### STORYLINES

**1. WEDNESDAY:** Miami opens NCAA Tournament play on Wednesday, March 18 at 9:15 p.m. against SMU in the First Four in Dayton, Ohio. The RedHawks (31-1) and Mustangs (20-13) are No. 11 seeds in the Midwest Region, with the winner scheduled to take on sixth-seeded Tennessee Friday in Philadelphia, Pa. Miami became the first Mid-American Conference team to earn an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament since the Wally Szczerbiak-led RedHawks made the Sweet 16 in 1999. This is Miami's first appearance in March Madness since 2007. Miami set records this year for the best start to a season in program history, the best start for a program in MAC history, the longest win streak in MAC history, the most consecutive conference wins in MAC history and the most wins in program history as the Red and White became just the fifth NCAA D-I men's program this century to go undefeated in regular-season play.

**2. MAC POSTSEASON AWARDS:** Head Coach Travis Steele was a unanimous selection as MAC Coach of the Year, while Peter Suder was named MAC Player of the Year and earned First-Team honors. Brant Byers received a spot on the All-MAC Second Team, Eian Elmer was selected to the All-MAC Second Team, Luke Skaljac was placed on the All-MAC Third Team and Antwone Woolfolk was recognized as All-MAC Honorable Mention. Steele is the first coach for the Red and White to take MAC Coach of the Year since Charlie Coles received the award in 2005. Suder becomes the seventh player in Miami program history and the first since Michael Bramos in 2009 to be named MAC Player of the Year.

**ABOUT SMU:** SMU enters the NCAA Tournament with a 20-13 record (8-10 ACC), as the Mustangs fell 62-58 to Louisville in the second round of the ACC Tournament last Wednesday. SMU went 24-11 (13-7 ACC) last year, head coach Andy Enfield's first season, and participated in the NIT. Enfield has enjoyed success in the NCAA Tournament at his previous head coaching stops, including a Cinderella run to the Sweet 16 with Florida Gulf Coast in 2013 and taking the USC Trojans to the NAAs five times (highlighted by a 2021 Elite Eight run). Heading into the 2025-26 season, SMU was selected to finish sixth of 18 teams in the ACC preseason poll. Five Mustangs average in double figures, paced by senior guards Boopie Miller (19.2 ppg) and Jaron Pierre Jr. (17.6). 7-foot-2 sophomore Samet Yiğitoğlu leads SMU in rebounds (7.9) and blocks (1.3). Miller tops the team in assists (6.4), while senior guard B.J. Edwards leads the Mustangs in steals (2.3).

**THE SERIES WITH THE MUSTANGS:** This Wednesday's game against the Mustangs will be the third all-time meeting between the two programs, with all three coming at neutral sites. SMU is 2-0 in the series, defeating Miami 83-69 in Pullman, Wash. on March 16, 1984 and beating the RedHawks 66-55 in West Lafayette, Ind. on Dec. 20, 2003.

**RECENT ACTION:** Miami dropped its first game of the season last Thursday, falling in the quarter-finals of the MAC Tournament in Cleveland, Ohio. Leonardo Bettiol scored a game-high 25 points as eighth-seeded Massachusetts rallied in the second half to upset top-seeded Miami 87-83. Brant Byers led five players in double figures for the No. 20 RedHawks with 17 points as Miami moved to 31-1 on the year. UMass outrebounded Miami 41-24 (including 17 offensive rebounds), out-scoring the RedHawks 23-8 in second-chance points and 54-30 in points in the paint.

**NATIONAL RANKINGS:** Miami moved into the national rankings for the first time since Feb. 15, 1999 on Monday, Jan 19 and climbed as high as No. 19, their highest ranking since March 13, 1978. The RedHawks became the first team from the MAC selected in the poll since the 2018-19 Buffalo Bulls. Miami is currently receiving votes in both polls heading into the Big Dance. The RedHawks have also been a fixture at the top of Collegelsider.com's Mid-Major Top 25® Poll this season and were ranked No. 2 in that poll this week.

**NATIONAL LEADERS:** Miami ranks among the top of the nation in numerous statistical categories heading into this game, which includes being first in field goal percentage (52.4), first in the country in effective field goal percentage (0.612), second in scoring offense (90.7), seventh in scoring margin (15.4), ninth in three-point percentage (39.2), 26th in defensive rebounds per game (27.19), 25th in threes per game (10.4), 42nd in assist/turnover ratio (1.54), 54th in turnover margin (2.4), 55th in assists per game (16.1), 70th in bench points per game (25.97) and 84th in free throw percentage (74.9).

**HISTORY IN THE MAKING:** Miami is just the fifth program this century (NCAA Division I) to go undefeated during regular-season play. The other teams to reach this accomplishment include Saint Joseph's (2003-04), Wichita State (2013-14), Kentucky (2014-15) and Gonzaga (2020-21). The Red and White also became the first team since Indiana State (1978-79) to enter its conference tournament unbeaten after being unranked in the preseason AP poll.

