STORYLINES

1. THURSDAY: Miami opens its stint in the 2026 Mid-American Conference Tournament with a quarterfinal contest with No. 8 seed UMass on Thursday, March 12 at 11 a.m. on ESPN+. The Red and White enter this Thursday's game as the only remaining undefeated team in the country with a 31-0 (18-0 MAC) record, its best start to a season in program history. Miami holds a new program record for wins in a season, breaking the mark of 25 established last year. The RedHawks hold the program record for most consecutive road wins overall (15) and in a season (14) as well. The Red and White have also secured the best start for a program in MAC history (originally set by WMU in 1975-76 at 19-0), the most consecutive conference wins in MAC history (originally set by Miami in 1956-57 at 16-0) and the longest win streak in MAC history (originally set by Kent State in 2001-02 at 21-0).

2. MAC POSTSEASON AWARDS: Head Coach Travis Steele was a unanimous selection as MAC Coach of the Year, while Peter Suder was named MAC Player of the Year and earned First-Team honors. Brant Byers received a spot on the All-MAC Second Team, Eian Elmer was selected to the All-MAC Second Team, Luke Skaljac was placed on the All-MAC Third Team and Antwone Woolfolk was recognized as All-MAC Honorable Mention. Steele is the first coach for the Red and White to take MAC Coach of the Year since Charlie Coles received the award in 2005. Suder becomes the seventh player in Miami program history and the first since Michael Bramos in 2009 to be named MAC Player of the Year.

ABOUT UMASS: UMass is currently 16-15 (7-11 MAC), as the Minutemen closed out the regular season with a 94-82 win at home over Ohio on Tuesday night. UMass went 12-20 (7-11 A10) last year. Head coach Frank Martin is in his fourth season with the Minutemen. Heading into the 2025-26 season, UMass was selected to finish fifth overall in the 2025-26 MAC Preseason Men's Basketball Poll. Senior forward Daniel Hankins-Sanford was named to the Preseason All-MAC Second Team. Graduate student forward Leonardo Bettiol leads the Minutemen in points (17.8/game) and graduate student guard Marcus Banks Jr. follows closely behind (16.9/game). Bettiol has brought down the most rebounds (7.9/game), freshman guard Danny Carbuccia has recorded the most assists (6.3/game), Banks Jr. has totaled the most steals (1.3/game) and Hankins-Sanford has produced the most blocks (0.6/game).

THE SERIES WITH THE MINUTEMEN: This Thursday's neutral site contest against the Minutemen will be the fifth meeting between the two programs. The series is even at 2-2 all-time. Miami defeated UMass in both contests earlier this season, as the RedHawks won in Oxford 86-84 on Jan. 27 and went on to earn an 86-77 victory on Feb. 17 in Amherst. This will be the first time that Miami and UMass have met in the MAC Tournament.

RECENT ACTION: Eian Elmer scored 32 points (best of his career) and Trey Perry added 21 as the Miami University men's basketball team downed Ohio 110-108 in overtime to finish the regular season a perfect 31-0. Brant Byers (15), Peter Suder (13) and Justin Kirby (10) also scored in double figures for the RedHawks, who scored the final three points of the contest to capture a road win at Ohio for the first time since 2011. Elmer also added 12 rebounds to record the first double-double of his career. Miami captured its 1500th win in program history. With this victory, the RedHawks improved to 8-0 in one-possession contests this year.

NATIONAL RANKINGS: Miami took No. 20 overall in the AP Top 25 men's college basketball poll on Monday, March 9. The Red and White moved into the national rankings for the first time since Feb. 15, 1999 on Monday, Jan 19 and have climbed as high as No. 19 (last week), their highest ranking since March 13, 1978. The RedHawks are the first team from the MAC selected in the poll since the 2018-19 Buffalo Bulls. Miami received its highest ranking of the 2025-26 season on the Mid-Major Top 25® Poll for the second consecutive week, as Collegeinsider announced its newest poll on Monday, with the RedHawks ranked No. 1 overall.

