IS JUST A NUMBER:** Glenn Box captured the 50th win of his career last Saturday versus Ball State in just 87 games coached. The only Miami coaches to win 50 games faster were Linda Wunder, 1988-90 (50 wins in 73 games) and Lisa Bradley, 1993-95 (50 wins in 79 games).

**MID-MAJOR MONSTER:** Miami currently ranks 14th in the Collegelinsider.com Mid-Major poll, which was last updated on Tuesday, Feb. 17.

**COMBINING FORCES:** Miami basketball has reached heights not seen in a long time in Oxford, Ohio. Combined with the women's 22-5 record and the men's perfect 27-0 record, Miami basketball is 49-5 overall in 2025-26. The 49 combined wins are second-most in the nation, behind UConn (54).

**LONG RANGE BOMBERS:** Miami ranks 33rd nationally, connecting on 8.3 three-pointers per contest. The RedHawks have made double-digit three-pointers in eight games this season, including a program record 17 in the win over Ohio back on Jan. 31. Eight different RedHawks are shooting at least 30% from distance and seven RedHawks have already made 10+ three pointers this season (Ashton Elley has nine).

**DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:** Coach Box has preached defense since the day he has arrived on campus and this year is no different.

- RedHawks ranks 45th in the country, allowing 58.3 points per contest.
- The RedHawks have held all 14 MAC opponents under their season scoring average.
- Miami is holding opponents to 38.4% shooting for the season.
- Miami is 24th nationally in turnovers forced per game (20.6).
- Are 36th in the country in steals per game (10.9).
- Miami is forcing 21.2 turnovers per game in MAC play.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The RedHawks are a perfect 12-0 at home this season and have out-scored their opponents 909-668 (20.1/game). Miami is shooting 39.8% from long range and are averaging 18.7 assists per game on its home court.

**NOTHING BUT NET:** The RedHawks are only attempting 15.1 free throws per contest, but are making the most of their opportunities. Miami ranks 27th nationally at 76.5% from the foul line. Six different RedHawks shoot at least 75% from the charity stripe.

**NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG:** Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 754 games and make 376 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 209 times.

**SINGING HER PRAISES:** Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 10.8 points and 7.3 assists, which ranks fourth nationally. She has surpassed 20 points three this season (none last year) and has led the team in scoring six times in 2025-26 (once all of last year).

**PASSING RECORDS:** Tamar Singer has 196 assists this season, which is a single season record for the RedHawks. She has posted 12 assists in a game twice (school record is 13) and is currently on pace to finish her sophomore campaign with 349 career assists (school record is 596 assists).

**DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS:** This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists. She has already posted 18 double-digit scoring contests after just three in 2024-25 and was named MAC Player of the Week on Jan. 27. She also leads the MAC in blocks/game (1.9).

**119 AND COUNTING:** Amber Scalia will be competing in her 119th career game on Wednesday. Prior to joining the RedHawks, Scalia played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. She has scored 1,485 points (12.5/game), connected on 197 three pointers and is a career 41% shooter from the field over her career. Her 1,485 points ranks 130th among active scorers in the country.

## Glenn Box Head Coach

**Years at Miami:** Third Season

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kempf became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kempf also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kempf, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.

Box earned his associate's degree in elementary education at Rend Lake in 1996 and went on to obtain his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Southeast Missouri State in 1998. He began his coaching career in the Cairo school district before entering the college ranks.

Box is married to Leah and has four children, two sons, Darius and William, and daughters, Auna and Bella.