**CAREER WATCH:** Eian Elmer has 990 career points and could surpass the 1,000-point mark this week. Earlier this season, Peter Suder eclipsed 1,500 career points with a 13-point double-double against Eastern Michigan.

**TELEVISION:** Miami's NCAA Tournament game against SMU will be broadcast on truTV.

**RADIO:** In its seventh year of its partnership with Van Wagner, the Miami Sports Network continues its coverage of Miami men's basketball.

**UP NEXT:** With a win over SMU, Miami would advance to face No. 6 seed Tennessee in a Midwest Region first-round game Friday at 4:25 p.m. in Philadelphia, Pa.

**SHARPSHOOTING:** Miami is currently shooting 52.4% from the field, 39.2% from the three-point line and 74.9% from the free-throw line.

**NEXT MAN UP:** This season, eight different RedHawks have scored at least 20 or more points in a game. This includes Almar Atlason, Brant Byers, Eian Elmer, Evan Ipsaro (out for the season), Trey Perry, Peter Suder, Kyle Waltz and Antwone Woolfolk.

# NATIONAL & MAC RANKINGS

**YEAR FOUR UNDER STEELE:** Miami set a program record for wins a year ago with 25 and shattered that mark by mid-February this season en route to 31 wins and counting; the RedHawks won their 22nd all-time MAC regular-season title and first since 2005. Miami's offense has rewritten the record books. The RedHawks have made more than 1,000 field goals in a season for the first time in program history and have scored at least 100 points on eight different occasions. Miami has won games this season scoring in the 60s, the 70s, the 80s, the 90s, the 100s, the 110s, the 120s and the 130s. Miami has built on a proud tradition in men's basketball and earned the 1,500th victory in program history on March 6 at Ohio in a 110-108 overtime thriller to cap off a perfect regular season.

**NCAA INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS:** Luke Skaljac ranks fourth in the MAC and 54th nationally in assist/turnover ratio. Skaljac leads the team with a ratio of 2.63. Peter Suder ranks fifth in the MAC and 53rd in the country from the field at 55.4%.

**HOME COURT ADVANTAGE:** Miami has won 31 consecutive games at Millett Hall dating back to November 2024. Miami and Akron are tied for second nationally (Duke, 32) for the longest active home win streak. The RedHawks played in front of 10,000 or more fans in each of their final four home games (including three capacity sellouts) and welcomed four of the five largest crowds in program history to Millett over the final five weeks of the regular season. The RedHawks also haven't lost a road game in more than a year (March 1, 2025) and set new program records for most consecutive road wins overall (15) and in a season (14) this winter.

**AWARD WATCH:** Numerous members of the Red and White have been recognized for their efforts on the court this season. Some of these include:

- Collegeinsider.com announced that Coach Steele has been named a finalist for the Jim Phelan award and the Hugh Durham award. The Jim Phelan award is presented annually to the top head coach in Division I college basketball, while the Hugh Durham award is presented annually to the top mid-major head coach in college basketball.
- The Field of 68 announced that Miami University men's basketball head coach Travis Steele has been named Coach of the Year.
- Silver Waves Media announced its 7th annual Mid Major Assistant Coaches and GM's lists, with Miami associate head coach Jonathan Holmes being named to the list.

# SEASON NUMBERS

**2025-26 ROSTER:** The RedHawks boast six freshmen, one redshirt sophomore, one sophomore, six juniors and three seniors. One of these players is finding a new home in Oxford after transferring to Miami University this season. Miami has seven new players on the 2025-26 roster. Miami also returns 10 players from 2024-25, and behind fourth-year head coach Travis Steele, the men's team is coming off a season that saw the most wins in program history. Below is a small breakdown of some of the new additions.

**ALMAR ATLASON:** The junior sharpshooter from Reykjavik, Iceland joined the RedHawks' program this year via transfer from Bradley University, and the newcomer's skill level is already showing up all over the court. Atlason played in 71 games for the Braves over the past two years, helping Bradley to an impressive 51-21 record over that span, which included a pair of trips to the NIT. He made six three-pointers in a game on two different occasions, including pouring in a career-high 28 points off the bench against Belmont in February 2025. As a rookie, he shot 41% from behind the arc in the 2023-24 campaign and was named to the All-MVC Freshman Team that season. To learn more about his story, [click here!](#)

**JUSTIN KIRBY:** Justin Kirby is a freshman guard from Fishers High School who averaged 13.1 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.1 assists as a senior. He was named an Indiana All-Star in 2024-25 and was a 4A state champion in the 2023-24 season.

**TREY PERRY:** Trey Perry is a local product from Lakota East High School who enters his first year at the guard position. He is a 1,000-point scorer who was named the District 15 Player of the Year after averaging 22.4 points and 4.3 assists per game in his senior season.

**TYLER ROBBINS:** Freshman forward Tyler Robbins attended Upper St. Clair High School where he was a two-time team captain and a two-time WPIAL champion. He earned WPIAL Player of the Year honors in his junior and senior seasons. Robbins also holds the record for most blocks in school history.