NATIONAL LEADERS: Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into this game, which includes being first in field goal percentage (52.6), second in the country in effective field goal percentage (0.613), second in scoring offense (90.9), seventh in scoring margin (16.0), ninth in three-point percentage (39.3), 16th in defensive rebounds per game (27.58), 25th in threes per game (10.4), 45th in assist/turnover ratio (1.52), 55th in turnover margin (2.4), 63rd in assists per game (16.0), 69th in bench points per game (26.29) and 84th in free throw percentage (74.9).

HISTORY IN THE MAKING: With Friday's victory over Ohio, Miami became just the fifth program this century (NCAA Division I) to go undefeated during regular season play. The other teams to reach this accomplishment include Saint Joseph's (2003-04), Wichita State (2013-14), Kentucky (2014-15) and Gonzaga (2020-21). The Red and White are also the first team since Indiana State (1978-79) to enter its conference tournament unbeaten after being unranked in the preseason AP poll. Since the NCAA Tournament expanded to 64 teams in 1985, there have only been four teams to enter the NCAA Tournament undefeated. This list consists of UNLV (1990-91), Wichita State (2013-14), Kentucky (2014-15) and Gonzaga (2020-21).

Please do not use Miami of Ohio, University of Miami of Ohio, etc. The latter are not the proper names for our institution. Also, in 1997, the University began using its new nickname, the RedHawks. It is one word with a capital H. Thank you.

TELEVISION: Miami's 32nd game of the season will be aired on ESPN+.

RADIO: In its seventh year of its partnership with Van Wagner, the Miami Sports Network continues its coverage of Miami men's basketball.

UP NEXT: With a win versus UMass, Miami will play in a semifinal game on Friday, March 13 at 5 p.m. in Rocket Arena against No. 4 Toledo or No. 5 Bowling Green.

NATIONAL & MAC RANKINGS

NCAA INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Luke Skaljac ranks third in the MAC and 56th nationally in assist/turnover ratio. Skaljac leads the team with a ratio of 2.60. Peter Suder ranks fifth in the MAC and 54th in the country from the field at 55.6%.

MAC INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS: Since the start of MAC play, Antwone Woolfolk is second in the conference in field goal percentage (64.7%), and Eian Elmer is sixth in three-point field goal percentage (43.8%). Luke Skaljac holds the seventh spot in assists (4.8/game) and Peter Suder is tenth (4.3/game). Suder stands at fourth in steals (1.6/game), Skaljac is ninth in steals (1.4/game) and Elmer is 11th in blocks (0.9/game).

CAREER WATCH: Peter Suder eclipsed 1,500 career points against Eastern Michigan, as the senior guard recorded a 13-point double-double. Eian Elmer is approaching 1,000 career points, as the junior has totaled 974 so far.

NEXT MAN UP: This season, eight different RedHawks have scored at least 20 or more points in a game. This includes Almar Atlason, Brant Byers, Eian Elmer, Evan Ipsaro (out for the season), Trey Perry, Peter Suder, Kyle Waltz and Antwone Woolfolk.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE: The RedHawks extended their home win streak to 31 games (most consecutive home wins in program history) with their most recent home win against Toledo (76-74). The Red and White are currently tied with Akron (31) and Duke (31) for the longest home winning streak in the nation. Miami set a new record with 16 straight home wins over the course of one season (originally set at 15 for the first time in 2024-25).

AWARD WATCH: Numerous members of the Red and White have been recognized for their efforts on the court this season. Some of these include:

- Collegeinsider.com announced that Peter Suder has been named a finalist for the 2025-26 Nolan Richardson Award. The award is presented annually to a Division I player who is the heart and soul of his team and a leader on and off the court.
- Collegeinsider.com announced that Coach Steele has been named a finalist for the Jim Phelan award and the Hugh Durham award. The Jim Phelan award is presented annually to the top head coach in Division I college basketball, while the Hugh Durham award is presented annually to the top mid-major head coach in college basketball.
- The Field of 68 announced that Miami University men's basketball head coach Travis Steele has been named Coach of the Year.
- Silver Waves Media announced its 7th annual Mid Major Assistant Coaches and GM's lists, with Miami associate head coach Jonathan Holmes being named to the list.

SEASON NUMBERS

SHARPSHOOTING: Miami is currently shooting 52.6% from the field, 39.3% from the three-point line and 74.9% from the free-throw line.

