STORYLINES

ON TAP: The Miami women's basketball team hosts Georgia Southern on Saturday, Feb. 7 at 1 p.m. The contest is part of the MAC vs. Sun Belt Challenge.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Amber Tretter has 26 double-doubles (third-best in program history) in her career and is a near walking double-double in points (14.0) and rebounds (7.9) this season. She is also on pace to become just the second RedHawk in program history to record 1,000 career rebounds and has scored 956 career points, which ranks 29th in program history. She has scored in double figures in 17 straight games.

BALANCED SCORING: Miami has four players averaging double-digits, led by Amber Tretter (14.0 ppg.). She is joined by Amber Scalia (13.8 ppg.), Ilse de Vries (12.5 ppg.) and Tamar Singer (10.5 ppg.). Each of the four have led Miami in scoring five different times this season.

RED-HOT REDHAWKS: Since Nov. 29, the RedHawks have lost just one contest and have won 14 of their last 15 games, including 11-straight.

BY THE MARGINS: Miami is currently third in the MAC in scoring (71.9) and first in defense (57.8), which results in a 14.1 point margin of victory, tops in the conference. The RedHawks are second in the MAC in field goal percentage (45.8%), first in three-point percentage (35.1%) and turnover margin (5.4). Miami is also second in three-pointers made (189), blocked shots (3.7), steals (11.0) and free throw percentage (77.1%).

OHIO RECAP: Miami set a program record with 17 made three-pointers en route to a 90-70 blowout victory over rival Ohio in the Battle of the Bricks, extending their winning streak to 11 games in the process. All five Miami starters scored in double figures, led by Amber Scalia's 23 points.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: Last Saturday, the RedHawks played in front of 5,034 fans, the largest crowd to ever see a women's basketball game in Millett Hall. The previous high was 2,876 versus BGSU back on Feb. 23, 2019.

MAC MOMENTUM: Miami's 10-0 record in MAC play is the best conference start in program history, surpassing the 9-0 start from the 1989-90 squad. Miami, the lone undefeated team in MAC play, last won a MAC regular season championship during the 2007-08 campaign.

CHASING HISTORY: The 18-4 overall start is the third-best start in program history, behind 2018-19 (started 21-4) and 1989-90 (started 23-4).

HISTORIC RUN: Miami's 11-game win streak is fifth-best in program history, trailing: 1982-83 (14), 1981-82 (13), 1989-90 (12) and 2003-04 (12).

ABOUT GEORGIA SOUTHERN: GSU is 17-5 overall, 10-2 in Sun Belt action and is tied for second in the conference standings. The Eagles feature a balanced offensive attack, with four double-digit scorers, led by Destiny Garrett (15.5 ppg.), McKenna Eddings (13.4 ppg.), Kishyah Anderson (13.4 ppg.) and Shanti Simmons (11.3 ppg.).

SERIES HISTORY: This will be the first meeting between the two programs. The RedHawks enter Saturday on a four-game win streak in the MAC/Sun Belt Challenge with wins over Coastal Carolina (2025-26), App State (2024-25), Louisiana (2024-25) and Georgia State (2023-24).

MID-MAJOR MONSTER: Miami currently ranks 12th in the CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major poll, which was last updated on Tuesday, Feb. 3.

COMBINING FORCES: Miami basketball has reached heights not seen in a long time in Oxford, Ohio. Combined with the women's 18-4 record and the men's perfect 23-0 record, Miami basketball is 41-4 overall in 2025-26. The 41 combined wins are second-most in the nation, behind UConn (45). Miami is also one of four school in the country to have both programs undefeated in conference play (Duke, UConn, and North Dakota State).

LONG RANGE BOMBERS: Miami ranks 28th nationally, connecting on 8.6 three-pointers per contest. The RedHawks have made double-digit three-pointers in seven games this season, including a program record 17 in the win over Ohio last Saturday. Eight different RedHawks are shooting at least 30% from distance and six RedHawks have already made 10+ three pointers this season (Ashton Elley and Clara Gonzalez Planella have nine).