**KYLE WALTZ:** Kyle Waltz graduated from York High School in 2024 and attended Spire Academy (post grad year) afterward. He was named All-Conference, Academic All-Conference and to the Daily Herald All-Area Team in 2023-24.

**MAC PRESEASON POLL:** On Tuesday, Oct. 21, the Mid-American Conference released its annual men's basketball preseason coaches poll. Akron was named first in the preseason rankings with 143 points and was followed by **Miami (133)**, Kent State (122), Ohio (108), UMass (98), Toledo (95), Bowling Green (73), Ball State (62), Eastern Michigan (52), Western Michigan (46), Buffalo (37), Central Michigan (31) and Northern Illinois (14). 

Last season, he led the Red and White to a new school record of 25 wins and finished the regular season with the program's most MAC wins (14-4) since 2005-06. The RedHawks secured the second seed in the 2025 MAC Tournament and reached their first MAC Tournament championship game since 2006-07. Miami increased its win total

by 10 from the previous year, the largest single-season turnaround since 1983-84. Steele saw three of his players earn All-MAC honors, including Peter Suder, who received First-Team All-MAC honors (the first since Julian Mavunga in 2012), and Brant Byers, who earned MAC Freshman of the Year (the first since Nike Sibande in 2018).

Steele saw massive improvements from the RedHawks offensively and defensively during the 2024-25 season. The Red and White increased its scoring average from 70.6 in year two to 80.6 points/game in year three (second best points/game in the MAC). Miami led the MAC in team field goal percentage (0.481), team three-point field goal percentage (0.397), turnover margin (2.00) and steals per game (8.00). The RedHawks didn't stop there, as they set program records for total points in a season (2,740), field goals in a season (985), three-point field goals in a season (363) and assists in a season (550).

In year two, Steele returned to the MAC Tournament for the second consecutive season as the RedHawks claimed the seventh seed. Miami won 15 games overall, its most since 2018-19, including nine conference victories (most since the 2020-21 campaign). The RedHawks defeated two NCAA Tournament teams in the 2023-24 season (Vermont and Akron). Under Steele's guidance, Darweshi Hunter and Anderson Mirambeaux earned Honorable Mention All-MAC, while Eian Elmer was named to the MAC All-Freshman Team.

In his debut campaign, Steele led the RedHawks to a 12-20 season and a berth in the MAC Tournament quarterfinals as the No. 8 seed. The Red and White won four consecutive games in February to qualify for the postseason after being picked 11th in the preseason poll, including a 17-point win over rival Ohio in the RedHawks' final home game of the year.

Miami's Mekhi Lairy was tabbed Third Team All-MAC in 2021-22, while newcomer Anderson Mirambeaux was named Honorable Mention All-MAC after his scoring average jumped from 1.5 points per game at Cleveland State to 14.3 ppg as a RedHawk. Rookie guard Ryan Mabrey was also named to the conference's All-Freshman Team.

Lairy finished his career as the program's all-time leader in free throw percentage and games played, and tri-captains Lairy, Mirambeaux and Morgan Safford all ranked among the top 20 scorers in the conference (combining to average 47 points per game).

Steele became the 28th men's basketball head coach in Miami history on March 31, 2022 after completing a four-year stint as the head coach at rival Xavier University. He posted a 70-50 mark with Xavier and led the Musketeers to two postseason berths.

"Travis Steele brings with him an exceptional recruiting pedigree and results," said Director of Athletics David Saylor. "He also brings unmatched energy, a CEO-like-vision for where Miami Basketball can and should go, and a relentless work ethic to match that vision. He is the right person to raise our program to the next level and put us back in the upper echelon of the Mid-American Conference and beyond."

In addition to recruiting two nationally-ranked classes among the top 20 as head coach, each of Steele's student-athletes graduated during his time at Xavier. As an assistant at XU, he also helped secure two top-10 nationally-ranked recruiting classes, made four NCAA Tournament appearances—twice advancing to the Sweet Sixteen—and won a conference championship.

Steele has coached at the high school, AAU, junior college and Division I levels. He has held nearly every role on a staff – from volunteer, to graduate assistant, to assistant coach, to video coordinator, to director of operations to head coach.

He was hired as the director of basketball operations at Xavier in 2008 before being elevated to assistant coach in 2009 and then associate head coach in 2015, and ultimately, head coach in 2018. Prior to Xavier, Steele worked on the staff at Indiana University. He joined the Hoosiers in August of 2006, taking on the duties of video coordinator. He also served as an assistant men's basketball coach at Wabash Valley College (2005-06) and spent a year with the Ohio State basketball program as a graduate manager (2004-05) under Thad Matta.

From 2001-06, Steele was a coach for the Spiece/Indiana Adidas Elite AAU Basketball program. Steele also was an assistant varsity coach at Ben Davis High School while attending Butler University. He earned his undergraduate degree in business from Butler, where he graduated cum laude in marketing in 2004.

Steele, the brother of current University of Akron head coach John Groce, was born Nov. 12, 1981 in Danville, Indiana. He and his wife Amanda reside in Cincinnati with their children, Aspen, Winston, and Anderson.