2025-26 ROSTER: The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

ALMAR ATLASON: The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

JUSTIN KIRBY: Justin Kirby is a freshman guard from Fishers High School who averaged 13.1 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior. He was named an Indiana All-Star in 2024-25 and was a 4A state champion in the 2023-24 season.

TREY PERRY: Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

TYLER ROBBINS: Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

KYLE WALTZ: Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

MAC PRESEASON POLL: On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). 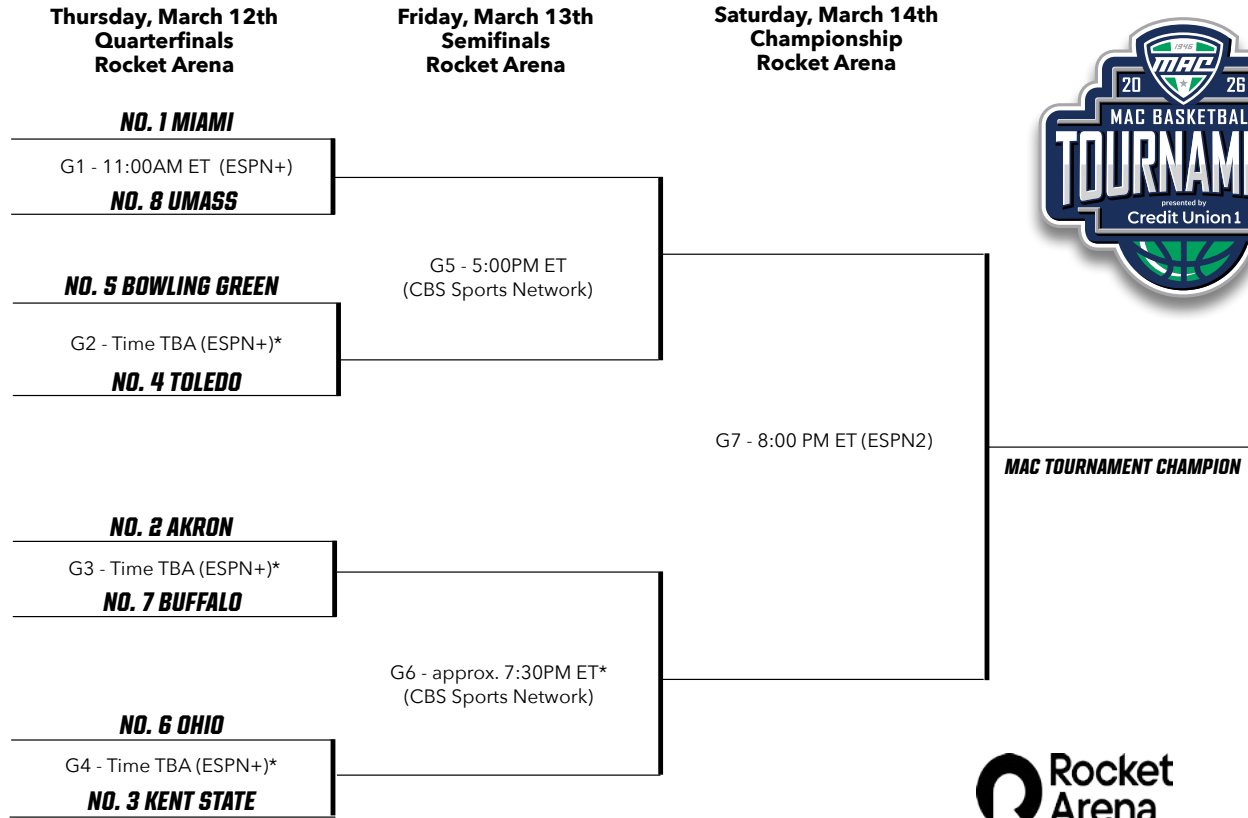

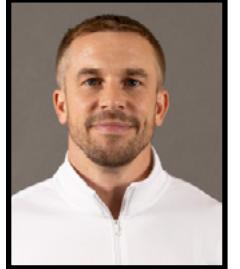

Head Coach Travis Steele



Travis Steele enters his fourth season as head men's basketball coach at Miami University.

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Saylor. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