20+ LEAGUE: Four different RedHawks have already scored 20-plus points this season and the RedHawks are 7-1 on the year when someone puts up a 20-point effort. Amber Tretter, Tamar Singer Ilse de Vries and Amber Scalia have each posted 20 points two different times this season.

HOME SWEET HOME: The RedHawks are a perfect 9-0 at home this season and have out-scored their opponents 698-484 (23.8/game). Miami is shooting 38.1% from long range and are averaging 19.4 assists per game on its home court.

TURNING THE TIDE: Miami ranks 24th in the country in turnovers forced at 21.3 per game and are 11-2 this year when they force at least 20 turnovers in a contest. They also rank 37th nationally at 11.0 steals/contest. The RedHawks have forced an average of 22.4 turnovers in MAC play.

NOTHING BUT NET: The RedHawks are only attempting 14.9 free throws per contest, but are making the most of their opportunities. Miami ranks 25th nationally at 77.1% from the foul line. Six different RedHawks shoot at least 75% from the charity stripe.

NEW, BUT NOT YOUNG: Despite eight new players on the roster, the RedHawks feature an experienced squad. Overall, the 12 players have combined to play in 701 games and make 351 starts. They have also combined to score in double figures 193 times.

SINGING HER PRAISES: Tamar Singer, one of the best freshman in the MAC a year ago, has taken her game to another level in 2025-26. Last season she averaged 6.3 points and 4.2 assists per game while running the point. This year she is averaging 10.5 points and 7.7 assists, which ranks third nationally. She has surpassed 20 points twice this season (none last year) and has led the team in scoring five times in 2025-26 (once all of last year).

PASSING RECORDS: Tamar Singer is threatening nearly every passing record in program history. The school record for assists in a game is 13 (Courtney Osborn and D'Nelle Seiple) ... Singer has twice posted 12 assists (IU-Southeast and WKU). Versus the Lady Toppers she has six assists before the first media time out (which has to be a school record). The school record for assists in a season is 175 (Jenna Schone) ... Singer enters Saturday's action at 169 assists this year. The career record for assists is 596 (Heather Cusick)...Singer is on pace for 352 assists through her first two years of play.

DE VRIES PLAYS OVERSEAS: This summer, sophomore Ilse de Vries represented the Netherlands as a member of the U20 National Team at the annual FIBA U20 EuroBasket League. In seven games, she averaged 11.1 points and 5.4 rebounds per contest. This season de Vries is averaging career bests in points, rebounds and assists. She has already posted 13 double-digit scoring contests after just three in 2024-25 and was named MAC Player of the Week on Jan. 27. She also leads the MAC in blocks/game (1.9).

114 AND COUNTING: Amber Scalia will be competing in her 114th career game on Saturday. Prior to joining the RedHawks, Scalia played in 91 games over three years at St. Thomas, where she scored 1,091 points and shot 34% from long distance. She has scored 1,408 points (12.4/game), connected on 189 three pointers and is a career 41% shooter from the field over her career. Her 1,408 points ranks 129th among active scorers in the country.

WELCOME BACK: Prior to the Toledo game (Jan. 3), Núria Jurjo had made just one of her last 18 shots. Over her past nine games, she has 86 points (9.6 ppg.) on 32-of-51 (62.8%) shooting overall and has made 16 of 27 shots (59.3%) from behind the arc. She currently leads the MAC in three-point shooting (46.3%).

Glenn Box was named the 10th head coach in Miami women's basketball history on May 8, 2023.

Stepping into an extremely difficult situation in year one, Box added eight newcomers to the roster in his first month at the helm. This new-look RedHawk squad went 9-20 overall and 6-12 in conference play, all while finishing the year third in MAC scoring defense (60.4) and first in field goal percentage defense (.381).

With a full off-season to work with in year two, Coach Box took that opportunity and ran with it. His 2024-25 RedHawks went 19-12 overall and 11-7 in MAC play, earning the No. 5 seed in the conference tournament and advancing to the WNIT for the first time since 2018-19. Miami added 10 wins to the previous season's output, matching a program record for the biggest single-season turnaround in Miami women's basketball history. Box helped produce two All-MAC performers, including Enjulina Gonzalez, who earned first-team All-MAC honors, Miami's first since 2019.

The wins weren't the only thing that improved in year two under Box. Miami's offense jumped from a 53.9 average in year one to 66.5 points/game in 2024-25. While the offense made incredible strides, Miami's calling card was on the defensive end. The RedHawks surrendered a MAC best 59.1 points/game (66th nationally), while also leading the conference in steals and ranking second in turnovers forced per game.

Box came to Miami after seven years on staff with the Indiana women's basketball program, the last four as associate head coach. During Box's time with the Hoosiers, they won 20 or more games in all seven of his seasons and earned seven postseason berths, including five NCAA Tournament appearances. In those NCAA appearances, the Hoosiers advanced to the second round all five times, made two Sweet Sixteens (2021, 2022) and advanced to the Elite Eight in 2020-21. The Hoosiers went 28-4, earning a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament in 2022-23. IU added a Big Ten regular season championship (first in 40 years) and climbed as high as No. 2 in both national polls that same season.

Under Box's tutelage, 11 Hoosier guards earned a total of 16 All-Big Ten honors including four-straight first team selections for Grace Berger (2019-23). Berger became the program's first WNBA first round selection in 2023, as she went seventh overall to the Indiana Fever and was a six-time All-American honorable mention in her five-year collegiate career.

Box helped guide the Hoosiers' defense, a calling card of the program. In 2022-23, they led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense (38.7%) and scoring defense (62.1 ppg.). Mackenzie Holmes became the program's first Defensive Player of the Year, and for the first time ever, IU had two players on the All-Big Ten defensive team in Holmes and Chloe Moore-McNeil.

Box arrived in Bloomington after spending two seasons at Saint Louis University. Overall, he spent a total of four seasons in two stints with the Billikens, having also served as an assistant coach at SLU in 2010-11 and 2011-12.

Under Box's watch, SLU sophomore Jackie Kempf became the program's first player to earn All-America honors as she received honorable mention distinction from the Associated Press and the school's first conference Player of the Year. Kempf also was named to the A-10 All-Academic Team and earned Academic All-District laurels. Along with Kempf, Box played a role in two additional Saint Louis student-athletes who earned all-conference honors in 2015-16.

Prior to his second stint at Saint Louis, Box coached two years at Akron in 2012-13 and 2013-14. During his tenure, the Zips played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament after winning the Mid-American Conference Tournament championship in 2014. In 2012-13, Akron won the East Division of the MAC, going 14-4 in conference play.

At Akron, Box played a role in five players earning All-MAC honors in two seasons, including the school's first-ever Mid-American Conference Player of the Year in 2013 in Rachel Tecca.

Before his first stop in Saint Louis in 2010, Box spent two years on the sideline as an assistant at Western Michigan. Prior to that, he spent six seasons at Rend Lake College, a junior college in Ina, Ill. He spent his first three years at Rend Lake as an assistant with the men's program before moving on to become head coach of the women's team.

A native of Cairo, Ill., Box posted a 64-31 record and downed four nationally ranked opponents during his three years as head coach. In 2007-08, Rend Lake went 21-11 and reached as high as No. 16 in the NJCAA national poll. He guided the Lady Warriors to a 24-8 ledger in 2006-07, the second-most victories in school history, while finishing in the top 25 in the country in scoring, field goal percentage, three-point field goal percentage and free throw percentage.

Box earned his associate's degree in elementary education at Rend Lake in 1996 and went on to obtain his bachelor's degree in criminal justice from Southeast Missouri State in 1998. He began his coaching career in the Cairo school district before entering the college ranks.
